Not Walking

OF Brewer Hicklen drew Atlanta's only walk last night, securing a free pass in the third inning.

The Braves have drawn exactly one walk in back-to-back games, both losses. The team's 401 bases on balls are the third-fewest in the majors, and only surpass the totals of San Francisco (380) and Toronto (382).

Atlanta is pacing for 467 walks this year, which would stand as its fewest over the course of a 162-game season since 1988. That club drew only 432 free passes while finishing last in the NL West (55-106).

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Atlanta Braves and Washington Nationals today complete a two-game midweek set, and with it, their season series against one another...The Braves won a pair of four-game series over the Nationals from April 20-23 (3-1) and July 30-August 2 (4-0).



The Nationals handed the Braves their first home series loss of the season from May 22-24, taking two-of-three games...Entering that set, Atlanta was a perfect 8-0-0 in home series and 14-1-1 in series play overall.



With eight wins over Washington this season, Atlanta has already captured the season series...The Braves have won the season set over the Nationals eight times in the last nine seasons, dating to 2018...The Braves are 85-52 (.620) in 137 total games against the Nationals in that span...In that time, their only losing season against the club occurred in 2024 (5-8, .385).



RHP Brad Lord is set to face the Braves for the third time as a starter and for the eighth time overall...Across seven previous outings, the 6-foot-3, 210-pound right-hander has gone 0-2 despite a 2.86 ERA (7 ER/22.0 IP)...The native of Tallahassee, FL, has pitched to a 7.71 ERA (16 ER/18.2 IP) in his last 10 outings, dating to June 23.

GRANT HOLMES: Is set to make his 25th start (26th appearance) as he sets a new career high in games pitched...Holmes is 9-5 with a 3.71 ERA (53 ER/128.2 IP) this season.



The 6-foot-0, 226-pound native of Conway, SC, has pitched exactly 6.0 scoreless innings in three of his last five outings...On August 20 at Chicago-AL, he carried a no-hit bid into the seventh inning.



Holmes has never earned a win against the Nationals, but the Braves are 3-1 in his four previous outings against them...He has gone 0-1 with a 3.18 ERA (6 ER/17.0 IP) against the team while striking out 18.



In two starts against Washington this season, Holmes has allowed five earned runs on five solo home runs.

ROSTER MOVE: The Braves today selected RHP Elieser Hernández to the major league roster after optioning RHP Blake Burkhalter to Triple-A Gwinnett following last night's game...To make room on the 40-man roster, Atlanta designated LHP Hayden Harris for assignment.



In two MLB outings this season, Hernández has pitched to a 1-0 record and a 1.50 ERA (1 ER/6.0 IP)...The Braves have won both outings in which he has appeared, including an extra-inning affair in Baltimore on July 24 that saw him pitch the game's final 3.0 innings.

MICHAEL HARRIS II: Last night belted his 24th home run of the season, extending his career-best total...Atlanta's centerfielder is also pacing to set career highs in runs scored (80), hits (183), RBI (96) and doubles (39)...He has already eclipsed his previous career high in total bases (252).



Chicago-NL's Pete Crow-Armstrong (38) and Minnesota's Byron Buxton (25) are the only major-league, primary centerfielders with more home runs than Harris...Atlanta's last primary centerfielder (min. 75% of games in CF) to reach 24 homers was Hall of Famer Andruw Jones in 2007 (26 HR).



With an MLB-leading 11 doubles in August, Harris surged onto the major-league leaderboard in that regard, tied for third with 32...His 57 extra-base hits overall are tied for 10th in the NL.

ON BASE: Michael Harris II and Ozzie Albies each extended their on-base streaks to 16 games yesterday via home run, tied for the fourth-longest streaks in Major League Baseball.



The only longer active streaks belong to Bryce Harper (PHI, 34 games), Miguel Vargas (CWS, 18 games) and Heriberto Hernández (MIA, 18 games).



Albies' streak is his second-longest this season behind an 18-gamer than spanned April-May...Harris II hasn't recorded a longer single-season streak since September 2024, when he reached in 17 straight.

WITHIN THE DIVISION: Despite yesterday's loss, Atlanta enters play today with the best intradivision record in Major League Baseball (27-14, .659)...The Milwaukee Brewers rank second at 23-12 (.657).



The Braves' .659 intradivisional winning percentage would finish as the team's fifth-best in the Divisional Era (since 1969)...The club finished with higher marks in 1993 (.705), 1999 (.686), 2023 (.673) and 2004 (.671).



Following this series, Atlanta has 10 games remaining against NL East foes: seven against Philadelphia and three against Miami...The Braves are 5-1 (.833) versus the Phillies and 8-2 (.800) versus the Marlins this season.

HA-SEONG KIM: Logged three of the Braves' eight hits last night and contributed the club's only multi-hit effort...For Kim, it marked his second three-hit game as a Brave...He also recorded three hits on September 14, 2025 versus Houston.



The Braves have received at least three hits from the shortstop position in six games this season (Dubón, 2; Jarvis, 2; Mateo, 1; Kim, 1), the team's most since receiving 12 such games in 2023 (Arcia, 11; Lopez, 1).



Kim is back in the lineup this afternoon, starting at shortstop and batting ninth.
