THE TWINS: Completed their three-game homestand/series with a 2-1 victory against the Royals over the weekend, winning games one and three...tonight, they will begin a short three-game roadtrip/series against the Yankees in the Bronx through Wednesday.
✎ Minnesota returns to the road where they have gone 24-36 this season...their last roadtrip was August 1-6, coming out of the trade deadline, where they dropped the first two games in Cleveland, won the finale, then took two of three in Detroit from August 4-6.
✎ Overall, the Twins have won four of their last five and five of their last seven.

BEST SUNDAY FITZ: The Twins beat the Royals yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 5-3 in 11 innings, earning their ninth walk-off win of 2025 — tied with San Francisco and Boston for most in baseball...José Ureña was the opener and allowed one run on three hits in 3.0 innings pitched...the club used six relievers, highlighted by Michael Tonkin, who earned his first win of the season, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings in the 10th and 11th...the offense recorded seven hits, two from Ryan Fitzgerald...Fitz recorded his first career hit with a home run in the third inning and his second career hit with a single in the fifth...Luke Keaschall went 3-for-5 and hit his first career walk-off homer, a two-run shot in the 11th inning off Carlos Estevez.
✎ For Fitzgerald, he had 2,516 career minor league at-bats and he homered in his fourth big league at-bat...he also played in 708 minor league games prior to yesterday.

WELCOME BUCK: The Twins have reinstated outfielder Byron Buxton from the 10-day Injured List...Buxton was placed on the 10-day IL on July 29 and missed the club's last 13 games with left ribcage inflammation...the 2025 AL All-Star has played in 85 games for the Twins this season, hitting .282 (92-for-326) with 14 doubles, four triples, 23 home runs, 59 RBI, 29 walks, 17 stolen bases, 68 runs scored and a .905 OPS...Buxton last week was announced as the Twins winner of the 2025 Heart and Hustle Award, voted on by the Major League Baseball Player's Alumni Association, marking the third time in his career (2017 and 2019).
✎ To make room for Buxton on the 26-man roster, the Twins optioned outfielder Carson McCusker to Triple-A St. Paul following yesterday afternoon's game...McCusker, who was recalled by Minnesota on Saturday appeared in one game during his most recent stint, going 1-for-3.

START SPREADING THE NEWS: The Twins and Yankees are playing the first of six games in 2025...Minnesota will host the Yankees for three games from September 15-17...Minnesota went 0-6 vs. the Yankees last season...they have lost seven straight against the Yankees, seeking their first win over New York since a 6-2 victory on April 25, 2023 at Target Field...prior to this stretch, they had gone 5-2 vs. the Yankees from September of 2022-April of 2023.
✎ Minnesota is 0-5 at Yankee Stadium dating back to April of 2023, their last win here coming on April 14, 2023, a 4-3 victory...prior to this slide, they won three-straight in the Bronx.
✎ Royce Lewis has homered in the only two games he has played against the Yankees, both in this ballpark on June 4 and 5, 2024, off Tommy Kahnle and Dennis Santana.

LUUUUUUUUUKE!!!: Luke Keaschall was named American League Player of the Week today...he played in five games, hitting .455 (10-for-22) with three doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, an .864 slugging percentage and a 1.318 OPS...the last Twin to win the award was Iy France, April 7-13...last Twins rookie with the award was Max Kepler in August of 2016.

TURN KEA TO START: Since returning from the Injured List, Luke Keaschall has gone 10-for-22 (.455) with three doubles, two home runs and 10 RBI...he has now hit safely in each of his first 11 games with an at-bat to start his career...also has reached base safely in all 12...below are Twins (since 1961) best on-base streaks to begin their career (above) and best hitting streaks to begin their career (below):

LUE EASCHALL, WITH NO Ks: In 48 major league plate appearances, Luke Keaschall has struck out just three times...the three strikeouts were April 19 at Atlanta vs. Chris Sale and Raisel Iglesias and yesterday vs. Ryan Bergert...in fact, since Keaschall came back from the IL on August 5, the Twins as a team have struck out just 30 times in 199 plate appearances — that figure is tied with the Yankees for the fewest in baseball since that date.

AMERICA'S NEXT TOP JEFF: Ryan Jeffers extended his season-high hitting streak to 12 games yesterday...his career-high is 14, done July 15-August 9, 2023...he is the second Twin with a double-digit hitting streak this season...the high for a Twin in 2025 was Brooks Lee's 19 (May 28-June 20).
✎ It's the second-longest active streak in baseball, trailing Dominic Smith's 13...teammate Luke Keaschall's 11-game streak is third.
✎ Over his last 24 games, Jeffers is hitting .382 (34-for-89) with seven doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI, four walks, a .421 on-base percentage, a .528 slugging percentage and a .949 OPS.

FEELING LIKE A MILLION BUX: Over his last 36 games, Byron Buxton is hitting .316 (43-for-136) with eight doubles, one triple, 13 home runs, 21 RBI, 31 runs scored, 12 walks, a .377 on-base percentage, a .676 slugging percentage and a 1.054 OPS.
✎ He has a 14.17 at-bat-per-home run ratio, fourth-best in the AL and seventh-best in baseball, trailing Cal Raleigh (9.71), Kyle Schwarber (10.56), Aaron Judge (10.59), Shohei Ohtani (11.10), Eugenio Suárez (11.49) and Junior Caminero (13.81).
✎ Buxton is 17-for-17 in stolen base attempts this season, one of two players in baseball with a stolen base percentage of 100% (minimum 15 attempts), the other being Trevor Story (19-for-19)...he has gone 23-for-his-last-23 with his last caught stealing being May 1, 2024 at Chicago-AL (Korey Lee/Chris Flexen).
✎ At 17 stolen bases, Buck needs three more to become the seventh different Twin (8th overall time) to join the 20/20 club...the others are Kirby Puckett (1986), Brian Dozier (2014), Corey Koskie (2001), Torii Hunter (2002 & 2004), Larry Hise (1977) and Marty Cordova (1995).

FLORIDA MAN: Low-A Fort Myers first baseman JP Smith II has been named Florida State League Player of the Week...in five games for the Mighty Mussels, Smith went 11-for-23 (.478) with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, six RBI and just two strikeouts.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: On this day in 2008, Ron Gardenhire earned his 600th managerial win in a 4-0 defeat of New York-AL at the Metrodome...Glen Perkins was the starter and winner that day, pitching 8.0 shutout innings with four hits allowed.

TIGER KING: Last pitched on August 5 at Detroit, opposite former Twin Chris Paddock, and earned his third win of the season and fourth of his career in Minnesota's 6-3 victory...allowed one run on five hits, with one walk and six strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...sole run allowed came on a Kerry Carpenter RBI double in the third inning.

⚔ Has recorded four-or-more strikeouts in each of his last 15 starts...is one of 11 pitchers to have an active streak of four-plus strikeouts in their last 15-plus starts.

GOT SOX'D: Pitched on July 30 vs. Boston, opposite Brayan Bello, and was dealt in his third loss of the season and seventh of his career in Minnesota's 1-13 defeat...allowed a season-high-tying five runs on a season-high-tying eight hits (1 HR), with no walks and four strikeouts in 4.1 innings.

⚔ Recorded a strikeout swinging, wild pitch in the fourth inning, allowing Masataka Yoshida to reach first base...marked the first time a Twins pitcher has allowed a runner to reach base on a strikeout swinging, wild pitch since Pablo López did so on May 4, 2023 at Chicago-AL...was also his second wild pitch of the season and third of his career.

MOW 'EM DOWN MATTHEWS: Matthews has totaled 91 strikeouts through his first 17 career major league games, the second most in Twins history (1961-)...here are some of his numbers compared to other Twins pitchers through their first 17 games:

⚔ Matthews' 48 strikeouts so far in 2025 are the third most by a Twins pitcher in their first eight starts this season, behind Joe Ryan (54) and Pablo López (49).

IN THE BRONX: Matthews is facing the New York Yankees for the first time...they become his 15th new opponent faced in 18 career games...he is 0-3, posting a 13.50 ERA (14.0 IP, 21 ER) with five walks, 20 strikeouts and a .397 (27-for-68) opponent batting average in four career starts against American League East opponents...nearly half of Zebby's total earned runs allowed in his career have come against the AL East.

⚔ Is his highest ERA and opponent batting average among all divisions.

⚔ With two outs and runners in scoring position, opponents have gone 9-for-37 with two doubles, one home run, four walks, 26 RBI and 16 strikeouts.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Zebby has gone 2-3 with an 7.44 ERA (32.2 IP, 27 ER), six walks, 47 strikeouts and a .322 (46-for-143) opponent batting average in eight career major league starts at home; compared to 2-4, 4.78 ERA (43.1 IP, 23 ER) with 15 walks, 44 strikeouts and a .274 (48-for-175) opponent batting average in nine career major league starts on the road.

⚔ In five major league starts on the road this season, Matthews has gone 2-2, posting a 5.63 ERA (24.0 IP, 15 ER) with nine walks, 28 strikeouts and a .289 (28-for-97) opponent batting average.

PLATOON SPLITS: Through his first eight major league starts this season, left-handed hitters have slashed .273/.313/.403 in 77 at-bats vs. Matthews, while righties have slashed .286/.329/.429 in 77 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 87.1 mph and a whiff rate of 31.1 compared to righties' 89.6 mph and 25.0 percent.

⚔ His hard-hit rate against lefties is 35.3 percent, compared to 44.9 percent in 2024; and his hard-hit rate against righties is 40.4 percent, compared to 38.5 percent in 2024.

THE ARSENAL: Matthews uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 45% of the time...primarily uses his fastball and slider against right-handed batters, while favoring is changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his 2025 pitch breakdown:

⚔ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 100 sliders, Zebby ranks second in strikeout percentage at 50.9 percent and has the 30th lowest opponent batting average (.167).

⚔ Holds the highest average fastball velocity among all Twins starters this season at 96.5 mph...followed by José Ureña (96.4), Pablo López (94.4) and David Festa (94.1).

⚔ His 11.27 SO/9 leads Twins starters...followed by Joe Ryan (9.93), Pablo López (9.05), David Festa (8.94) and Simeon Woods Richardson (7.70).

⚔ Added a sinker to his pitch arsenal in his last start against Detroit on August 5.
