REMAINING SPRING SLATE: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their final week of Grapefruit League with a pair of split-squad day games on their last Friday in Florida, welcoming the Houston Astros to Jupiter's Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium and traveling to Port St. Lucie to play the New York Mets at Clover Park ... St. Louis breaks camp in Florida on Monday to fly to Memphis to play the "Battle of the Birds" exhibition with the Triple-A Redbirds at AutoZone Park (6:15 p.m. CT).

WORKOUT DAY: The Cardinals and Twins will hold team workouts and batting practice at Busch Stadium on Wednesday, March 26 ... Minnesota's workout is scheduled for 1:00 p.m. CT, followed by St. Louis.

GRAY TO START OPENING DAY: RHP **Sonny Gray** has been named the Cardinals Opening Day starter vs. Minnesota on March 27 at Busch Stadium.

- Gray has been the Opening Day starter for his team three times (Oakland 2013 & 2014; Cincinnati 2020); Gray, who was scratched from making the 2016 Athletics Opening Day start due to food poisoning, is lifetime 2-0 with an 0.45 ERA in his three Opening Day starts.
- The three-time All-Star had been named the Cardinals 2024 Opening Day starter before suffering hamstring injury in his 2nd Grapefruit League start on March 4.
- With the start, the Cardinals will have sent a right-hander to the mound on Opening Day in 26 consecutive seasons since 2000 ... LHP **Donovan Osborne** in 1999 vs. Milwaukee was the last St. Louis southpaw.
- The 35-year-old Gray follows **Miles Mikolas**, who started the 2024 opener at 35 years of age ... It marks the first time in Cardinals history in which the Redbirds had two different Opening Day pitchers age 35-or-older in consecutive seasons ... Hall of Famer **Bob Gibson** made five consecutive Opening Day starts at age 35-or-older from 1971-75.

IT IS YOUR BIRTHDAY: Happy 23rd birthday to short-stop **Masyn Winn** ... Other notables born on this date include pitchers **Frankie Montas** (32) and **Carlos Carrasco** (38), infielders **Shawon Dunston** (62) and **Cristian Guzmán** (47), catcher **Manny Sanguillén** (81), outfielder **Tommy Davis** (1939-2022), and actors **Matthew Broderick** (63) and **Gary Oldman** (67).

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHERS

#54 SONNY GRAY (RHP) · R/R · 35 yrs · 5-10, 185 lbs

- Signed by the Cardinals as a free agent to a three-year contract with a club option through 2027 in November 2023.
- Announced as the Cardinals 2025 Opening Day starter.
- Ranks among active Major League leaders in wins (111, 10th), starts (298, 12th), innings pitched (1,737.1, 13th), strikeouts (1,724, 14th), ERA (3.51, 7th), opponent average (.229, 7th), SO/9 (8.93, 12th), HR/9 (0.87, 4th), WHIP (1.19, 10th), and wild pitches (104, 1st).
- Struck out 203 batters in his first season in St. Louis (two-shy of his career-high), 19th-most in Cardinals single-season history. Became the 9th pitcher in Cardinals single-season history (20th instance) to reach 200 strikeouts and first since Jack Flaherty (231 in 2019).
- Established a new single-season Cardinals records in strikeouts/9 IP (10.98) and strikeout percentage (30.3%) in 2024, surpassing Jack Flaherty (10.59, 29.9%) in 2019.
- Made 28 starts in his first season with St. Louis while missing 20 games due to a right hamstring strain suffered during Spring Training and season-ending right forearm flexor tendinitis.
- Allowed one earned run or fewer in 11 starts (St. Louis was 11-0).
- Finished 2nd in the 2023 American League Cy Young Award voting behind Yankees Gerrit Cole, who received 30 unanimous 1st place votes. Gray received 20 2nd place votes and six 3rd place. Also ranked 18th in AL MVP voting.

#36 MICHAEL McGREEVY (RHP) · R/R · 24 yrs · 6-5, 215 lbs

- Enters the 2025 season ranked as the No. 10 prospect in the Cardinals organization by *Baseball America*.
- Cardinals 1st round pick in 2021 made his Major League debut vs. Texas on July 31, 2024, throwing 7.0 innings and allowing one run in a 10-1 victory.
- Sports a 1.96 ERA (5 ER/23.0 IP) through his first four career games, best by a Cardinal through his first four career games since RHP René Arocha's 1.52 ERA (4 ER/23.2 IP) in 1993 (min. 20 IP).
- Led Minor League Baseball in wins (31), games started (82), complete games (4), innings pitched (447.1), and number of pitches (7,254) over the past three seasons.
- Has thrown 47.1 more innings and 655 more pitches than any other pitcher in minor league baseball since 2022.
- Began the season in Memphis (AAA) and made a team-leading 27 starts for the Redbirds, which ranked tied for 4th in the International League. Finished the season with wins in four straight starts (4-0, 2.35 ERA, 23.0 IP, 6 R, 28 SO).
- Is the only Cardinal in franchise history to earn a win as a starting pitcher and then a relief pitcher in his first two appearances (7/31 vs. TEX & 9/18 vs. PIT).
- His 0.78 WHIP was the best in franchise history among Cardinals pitchers with 20.0 or more innings and three or more starts and best mark since Bob Gibson (0.85) in 1968. Was also the best among MLB rookie pitchers with the same qualifications.
