REDBIRD RUNDOWN: The defending 2019 NL Central Champion St. Louis Cardinals continue a 12-game homestand tonight with the third game of a four-game series against the division-rival Cincinnati Reds ... St. Louis is in the midst of playing 53 games over the final 44 days of the season, which includes 10 doubleheaders (55 games in 45 days, if necessary).

BACK AT BUSCH: The current 12-game, 11-day Cardinals homestand against the Cincinnati Reds (4G), Kansas City Royals (3G), Pittsburgh Pirates (2G DH), and Cleveland Indians (3G) is the club's longest since playing a 13-game, 14-day homestand from May 26-June 8, 2003 at Busch Stadium II ... The last time St. Louis played 12 or more consecutive home dates without an off day was from June 25-July 7, 2002 (13 straight games).

BETTER AT BUSCH: With Thursday night's victory, the Cardinals have defeated the Reds (78-43) and Pirates (78-44) more than any opponent in Busch Stadium III history ... Since Busch Stadium open in 2006, St. Louis' .588 home win pct. ranks the 3rd-best in MLB behind the Yankees (.623) and Dodgers (.602).

YADI PASSES THE WIZARD: Yadier Molina will pass Hall of Famer Ozzie Smith (1982-96) for 3rd all-time in franchise history in games played with 1,991 tonight ... Molina needs three RBI to tie Joe "Ducky" Medwick (923) for 8th all-time in Cardinals history and two more doubles to tie Johnny Bench (381) for 8th all-time among primary catchers in MLB history ... Molina is 11 hits shy of tying Red Schoendienst (1,980) for 6th in Cardinals history, and is 31 hits away from becoming the 11th primary catcher in MLB history to reach 2,000 career hits.

DANGEROUS LIMITS: Until last night, the Cardinals had never allowed four or more runs and two or fewer hits and took a loss (since 1901). St. Louis' pitching staff leads Major League Baseball with the lowest opponent batting average at .184 this season. The Cardinals have allowed 57 runs with 54.4% of those scores coming via home run (31). Last night, the Cardinals held the Reds to two hits in the loss, their first loss limiting their opponent to two hits or less since July 7, 2019, at San Francisco (1-0).

MILLER THRILLER: Since making his debut as a member of the Cardinals last Saturday (8/15-present), Brad Miller has not gone more than one game without recording an RBI and is T-4th in MLB over that period with teammate Matt Carpenter. The two have 10 RBI during the stretch and trail former Cardinal Randal Grichuk (TOR, 14), Fernando Tatis, Jr. (SD, 11), son of former Cardinals third baseman, Fernando Tatis, and Jose Abreu (CWS, 11). Miller had 25 RBI in 79 games last season and already has 10 RBI in nine games this season.

WALK-OFF INFO: The Cardinals' last three regular season walk-off wins have been against the Reds (Aug. 31-G2, 2019, Sept. 1-G1, 2019, Aug. 20, 2020) ... St. Louis walked off on four occasions last season ... Thursday night was Kolten Wong's 5th career walk-off hit (deep flyball single against five-man infield) and his first that wasn't a homer ... Since 1916, Stan Musial's 20 career walk-off RBI are most in franchise history, while Yadier Molina and Matt Carpenter tie for the active team lead (T17th all-time) with 7 ... Albert Pujols (8) is Busch Stadium's walk-off RBI leader, followed by Carpenter (7) ... St. Louis has walked off the Cubs (16) most in Busch III history, followed by the Pirates (13) and Reds (12).

LOAD'EM UP: Despite playing several fewer games than the rest of Major League Baseball, the Cardinals rank T6th with eight hits in bases loaded situations. The Cardinals rank 3rd in MLB in bases loaded batting average (.444, 8-for-18) and on-base pct. (.500), with Milwaukee leading the way (.467 BA, 8-15).

THE BAKERS DOZEN: Johan Oviedo joined Jesus Cruz, Ricardo Sánchez, Nabil Crismatt, John Nogowski, Roel Ramírez, Seth Elledge, Rob Kaminsky, Dylan Carlson, Jake Woodford, Max Schrock, Kwang Hyun Kim and Kodi Whitley as the 13th Cardinal to make a Major League debut this season on Wednesday at Chicago (11th during the road trip), surpassing Miami for most in MLB...eight Cardinals made MLB debuts in 2019, while this year's crew are the club's most since 1997 (T-7th-most in franchise history).

COME ON DOWN!: Twenty-five Cardinals have pitched in the first 15 games, already surpassing their total of 23 from the entire 162 game schedule in 2019 (including Jedd Gyorko) ... The group of Cardinals pitchers rank 3rd in MLB behind the Marlins (30) and Pirates (26).

BIRD BYTES: Kolten Wong dropped his first bunt base hit of the season last night (27th career), leading the Cardinals since his debut in 2013 and ranking T-16th in MLB over that period (leader: Dee Gordon, 71) ... Paul Goldschmidt has walked in six straight games, currently tied with Kevin Pillar (BOS) for the longest active in MLB and three behind his career high (2014, ARI) and the season leader (Carlos Santana, 9).

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (August 22): 1982: Third-string catcher Glenn Brummer steals home with two strikes and two outs in the 12th inning to give the Cardinals a 5-4 walk-off win over the visiting San Francisco Giants at Busch Stadium.

CINCINNATI CONNECTIONS

Daniel Ponce de Leon (38th round in 2012) and Tyler Webb (48th round in 2011) were both selected by the Reds, but did not sign.

Daniel Ponce de Leon (July 23, 2018 at GABP) and Alex Reyes (August 9, 2016 at Busch) made their MLB debuts vs. Cincinnati.

Mike Maddux was born in Dayton, Ohio...originally selected by the Reds in the 36th round of the 1979 MLB draft, but did not sign to attend the University of Texas at El Paso.

Cardinals broadcaster and Hall of Famer Jim Edmonds played 13 games for the Reds during his final professional season in 2010.

David Bell previously served as a Cardinals assistant hitting (2014) and bench coach (2015-17)...played parts of four seasons with St. Louis (1995-98)...traded by Cleveland with Pepe McNeal and Rick Heiser to the Cardinals for Ken Hill (July 27, 1995).

Reds Executive Advisor to the CEO Walt Jocketty served as the Cardinals GM for 13 seasons (1995-2007)...during tenure, the Cardinals compiled seven NL Central Division championships (1996, 2000-02, '04-06), two NL Championships ('04, '06), and one World Series Championship ('06)...named MLB Executive of the Year (2000, '04, '10).

Cardinals Hall of Famer Scott Rolen played his final four seasons in a Reds uniform (2009-12), where he was a 2010 Gold Glove Award winner and two-time All-Star (2010-11).

Cardinals Hall of Famer Vince Coleman played in 33 games for the Reds in 1996.

Reds Assistant Hitting Coach Joe Mather was selected by the Cardinals in the 3rd round of the 2001 MLB draft...played parts of two seasons with St. Louis (2008, '10).

Reds Bullpen Coach Lee Tunnell pitched in 32 games for St. Louis in 1987.

Reds first base coach Delino DeShields played two seasons with St. Louis (1997-98).

Reds broadcaster Jeff Brantley pitched in 48 games for St. Louis in 1998.

Reds Special Asst. to the GM Marty Maier spent 24 seasons with St. Louis as an area scout, Latin American coordinator, asst. director of scouting, scouting director and special asst. to the GM.

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Office William DeWitt Jr. was a prior owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals...his father, William O. DeWitt, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Reds CEO Robert Castellini, Chairman W. Joseph Williams Jr. and Vice Chairman Thomas Williams were Cardinals investors from 1995-2006...interests were sold as a condition of their acquisition of a controlling ownership stake of the Reds.

- Was moved into the starting rotation following the injury to Miles Mikolas (right forearm strain) and Carlos Martínez placed on the Injured List.

- Made his 300th career professional appearance, with 298 coming in the Korea Baseball Organization (KBO).
- Started the game with three scoreless innings before giving up his only run of the game via a Ian Happ home run to lead-off the 4th inning.
- Became the only player from South Korea to start a game in franchise history.

2019 SEASON

- Named the Korea Baseball Organization "Best Pitcher" (equivalent to MLB's Cy Young Award) with the SK Wyverns posting a 17-6 record with a 2.51 ERA in 30 starts (31 app.) and 180 strikeouts over 190.1 innings pitched.
- Led the KBO in quality starts (24) while ranking 2nd in wins (17); and 3rd in ERA (2.51) and innings pitched (190.1).
- Struck out a season-high 10 batters (5.0 IP) vs. Hanwha (5/9) and a season-high 8.0 innings vs. Kiwoom (8/8).
- Was 13-1 with a 2.30 ERA in 16 road appearances during the 2019 KBO season with SK Wyverns. Earned 13 of his 17 wins last season on the road.

CAREER

- Made his debut in 2007 as an 18-year old rookie with the SK Wyverns of the Korea Baseball Organization (KBO) and was 3-7 with a 3.62 in 20 appearances (13 starts).
- Named the 2008 KBO Most Valuable Player leading the league with 16 wins and 150 strikeouts in just his second professional season, beginning the season as a 19-year old.
- Pitched 12 professional seasons (2007-16, '18-19) over 13 years in the KBO, missing the 2017 season due to an injury requiring Tommy John surgery.
- Compiled a career record of 136-77 with a 3.29 ERA over 298 career appearances (276 starts) in the KBO.
- Four-time KBO Series Champion with the SK Wyverns (2007-08, 2010, 2018).
- Won the KBO Gold Glove at the pitching position in 2008.
- Led the KBO in wins twice (2008, 2010), ERA (2009), strikeouts (2008), winning pct (2008) and innings pitched (2010).
- Was a member of the South Korea team in the 2009 World Baseball Classic and was an Olympic Gold Medal winner with South Korea in the 2008 Summer Olympics in Beijing.

- Nickname is "KK".
- His translator's name is Yonsei "Craig" Choi.
- Has stayed in the United States during the 2020 COVID-19 pandemic and conditioned during the off time with Cardinals veteran pitcher, Adam Wainwright, at his home in St. Louis.
- His family (wife Sang Hee, daughter Minjoo, son Minjae) reside in Incheon, South Korea and have remained there since the outbreak.
