# TONIGHT'S STARTER: #51 - RHP FREDDY PERALTA (20gs, 11-4, 2.66) - 2025 ALL-STAR 2025 Arsenal: 4-Seam Fastball (56.9%) - Changeup (20.1%) - Curveball (14.6%) - Slider (8.4%)

PERALTA AT A GLANCE: All-Star Freddy Peralta, 29, will make his 21st start of the season and second against the Dodgers.....he last started last Sunday vs. Washington in an 8-1 win (6.2ip, 3h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 7k, 103 pitches).....the team is 13-7 in his starts.....he has 9 quality starts, including 3 in a row....opponents are batting .199 (81-for-407, 12hr)..... he has won each of his last 6 starts, posting a 2.60 ERA (34.2ip, 23h, 10r, 10er, 6bb, 40k, 3hr).....Peralta was acquired from Seattle with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

RIGHT SAID FRED: Peralta is currently tied with Max Fried (NYY) for the Major League lead in wins (11).....he is tied with 26 others for the Major League lead in starts (20)..... he also ranks among the National League leaders in opponent AVG (5th, .199), H/9IP (5th, 6.53), ERA (7th, 2.66) and WHIP (8th, 1.06).

FREDDY K-RUEGER: Peralta has 1,067 career strikeouts, trailing only Yovani Gallardo (1,226), Ben Sheets (1,206) and Teddy Higuera (1,081) on the all-time franchise list.

**CAREER:** Is 64-40 with a 3.65 ERA and 1 save in 198 games/149 starts (866ip, 351er).....is in his eighth Major League season, all with the Brewers (2018-25).....is 56-38 with a 3.63 ERA as a starter (782ip, 315er) and 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA in relief (84ip, 36er).....was an All-Star in 2021 and 2025.....was the Opening Day starter in 2024 and 2025.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: IS 38-19 with a 3.27 ERA in 105 games/77 starts (465.2ip, 169er)..... is 7-0 with a 1.53 ERA in 10 starts this season (58.2ip, 10er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: IS 26-21 with a 4.09 ERA in 93 games/72 starts [400.1ip, 182er].....is 4-4 with a 3.91 ERA in 10 starts this season (53ip, 23er).
