THE TWINS: After completing their three-game homestand with a 2-1 series victory against
the Royals over the weekend, the Twins began their three-game roadtrip with consecutive
losses în the Bronxtonight, they will play the three-game series finale at Yankee Stadium
after tonight's game, Minnesota will travel home to play a seven-game, eight-day homestand
with four against the Tigers from Thursday-Sundaythey will enjoy an off-day on Monday,
I then host the Athletics for three games trom next Tijesday-Thursday

**NEW CHAPTER, SAME STORY:** The Twins lost to the Yankees last night in the Bronx by a score of 9-1, losing the series, making them 16-21-2 in series play this season...Travis Adams (1-2) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing four runs on four hits in 2.1 innings pitched...all four of Adams' runs allowed came on home runs from Aaron Judge (solo) and Anthony Volpe (3-run)...the offense recorded one hit, an Austin Martin leadoff single in the first inning...the only run was scored on a Royce Lewis fielder's choice, scoring Martin a few batters later...Minnesota was one-hit for the first time since May 7, 2023 at Cleveland.

EMPIRE STATE OF MIND: The Twins and Yankees are playing the third of six games in 2025... Minnesota will host the Yankees for three games from September 15-17...Minnesota has lost nine straight against the Yankees, seeking their first win over New York since a 6-2 victory on April 25, 2023 at Target Field...prior to this stretch, they had gone 5-2 vs. the Yankees from September of 2022-April of 2023.

■ Minnesota is 0-7 at Yankee Stadium dating back to April of 2023, their last win here coming on April 14, 2023, a 4-3 victory...prior to this slide, they won three-straight in the Bronx.

LONG HAIR DON'T CARE: Luke Keaschall has hit .345 (10-for-29) with three doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, a .655 slugging percentage and a 1.000 OPS in seven games since returning from the Injured List...he has hit safely in 11 of 14 games to begin his career, hitting .354 (17-for-48) with six doubles, two home runs, 12 RBI, five walks, five stolen bases, a .436 on-base percentage, a .604 slugging percentage and a 1.041 OPS.

The strike outs were April 19 at Atlanta vs. Chris Sale and Raisel Iglesias, Sunday vs. Ryan Bergert, Monday night vs. Will Warren and last night vs. Carlos Rodón.

JEFF YEA: Over his last 26 games, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .362 (34-for-94) with seven doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI, five walks, a .412 on-base percentage, a .500 slugging percentage and a .912 OPS.

◆In that same span, he is hitting .417 (24-for-58) off fastballs, fourth-best in baseball (minimum of 200 fastballs seen), trailing Luis Rengifo (.451), Giancarlo Stanton (.429) and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.421).

**BREAKING BROOMS:** Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the fifth time this season...the other four were in three games at St. Louis (March 27-30), three games at Atlanta (April 18-20), three games at Houston (June 13-15) and three games vs. Milwaukee (June 20-22).

(June 20-22).

◆ Other than those four sweeps, the Twins have entered a finale down 0-2 and avoided a sweep five times this season: April 13 vs. Detroit, June 8 vs. Toronto, June 19 at Cincinnati, July 20 at Colorado and August 3 at Cleveland.

◆ Twins have been swept four times in their last seven series at Yankee Stadium since 2017.

FOUR-POINT BUCK: Byron Buxton hit his 24th home run on Monday night and is now four short of his single-season career-high of 28, hit in 2022...he is on pace to finish with 32 home runs.

◆ Since June 17, he has homered nine times in 16 road games, tied for fifth-most in baseball during that span...since that date, he has homered in five different road series' four at Cincinnati (June 17-19), two at Detroit (June 27-29), none at Miami (July 1-3), one at Colorado (July 18-21), one at Los Angeles-NL (July 21-23) and one Monday night at New York-AL.

◆ He has a 13.83 at-bat-per-home run ratio, fourth-best in the AL and seventh-best in baseball, trailing Cal Raleigh (9.80), Aaron Judge (10.47), Kyle Schwarber (10.50), Shohei Ohtani (10.72), Eugenio Suárez (11.57) and Junior Caminero (13.64).

◆ Over his last 38 games, Buxton is hitting 310 (44-for-142) with eight doubles, one triple, 14 home runs, 22 RBI, 32 runs scored, 13 walks, a .373 on-base percentage, a .676 slugging percentage and a 1.049 OPS.

FLY ON THE WALLNER: Matt Wallner homered on Saturday vs. Kansas City...it marked Wallner's 16th of the season, extending his single-season career-high — entered the year with 14 as his career-high in 2023...he now has five home runs in his last 12 games...since July 1, he has nine home runs, tied for 11th-most in the AL.

♣ Over his last 18 games, Wallner has reached base safely in 15 games, posting a .406 on-base percentage (14 hits, 13 walks), a .667 slugging percentage and a 1.072 OPS in that span.

TREVOLUTION: Trevor Larnach has homered three times in his last five games, all on the road — two in Detroit on August 4 and 5 and one Monday night…over his last eight games overall, Larnach is hitting .308 (8-for-26) with three home runs, six RBI, two walks, a .379 on-base percentage, a .654 slugging percentage and a 1.033 OPS.

♣ Larnach's home run on Monday night was his 16th of the season, setting a new single-season career-high, passing his previous high of 15 in 2024…also, he sits at 92 hits (also last season), one more will set a new career-high.

FARM REPORT: MLB.com released updated farm system rankings yesterday as the Twins checked in at number two, behind Los Angeles-NL...Minnesota began the season ranked at number 10...they now have five players ranked in the top 100: outfielder Walker Jenkins (14), catcher Eduardo Tait (54), infielder Luke Keaschall (64), outfielder Emmanuel Rodriguez (72) and infielder Kaelen Culpepper (77).

◆ Saturday: Enjoy 612 Saturday presented by Carbliss; a special celebration honoring the 60th anniversary of the 1965 American League Champion Twins, Minnesota's first pennant winners — including appearances from Twins Hall of Famers Jim Kaat, Tony Oliva and Jim Perry; and a fan photo opportunity with 2025 Twins Hall of Fame electee Corey Koskie.

◆ Sunday: The Twins will induct Corey Koskie into the Twins Hall of Fame...24 Twins Hall of Famers are scheduled to be on hand to celebrate the former third baseman, who helped lead Minnesota to three-straight American League Central Division titles (2002-04).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Last started on August 1 at Cleveland, opposite Gavin Williams, but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-3, 10-inning walk-off loss...allowed two runs on five hits over 6.0 innings, with one walk and four strikeouts...surrendered leadoff single to Steven Kwan, who scored on José Ramírez's one-out RBI single; marked just the fifth first-inning run allowed by Ryan this season...in the second, Carlos Santana singled and scored on Brayan Rocchio's RBI single...retired 12-straight from the second-sixth innings...marked his 12th quality start of the season.

• Allowed five-or-more hits in six-straight games for the third time in his career...did so in six-straight from June 19-July 21, 2024 and in eight-straight from June 27-August 23, 2023.

**600 CLUB:** Ryan's 602.2 career innings pitched make him the 38th pitcher in Twins history to reach the 600.0 IP mark; Glen Perkins ranks 37th with 624.1 innings pitched...his 602.2 IP are the 14th most all-time among Twins pitchers (1961-) through their first 107 career games...among Twins pitchers with 600.0-or-more innings pitched through their first 107 career games, Ryan's 671 strikeouts are the most; Bert Blyleven is the next closest with 606 K in 754.2 IP...also, his .587 win percentage ranks first, his 134 walks rank second and his 3.67 ERA ranks third.

**FACING THE YANKEES:** In four career starts against New York-AL, is 2-2 with a 3.86 ERA (23.1 IP, 10 ER), five walks and 25 strikeouts...took the loss in his last outing vs. Yanks on May 16, 2024 at Target Field; allowed four runs on six hits (1 HR), with one walk and five strikeouts over 5.1 innings...on April 13, 2023, struck out 10 batters, his third career double-digit strikeout game at Yankee Stadium.
