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**BIRDLAND BITES:** The Orioles continue a seven-game homestand tonight against the Red Sox (0-2, 2 to play) before hosting the Guardians (3 to play) beginning Monday...Baltimore wrapped up a 6-3 road trip at the Cardinals (2-1), Athletics (3-0), and Rockies (1-2) on Wednesday, but dropped the final two games in Colorado...The O's are in the midst of 16 games in as many days since August 25, which will end with an off day following this homestand on September 10...The O's are in fifth place in the AL East and 3.0 games behind Cleveland for the final Wild Card spot with Toronto (1.0 GB) and Texas (2.0 GB) the first teams out of the last spot.

👉 The Orioles have lost four games in a row for the fifth time this year (last: 8/17-20) and one shy of their season high (4/30 [G2]-5/4)...The O's won eight of 10 before this losing streak from August 21-31.

👉 The Birds have dropped three straight games all by one run for the first time since August 5 (G1)-6, 2020...The club has not lost four consecutive games by a run since May 10-14, 2017.

👉 Last night, Baltimore was shut out for the fifth time this year and for the fourth time since July 28...Friday was the first 1-0 Orioles loss since August 12, 2025 vs. Seattle and the first 1-0 O's defeat with the lone run scoring via home run since September 13, 2024 at Detroit (Kerry Carpenter HR).

👉 **Coby Mayo** extended his hitting streak to a career-high nine games yesterday...He's 10-for-32 (.313) with two homers and eight RBI during that stretch.

👉 **Blaze Alexander** recorded three of the team's six hits last night...Over the last three games, Alexander has accounted for over 30 percent of the Orioles hits (7-of-23).

👉 Since the beginning of the previous road trip, **Christian Encarnacion-Strand** is slashing .368/.415/.605 (14-for-38) with three doubles, two homers, six runs, and eight RBI in 11 games (9 GS).

**POLAR BEAR SIGHTING:** **Pete Alonso** ranks among AL leaders in RBI (T-1<sup>st</sup>, 94), home runs (4<sup>th</sup>, 33), total bases (4<sup>th</sup>, 265), slugging percentage (5<sup>th</sup>, .498), OPS (5<sup>th</sup>, .856), runs (T-7<sup>th</sup>, 86), extra-base hits (6<sup>th</sup>, 57), and hits (9<sup>th</sup>, 142).

👉 Alonso has started all 142 O's games this year, tied for the most in the majors this year with SF's Rafael Devers...The only other player in the AL to start each of his team's games this year is TB's Junior Caminero (141 GS)...The last Oriole to start every team game in a season was Jonathan Schoop in 2016.

👉 Alonso is tied with HOU's Yordan Alvarez for the AL lead in RBI...He looks to become the eighth player in franchise history (since 1954) to lead the AL in RBI, joining Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).

👉 According to *STATS Perform*, since RBI became official in 1920, the only players to lead the AL in RBI in their first year playing in the Junior Circuit (including ties) are TEX's Josh Hamilton (130 RBI, 2008), CWS' Dick Allen (113 RBI, 1972), BAL's Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), BOS' Dick Stuart (118 RBI, 1963), and BOS' Ted Williams (145 RBI, 1939).

**PLAYING THE LONG GAME:** The Birds have hit 38 homers since August 9, second most in MLB behind the Cubs (53) and ahead of the Athletics and White Sox (both 33) in the AL during that time...Last night snapped a 10-game homer streak for the O's at Camden Yards since August 4.

**PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE:** The O's lead the AL and rank fourth in the majors with 526 walks this season behind the Cubs (598 BB), Brewers (584 BB), and Dodgers (533 BB)...The Guardians are second in the AL with 508 free passes.

👉 The team's 30 games with 6+ walks are the most by a Baltimore club since 1999 (35).

👉 The Birds are averaging 3.98 pitches per plate appearance, tied for second in MLB with the Yankees behind the Brewers (3.99).

**'PEN PALS:** The Orioles bullpen has allowed nine runs (7 ER) in the last four games, but the team's 2.03 ERA (11 ER/48.2 IP) in 15 games since August 20 ranks second in the majors during that period behind the Braves (1.90 ERA).

👉 **Alex Hoppe** has yet to allow an earned run in 13 appearances (10.1 IP) since making his Orioles debut on August 5...His streak of 13 consecutive appearances without allowing an earned run is tied for the third-longest active streak in the AL with teammate **Josh Walker**, behind HOU's Josh Hader (20 G) and TOR's Mason Fluharty (18 G).

👉 **Yennier Cano** surrendered a home run on Thursday, snapping a streak of 48 consecutive appearances without allowing one.

👉 Ten Baltimore pitchers have recorded at least one save this season, tying the 1987 Orioles for the most in franchise history (since 1954)...The Birds are one of 11 teams in MLB to have at least 10 players tally at least one save this year, led by the Cubs (13).

**NIP AND TUCK:** The Orioles are 46-50 in games decided by three runs or fewer, tied for the most such games in the majors this year with the Guardians (50-46)...The .479 winning percentage in those games ranks 19<sup>th</sup> in the majors.

👉 Baltimore is 16-22 in one-run games this year...The .421 winning percentage is the fifth lowest in the majors this year.

**KEYS TO SUCCESS:** The High-A Frederick Keys won their 81<sup>st</sup> game of the season last night at Brooklyn, setting the franchise record for regular season wins...The team's .638 winning percentage is the best among full-season minor league teams this year and would be the best by a full-season Orioles minor league team since Single-A Delmarva was 90-48 (.652) in 2019.

👉 Frederick has already clinched a playoff spot by winning the South Atlantic League North Division first half, but the magic number to clinch the second half division title is one over Greensboro (PIT) with two games to play...Regardless of the second half results, the Keys will face the Grasshoppers in the first round of the playoffs with game one of the best-of-three series at Greensboro on September 8...Frederick will host game two on September 10, as well as game three (if necessary) on September 11.

**QUICK HITS:** Bassitt is scheduled to make his 15<sup>th</sup> start (17<sup>th</sup> appearance) of the season...Signed a one-year major league contract with Baltimore on February 13, 2026, to mark his fifth MLB team, following Toronto (2023-25), New York-NL (2022), Oakland (2015-21), and Chicago-AL (2014)...Was selected by Chicago-AL in the 16<sup>th</sup> round (No. 501 overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft.  
⚡ Was placed on the 15-day Injured List (low back discomfort) on June 8, retroactive to June 5, and transferred to the 60-day IL on July 17...Reinstated from the 60-day IL on August 14.  
⚡ Reached 10 years of major-league service time in May.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Bassitt earned the win on August 30 at the Athletics, allowing five runs in 5.2 innings pitched on eight hits (1 HR) and three walks with four strikeouts...Threw 99 pitches, 65 strikes.  
⚡ The eight hits tied a season high (3x, last: 8/19 vs. NYY).  
⚡ Has pitched at least 5.0 innings in a season-high-tying four consecutive starts since returning from the IL on August 14.

**BOSTON CALLING:** Has made 10 career starts opposite Boston, going 2-4 with a 3.88 ERA (24 ER/55.2 IP).  
⚡ Has lost his past four decisions (5 GS) vs. the Red Sox since August 28, 2024, during which he holds a 6.23 ERA (15 ER/21.2 IP).

**A TALE OF TWO PITCH TYPES:** Hitters are slashing .204/.297/.301 (21-for-103) with four doubles and two homers off Bassitt's breaking balls (curve, sweeper, slider) compared to .350/.409/.515 (72-for-206) with 13 doubles and seven homers on his fastballs (sinker, cutter, four seamer).  
⚡ However, his .233 opponent average (17-for-73) on his curveball this season is the second-highest mark of his career ahead of 2015 (.255)...In 2025, his .172 opponent average (17-for-99) on the pitch was fourth lowest in MLB among 20 pitchers that threw 400 or more curveballs.

**TO THE LEFT:** Bassitt has allowed 21 of his 27 extra-base hits (18 2B, 9 HR) this season to lefties, who are slugging .521 against him compared to a .331 mark for right-handed batters...In 2025, he allowed 38 extra-base hits (22 2B, 3 3B, 13 HR) to left-handed batters, more than double his 18 extra-base hits (9 2B, 9 HR) given up to righties.  
⚡ Allowed his first home run of the season to a righty (Brian Serven) in his last start on August 30 at the Athletics.

**WEAK CONTACT:** Only 14 of Bassitt's 269 batted balls (5.2%) have been barreled this season...The 5.2 percent barrel rate is the second-lowest mark of his career (4.7%, 2015) and ranks in the 85<sup>th</sup> percentile of MLB.  
⚡ His 87.7 mph average exit velocity ranks in the 71<sup>st</sup> percentile of MLB while his 36.1 percent hard-hit rate ranks in the 68<sup>th</sup> percentile.

**MAKING THE ADJUSTMENT:** The first time through the lineup, opponents are batting .347 (43-for-124) with eight doubles, five home runs, 14 walks, and a .956 OPS.  
⚡ Those figures drop to .294 (37-for-126) with eight doubles, three home runs, nine walks, and a .774 OPS the second time through, and .243 (17-for-70) with two doubles, one home run, six walks, and a .643 OPS the third time around.

**MY HOUSE:** Bassitt is 11-1 (.917) with a 2.89 ERA (42 ER/130.2 IP) over 23 home games (21 GS) since 2025, during which his teams are 17-6 (.739)...His .917 winning percentage at home is the best mark in MLB (min. 20 GS) over that span ahead of MIL's Jacob Misorowski (.909, 10-1).  
⚡ During the 2025 season, went 8-0 with a 2.71 ERA (28 ER/93.0 IP) in 16 home starts with Toronto.

**TIME OF THE SEASON:** Bassitt is 29-19 with a 3.21 ERA (163 ER/457.1 IP) over 85 career appearances (77 GS) in the months of August and September compared to 60-49 with a 3.95 ERA (392 ER/892.1 IP) in 161 career games (153 GS) from March-July...He holds a 4.24 ERA (11 ER/23.1 IP) in four August starts this season after pitching to a 5.27 ERA (33 ER/56.1 IP) over his first 12 games (10 GS) of the year.  
⚡ Held a 4.24 ERA (58 ER/123.0 IP) with a .274 opponent average (135-for-492) in his first 23 games (22 GS) last season from March-July...Recorded a 3.23 ERA (17 ER/47.1 IP) and .223 opponent average (39-for-175) in nine starts from August-September.

**WORK HORSE:** Bassitt is one of 28 active MLB pitchers to have reached 1,300 career innings, which he did on April 22 at Kansas City... Entering the 2026 campaign, he was one of seven MLB pitchers to have made at least 30 starts in each of the past four seasons, joining Toronto's José Berrios, Dylan Cease, and Patrick Corbin, Chicago-NL's Kevin Gausman, Miles Mikolas, and SF's Logan Webb.
