BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Chicago Cubs celebrate Fourth of July weekend with the opener of a three-game series this afternoon at Wrigley Field as the club honors and celebrates **Chip Caray** this six-game #ChipTrip ... **Oliver Marmol** celebrated his 40th birthday last night with a pregame mariachi serenade and then a wild, come-from-behind 11-5 Cardinals win at the Chop House as St. Louis took two of three from first place Atlanta ... The Cardinals bullpen fired 8.1 scoreless innings for the first time in a nine-inning game since **June 16, 1987** vs. Pittsburgh, which was closed out by **Ricky Horton** (3.0 IP).

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 2.5 games behind Chicago and 7.5 games back of Milwaukee ... The Cardinals currently own the 3rd NL Wild Card spot, 1.0 game ahead of the Marlins (46-42) ... St. Louis (-4), Texas (-2), and Cleveland (-7), are the only three MLB teams with winning records but negative run differentials.

STANEK RE-JOINS ST. LOUIS: Prior to today's series opener, the Cardinals activated RHP **Ryan Stanek** from the Paternity List ... A corresponding move will be announced.

BEAT THE BEST TO BE THE BEST: The Cardinals are playing a stretch of 14 games over 13 days without an off day leading into the All-Star Break (June 30-July 12), all against teams currently in playoff position (2-1 at Braves; 3 at Cubs; 5 vs. Brewers; and 3 vs. Braves) ... St. Louis finishes the season with the 5th-hardest remaining strength of schedule (.513) behind the Cubs (.515), Pirates (.515), Reds (.532), and Mets (.532).

ROAD RAGE: St. Louis is averaging 5.35 runs per game on the road this season, 2nd-highest in MLB to the Dodgers (6.04) ... **Iván Herrera's** .444 OBP and **Jordan Walker's** 45 RBI both lead all of MLB in road games.

FEELING A DRAFT: The Cardinals own six of the top 86 picks (13, 32, 50, 68, 72, 86) in the upcoming 2026 MLB Draft next weekend (July 11-12), the most of any Major League team ... In the DeWitt ownership group era (1996-present), 2026 will be only the third time St. Louis has possessed as many as six of the top 86 selections, following 2005 (6 of top 78) and 2012 (6 of top 86).

LET THE KIDS PLAY: According to *ESPN*, the Cardinals sport the youngest active MLB roster with an average age of 26.5, while the Cubs (30.1) and Braves (30.0) average MLB's top two oldest ages ... Eight current Cardinals are 25 or younger, anchored by 23-year-old rookie infielders **JJ Wetherholt** and **Blaze Jordan**.

• According to *Elias Sports Bureau* (weighted average by playing time), the last time the Cardinals finished any season with Major League Baseball's lowest average age was **1944**, when 23-year-old **Stan Musial**, 26-year-old **Whitey Kurowski**, and 27-year-old NL MVP **Marty Marion** led the Cardinals over the crosstown Browns in the World Series aka "Streetcar Series."

MARMOL NAMED TO NL ALL-STAR COACHING STAFF: Dodgers manager **Dave Roberts** has invited **Oliver Marmol** and Phillies interim manager **Don Mattingly** to serve as honorary coaches alongside the Dodgers coaching staff for the NL in the 2026 All-Star Game on July 14 at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia.

• Marmol becomes the 10th different Cardinals manager to serve as an honorary National League All-Star coach with **Tony La Russa** (2003, 2009), **Joe Torre** (1992), **Red Schoendienst** (1972, 1974, 1975), **Johnny Keane** (1962-G1), **Solly Hemus** (1960-G1 & G2), **Fred Hutchinson** (1956), **Eddie Stanky** (1952), **Eddie Dyer** (1948), & **Frankie Frisch** (1937, 1938).

Iván Herrera tallied his first MLB hit vs. the Cubs with a single (June 26, 2022)...**José Fermín** notched his first career MLB hit at the Cubs (July 21, 2023) with a bunt single...**Pedro Pagés** swatted his first MLB homer (June 14, 2024) at the Cubs.

JoJo Romero recorded his first MLB save on July 30, 2023 vs. the Cubs.

George Soriano's first cousin is former Cubs OF **Alfonso Soriano** (2007-13).

Carson Kelly was drafted by St. Louis in 2012 and played three seasons (2016-18) for the Cardinals.

Phil Maton pitched in 40 games as a reliever for the Cardinals in 2025 after he signed a one-year deal as a free agent in March 2025.

Brant Brown was the Cubs 3rd round draft pick in 1992 and played parts of four seasons (1996-98 & 2000) with the North Siders.

Cardinals.TV play-by-play announcer **Chip Caray** served as the Cubs play-by-play announcer for seven seasons (1998-2004) on WGN...his grandfather, **Harry Caray**, spent the final 16 years of his career broadcasting Cubs games (1982-97).

Lars Nootbaar and **Shota Imanaga** were teammates on Gold Medal winning Team Japan in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

Jon Jay played in 141 games for the Cubs in 2017 and was part of their playoff run to the NLCS.

Daniel Descalso played his final MLB season with the Cubs in 2019.

Nelson Velázquez played parts of two seasons with the Cubs (2022-23), where he made his MLB debut (May 30, 2022 vs. Milwaukee)...singled off Ethan Small in his first career plate appearance.

Cubs Scouting VP **Dan Kantrovitz** previously was Cardinals Scouting Director (2012-14)...2001 Cards 25th Rd. draft pick from Brown Univ...first MLB job was Cardinals Scouting Coordinator.

Stubby Clapp (June 18, 2001 at Busch II) made his MLB debut vs. the Cubs...was also a coach on Team Canada for the 2013 & 2026 WBC squads that featured **Jameson Taillon** on the pitching staff.

Cubs Staff Assistant **AJ Lewis** played college baseball at the University of Missouri in 2017 and John A. Logan College (Carterville, IL) in 2018.

Cubs Major League Assistant Strength & Conditioning Coach **Mark Weisman** was the Director of Performance at Southeast Missouri State University (Gape Girardeau, Mo.) in 2020.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played part of 2008 with the Cubs.

Cardinals VP & Sr. Advisor **Michael Girsch** is a Chicago native...graduated from the University of Notre Dame and the University of Chicago.

Marquee Sports Network Analyst **Rick Sutcliffe** played for St. Louis in 1994.

Cardinals.TV Analyst **Mark Sweeney** made his MLB debut with St. Louis vs. the Cubs on Aug. 4, 1995 at Busch Stadium II.

Hall of Fame manager **Tony La Russa** played in one game for the Cubs in 1973.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Tom Herr** made his MLB debut vs. the Cubs on Aug. 13, 1979 at Busch Stadium II, and fellow Cards HOF **Jason Isringhausen** made his MLB debut on July 17, 1995 at the Cubs while pitching for the Mets.

Cubs Special Assistant to the GM/National Cross-checker **Jaron Madison** previously served as the Cardinals Assistant Director of Scouting (2008-09).

Cubs Strength & Conditioning Director **Blaine Kinsley** was the Strength & Conditioning coach for the Springfield Cardinals (AA) in 2017.

Cubs Asst. Athletic Trainer **German Suncin** attended Western Illinois Univ. & SIU Carbondale.

Cubs Catching Coordinator **Mark Johnson** played in 10 games for the Cardinals in 2008.

TODAY'S STARTER:

- Making his 17th start of the 2026 season today and his 78th career start (186th career appearance).
- **Is seeking his 10th win of the season** for a 2nd time after taking a 5-1 loss his last time out on 6/27 vs. MIA.
- Making his 2nd start of the season against the Cubs, and is in search of his 1st career win vs. CHC (0-4 career).
- Prior to his loss last week, the Cardinals had won each of his last six games started and Andre had a career-best 5-game win streak.
- Pallante's nine wins are most by a Cardinal through their first 16 starts in a season since **Sonny Gray** (9 in 2024); the last Cardinals pitcher with 10+ wins prior to the All-Star break was **Miles Mikolas** (10-3) in 2018.
- He allowed 2 runs or fewer in five of six starts from May 17 to June 22 (2.88 ERA) and led the Cardinals starting staff with his 3.16 ERA in June.
- **Owens an 8.73 Run Support Average on the road** and 3.04 at home ... He's received 3 runs or fewer in 9 of his 10 Home starts, yet 5 runs or more in 5 of his 6 Road starts.
- Making his his 186th career appearance today, ranking 66th all-time among Cardinals pitchers. He has joined **Adam Wainwright** (478 starts), **Carlos Martinez** (274), **Lance Lynn** (206), **Miles Mikolas** (204), **Chris Carpenter** (198), and **Matt Morris** (187) since 2000 to reach both 186 career games pitched for St. Louis while also making 75 or more starts.
- **Is 5-0 in six Road starts (St. Louis is 5-1)** and he's 4-5 in Home games with the Cardinals going 5-5 in his Home starts after starting out 1-4 in his 1st five Home starts.
- **Leads all current Cardinals pitchers in career starts (77), wins (33), and innings pitched (549.1).**
- Had his streak of 10 consecutive starts of 5.0+ IP to begin the season end on May 29 vs. CHC when he exited after 3.0 IP (75 pitches). His 10 starts of 5.0 innings or more to begin a season were the most since **Sonny Gray** ran off 10 straight such starts to begin 2024.
- Alternated Home & Road starts in first 11 starts to begin the season, but that trend ended on May 29-June 7 homestand after consecutive Home starts.
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 5th time (2022-26), tied with **Lars Nootbaar** for most among active Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT (Saturday, June 27 vs. Miami at Busch Stadium): L, 5-1; 6.2 IP, 11 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 1 BB, 4 SO, 0 HR, 98 pitches.

- Had his 5-game win streak snapped in a 5-1 defeat, allowing a career single-game high 11 hits over 6.2 IP.
- Induced a season-high 3 GIDPs balls, matching Dustin May & Michael McGreevy for MLB single-game high in 2026. He induced 12 ground balls, two shy of his single game high 14 on May 6 vs. MIL.

2026 NOTES:

DRESSED TO THE NINES: Became the 1st Cardinal to win 9 games in 1st 15 starts of a season since Sonny Gray did so in 2024 in 3-2 win over ARI on 6/22 as he posted his 3rd-straight quality start.

SLIDE ON IN: Is holding opposing batters to a .190 BA (20-105) with his slider, and 34 of his 68 strikeouts this season have come via the slider ... Boasts an 8 Run Value on his slider, T-8th best slider in MLB according to Baseball Savant this season.

COUNT ON ME: Has worked at least 5.0 IP in 15 of his 16 starts this season, allowing 2 runs or fewer in nine of those games.

IF AT FIRST: Has had issues with 1st inning, allowing a .880 OPS, 14 runs and 4 HRs in 1st inning ... Batters are hitting .318 (14-44) when contacting the 1st pitch of an 0-0 at-bat.

SIX & THIRTY: Snapped a 4-game losing skid in games pitched at Busch Stadium as he matched his season total from 2025 with his 6th win of the season on 6/3 vs. TEX; It also marked his 30th career win.

THE STATE OF WINNING: With a win in Sacramento (May 12), earned his first MLB in his home state (CA).

BITTER BREW: Allowed four 1st inning runs, including 3-run HR, in 6-2 loss to MIL (5/6), losing his 3rd straight decision at Busch Stadium.

AHOY MATEY: Pitched then season-best 6.0 IP while allowing 1 run in Cards 5-4 win at PNC Park (4/29) in G3 of a 4-game series sweep of Pittsburgh.

TRI-DENT: Fanned 8 Mariners on 4/24 in 5.1 IP, but took the 3-2 loss after Josh Naylor's solo HR in the 6th snapped a 2-2 tie.

SPACE TRAVELER: Earned his 1st road win since 5/16/25 (at KC) in a 7-5 Space City win over the Astros on 4/18 in Houston.

MARCH MADNESS: Made his 2026 season debut vs. NYM (3/31) and gained a 3-0 win as he worked 5.0 scoreless IP, allowing just 3 hits.

CAREER:

- Has made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for five consecutive seasons (2022-26) after arriving at 2022 Spring Training as a non-roster invitee, his first official invite to Major League Spring Training.
- **Since his 2022 MLB debut, boasts the highest ground ball pct. (62.3%) in Major League Baseball among pitchers with 500.0+ IP.** As a starting pitcher (417.2.0IP), Pallante's 59.1 career groundball pct. currently is the T-9th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 400.0 IP as starter).
- Started vs. San Francisco (June 20, 2024) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., tossing 5.1 innings in the 6-5 Cardinals win. Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site since Alan Benes vs. San Diego on April 19, 1997 at Aloha Stadium in Honolulu, Hawaii.

PALLANTE VS. CHICAGO CUBS

- Makes his 14th career appearance (7th start) against the Cubs; He's 0-4 with a 5.12 ERA (31.2 IP) and 18 strikeouts vs. the Cubs.
- Among teams he's faced 10+ career times, the Cubs (0-4) and Brewers (0-3) are lone teams he's yet to record a win against.
- In six career starts vs. CHI, is 0-4 with a 6.65 ERA (23.0 IP) and 13 strikeouts, while receiving seven total runs of support (STL is 2-4).
- Made a relief appearance vs. Cubs at London Stadium (June 25, 2023). Pitched a scoreless 8th inning allowing one hit and recorded a Hold, setting up Jordan Hicks for the save in the 9th inning.
- Has made 26 career starts against the NL Central Division since 2022, is 8-12 with a 3.84 ERA (136.0 IP) and 99 strikeouts. He's allowed 1 run or fewer in 11 of those 26 starts.

LAST START VS. CUBS (May 29, 2026 at Busch Stadium): ND, W, 6-5; 3.0 IP, 8 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO, 1 HR, 75 pitches

- Allowed 3 runs in the 1st inning, but the Cardinals bounced back with three runs in the bottom half of the 1st and went on to win 6-5.
- His 3.0 IP were a season low and the only time this season he failed to go at least 5.0 IP.
