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BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore and Boston had Tuesday's game postponed due to inclement weather...The Orioles had their seven-game winning streak snapped on Monday in the series opener following a three-game sweep of the Astros coming out of the All-Star break...The Birds have an off day tomorrow before returning home to host Atlanta this weekend...Despite Monday's loss, the club has won 10 of 14 and is 9.5 games behind Tampa Bay in the AL East and 3.0 games back in the Wild Card.

👉 **Shane Baz** surrendered two earned runs (4 total R) in 6.0 innings on Monday...He has a 3.26 ERA while allowing two earned runs or less in eight of 11 starts since May 20.

👉 **Gunnar Henderson** went 3-for-5 with a career-high three doubles and a run scored...It marks the second time in his career with 3+ extra-base hits, joining August 20, 2023 at Oakland (4 XBH)...He's the second Oriole with three doubles in a game this year, joining **Taylor Ward** on April 8 at Chicago-AL.

👉 The O's committed four errors on Monday, their most in a game since July 18, 2023 vs. Los Angeles-NL, and the team's 67 errors this season are tied with the Blue Jays for the AL lead...Only 11 times in MLB history has a team made the Postseason after leading their league in errors: 2025 Boston Red Sox (116 E), 2021 Boston Red Sox (108 E), 2020 New York Yankees (48 E), 2015 Pittsburgh Pirates (122 E), 2014 Pittsburgh Pirates (109 E), 1995 Boston Red Sox (120 E), 1995 Los Angeles Dodgers (130 E), 1985 Los Angeles Dodgers (166 E), 1971 San Francisco Giants (179 E), 1965 Minnesota Twins (172 E), and 1925 Pittsburgh Pirates (224 E).

👉 The club has allowed an MLB-high 58 unearned runs this season.

👉 Baltimore hitters have struck out at least 10 times in a season-high six straight games... Overall this season, the team has fanned 933 times, third most in the majors behind the Angels (958 K) and Pirates (956 K).

👉 The Orioles are 3-8 in their last 11 games against the Red Sox since August 25, 2025 while posting a 4.82 ERA and 3.5 runs per game during that time.

DOUBLE BUBBLE: The Orioles will play their third doubleheader of the year today, joining April 30 vs. Houston and May 24 vs. Detroit...Baltimore split both of those after winning the opening game of each.

ALL GOOD THINGS COME TO AN END: The O's seven-game winning streak was the longest by the Orioles since 2023, when the team had three separate streaks of 7+ wins in a row.

👉 Boston has won 14 games in a row, marking the third time Baltimore will face a team with a 14+ game winning streak, September 8-10, 2017 at Cleveland (15, 16, & 17 G) and June 17, 1991 vs. Minnesota (15 G).

BRAD TO THE BONE: **Kyle Bradish** is scheduled tonight to make his first start after agreeing to a five-year contract extension through 2031 on Saturday...He finished fourth in the AL Cy Young voting in 2023 before undergoing right elbow reconstruction with internal brace on June 19, 2024...Among pitchers with at least 60 starts since the start of 2023, Bradish's 3.03 ERA ranks 10th in the majors.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The Orioles are 21-27 (.438) on the road this season, but are 8-4 (.667) away from Camden Yards since June 20...The pitching staff has compiled a 2.51 ERA during that stretch while the offense, despite a .226 batting average and .380 slugging percentage, is averaging 4.8 runs per game over that period.

MAKING THEIR PITCH: The O's have posted a 3.48 ERA in 50 games since May 24, the third-best ERA in the majors during that time behind the Tigers (3.35) and Red Sox (3.38)...Entering that day, the Orioles had a 4.95 ERA in the first 51 games of the year, second worst in MLB ahead of the Astros (5.16).

👉 The rotation has posted a 3.52 ERA since May 24, the fourth-best starter ERA in the majors during that time behind the Tigers (3.07), Mariners (3.30), and Red Sox (3.50)... Entering that day, O's starters had a 5.13 ERA, second worst in MLB ahead of the Rockies (5.55).

👉 Orioles relievers have a 2.85 ERA since June 16, the third best in the majors behind the Yankees (2.52) and Astros (2.79)...Entering that day, the team's bullpen ERA was 4.53, ranked ninth in the AL and 21st in MLB.

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 92 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Mets (34 G)...The Orioles have drawn multiple walks in a season-high 21 straight games, their longest run since a 21-game stretch from July 20-August 10, 2024...Seven teams have had longer such stretches this season, led by the Twins who walked 2+ times in 29 straight games from March 26-April 27.

👉 **Taylor Ward** has 79 walks this season, 17 more than an Oriole had in 2025 and one more than the team leader had in 2024...The last O's player with more than 78 walks in a season was **Adley Rutschman** (92 BB) in 2023...An Oriole has not reached 100 free passes in a season since Albert Belle (101) in 1999.

👉 The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season (4/5 at PIT).

👉 Overall, the O's lead the AL and rank fourth in MLB with 390 walks.

FOR PETE'S SAKE: **Pete Alonso** is tied for third in the AL and is tied for 10th in the majors with 66 RBI...He is batting .267/.365/.504 (69-for-258) with 10 doubles, 17 homers, 44 runs, 53 RBI, 37 walks, and five hit-by-pitches in 70 games since May 1.

👉 Alonso played in his 500th consecutive game on June 27 vs. Washington and he has played 517 straight games, trailing ATL's Matt Olson (882 G) among active players...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, he is one of 39 players since 1900 to play in at least 500 consecutive games.

👉 He has posted three outs above average this year after tallying -9 in both 2025 and 2024... Alonso has one defensive run saved after posting -9 last year, worst among MLB first basemen.

QUICK HITS: Kremer is scheduled to make his sixth start of the season and 129th of his career today in Game 1 of the doubleheader at Boston...Went 11-10 in 2025 with a 4.19 ERA (80 ER/171.2 IP) and 1.21 WHIP on 163 hits (22 HR), 45 walks, two hit batters, nine wild pitches, and one balk with 142 strikeouts in 31 appearances (29 GS)... Led the Orioles in innings pitched...Was acquired by Baltimore on July 18, 2018, from Los Angeles-NL along with INF Rylan Bannon, OF Yusniel Díaz, RHP Zach Pop, and INF Breyvic Valera in exchange for INF Manny Machado.

👉 Was placed on the 15-day Injured List (right quad strain) on April 23 (retroactive to 4/20) and activated from the 60-day IL on July 1.

👉 Made his season debut on April 13 vs. Arizona after being recalled from Triple-A Norfolk prior to the game.

LAST TIME OUT: Didn't factor into the decision of a 3-2 Orioles win on July 17 at Houston, allowing two runs on four hits and a season-high three walks in 4.0 innings pitched with five strikeouts...Threw 83 pitches, 51 strikes.

👉 Marked his shortest start since throwing 3.0 scoreless innings vs. Los Angeles-NL on September 5, 2025...Had reached at least 5.0 innings in each of his previous six starts.

BEANTOWN: Kremer is 3-4 with a 5.04 ERA (28 ER/50.0 IP) over 10 career starts opposite Boston, including a 1-3 mark and 6.28 ERA (20 ER/28.2 IP) over six starts at Fenway Park...However, has won his past three decisions vs. the Red Sox since April 24, 2023, during which he holds a 1.93 ERA (5 ER/23.1 IP).

👉 Over 48 games (46 GS) against the AL East, Kremer is 16-12 with a 3.97 ERA (108 ER/245.0 IP) and 15 quality starts...Has won his past seven decisions (12 G) vs. the division since September 6, 2024, over which he has a 1.77 ERA (13 ER/66.0 IP) and 0.97 WHIP.

BOMBS AWAY: Kremer holds a 3.12 HR/9.0 IP through five starts this season, the highest mark of his career and a 1.97-point increase from 2025 (1.15 HR/9.0 IP)...He surrendered at least one home run in each of his first four starts this season, including a career-high four homers on July 8 vs. Chicago-NL...The nine homers allowed over his first four starts were a career high for any single four-game span in his career.

👉 Five of his home runs this season have come off his four seamer, which opponents are slashing .292/.357/.917 (7-for-24) against.

LICKETY-SPLIT: Opponents are batting .162 (6-for-37) with two home runs and 19 strikeouts off Kremer's splitter, which he's using a career-high 32.2 percent of the time ahead of 2025 (21.1%)...His 44.4 percent whiff rate on the pitch is the second-highest mark among MLB starters (min. 100 splitters thrown) behind PHI's Zack Wheeler (46.4%).

👉 Kremer's 39.4 percent whiff rate on his splitter in 2025 ranked third in MLB (min. 500 splitters thrown), trailing LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto (42.1%) and NYM's Kodai Senga (41.8%)...Held batters to a .206 average (32-for-155) on his split finger and recorded 51 strikeouts with it, the most with any of his pitches.

SMALL SAMPLE: His 28.2 percent strikeout rate through five starts this season is the highest mark of his career ahead of 2020 (26.5%) and an 8.1 percent increase from last season (20.1%)...The 48.7 percent strikeout rate on his splitter is the third-highest mark in MLB (min. 125 splitters thrown) behind ATH's Mark Leiter Jr. (54.4%) and NYY's Fernando Cruz (49.0%).

👉 His 32.8 percent hard hit rate is a career low ahead of 2024 (35.4%) and a 3.0 percent decrease from last season (35.8%).

RIGHT HAND MAN: Kremer is holding right-handed hitters to a .115 (6-for-52) average with two home runs, four walks, and 15 strikeouts over nine games (8 GS) since September 5, 2025...Over his first 27 outings (26 GS) of 2025, righties hit .260 (73-for-281) with 13 doubles, eight home runs, 20 walks, and 64 strikeouts.

IN THE ZONE: During the 2025 season, Kremer's 65.7 first-pitch strike percentage was the second-highest mark by a qualified Oriole since tracking began in 1988, trailing Wei-Yin Chen (68.3%, 2015)... That mark also ranked 10th in MLB and fifth in the AL behind DET's Tarik Skubal (71.5%), TOR's Kevin Gausman (68.8%), SEA's Bryan Woo (66.5%), and MIN's Joe Ryan (66.0%).

👉 Kremer has registered a 65.0 first-pitch strike percentage over five starts this season but only threw 53 percent of his first pitches for strikes (9/17) in his last start at Houston.

QUICK HITS: Bradish is scheduled to make his 20th start of the season and 87th of his career tonight in Game 2 of the doubleheader at Boston...Made six starts in his return from Tommy John surgery last season, going 1-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER/32.0 IP) on 23 hits (3 HR), 10 walks, and one hit batter with 47 strikeouts...Acquired from Los Angeles-AL along with RHP Kyle Brnovich, RHP Isaac Mattson, and RHP Zach Peek in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019.

☯️ Agreed to terms on a five-year contract with the O's on July 18, extending him through 2031.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his sixth win of the season on July 11 vs. Kansas City after tossing 6.2 innings of one-run ball, scattering two hits and two walks with five strikeouts...Threw 96 pitches, 58 strikes.

☯️ Over his last five starts since June 17, has pitched to a 2.12 ERA (8 ER/34.0 IP) with an 0.88 WHIP...The 2.12 ERA over that span is the fifth-lowest mark in the AL (min. 30.0 IP) behind teammate **Trevor Rogers** (0.88), BOS' Jake Bennett (1.17), CWS' Sean Burke (1.40), and BOS' Sonny Gray (1.60).

☯️ Recorded his team-leading ninth quality start.

BOSTON CALLING: Bradish is 1-6 with a 6.75 ERA (33 ER/44.0 IP) over ten career starts opposite Boston, including a 1-0 mark and 13.50 ERA (15 ER/10.0 IP) in three starts at Fenway Park...The 13.50 ERA is his highest mark at any ballpark over his career, behind PNC Park (9.00, 1 GS) and Rogers Centre (6.93, 5 GS).

☯️ However, earned his lone win against the Red Sox the last time he pitched at Fenway Park on September 8, 2023, when he threw 6.0 innings of two-run ball on four hits (1 HR) and zero walks with nine strikeouts in an 11-2 Orioles victory.

☯️ Over 38 career starts vs. the AL East, Bradish is 7-16 with a 5.04 ERA (105 ER/187.2 IP) and 13 quality starts...That includes a 2-4 mark with a 3.86 ERA (16 ER/37.1 IP) in seven starts this year.

BREAKING BRAD: Over two starts from June 17-22, Bradish allowed one run over 15.2 innings with 21 strikeouts to become the third pitcher in franchise history (since 1954) to have 20+ strikeouts and no more than one run allowed over a two-start span in a single season, joining Mike Mussina (2000) and Erik Bedard (2007).

☯️ Along with his career-high 12 strikeouts, he generated a career-high-tying 18 whiffs (also 9/20/23 at HOU) on June 17 at Seattle.

FIRST-INNING FOCUS: Bradish has allowed only two runs in the opening frame this season, during which opponents are slashing .190/.271/.302 (12-for-63) with four doubles, one home run, seven walks, and 23 strikeouts.
