**BIRDLAND BITES**: The Orioles continue their final homestand of the year tonight against the Yankees (1-1, 2 to play) and Rays (3 to play)...Baltimore is in the midst of 13 games in as many days with the club's next scheduled off day on Monday, September 22.

- (564, 584) The Birds are 13-6 (.684) since August 30, tied for the third-best record in MLB during that time with the Mariners, behind the Guardians (.750, 15-5) and Phillies (.737, 14-5)...Since May 24, the Orioles are 57-48 (.543), an 87-win pace, which is the fourth-best record in the AL over that period behind the Blue Jays (.615, 64-40), Red Sox (.569, 58-44). and Astros (.563, 58-45).
- 44), and Astros (.563, 58-45). **Gunnar Henderson** recorded his 500<sup>th</sup> career hit in the sixth inning and 100<sup>th</sup> career double in the seventh in his 489<sup>th</sup> game...He is the seventh fastest to 500 career hits in team history (since 1954) behind **Manny Machado** (439 G), **Cal Ripken**, **Jr.** (447 G), **Nick Markakis** (452 G), **Brian Roberts** (458 G), **Eddie Murray** (461 G), and **Trey Mancini** (486 G).
- Ryan Mountcastle opened the scoring with a solo home run last night and later added a sacrifice fly to record his first multi-RBI game this month.
- (2.32 ERA) and Dodgers (2.46 ERA).

MR. ROGERS' NEIGHBORHOOD: Following last night's 6.0 scoreless innings, Trevor Rogers has allowed two runs or fewer in a career-high 15 consecutive starts, the longest such stretch by an Orioles starter in team history (since 1954) and the longest by a major league starter this season...The last starter (non-opener) to post a longer streak of two or fewer runs is LAD's Julio Urías (17 G) from July 16, 2022-April 10, 2023.

- 6) He has now allowed 16 earned runs in 17 starts this season...Among pitchers with at least 15 starts and 50.0 innings pitched (to exclude openers), Rogers is looking to become the third pitcher since 1913 (when ER were tracked in both leagues) to finish with fewer earned runs than starts, joining TEX's Jacob deGrom in 2021 (15 GS, 11 ER) and BOS' Dutch Leonard in 1914 (25 GS, 24 ER), per the Elias Sports Bureau.
- (b) Last night, Rogers became the first Orioles starter to allow one or no hits and surrender no runs in a start against the Yankees since **Chris Ellis** on September 4, 2021 at Yankee Stadium (5.0 IP, 1 H), the first to do so at home since **Wade Miley** on April 9, 2017 (5.0 IP,
- (b) 1 H), and the first to do so while completing 6.0 innings since Adam Loewen on August 5, 2006 at Oriole Park (6.1 IP, 1 H).

<u>LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS</u>: Dylan Beavers has reached base safely in 23 of his first 28 career games since August 16, ranking among AL leaders in on-base percentage (5<sup>th</sup>, .417) and walks (6<sup>th</sup>, 22).

- (2) His 22 walks are the second most in O's history (since 1954) through a player's first 28 career games behind **Glenn Gulliver** (23 BB, 1982)...The club record through 29 games is also held by Gulliver (23 BB).
- (9) He has reached base safely 45 times to begin his career, tied for the second most through a player's first 28 career games in team history (since 1954) with Curtis Goodwin (1995), behind **Billy Ripken** (48 TOB, 1987)...The most through 29 games is Ripken (50 TOB) ahead of Goodwin (48 TOB).

<u>HOLLIDAY SEASON</u>: Jackson Holliday paces the Birds with 17 home runs, one ahead of **Gunnar Henderson** (16 HR)...The only Oriole under 22 years old to finish the season leading the club in homers is Eddie Murray (27 HR, 1977).

  8 Baltimore has not had a player fail to reach the 20 home run mark since 2001, when Jay Gibbons and Chris Richard each paced the club with 15 homers apiece...Only five teams in Orioles history (since 1954) have not had a player hit 20+ homers ('01, '74, '57, '55, '54).

IT TAKES A VILLAGE: With José Castillo making his team debut on Thursday, Baltimore has used 69 different players this season, one shy of the major league record set by the 2024 Marlins...The 2021 Cubs also used 69 players...The Braves have used 68 players this year...The previous team record for the Orioles was set in 2021 with 62.

- (h) The O's have used 40 different pitchers this year (including position players), second most in a season in franchise history (since 1954) behind the 2021 Orioles (42).
- The Orioles have had 34 different position players appear in a game, the most by a major league team since 2022 (37, SF; 34, LAA, OAK, PIT) and tied for the most in a season in franchise history with 1955.
- The Orioles have had 23 players hit a home run for the team, breaking the team record (since 1954)...That's the most players to homer by one MLB team since 2024 (SF, 23).
- Baltimore has had 19 players steal a base, breaking the O's record.
- The Birds have used seven different players at catcher, setting the franchise record...The last MLB club to use at least seven catchers in a single season was the 2023 Cleveland Guardians (also 7)...The 2022 Pirates are the last team to use eight.

YANKEE DOODLES: Baltimore and New York meet five times over the final nine days of the regular season, including two more times in this series at Camden Yards and three times at Yankee Stadium to wrap up the schedule from September 26-28...The team have split the first eight games in 2025...The O's have won two straight season series against the Yanks since 2023 after losing six straight years from 2017-22...Baltimore has not won three consecutive season series against New York since 2014-16.

### THIS DATE IN O'S HISTORY September 20, 1958 - Knuckleballe

Hoyt Wilhelm pitches the first nohitter in Orioles history, beating the Yankees, 1-0, at Memorial Stadium.

September 20, 1966 - Frank Robinson hits his 47<sup>th</sup> home run of the season at Kansas City, breaking Jim Gentile's club record of 46 set in 1961. Robinson would hit 49, a record that stood until Brady Anderson hit 50 in 1996 and Chris Davis hit 53 in 2013.

September 20, 1970 - Jim Palmer joins teammates Mike Cuellar and Dave McNally to the 20-win club as the Orioles become the first team with three 20-game winners since Cleveland in 1956 (Early Wynn, Bob Lemon, Herb Score).

September 20, 1998 - Prior to the last home game of the year, Cal Ripken, Jr. asks O's Manager Ray Miller to take him out of the lineup, ending Ripken's major league record of consecutive games played at 2,632.

QUICK HITS: Set to make his 29th career MLB start...Is the third-ever Japanese QUICK HITS: Set to make his 29<sup>th</sup> career MLB start...Is the third-ever Japanese player for the Orioles, joining right-handed relievers **Shintaro Fujinami** (2023) and **Koji Uehara** (2009-11)...In his March 30 debut at Toronto, at 35 years, 170 days old, became the oldest Japanese player to make his MLB debut since NYM's Ken Takahashi (40-016) on May 2, 2009 at Philadelphia...Is the 10<sup>th</sup> Japanese-born rookie pitcher to record 10+ wins in a season (last: CHC's Shota Imanaga in 2024 - 15 W).

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on September 13 at Toronto after

throwing 6.0 innings of one-run ball, allowing four hits (1 HR) with zero walks and four strikeouts...Threw 63 pitches, 45 strikes.

Became the second Oriole starter in franchise history (since 1954) to complete 6.0 innings on 63 pitches or fewer, joining Mark Williamson on April 29, 1988 at Chicago-AL (6.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 2 K, 61 P).

**BATTLING THE EVIL EMPIRE**: Set to make his third start against the Yankees, having gone 1-0 with a 3.12 ERA (3 ER/8.2 IP)...Struck out a career-high-tying eight hitters (also 7/27 vs. COL) in his April 28 start opposite New York at Camden Yards.

TAKING ON THE LEGENDS: In each of his prior three starts, Sugano took on a trio of 200+ game winners in SF's Justin Verlander (265-14). LABLE OF 200+ game winners in SF's Justin Verlander (265 W), LAD's Clayton Kershaw (222 W), and TOR's Max Scherzer (221 W).

O According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the last MLB starter to make three straight

- outings against opponents with 200+ career wins was WSH's Jason Bergmann, who faced Tom Glavine and made back-to-back start opposite Jamie Moyer from September 25, 2007-April 3, 2008.
- The last occurrence in a single season was FLA's Scott Olsen from September 8-24, 2006...Olsen faced both Glavine and Moyer twice during a four-start stretch during that period.

<u>UPS AND DOWNS</u>: Prior to making his 10<sup>th</sup> quality start of the year in his last start at Toronto, Sugano posted a 10.22 ERA (14 ER/12.1 IP) in his previous three starts with opponents slashing .397/.419/.776 (23-for-58)...That followed a five-start stretch from July 27-August 19 in which he went 3-0 with a 1.91 ERA (6 ER/28.1 IP) and opponents

(22-for-103).

(3) Left-handed hitters are 15-for-41 (.366) with one double, one triple, six home runs, and 11 RBI against him over his last four outings...During his previous five starts, Sugano limited lefties to a .192 (10-for-52) average with three doubles, one triple, zero home runs, and one RBI.

WISE BEYOND HIS YEARS: Sugano has made five starts of 7.0+ innings, the most among all MLB rookies ahead of ATH's Jacob Lopez (4 GS).

Os Sugano's 10 wins and 149.2 innings both rank second among all MLB rookies behind CHC's Cade Horton (11 W) and NYY's Will Warren (157.1 IP), respectively... He is seeking to become the fourth O's pitcher to lead all rookies in wins and innings in a season in club history (since 1954) along with Daniel Cabrera (2004), Wally Bunker (1964), and Chuck Estrada (1960), per Stats Perform.

HOME RUN HOMEWORK: Sugano has permitted a total of 22 home runs from innings

- Of the 28 homer she has allowed overall, 20 have been solo shots and four have come with one runner on base...The 20 solo homers are fifth most MLB behind CIN's Zack Littell (26 HR), CHC's Shota Imanaga (24 HR), and ATH's Jeffrey Springs/SEA's Bryan Woo (both 21 HR).
- The 20 solo shots are the most allowed by an Orioles starter since Gabriel Ynoa (23 HR) in 2019.

<u>TOP OF MIND</u>: Opposing one-hole hitters are slashing .368/.422/.632 (28-for-76) with six home runs off Sugano...His 1.053 OPS allowed against one-hole hitters is fourth highest in the majors (min. 75 BF) ahead of COL's Kyle Freeland (1.162 OPS), MIN's Taj Bradley (1.157 OPS), and CWS' Shane Smith (1.075 OPS).

### **TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP KYLE BRADISH (1-1, 2.45)**

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his first win of the season on September 15 at Chicago-AL after tossing 5.0 innings of one-run ball, scattering four hits and four walks with nine strikeouts...Has allowed four hits in each of his four starts in 2025 and has allowed four or fewer hits in 11 of 12 starts since the beginning of 2024.

.NEW YORK-AL: Has made five career starts opposite the Yankees, going 1-1 with a 3.24 ERA (9 ER/25.0 IP)...Last faced New York at Oriole Park at Camden Yards on May 2, 2024 and did not factor into the decision... Worked 4.2 innings, allowing one run on four hits, two walks, and one hit batter with five strikeouts
