**RAY REPORT**—The Rays continue their final homestand of the season against the Red Sox (2-1) and Blue Jays (1-0, 2 to play) today at Tropicana Field...have not won or lost more than three consecutive games since being swept by Baltimore from June 7-10, going 45-43 since that series...are 22-26 since the July 30 trade deadline and 28-30 since the All-Star break...hold a share of third place in the AL East for the first time since entering play on June 6 (31-31)—spent 94 consecutive days in fourth from June 20 (entering play) through Sept. 20...are 5.0 games behind the Twins for the AL's third and final Wild Card spot...have spent the entire season no more than five games below or three games above .500...need to win at least five of their final eight games to finish .500 or better.

★ **Jonathan Aranda's** 6th-inning solo shot represented the only run in last night's 1-0 win over the Blue Jays...it marked Tampa Bay's fourth 1-0 win this season, tying Pittsburgh for the most in the majors and signaling the Rays most since 2018 (4).  
★ The Rays have recorded back-to-back shutout wins for the 19th time in franchise history (last: April 18-19, 2023 at CIN)...their eight shutouts since the All-Star break lead the AL and rank second in the majors behind the Padres (10).  
★ The Rays have recorded an MLB-most 14 wins when scoring two runs or fewer, matching 2014 for the most in club history...they have scored two runs or fewer 64 times overall, second most in the majors behind the White Sox (70) and second most in team history behind the inaugural 1998 campaign (71)...Tampa Bay has been held to the mark in five of six and eight of its last 12 games.  
★ Tampa Bay's 3.15 ERA since the All-Star break ranks second in MLB behind Detroit (3.13)...the club has an active 19.0 scoreless inning streak and has yielded only 3 ER across its last 34.0 innings (0.79 ERA).  
★ Of the Rays 19 games in September, 13 have been decided by two runs or fewer, including seven of nine home contests...their 83 such games this season lead MLB and are tied for fifth most in a season in club history (most: 94G in 2015).  
★ The Rays are looking to win three straight games for the first time since Aug. 16-18 vs. AZ...they are one of seven teams in MLB history to hold a .500 record at least 32 times (excl. 0-0), including the first since the 2011 Blue Jays (33), but they have not been at the mark since holding a 65-65 record entering play on Aug. 26.

**BLANK SLATE**—The Rays have recorded back-to-back shutout victories for the first time since April 18-19, 2023 at CIN...they have recorded back-to-back shutout wins in which they scored two runs or fewer for the third time, joining Aug. 19-20, 2018 and May 9-10, 2008...Tampa Bay has posted three consecutive shutouts just once in franchise history, turning the trick from April 8-10, 2023 (OAK x2, BOS) during their modern era-record-tying 13-game winning streak to open last season...only one major league club has tallied three consecutive shutouts in 2024: the Marlins from May 14-17 (DET x2, NYM).  
★ The Rays season-high 19.0 team scoreless inning streak marks their longest since a 20-inning run from June 5-7, 2023...their last longer streak spanned a franchise-record 32 innings from April 8-11, 2023, per STATS LLC.

**PITCH PERFECT**—Rays pitching has yielded three runs or fewer in 12 of their last 14 games since Sept. 6, ranking fourth in the majors with a 2.31 ERA (120.2IP, 31ER) in that span...excluding games on Sept. 10 at PHI (8) and Sept. 14 at CLE (6) in which they yielded a combined 14 ER, the Rays have turned in a 1.46 ERA (104.2IP, 17ER) in the other 12 games...they have allowed three runs or fewer 34 times since the All-Star break, second most in the AL behind the Tigers (35) and fourth most in MLB.  
★ Tampa Bay's rotation has permitted two runs or fewer in nine straight and 13 of their last 14 starts, tying their longest streak of the season (also June 23-July 3)...the rotation's last longer streak came from Aug. 13-26, 2022 (14G).  
★ Rays starters have not allowed a run in their last 11.1 IP and own a 1.23 ERA (36.2IP, 5ER) and 0.55 WHIP in their last seven games, holding opponents to a .121/.168/.218 (15-for-124) line with 44 strikeouts and five walks...opposing hitters are 7-for-79 (.089) against the rotation over the last four games.  
★ The bullpen's 2.74 ERA (239.2IP, 73ER) since the Midsummer Classic ranks second in the majors behind the Guardians (2.63).  
★ Rays pitching has tallied 10+ SO in a season-high-tying three straight games (3x, last: June 24-26 vs. SEA)...their last longer streak came from Sept. 2-6, 2023 (5G).

**UNTOUCHABLE**—Kevin Kelly (22.0IP) and Zack Littell (20.0IP) own two of the four longest active scoreless inning streaks in the majors...according to STATS LLC, it marks the third time in franchise history two Rays have had concurrent scoreless streaks of 20.0+ innings...the last instance involved Pete Fairbanks (29.2) and Yonny Chirinos (21.2) on April 29, 2023, when Chirinos extended his streak beyond the 20-inning mark, but saw it snapped in the same game vs. the White Sox...the other occurrence came on Aug. 7, 2012, when Fernando Rodney (22.0) and J.P. Howell (20.0) had active streaks.  
★ Kelly has not permitted an earned run in 23 straight outings, the longest active streak in the majors and tied with Fernando Rodney (2012) for the third-longest streak in club history behind Pete Fairbanks (30, 2022-23) and J.P. Howell (24, 2012).

**LOCK IT DOWN**—The Rays have won 31 consecutive games when holding a lead through six innings, the third-longest streak in club history behind runs of 36 (April 14-July 12, 2019) and 33 games (Aug. 1, 2010-April 20, 2011), according to STATS LLC...they are 51-4 when leading through six frames, tying the Yankees for the second-fewest such losses in MLB behind the Guardians (2)...the Rays also own the majors' second-highest wining pct. when leading through seven innings (57-2/.966) behind the Guardians (75-2/.974).  
★ Last night, Hunter Bigge became the 12th Ray to record a save, tying the Brewers and Dodgers for the most in the majors...it ties 2020 for the second most in a season in Rays history, trailing only 2021 (14).

**RACE TO THE FINISH**—The Rays need to go at least 5-3 over their final eight games to finish with a .500+ record for a seventh consecutive season...they were last under the mark in 2017 (80-82)...it would surpass 2008-2013 (6) for the longest streak in franchise history...the Rays are one of four teams to post a .500+ record each season from 2018-23, joining the Braves, Dodgers and Yankees...Tampa Bay needs to at least split the next two games to post its eighth consecutive winning season at home...its last losing record at Tropicana Field came in 2016 (36-45)...the Rays, Brewers, Dodgers and Yankees are the only clubs to finish above .500 at home in each of the last seven seasons since 2017.  
★ Since becoming the Rays in 2008, the club has finished with a winning record in 12 of 16 seasons...only the Yankees (16) and Dodgers (15) have more such campaigns in that timeframe (excl. 2024).

**RAYS AND JAYS**—The Rays and Blue Jays meet for their fourth and final set, concluding a 13-game season series...this marks Toronto's first visit to Tropicana Field since the clubs split a season-opening four-game series from March 28-31...last night's 1-0 victory secured the Rays club-record seventh straight season series win over the Jays dating back to 2018, surpassing 2008-13 (6)...the Rays are 9-4 in their last 13 and 14-8 in their previous 22 games against the Jays.  
★ Tampa Bay has homered in 10 of 11 games vs. Toronto this season and 22 of 24 meetings since the start of 2023...the club has homered in eight straight home games vs. the Jays, the second-longest streak in franchise history (12G, 2015-16).  
★ Yandy Diaz is batting .393 (11-for-28) over eight games vs. Toronto in 2024.

**BUTTER UP**—Double-A Montgomery defeated Biloxi (MIL), 8-2, in Game 3 of the Southern Division Finals last night to advance to their first SL Championship Series since 2021...seeking their first championship since claiming back-to-back titles from 2006-07, the Biscuits open a best-of-three series against Birmingham (CWS) on Sunday afternoon.

- ★ Rays Manager Kevin Cash began his MLB playing career with the Blue Jays from 2002-04...he was also a major league advance scout for Toronto in 2012.
- ★ Blue Jays VP, Baseball Strategy James Click spent 14 seasons with the Rays from 2005-19, including three as VP, baseball operations.
- ★ Rays Asst. GM Carlos Rodriguez spent four years as a Blue Jays scout before joining the Rays in 2010.
- ★ Rays Hitting Coach Chad Mottola held the same position with Toronto in 2013 after five seasons as a Blue Jays minor league coach...during his playing career, he was signed by the Jays three times and was a teammate of Kevin Cash with Triple-A Syracuse in 2002.
- ★ Bally Sports Sun announcer Brian Anderson made his MLB debut at Rogers Centre (then SkyDome) on Sept. 10, 1993 in relief for the Angels...the first batter he faced was Hall of Famer Paul Molitor.
- ★ Richie Palacios' brother, Joshua, was drafted by Toronto in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft and made his debut with the Blue Jays in 2021 at Rogers Centre.
- ★ Blue Jays OF Kevin Kiermaier spent 10 seasons with the Rays from 2013-22, winning three Gold Glove awards and one Platinum Glove...his 31.7 bWAR with the Rays rank fourth club history.
- ★ Toronto LHP Ryan Yarbrough pitched for the Rays from 2018-22...he was acquired from the Dodgers in exchange for Kiermaier at the trade deadline.
- ★ Blue Jays LHP Génesis Cabrera spent nearly five seasons in the Rays system before being dealt to the Cardinals in 2018.
- ★ Toronto INF Bo Bichette (Orlando) and RHP Bowden Francis (Tallahassee) hail from the Sunshine State...the latter was a teammate of José Caballero at Chipola College (2016-17), located in Florida's panhandle...the duo won an NJCAA National Championship in 2017.

**TODAY'S START**—Bradley will toe the rubber for his 24th start, including his 13th at home...has a career-high-seven-decision losing streak in his last nine starts, turning in a 7.88 ERA (45.2IP, 40ER) in that span (since July 31)...opened the season on the 15-day IL (right pectoral strain) before his May 10 reinstatement.

**LAST TIME OUT**—Took the loss on Sept. 15 at Cleveland...worked 4.1 innings, allowing two runs on five hits and three walks while fanning six...allowed a leadoff double to Daniel Schneemann in the 2nd inning, who came around to score two batters later on a Brayan Rocchio single...retired the next seven batters before issuing a two-out walk to Bo Naylor in the 4th frame...Angel Martinez opened the 5th inning with a single and two batters later, a José Ramirez single chased Bradley from the game...was relieved by Mason Montgomery and charged his second run when Martinez scored as Ramirez was caught stealing second.

**TAJ AND TORONTO**—Bradley earned the win in his lone start this season opposite Toronto on July 25 at Rogers Centre (6.0IP, 2H, OR, 1BB, 7SO)...in five career appearances (3GS) against the Blue Jays, he is 1-2 with a 5.68 ERA (19.0IP, 12ER), including an 0-2 mark and 8.18 ERA (11.0IP, 10ER) in two starts at Tropicana Field.

After allowing a career-high nine runs on June 1 vs. BAL, Bradley owns a 0.50 ERA (18.0IP, 1ER) with 19 SO in hi last three starts against AL East opponents (June 8 vs. BAL, July 20 at NYY, July 25 at TOR).

**EARLY BIRD**—In eight daytime starts since June 8, Bradley is 3-4 with a 2.35 ERA (46.0IP, 12ER), .178 (29-for-163) opp. average and a 0.91 WHIP...min. 40.0 IP, it marks the fifth-lowest daytime ERA in MLB in that time behind SEA Logan Gilbert (1.56), CHC Jameson Taillon (2.06), MIN Bailey Ober (2.08) and SEA George Kirby (2.25).

**HIGHS AND LOWS**—He is 0-6 with an 7.88 ERA (45.2IP, 40ER) and 1.64 WHIP over his last nine starts, allowing opponents to hit .310/.365/.578 (58-for-187) with 12 HR...min. 40.0 IP, it marks the highest ERA in MLB over that timeframe (since July 31), with the next closest being PIT Mitch Keller (6.85)...Bradley has yielded a combined 42 runs in his last nine outings after permitting a total of five runs in his previous nine starts (June 8-July 25).

In nine starts from June 8-July 25, he went 5-1 with a 0.82 ERA (55.0IP, 5ER), the lowest over a 10-start span in franchise history.

His seven-decision losing streak is the longest by a Ray this season and the longest by a Tampa Bay starter since Ryan Yarbrough (10G, Sept. 15, 2019-April 30, 2021).

**SPLITTING HAIRS**—During his dominant nine-start stretch from June 8-July 25, opponents slashed .129/.164/.186 (9-for-70) with 33 strikeouts off Bradley's splitter, whiffing 33.3 pct. of the time on the offering while striking out at a 44.6 pct. clip.

In nine starts since, however, opponents have slashed .333/.397/.550 (20-for-60) with 18 strikeouts...his 33.1 pct. whiff rate remains in line from the previous stretch, but his 26.5 pct. strikeout rate has fallen by 18.1 pct.

**HOMER (UNHAPPY)**—On the heels of a career-long 35.0 homerless inning streak, he has permitted 12 HR across his last nine starts (2.36 HR/9.0IP), yielding multiple home runs in five of those outings.
