AROUND THE HORN

PRESIDENT'S CIRCLE GRANTS: During a special pregame ceremony last Friday, **Derrick Hall** and the Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation celebrated the 63 Arizona nonprofits awarded with \$309,000 in Derrick Hall President's Circle Grants at the end of 2025... established in 1998 and renamed in 2024 in honor of Derrick Hall, whose long-standing leadership has helped expand the club's statewide community impact, the program has awarded a total of \$7.3 million in grants.

HERE'S THE STORY: D-backs starters have allowed 1 or fewer runs in 6 of the last 7 games and own a MLB-best 1.51 ERA in that span, ahead of the Braves (1.78).

- In the span, the D-backs lead MLB in quality starts (1st, 6), innings (1st, 47.2), innings/GM (1st, 6.2), OBP (1st, .235), OPS (1st, .510), WHIP (1st, 0.71), opponent AVG (2nd, .162) and runs (2nd, 8).
- The D-backs starters have 7 straight starts of 6.0+ innings for the first time since Sept. 9-16, 2017.
- The D-backs starters have a franchise-high-tying 4 consecutive starts of 6.0+ innings, 1 or fewer runs and 4 or fewer hits.
- **Ketel Marte** tonight, with his 1,093rd game as a D-back, will pass Paul Goldschmidt for second-most games in club history, to Luis Gonzalez (1,194).
- The D-backs are 15-4 (.789) when leading after 5.0 innings, including 6-3 (.667) on the road.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 1-0 @ Rangers last night.

- **Michael Soroka** improved to a team-best 5-2 after tossing 6.1 scoreless innings, his eighth career game with 6.0+ shutout innings and first since June 6, 2025 vs. Rangers while with the Nationals.
 - Sixth career game with 6.0+ shutout innings with fewer than 90 pitches (last: June 6, 2025 vs. Rangers).
 - After a leadoff walk in the second inning, Soroka retired 11 consecutive batters and 17 of 18 to finish his start (single in sixth inning).
- **Geraldo Perdomo** knocked in the D-backs' lone run with his RBI double in the first inning.
- **Corbin Carroll** reached base 3 times and scored the eventual game-winner (1-for-2, 2B, 2 BB).
- **Brandyn Garcia** (0.2 IP), **Taylor Clarke** (1.0 IP) and **Paul Sewald** (1.0 IP) combined for 2.2 scoreless innings with 1 hit, 0 walks and 2 strikeouts.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs acquired Minor League OF **Jose Requena** from the Dodgers for OF **Alek Thomas**.

LOGGING INNINGS: D-backs starters have logged 7 straight starts of 6.0+innings, the longest active streak in MLB, for the first time since logging 8 straight from Sept. 9-16, 2017.

STARTERS DEALING: D-backs starters, for the fifth time all-time, have a franchise-high-tying 4 consecutive starts of 6.0+ innings, 1 or fewer runs and 4 or fewer hits (also: June 1-5, 2009; July 23-26, 2015; Sept. 3-6, 2017; July 5-12, 2019).

- The Dodgers (April 13-17) are the only other club in MLB this season with a 4-game streak...the 2019 Athletics are the last team to record 5 consecutive (March 28-April 1).

CLOSE IT OUT: **Paul Sewald** (9 SV) is 1 of 3 closers in MLB with 8+ saves who are perfect in save opportunities (also: Mason Miller/SD (12 SV) and Aroldis Chapman/BOS (8 SV)).

ROLLIN' NOLAN: **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 16 of his last 17 starts, hitting .370 (20-for-54)/1.061 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 homers, 7 RBI and 9 walks, including 8 games reaching base 2+ times.

- Since April 21, ranks among MLB third basemen [min. 60 PA] in OPS (1st, 1.043), OBP (1st, .462), AVG (2nd, .364), SLG (3rd, .582), hits (T-4th, 20), runs (T-4th, 12) and homers (T-5th, 3).

ROAD SNAKES: **Ildemaro Vargas** has hit safely in 13 of his 15 road games at a .349 clip (22-for-63)/.839 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer, 5 RBI and 3 walks.

- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base in his last 8 road games, hitting .333 (10-for-30)/.912 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 4 RBI and 4 walks, including 3 multi-hits.
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has hit safely in 4 of his last 5 road games at a .368 clip (7-for-19)/.821 OPS with 1 double, 1 RBI and 1 walk, including 3 multi-hits.

¡BRAVO MORILLO! **Juan Morillo** has allowed 1 run over his last 10 games, going 1-0 with 1 save, a 0.84 ERA (1 ER in 10.2 IP), opponent .111 AVG, 0.47 WHIP, 1 walk and 14 strikeouts.

- Has not allowed a hit or walk to a righty in his last 8 games (0-for-12, 14 BF) with 3 strikeouts.

PEN SPOTLIGHT: In their last 10 games, since May 1, the D-backs own a NL-best 1.35 ERA (5 R-4 ER in 26.3 IP), ahead of the Padres (1.55) and Brewers (2.01)...rank second in MLB to the Rays (0.94).

- In their last 10 games, the D-backs' bullpen owns a MLB-best opponent .126 AVG (11-for-87), .419 OPS and 0.71 WHIP with 8 walks, 21 strikeouts and no home runs.

VS. RANGERS: The D-backs are 10-5 in their last 15 matchups and have won 3 straight series, including their last on the road from Aug. 11-13, 2025 (2-1).

- The D-backs are 9-6 in their last 15 road games @ Rangers.

- **Ketel Marte** has homered in 5 of his last 8 games, including 4 straight from Aug. 12-Sept. 2, 2025.

- Has reached base in 8 straight games, hitting .394 (13-for-33)/1.384 OPS with 3 doubles, 5 homers, 14 RBI and 2 walks.

- **Gerardo Perdomo** is hitting a career .364 (16-for-44)/1.063 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers, 7 RBI and 3 walks over 13 games.
