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BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore wraps up a six-game homestand with a three-game series against the Rays that continues tonight...The Orioles were swept by the Yankees in the first three games from Tuesday-Thursday....The O's embark on another three-city road trip, their second in as many trips, after this homestand at the Cardinals (8/25-27), Athletics (8/28-30), and Rockies (8/31-9/2)...The Birds are in last place in the AL East, but 2.0 games behind the Rangers for the final Wild Card spot.

⚾ Following his long ball last night, **Dylan Beavers** has homered in three consecutive games for the first time in his career...He is the second Oriole to do so this season, joining **Coby Mayo** from April 21-24...It is tied for the longest active streak in MLB along with STL's Jordan Walker...The last Oriole to homer if four straight was **Tyler O'Neill** (4 G, 7/25-29 (G1)/25.

⚾ Over the past three games, the Birds are 1-for-19 (.053) with zero extra-base hits and six strikeouts against left-handed pitching...In their previous 23 games against southpaws from July 20-August 18, they slashed .266/.341/.478 (83-for-312) with 17 doubles, two triples, and 15 home runs...Their .819 OPS off left-handed pitching during that time ranked third in MLB behind the Cubs (.931) and Diamondbacks (.827).

RAYS UP: Since the start of 2022, the O's are 22-11 (.667) against Tampa Bay at Camden Yards... From 2018-21, Baltimore went 14-23 (.378) against the Rays at home.

⚾ The Orioles have won five straight home games against the Rays since the final home date of 2025...Baltimore has not taken six straight from Tampa Bay at Oriole Park since a seven-game run from September 2, 2015-June 26, 2016.

⚾ Overall, Baltimore has homered in 12 straight games opposite Tampa Bay since September 25, 2025...It is tied for the second-longest such streak since the two clubs first met in 1998, trailing a 14-game stretch from July 30, 2002-April 21, 2003.

POLAR VORTEX: **Pete Alonso** has hit safely in a career-high 13 straight games since August 8, the second-longest active streak in the majors behind AZ's Gabriel Moreno (14 G)...The current hitting streak is the longest by an Oriole since **Jeremiah Jackson** hit safely in 13 consecutive games from August 21-September 2, 2025, while the last Bird to hit safely in 14 straight was **Gunnar Henderson** (14 G, 6/5-20/25).

⚾ Alonso hit his 30th home run yesterday, becoming the fifth player in MLB history to hit 30+ homers in at least seven of his first eight seasons, joining Ralph Kiner, Eddie Mathews, Albert Pujols, and Mark Teixeira...The lone year he did not hit 30+ homers was during the 60-game 2020 season.

⚾ Alonso became the eighth Oriole (since 1954) to hit at least 30 home runs in his first season with the team, joining Mark Trumbo (47 in 2016), Nelson Cruz (40 in 2014), J.J. Hardy (30 in 2011), Mark Reynolds (37 in 2011), Miguel Tejada (34 in 2004), Albert Belle (37 in 1999), and Frank Robinson (49 in 1966).

⚾ During his active 13-game hitting streak, Alonso is slashing .480/.544/.940 (24-for-50) with two doubles, seven homers, 11 runs, 14 RBI, and six walks...Over that period, Alonso leads the majors in batting average, on-base percentage, slugging percentage, OPS (1.484), hits, home runs, and total bases (47).

⚾ Overall this season, Alonso ranks among AL leaders in RBI (2nd, 85), total bases (3th, 244), home runs (4th, 30), runs scored (T-5th, 79), slugging percentage (6th, .504), and OPS (7th, .865).

⚾ Alonso was named the AL Player of the Week on Monday, his sixth career honor and first in the AL...The last Oriole to win the award was **Gunnar Henderson** on September 7, 2024...He is the 12th player ever to garner honors in at least five consecutive seasons, regardless of team or league.

TOUGH SLEDDING: Baltimore has the fourth-most difficult remaining schedule in the AL with a .499 combined opponent winning percentage, trailing Tampa Bay (.508), Texas (.504), and Kansas City (.501)...Nine NL teams have the highest remaining combined opponent winning percentage, led by the Reds (.560).

⚾ Among teams currently in playoff position, the O's have four games against the Red Sox (9/3-6), three each against the Brewers (9/18-20) and Yankees (9/25-27), and two left against the Rays this weekend.

⚾ Against AL teams within 3.0 games of the Wild Card, the Orioles lost the season series to Seattle (3-4) and Texas (2-4), beat Detroit (4-2), and split with Minnesota (3-3), with games remaining against Boston (4 G, 4-5), Cleveland (3 G, 1-3), New York (3 G, 2-8), and Toronto (6 G, 3-4).

PLAYING THE LONG GAME: The Orioles lead the majors with 24 home runs since August 9 ahead of the Cubs (22)...Baltimore has homered a season-high 10 straight games, having last done so in 11 straight from June 10-20, 2025.

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 120 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Brewers (41 G).

⚾ Baltimore has secured a walk in 100 straight games for the sixth time in franchise history (since 1954)...The O's drew 1+ walk in a franchise-record 172 games from July 2, 2024-July 12, 2025...The current 120-game stretch is the longest single-season streak in team history (since 1954), surpassing a 112-game run in 1995.

⚾ The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season (4/5 at PIT).

⚾ Overall, the O's lead the AL with 490 walks while ranking third in MLB behind the Cubs (546 BB) and Brewers (537 BB).

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 40-44 (.476) in games decided by three runs or fewer, tied for the fourth-most such games in the league this season and 19th in winning percentage in those situations this year...The club is 32-31 (.508) in games decided by two runs or fewer and 12-19 (.387) in one-run games...The team's winning percentage in one-run games is the third lowest in the majors ahead of the Giants (11-21, .344) and Tigers (12-22, .353).

PINCH ME: The Orioles lead MLB with 31 pinch-hit RBI this season, ahead of the Nationals (27)...The O's are one of seven teams in the majors this year with at least five pinch-hit home runs, led by the Nationals (8).

⚾ **Tyler O'Neill** is one of five players in the majors with at least three pinch-hit homers this year, along with CHC's Michael Conforto (4) and CWS' Randal Grichuk, MIA's Heriberto Hernández, and PHI's Derek Hill (all 3)...His three pinch-hit home runs are tied for the single-season franchise record (since 1954), joining Sam Horn (1991), Jim Dwyer (1986), Pat Kelly (1979), Sam Bowens (1967), and Whitey Herzog (1962).

⚾ **Jeremiah Jackson** leads all Orioles batters with six pinch-hit RBI this season.

⚾ The team record for most pinch-hit RBI in a season is 45 in 1982...Miami led the majors with 33 pinch-hit RBI in 2025.

QUICK HITS: Young is set to make his 22nd start of the season and the 34th of his career tonight vs. Tampa Bay...Was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk for the second time this year on April 23...Was optioned to minor league camp on March 7 after making two Grapefruit League appearances...Signed with the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent on June 14, 2020.

LAST TIME OUT: Didn't factor into the decision of a 7-6 Orioles loss on August 17 at Tampa Bay after allowing four runs in 4.0 innings on eight hits (3 HR) and one walk with three strikeouts...Threw 82 pitches, 57 strikes.
⌚ Allowed a season-high three home runs, his fourth time allowing multiple home runs this year (last: 7/31 vs. PHI).
⌚ Marked his shortest start since recording a season-low 3.2 innings on May 17 at Washington.

SWEET VICTORY: The Orioles have won 16 of Young's 21 starts this season after going 3-9 in his 12 outings last season...That included a seven-game winning streak from May 6-June 10, over which he went 3-0 with a 2.59 ERA (12 ER/41.2 IP) and five quality starts.
⌚ Young is 9-3 (.750) in 21 starts this season...The .750 winning percentage is tied for third in the AL (min. 15 GS) with TB's Nick Martinez (12-4) behind BOS' Sonny Gray (.833, 15-3) and DET's Troy Melton (.778, 7-2).

FASTBALL FOCUS: Opponents are slashing .218/.310/.374 (38-for-174) off his four-seam fastball with six doubles, seven home runs, 22 walks, and 31 strikeouts...However, Young allowed a career-high six hits on the pitch in his last start on August 17 at Tampa Bay, including a career-high two home runs.
⌚ His average fastball has climbed to 94.2 mph in 2026, up 1.7 miles per hour from 2025 (92.5 mph)...The 1.7 mph increase is the sixth-highest year-over-year increase by any pitcher in MLB, including the highest by a starting pitcher.
⌚ Opponents are slashing .316/.395/.474 (24-for-76) on his sinker with three doubles, three home runs, nine walks, and 10 strikeouts.

HEATED RIVALRY: Young is 2-0 with a 4.24 ERA (16 ER/34.0 IP) in six career starts vs. the AL East with a .288 opponent average (38-for-132) and 1.35 WHIP...He's recorded at least 5.0 innings in five of those six starts with the lone exception on August 17 at Tampa Bay (4.0 IP).
⌚ Earned his first career win against the division earlier this season on April 24 vs. Boston, allowing three runs in 5.2 innings on seven hits (1 HR) and one walk with five strikeouts.

WHIFFIN': Young recorded a 9.00 K/9.0 IP from June 21-July 31, tallying five or more strikeouts in a career-high seven consecutive starts...However, holds a 6.91 K/9.0 IP with four or fewer strikeouts in each of his three outings this month...Opened the season with a 6.35 K/9.0 IP over his first 11 starts with five or more strikeouts in five of those games.
⌚ On June 27 at Washington, recorded a career-high 23 swings and misses...The 23 whiffs were the most by an Oriole pitcher since Kyle Gibson (also 23) on July 9, 2023 at Minnesota.
⌚ He has tallied 32 of his 96 strikeouts (33.3%) this season on his slider, which opponents are whiffing at 41.7 percent of the time... The 41.7 percent whiff rate is the second-best mark among AL starters (min. 200 sliders thrown) behind TOR's Dylan Cease (43.8%).

THEM CHANGES: Young is averaging 83.4 mph and 1,386 revolutions per minute (RPM) on his split finger over his last 15 starts since May 24 (G1), during which opponents are hitting .254 (18-for-71) with three doubles, one triple, one home run, and 14 strikeouts to two walks...Over his first six starts of the season his splitter averaged 87.7 mph and 1,501 RPM, with opponents hitting .476 (10-for-21) off it with three doubles and two strikeouts to two walks.

CATCHING FIRE: In 11 starts from May 24 (G1)-July 25, Young went 5-1 with a 2.65 ERA (20 ER/68.0 IP)...Among all major league pitchers who threw at least 65.0 innings during that period, his 2.65 ERA was the third-lowest mark in the AL and sixth lowest in all of MLB.
