RAY REPORT—The Rays wrap up their final road trip of the season against the Tigers (0-3) and Red Sox (2-0, 1 to play) with their final game of 2024 today at Fenway Park...are 7-4 in their last 11 games and 9-6 in their last 15...are 26-29 since the July 30 trade deadline and 32-33 since the All-Star break...have been eliminated from playoff contention, ending a streak of five consecutive postseason appearances from 2019-23 matched only by the Astros, Braves and Dodgers...have spent the entire season no more than five games below or three games above .500.

- ✦ The Rays matched a season-high (4x) with four infield singles as part of a 10-hit effort in last night's 7-2 win...their 1-3 hitters went a combined 7-for-13, including a 3-for-5, 3 RBI performance from **Junior Caminero**.
- ✦ Tampa Bay has scored 7+ runs twice over its last 19 games—both came against Boston (also Sept. 17 at TB, 8-3 W)...the Rays have held the Red Sox to two runs or fewer in four consecutive matchups, pitching to a 1.25 ERA (36.0IP 5ER)...it ties the longest streak in franchise history (3x, last: April 27–June 8 [G1], 2023).
- ✦ The Rays have now won seven of eight series against the Red Sox since the start of last season and have claimed four straight series victories at Fenway Park, their longest streak since April 27, 2019–Aug. 13, 2020 (also 4).
- ✦ A year after averaging a club-record 5.31 runs per game, the Rays 3.75 mark this season is the lowest in franchise history (prev. 3.78 in 2014)...they would need to score 10 runs today to surpass their 2014 average...they have pushed across double-digit runs six times this season (last: 11R on Aug. 31 vs. SD).
- ✦ The Rays 3.15 ERA since the All-Star break ranks second in the majors behind the Tigers (3.05)...their 4.20 ERA before the break was 11th in the AL/21st in MLB.
- ✦ Today, Tampa Bay seeks a seventh straight .500+ season...at minimum, the club will finish with 80+ wins for the eighth straight year and 15th time in 17 seasons since becoming the Rays in 2008 (2015 – 68-94; 2014 – 77-85).

WHAT'S AT STAKE

- ✦ Reach the .500 mark for the 34th time (excl. 0-0), tying the 2009 Twins for second most in MLB history behind the 1959 Cubs (35).
- ✦ Become the fifth team to go exactly .500 before and after the All-Star break since the Midsummer Classic's 1933 inception, joining the 2022 White Sox, 2015 Orioles, 1969 Astros, 1958 Tigers and 1953 Senators/Twins.
- ✦ Finish .500 or better for the seventh straight season, setting a new club record (prev. 6, 2018–23 and 2008-13)...they are one of four clubs to accomplish the feat each year from 2018-23, joining the Braves, Dodgers and Yankees.
- ✦ Conclude the season in third place in the AL East standings, which would mark their eighth straight season among the division's top three dating back to 2017.
- ✦ Sweep their final series of the season for the fourth time, joining 2020 (vs. PHI), 2014 (at CLE) and 2011 (vs. NYY)...it would mark the first time each of their final three series in a season resulted in sweeps (sweep vs. TOR, swept at DET).
- ✦ Improve to 11-1 in their last 12 games at Fenway Park.
- ✦ Record their first sweep at Fenway since Sept. 26-27, 2023 (2G) and first in a series of 3+ games since Aug. 10-13, 2020 (4G).

HI, KEVIN—Last night, **Kevin Kelly** extended his scoreless inning streak to 24.1, the longest active run in the majors, ahead of KC **Daniel Lynch** (20.2), and the third-longest single-season streak by a Ray, trailing **J.P. Howell** (27.1, 2012) and **Alex Cobb** (24.2, 2014)...it marks the fifth-longest streak overall, also trailing multi-season streaks by **Pete Fairbanks** (29.2, 2022-23) and **Alex Torres** (25.1, 2011-13)...Kelly has not permitted an earned run in 26 straight outings, the longest active streak in the majors, ahead of **STL Ryan Helsley** and **BOS Greg Weissert** (both 17), and second longest in Rays history behind **Pete Fairbanks** (30, 2022-23)...Kelly's run is the longest single-season streak by a Ray, surpassing **Howell** (24) in 2012.

Since the 0 ER streak began on July 23, Kelly leads the majors (min. 25.0IP) in opp. OPS (.362) while ranking highly in opp. OBP (T2nd, .186), WHIP (3rd, 0.63), opp. SLG (3rd, .175) ground ball rate (T5th, 60.0%), opp. average (8th, .144) and fewest pitches per IP (8th, 13.6)...15 of 26 appearances during the streak have been hitless.

LET'S GET IT STARTED—Rays starters have pitched to a 1.06 ERA (17.0IP, 2ER) over the last three games...they have allowed 3 ER or fewer in 21 consecutive games, their longest single-season streak since a 25-game run from May 2-31, 2019...the rotation has posted a 1.97 ERA (105.0IP, 23ER) and .182/.246/.290 (69-for-379) opp. slash line since the current streak began on Sept. 6—all marks lead the majors...currently 10th in the majors with a 3.825 ERA, decimal points ahead of the 11th-ranked Yankees (3.829), they are seeking a third consecutive season finishing with a top-10 ERA...they have accomplished the feat in six of the last seven seasons since 2017 (14th in 2021).

RUNNIN' RAYS—The Rays 178 SB lead the AL, ahead of the Guardians (148), and rank fourth in MLB behind the Nationals (222), Brewers (217) and Reds (205)...it marks the second-highest total in club history behind 2009 (194)...with only one game remaining, the Rays will lead the AL in steals for the sixth time, joining 2011, 2010, 2009, 2008 and 2003...they are just 1-for-5 on stolen base attempts over their last eight games and have gone a season-high six games without a steal, their longest streak since Sept. 23-30, 2023 (6G)...their last long streak was Aug. 1-9, 2023 (7G).

José Caballero leads the AL with 44 SB, three ahead of CLE **José Ramírez** (41SB)...he looks to join **Carl Crawford** (2007, 2006, 2004, 2003) as the only players in franchise history to pace the AL in steals...Caballero's 44 SB are tied for eighth most in club history and match **B.J. Upton** (2008) for the most by any Ray other than Crawford, who owns the club's seven highest single-season totals.

STUCK IN NEUTRAL—The Rays have spent the entire season no more than five games below or three games above .500...regardless of today's outcome, they will become the 12th team in the modern era (since 1901) to stray no more than five games from .500 over the course of an entire season...they are the ninth to do so over a full 162-game season, as three clubs turned the trick during the 60-game 2020 campaign...see the table to the right for the full list of teams, provided by STATS LLC.

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays lead the majors with 13 one-run games in September (5-8), ahead of the Athletics (12)...six of eight and seven of their last 10 games have been decided by one run...on the season, Tampa Bay owns MLB's second-best record in games decided by two runs or fewer (54-34/614), trailing San Diego (40-25/615), and the fourth-best mark in one-run games (30-22/577), despite its club-record 30 one-run victories ranking second behind Detroit (31)...the Rays 88 games decided by two runs or fewer pace MLB, ahead of the Brewers and Giants (both 84), and are third most in a season in club history (2015-94G; 2003-90G).

SHIPPING UP TO BOSTON—Yesterday's 7-2 win gave the Rays a 7-5 lead in the 13-game season series vs. the Red Sox, securing their sixth consecutive winning season against Boston dating back to 2019...their .652 (60-32) winning pct. vs. the Red Sox in that span is the highest in the AL, outpacing the Astros (20-12/.625), and marks the best record by any AL East club against a division rival over that timeframe, outpacing the Yankees over the Orioles (58-35/.624).

Min. 200 PA, **Brandon Lowe's** .628 SLG vs. Boston is fourth highest all-time behind **Babe Ruth** (.683), **Frank Robinson** (.652) and **Lou Gehrig** (.644).
✦ **Josh Lowe** is 19-for-52 (.365) with 4 2B, 4 HR, 9 RBI and a 1.094 OPS in his last 14 games against Boston dating to Sept. 26, 2023.

TODAY'S START—Pepiot will toe the rubber for his 26th start of the season and 12th on the road...has allowed 3 ER or fewer in 12 straight starts, posting a 2.71 ERA (63.0IP, 19ER)...the Rays are 6-4 in his last 10 starts...ranks fifth in the AL (min. 100.0IP) in whiff rate (30.1%) and eighth in opp. average (.211)...has been on the 15-day IL twice (May 6-22, lower left leg contusion; July 19-Aug. 16, right knee infection).

LAST TIME OUT—Did not factor into the decision on Sept. 24 at DET...worked 5.0 innings, allowing two runs on three hits and a season-high-tying four walks while striking out six...did not allow a hit until Riley Greene recorded a one-out single in the 4th frame...retired Zach McKinstry to open the 5th, but allowed the next three batters to reach (BB, 1B, BB)...got Kerry Carpenter to fly out, but with two outs, Wenceel Pérez recorded a two-run, ground-rule double, giving the Tigers a 2-0 lead.

IF THE SOX FIT—He has not factored into the decision in either of his starts this season opposite Boston, both of which came at Tropicana Field (May 22 & Sept. 18)...in his last outing, he struck out a career-high 12 batters across 6.0 innings, allowing just one run, a solo shot by Trevor Story in the 6th frame.

✦ Pepiot is 2-1 with a 3.33 ERA (27.0IP, 10ER) and 35 strikeouts in five starts against AL East foes this season.

ON THE ROAD—Pepiot has permitted 2 ER or fewer in seven straight road starts dating to June 21 at PIT, producing a 3.69 ERA (31.2IP, 13ER) in those outings...it ties the fourth-longest streak in club history (excl. openers)—Shane McClanahan (11GS, Aug. 13, 2021-July 26, 2022) holds the record...Pepiot's streak is tied for the fourth-longest active run in MLB behind ATL Chris Sale (13GS) and BAL Kyle Bradish/PHI Zack Wheeler (both 9GS).

LET'S GO STREAKING—He has allowed 3 ER or fewer in a career-high 13 straight starts overall, the second-longest active streak among AL pitchers (excl. openers) behind NYY Clarke Schmidt (17GS) and seventh longest in the majors...it marks the longest streak by a Rays starter since Shane McClanahan (23GS) from Sept. 8, 2021-July 26, 2022...Pepiot's 2.71 ERA (63.0IP, 19ER) since the streak began on June 21 ranks eighth in the AL (min. 50.0IP).

✦ From June 21-Aug. 26, Pepiot held opponents to 2 ER or fewer in a career-best eight straight starts, posting an AL-best (min. 40.0IP) 2.16 ERA (41.2IP, 10ER) in that span.

AN IMMACULATE PERFORMANCE—In his Sept. 18 outing, Pepiot tossed the fourth immaculate inning in Rays history and first by a starter, setting down Connor Wong, Willyer Abreu and Triston Casas in order in the 5th frame...he joined José Alvarado (Aug. 4, 2017 vs. MIL - 9th), Brad Boxberger (May 8, 2014 vs. BAL - 6th) and Rafael Soriano (Aug. 23, 2010 at LAA - 9th) as the only Rays pitchers to turn the trick...Pepiot recorded the first two strikeouts on six consecutive fastballs before going changeup, changeup, fastball to retire Casas...he generated five swinging strikes in the frame.

✦ It marked the second immaculate inning in the majors this season, joining CWS Michael Kopech on July 10 (G1) vs. MIN (9th)...Pepiot is the first starter to accomplish the feat since LAA Reid Detmers on July 31, 2022 vs. TEX (2nd)...according to Baseball Almanac, it marked the 114th immaculate inning in MLB history (47th in AL).

KEEP THE CHANGE—Over his last 10 starts, opponents are batting .116 (8-for-69) with 22 SO in at-bats ending with Pepiot's changeup...min. 50 AB, it marks the second-lowest opp. average on any MLB starter's changeup over that span (since July 9), trailing only MIN Bailey Ober (.113)...in his previous six starts from June 4-July 3, opponents had gone 13-for-28 (.464) against the pitch.

THINK FAST—Pepiot has held opponents to a .175 (37-for-211) clip on his four-seam fastball, recording 75 of his 137 strikeouts (54.7%) on the pitch...the .175 average is the second-lowest mark on any starter's four-seamer in the majors (min. 150AB, starts only), trailing PHI Aaron Nola (.167)...min. 150 AB, it would mark the third-lowest average on any Rays pitcher's four-seamer over a full season in the pitch tracking era (since 2008) behind Steve Geltz (.167) in 2015 and Colin Poche (.172) in 2019...he has a 32.2 pct. whiff rate on the offering, the highest mark on any MLB starter's four-seamer (min. 300 swings, starters only), ahead of CWS Garrett Crochet (31.4%).

✦ Pepiot collected a career-best 8 SO on his four-seamer in his Sept. 18 start vs. BOS, tied for third most by a Ray in the pitch tracking era (since 2008) behind a pair of efforts by Blake Snell (11SO on June 30, 2019 vs. TEX; 9SO on Aug. 21, 2018 vs. KC).
