**RAY REPORT**—The Rays continue a seven-game road trip against the Red Sox (1-1, two to play) and the Blue Jays (three to play) this afternoon at Fenway Park...they have won seven of their last eight, 13 of 15, and 23 of 31...since April 4, their 3.00 ERA is the best in the majors and their 23-8 (.742) record trails only the Cubs (24-8/.750)...are 7-1 on a stretch of 13 games in as many days (May 1-13), the final leg in a stretch of 28 games in a 30-day window (April 14–May 13)...own MLB's fourth-best record behind the Cubs (27-12), Yankees (26-13), and Braves (26-13)...are off to their fourth-best start in franchise history (see table on the right)...are 0.5 GB the Yankees for first in the AL East, spending 25 straight days in first or second since April 14...have spent six days leading the division, 25 in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth.

- ✦ The Rays fell, 2-0, to the Red Sox last night...the result snapped a season-best seven-game winning streak...it was the first time the club had been shut out since Sept. 23, 2025 at BAL (6-0)...the run of 42 consecutive games with at least one run scored was the ninth-longest streak since **Kevin Cash** became manager in 2015.
- ✦ The loss ended a 7-0 start to the season against divisional foes and a 7-0 start to the month of May...according to Stats Perform, the seven-game winning streak to start the season against AL East opposition was the longest in franchise history, and the 7-0 start to May was the second-most to begin a month in franchise history behind April 2023 (12G).
- ✦ Prior to last night, the Rays were one of three teams in the majors yet to be shut out this season, alongside the Orioles and Twins.
- ✦ Rays pitching has allowed three earned runs or less in a franchise record 15 straight games (April 22–pres.) – see "The Ray Way" note below for more.
- ✦ The Rays are the eighth AL club in the modern era (since 1900) to begin a season 17-3 or better against intraleague opponents, and the first since the 2023 Rays (17-3)...only the 2018 Red Sox (17-3) and 2003 Yankees (17-3) have also turned the trick since 1988.
- ✦ **Nick Martinez** (35.277) takes the mound today looking for a win in his fourth straight start (April 22–pres.)...he would become the oldest pitcher in franchise history to accomplish the feat, surpassing **Charlie Morton** (May 25–June 10, 2019 - 35.210).

**RECENT TRANSACTIONS**—Today, the Rays selected the contract of **RHP Aaron Brooks** from Triple-A Durham and have optioned **RHP Mason Englert** to Durham...to make room on the 40-man roster, **OF Justyn-Henry Malloy** has been designated for assignment.

✦ Brooks was signed to a minor league contract on April 25 after making one start for Caliente De Durango in the Mexican Baseball League...across six major league seasons since 2014, he has made 57 appearances (32 starts) with a 6.36 ERA (206.2IP, 146ER), 142 strikeouts, and 63 walks with Oakland (2024, 2018-19, 2015), St. Louis (2022), Baltimore (2019), and Kansas City (2014-15).

**THE RAY WAY**—The Rays staff has yielded three earned runs or fewer in a franchise-record 15 consecutive games...in the live ball era (since 1920), only 15 AL clubs have produced such a streak of 15 games or longer with the last being the 2022 Astros (15G) en route to a World Series title...extending the streak to 16 games today would mark the second time a club has done so since 1994, joining the 2010 Giants (18G, Sept. 5-24) who went on to lift the Commissioner's Trophy...the Rays have permitted 23 runs during the streak, fewest over any 15-game stretch in franchise history...the 2025 Guardians are the last team and only team to do so since 2018, accomplishing it twice between Sept. 6-20 (G2) (22R) and Sept. 5-20 (G1) (23R)...the fewest runs allowed over any 16-game span in club history is 27 (July 22–Aug. 9, 2012)...the Rays have held opponents to one or zero runs 10 times, tied with the Tigers for most in MLB, and have gone 10-0 in those games.

- ✦ The rotation's 3.15 ERA (191.1IP, 67ER) ranks third in the majors behind the Dodgers (2.95) and Yankees (3.09)...this includes an MLB-best 1.68 ERA (80.1IP, 15ER) in their last 15 outings (April 22–pres.).
- ✦ The Rays bullpen has allowed two runs over their last 47.2 innings...the pen's 1.01 ERA (53.2IP, 6ER) over the last 15 games since April 22 is the best in MLB, ahead of the Yankees (2.10)...all other major league bullpens over that span have allowed more than double the Rays 6 ER.
- ✦ **Jesse Scholtens** was tagged for 2 HR last night on the heels of the pitching staff surrendering 1 HR over their previous 78.0 innings.

**SOUTHPAW SUCCESS**—The Rays 9-2 record vs. left-handed starting pitchers is the best in the majors...their loss last night was the first against a starting southpaw since Opening Day against STL Matthew Libatore...since that loss they produced a nine game winning streak against lefties, their longest streak since May 21–June 26, 2004 (10G)...the club has the lowest whiff rate against southpaws in the majors at 18.0 pct., missing on 150 of 833 swings.

- ✦ **Yandy Diaz** is 11-for-36 (.306) vs. LHP, 11th best in the AL (min. 35AB)...over his career he has hit 307 (306-for-997) against lefties with an OPS of .898.
- ✦ **Ryan Vilade** has batted .297 (11-for-37) vs. LHP in 2026 and .379 (11-for-29) since April 11...over that span his .379 average is tied for third best in the AL with BOS **Wilyer Abreu** and behind only ATH **Shea Langeliers** (.433) and CWS **Chase Meidroth** (.385).

**THE MILLENNIUM MAN**—**Yandy Diaz** became the 20th Cuban-born player in major league history with 1,000 hits in his career on Thursday night with a ground-rule double...it also marked his 284th XBH as a Ray, surpassing **Carlos Peña** for seventh most in team history...additionally, it was his second hit of the game and registered his 272nd multi-hit game as a Ray, tying **Ben Zobrist** for third most in franchise history behind **Carl Crawford** (444G) and **Evan Longoria** (375G).

- ✦ He has 104 HR in his tenure with Tampa Bay, tied with **Carl Crawford** for seventh most in franchise history.
- ✦ Diaz is batting an MLB-best .560 (14-for-25) in the 8th inning or later...min. 50 AB, his .367 (84-for-229) average in such situations since the start of 2024 is the best in the majors, ahead of KC **Bobby Witt Jr.** (.360).

**ARANDA WORLD**—**Jonathan Aranda** in the month of May is batting .444 (12-for-27) with 1 2B, 4 RBI, 2 R, 1 HBP, and a .998 OPS...his OPS this month is the ninth best among AL hitters (min. 25AB)...his 29 RBI this season are tied for the most in the AL with NYY **Aaron Judge**, CWS **Munetaka Murakami**, and HOU **Yordan Alvarez**...26 of his 29 RBI have come against right-handers, most in the AL.

- ✦ He went 11-for-19 (.579) with 1 2B and 4 RBI last homestand, including a career-high-tying four straight multi-hit games between May 2-5 (also: May 26-29, 2025)...min. 20 AB, it marked the third-highest average by a Ray in a single homestand behind **Yandy Diaz** (.591, Sept. 15-21, 2025) and Greg Norton (.588, Aug. 15-24, 2006) from Sept. 15-21, 2025 (Elias).

**THE GREAT GREEN JEWEL OF THE COMMONWEALTH**—The Rays and Red Sox continue a 13-game season series today, with the clubs meeting again in Boston after the All-Star break on July 17-19 (3G) and at Tropicana Field between June 8-10 (3G) and Sept. 18-20 (3G)...despite outscoring the Red Sox, 59-58, in their meetings last year, the Rays were 3-10 in those contests and 0-5 in one-run games.

- ✦ **Yandy Diaz** has tallied 104 hits against the Red Sox in his time with the Rays, third most by any Ray in club history behind **Evan Longoria** (184) and **Carl Crawford** (181)...he has also reached base at a .415 clip in his 85 career games against the club, third best in team history (min. 50PA), behind **Wade Boggs** (.422) and **Brandon Guyer** (.421)...Diaz has reached base in each of his last 16 contests (Sept. 28, 2024–pres.) against the Red Sox and has slashed .367/.451/.550 (22-for-60) over that span.
- ✦ **Taylor Walls** has reached base safely in each of his last 11 games against Boston (April 14, 2025–pres.)...over that span he has hit .237 (9-for-38) with 3 RBI and 4 R...the stretch included an eight-game hitting streak between April 15–July 13, 2025.

**A RIVERDAWG**—Less than a week after being named Pitcher of the Month for April by Rays Player Development, **Aidan Cremarosa** spun a no-hitter last night for Class-A Charleston...over 9.0 innings he allowed one walk with 11 strikeouts on 101 pitches...he kept a perfect game through 7.2 innings before issuing the walk...it was the first 9.0-inning complete game no-hitter in the full-season minor leagues since Aug. 19, 2022 by **Daniel Gossett** with Double-A Wichita, the 11th such game at the Class-A level since 2015, and the first by a RiverDog since at least 2005.

**TODAY'S START**—Nick Martinez will make his eighth start with the Rays and fifth on the road...marks his 288th career appearance (137th start) and 10th opposite the Red Sox (6th start)...is seeking a team-high fifth quality start of the campaign...enters his ninth major league season and first with the Rays...signed as a free agent on Feb. 10, 2026.

- ✦ Ranks third among AL qualifiers with a 1.71 ERA and fourth in MLB.
- ✦ At 35 years and 277 days, Martinez is the third-oldest AL arm since the start of the Wild Card era (since 1995) to log a 1.71 ERA or lower in their first seven starts to begin the season, younger than only HOU Justin Verlander (2x, 1.13ERA in 2018 & 1.38ERA in 2022) and NYY David Cone (1.33ERA in 1999).
- ✦ With a win today, he would become the oldest Ray in franchise history to win four straight games.

**LAST TIME OUT**—Earned his third straight win after allowing one earned run over 5.0 innings on May 4 vs. TOR (5.0IP, 3H, BB, 4SO)...has allowed two runs or fewer in each of his seven starts to begin the season...became the 10th Ray in club history to do so (last: Shawn Armstrong, March 31–July 28, 2024) and the first starter in the majors age 35-or-older to turn the trick since Jon Lester (March 28–May 12, 2019) did so with the Cubs.

- ✦ Martinez (35.272) is the second-oldest pitcher in franchise history to win three straight starts (April 22–pres.) behind Corey Kluber (36.146, Aug. 23–Sept. 3, 2022).
- ✦ Martinez has allowed two runs or fewer in each of his seven starts to begin the season...he is the second pitcher age 35 or older in Rays history to turn the trick in seven starts or more, joining Rich Hill (8GS, April 26–June 5, 2021)...it marks the longest active such streak in the majors and the longest since Chris Sale threw eight straight starts between May 15–Sept. 5, 2025.
- ✦ His 1.71 ERA (42.0IP, 8ER) through his first seven starts with the franchise is the best in club history by a traditional starter...it is the fourth-best ERA to start a season by a Rays traditional starter and best since Tyler Glasnow's 1.47 ERA between March 30–May 3, 2019.

**LOVE THAT DIRTY WATER**—The veteran right-hander is 1-3 with a 5.80 ERA (35.2IP, 23ER) and 22 strikeouts in nine career appearances (five starts) opposite the Red Sox...in his last start at Fenway Park, on July 2, 2025, he went 6.2 innings, allowing four earned runs on nine hits (1HR), with two strikeouts.

- ✦ Martinez is 7-10 with a 5.51 ERA (150.1IP, 92ER) and 87 strikeouts in 23 career starts vs. AL East opponents...he has pitched to a 1.86 ERA (9.2IP, 2ER) with eight strikeouts across two starts against AL East opponents this season (April 11 vs. NYY & May 4 vs. TOR).
- ✦ In three career starts at Fenway Park, he is 1-2 with a 7.88 ERA (16.0IP, 14ER) and 7 SO, receiving two runs of support or more in all three starts.
- ✦ Martinez made one appearance in the historic Cape Cod Baseball League for the Falmouth Commodores in 2011, allowing one earned run across 2.0 innings with three strikeouts against the Brewster Whitecaps on June 10, 2010...played alongside future major leaguers Tyler Duffey, Kent Emanuel, Andrew Heaney, and Spencer Kieboom with Falmouth.

**CHANGE UP THE PACE**—Martinez has posted a .119 (5-for-42) opp. average against his changeup this season with a slugging pct. of .143...min. 30 AB, his opp. average is the fourth-best in the AL behind CLE Tanner Bibee (.074/2-for-27), TB Shane McClellan (.100/4-for-40), and LAA Walbert Ureña (.107/3-for-28)...of those five hits on Martinez's changeups, none of them have been barreled...his 33.3 whiff rate on the pitch is the 11th best in the AL under the same criteria.

**WHOLE LOTTA RED**—Martinez ranks highly in multiple MLB pitching rankings, according to Baseball Savant...his Pitching Run Value (12), Fastball Run Value (9), and Offspeed Run Value (5) are all in the 99th percentile, an improvement from his -2 Pitching Run Value, 0 Fastball Run Value, and -2 Offspeed Run Value in 2025.

- ✦ Since the start of 2023, Martinez's 31.9 pct. hard-hit rate is second lowest in the majors (min. 1000BF) behind NYY Ryan Yarbrough (30.0 pct.).
- ✦ Opposing hitters have an average 86.8 mph exit velocity since the beginning of 2023, the fourth lowest in the majors during that span (min. 1,000PA) behind LAA Kyle Hendricks (85.8), SD Michael King (86.5), and NYY Max Fried (86.6).

**NO FREE 90S**—Since the start of 2024, Martinez has issued only 70 walks, good for the sixth-lowest walks per 9.0 innings (1.80) in the majors during that stretch (min. 250.0IP)...the veteran right-hander trails only SEA Bryan Woo (1.45), DET Tarik Skubal (1.55), SEA George Kirby (1.56), CHC Shota Imanaga (1.65), and WSH Zack Littell (1.80) during that span.

**NOT JUST QUALITY**—On April 28 at CLE, Martinez became the oldest Ray to turn in consecutive ultra quality starts (7.0IP or more with 2ER or fewer) in franchise history (April 22–28) and the oldest pitcher to turn the trick since HOU Justin Verlander registered five straight ultra quality starts (May 10–June 1, 2019).

- ✦ The last Ray to record back-to-back ultra quality starts was Taj Bradley between May 27–June 1, 2025.

**SOFT CONTACT KING**—Among qualified pitchers last season, Martinez's 34.5 pct. hard-hit rate tied MIL Freddy Peralta for the fifth lowest in the majors, higher than only HOU Hunter Brown (32.2%), DET Tarik Skubal (33.0%), CIN Andrew Abbott (33.7%), and LAA Kyle Hendricks (34.3%).

- ✦ He also ranked fourth among qualified AL pitchers in barrel pct. (6.9%) behind only Brown (5.9%), ATH Luis Severino (6.0%), and HOU Framber Valdez (6.7%).
