**BIRDLAND BITES:** The Orioles continue a stretch of 15 games in 14 days tonight which started with an April 30 doubleheader vs. the Astros...The Birds will play each of the next seven days, including three-game sets against the Athletics and Yankees before enjoying an off-day on May 14.

With a win tonight, Baltimore can earn its second series sweep of 2026 (also 4/6-8 at CWS)...The Birds can earn their second ever sweep of the Marlins, joining a three-game sweep at Camden Yards from July 14-16, 2023...Entering the current series, the O's had never won back-to-back road games against the Marlins since the clubs first met in 1997, but can earn a fourth consecutive victory this evening.

**Taylor Ward** (0-for-2, 3 R, 3 BB) became the first Oriole to score at least three runs and draw at least three walks in the same game since **Chris Davis** on June 1, 2016 vs. Boston (3 R, 4 BB)...He has scored three runs in back-to-back games, becoming the first Oriole to do so since **Gunnar Henderson** (2 G) from June 20-21, 2024...**Roberto Alomar** is the only player in team history (since 1954) to accomplish the feat in three straight, doing so from July 25-27, 1996.

**Adley Rutschman** reached base safely a season-high four times, going 2-for-3 with two doubles, one run, two RBI, one walk, and one hit-by-pitch.

**Brandon Young** made the eighth quality start by an Oriole in 2026...The Birds are 15-9 this season when their starter throws 5.0+ innings.

Baltimore hitters recorded seven walks yesterday and have 17 games this season with 5+ free passes, tied with Milwaukee for second most in MLB behind Chicago-NL (19).

The O's have scored 16 runs over their past two games after scoring 15 over their previous five contests...Baltimore has plated 7+ runs in two straight road games for the first time since August 29-30, 2025...It has not done so in three straight since June 19-21, 2024 (3 G).

**GARCIA'S GREATNESS:** **Rico Garcia** has posted a 0.53 ERA (1 ER/17.0 IP) with 19 strikeouts across 18 appearances...His lone hit allowed is a home run by KC's Michael Massey on April 21.

His .020 (1-for-51) opponent average and 0.41 WHIP are the best among all MLB relievers, outpacing MIA's John King (.063, 3-for-48) and SEA's Matt Brash (0.44 WHIP), respectively.

Prior to Garcia's current run, the fewest number of hits allowed by an Oriole through their first 18 outings of a season was four (**Jesse Orosco**, 1997).

He has yet to allow a hit in each of his eight home appearances to open the 2026 campaign, one of three Oriole pitchers in franchise history to accomplish the feat along with **Bryan Baker** (9 G, 2023) and **Shawn Armstrong** (8 G, 2019).

**POLAR BEAR PETE:** **Pete Alonso** has hit safely in a season-high seven straight games, batting .360 (9-for-25) with four doubles, three home runs, 10 runs, and eight RBI during that stretch.

He has an extra-base hit in seven of his last nine games, posting a 1.271 OPS in that time.

He has 57 extra-base hits opposite Miami since making his MLB debut in 2019, the most by any player in MLB against a single opponent during that period, outpacing CLE's José Ramírez's 55 extra-base hits against Detroit.

Alonso's 33 career home runs opposite the Marlins are third most among all active players, trailing LAD's Freddie Freeman (42) and PHI's Bryce Harper (39).

He has reached base safely in 25 of his last 26 games in Miami since July 31, 2022, slashing .295/.370/.562 (31-for-105) with 10 doubles, six home runs, 20 runs, 24 RBI, and 13 walks.

**CAN'T WARD HIM OFF:** **Taylor Ward** has reached base safely 72 times through his first 36 games with the O's (37 H, 34 BB, 1 HBP), the third-highest figure by an Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) behind **Frank Robinson** (74 TOB, 1966) and **Roberto Alomar** (73 TOB, 1996)...The record through 37 games is 76, shared by Alomar and Robinson.

Ward's .434 on-base percentage ranks third in MLB...According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in on-base percentage was **Eddie Murray** in 1984 (2<sup>nd</sup>, .410).

Ward has reached safely in 33 of the last 35 games since March 28 while slashing .294/.444/.421 (37-for-126) with 13 doubles, one homer, 25 runs scored, 12 RBI, 34 walks, one hit by pitch, and one stolen base during that time.

**FASTBALL FOCUS:** Baltimore hitters own a collective .479 slugging percentage off fastballs (4-seam, 2-seam, cutter), the best mark in the AL and fourth-highest in MLB behind Arizona (.510), Atlanta (.506), Chicago-NL (.499), and Los Angeles-NL (.496).

The O's .295 slugging percentage on all other pitches is second lowest in the majors ahead of only the Twins (.287).

**Pete Alonso** is slashing .375/.500/1.125 (6-for-16) with four home runs off fastballs in nine games since April 27...He opened the season slashing .217/.347/.350 (13-for-60) with two doubles and two homers off heaters across 28 contests.

**'PEN PALS:** **Grant Wolfram** has not allowed a home run in 34.0 consecutive innings dating to July 21, 2025...He has allowed two long balls in 39.2 innings since his MLB debut on April 26 (G2) at Detroit, with both home runs coming on July 18, 2025 at Tampa Bay.

The O's 15.7 percent inherited runners scored rate (8 IRS/51 IR) is second lowest in the majors behind the Mariners (12.2%; 5 IRS/41 IR).

The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on April 17 in Cleveland...It was the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

**FIGURING OUT THE FISH:** The O's and Marlins conclude their lone series of 2026 this evening... Baltimore is 17-32 (.347) all-time opposite Miami, the second-lowest winning percentage against a single opponent in franchise history (since 1954), ahead of only Chicago-NL (8-17, .320).

Each of the last 10 games between the Orioles and Marlins in Miami dating to May 22, 2015, have been decided by three runs or fewer, with the Birds going 5-5 in those affairs.

**QUICK HITS:** Povich is scheduled to make his third start of the season (4<sup>th</sup> appearance) and 39<sup>th</sup> of his career tonight in the series finale at Miami...Appeared on his first career Opening Day roster in 2025 and went 3-8 with a 5.21 ERA (65 ER/112.1 IP) on 125 hits (17 HR), 43 walks (2 IBB), one hit batter, and six wild pitches with 118 strikeouts in 22 appearances (20 GS)...Had one stint on the 15-day Injured List (left hip inflammation) from 6/16-8/3/25...Acquired from Minnesota along with **RHP Yennier Cano**, LHP Juan Rojas, and RHP Juan Nunez in exchange for RHP Jorge López and cash considerations on August 2, 2022.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Was dealt his first loss of the season on May 1 at New York-AL, allowing five runs on seven hits (2 HR) and two walks in 4.0 innings with four strikeouts...Threw 77 pitches, 46 strikes...Marked his shortest start since allowing seven runs in 3.1 innings on April 18, 2025 vs. Cincinnati.

👉 Batters went 5-for-13 (.385) on his fastballs (4-seam, 2-seam) after going a combined 3-for-20 (.150) on his heaters over his first two games (1 GS) of the season.

**THE 305:** Povich is scheduled to make his first career start vs. Miami...He's 1-1 with a 2.63 ERA (7 ER/24.0 IP) in four career starts opposite the NL East, his lowest ERA against any division ahead of the AL Central (3.57)...Over 11 career Interleague games (10 GS), Povich is 3-4 with a 5.09 ERA (33 ER/58.1 IP) but is on a two-decision winning streak dating to September 3, 2025, during which he holds a 3.52 ERA (9 ER/23.0 IP).

**MEANT TO BE BROKEN:** Povich has lost his last seven nighttime decisions dating to May 6, 2025 at Minnesota...During that stretch, he holds a 6.75 ERA (38 ER/50.2 IP) with no quality starts and has reached 6.0 innings only once in those 10 games (9 GS).

👉 He's 3-0 over his last 10 games (8 GS) during the day with a 3.40 ERA (20 ER/53.0 IP), including a 2.19 mark (3 ER/12.1 IP) in two daytime games (1 GS) this season with the O's.

**OFF AND RUNNING:** Povich allowed three hits (2 2B, 1 HR) the first time through the lineup in his last start on May 1 at New York-AL after holding the opposition hitless (0-for-17) over his first two games of the season (1 GS)...Still, batters are 3-for-25 (.120) the first time through the lineup compared to 9-for-25 (.360) the second time around and 4-for-13 (.308) the third time through.

**HELLO, GOODBYE:** Povich is generating a 41.5 percent whiff rate on his breaking balls this season, which include his slider (42.1%) and curveball (40.9%)...The 41.5 percent whiff rate on his breaking balls ranks third among Orioles pitchers behind Anthony Nunez (56.1%) and Trevor Rogers (43.3%)...Last season, Povich recorded a 27.3 whiff rate on his breaking balls (slider, curve, sweeper).

**SMALL SAMPLE:** Although he has tossed only 16.1 innings in 2026, Povich's 31.7 percent out of zone swing rate is up 5.2 percent from last season (26.5%), while his 30.9 percent first pitch swing rate is up 4.3 percent from 2025 (26.6%).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered the loss on May 2 at New York-AL after tossing 4.0 innings, permitting five runs on seven hits (2 HR) and four walks (1 IBB) with four strikeouts...The 4.0 innings tied a season low (also 4/3 at PIT), while the five runs were his most allowed since June 1, 2024 vs. Tampa Bay (also 5 R).

**vs. AHTLETICS:** Set to make his second career start opposite the A's...Made the start on August 20, 2023 and earned the win after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings, scattering two hits, one walk, and one hit batter with nine strikeouts.
