RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and visiting Atlanta Braves kick off the final series before the All-Star Break tonight with the first of three this weekend at Busch Stadium ... St. Louis opened their six-game homestand by taking two-of-three from the Washington Nationals.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis entered today in 3rd place in the NL Central, 5.5 games behind first place Chicago and 1.0 game behind San Francisco (51-43) for the 3rd Wild Card spot ... St. Louis is scheduled to play 97 games before the All-Star break, tying the 1969 Cardinals (49-48 record) for the most in franchise history before the break.

LIVE FROM ST. LOUIS, IT'S FRIDAY NIGHT!: The Cardinals are 5-1 in their red Nike City Connect jerseys on Friday home games, and are 15-5 (.750) overall in weekend home games (Friday-Sunday), MLB's 2nd-best home weekend win pct. behind San Francisco (16-2, .889).

NIFTY FIFTY: The Cardinals have reached the 50-win mark before the All-Star break for the second consecutive season, marking the first time St. Louis has logged 50+ wins prior to the All-Star Break in back-to-back years since 2014-15 (52 & 56).

YOUNG GUNS: **Matthew Liberatore** is the youngest Cardinals lefty starter age 25 or younger to win 6+ games since 23-year-old **Jaime García** won 13 in 2010 ... Libby's six victories lead MLB lefty starters age 25 or younger this season, and only trails **Bryan Woo** (8) and **Spencer Schwellenbach** (7) among any pitcher 25 or younger.

BEST FRIENDS: **Nolan Gorman** has homered in three consecutive games started (8 total RBI) by his teammate & childhood friend, **Matthew Liberatore**.

RED CARPET HIT PARADE: **Brendan Donovan** needs two hits this weekend to become the first Cardinal with 100+ pre-All Star hits since 1B **Paul Goldschmidt** (112) in his 2022 MVP season and just the second to do so since SS **Jhonny Peralta** (100 in 2015) ... Cards primary second baseman to reach the 100+ hit threshold before the break include **Fernando Viña** (102 in 2001), **Tom Herr** (106 in 1985), and **Red Schoendienst** (106 in 1949; 114 in 1953; 119 in 1954).

NOT YOUR AVERAGE JOES: **Alec Burleson** (.289, 10th) and **Brendan Donovan** (.296, 2nd) are aiming to become the first pair of Cardinals to rank in the National League Top 10 in batting at the All-Star break since 2013: **Yadier Molina** (.341, 1st) and **Allen Craig** (.333, 2nd).

ON-BASYN WINN: **Masyn Winn** has reached base safely in his last 17 home games since June 5, longest home on-base streak by a Cardinal since 29 in a row at home by **Brendan Donovan** (May 4-June 30, 2024).

THE HEAT IS ON: Atlanta native **Victor Scott II** has stolen 23 bases, T-8th-most in MLB this season and most by a Cardinal before the All-Star Break since **Édgar Rentería** (23 in 2003) ... The last Cardinal with 25+ SB before the Break was **Delino DeShields** (31 in 1997) ... 1985 Rookie of the Year **Vince Coleman** (62 SB) holds the Cards pre-ASB record, 2nd-most by any Major Leaguer behind Hall of Famer **Rickey Henderson** (84 in 1982).

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (July 11, 2017): **Yadier Molina** (age 34-363) becomes the oldest catcher to homer in an All-Star Game, passing a mark held by **Yogi Berra** (34-083) with a solo homer in the sixth inning ... It was also the first homer by a Cardinal in an All-Star game since **Reggie Smith** (1974) at Pittsburgh's Three Rivers Stadium.

Cardinals broadcaster **Chip Caray** previously was the play-by-play voice of the Braves for 20 seasons on Bally Sports South and Bally Sports Southeast (2010-22), TBS and Peachtree TV (2005-2009) and on TBS and the Atlanta Braves Radio Network (1991-1992).....his father, **Skip Caray**, was part of Braves broadcasts from 1978-2008.

Victor Scott II was born in Atlanta...graduated from McEachern High School in Powder Springs, Ga...resides in Powder Springs...grew up a fan of the Atlanta Braves.

Jordan Walker was born in Stone Mountain, Ga... Graduated from Decatur (Ga.) High School, where he was a 2019 and 2020 Gatorade High School Player of the Year.

Brian Snitker was born in Decatur, Ill...graduated from Macon (Ill.) High School...managed **Adam Wainwright** on the 2003 Greenville Braves.

Marcell Ozuna played two seasons with St. Louis (2018-19)...originally became a Cardinal via trade with Miami for **Sandy Alcantara**, **Daniel Castano**, **Zac Gallen**, & **Magneuris Sierra** (Dec. 14, 2017)...as compensation for Ozuna signing with Atlanta, St. Louis selected **Alec Burleson** in the 2nd round of the 2020 MLB draft.

Austin Riley made his MLB debut vs. the Cardinals (May 19, 2019 at Truist Park).

Drake Baldwin played college baseball at Missouri State University (2020-22).

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** played for & managed both the Cardinals (1969-74 & 1990-95) and Braves (1966-68 & 1982-84)...traded to St. Louis from Atlanta for **Orlando Cepeda** (Mar. 17, 1969).

Braves pitching coach **Rick Kranitz** was originally selected by the Cardinals in the 3rd round of the 1977 MLB January Draft, but did not sign.

Kyle Leahy's uncle, **Thomas Leahy**, pitched in the Braves minor league organization (1991-93).

Pierce Johnson pitched three seasons (2010-12) at Missouri State University...set the school's single-season record with 119 strikeouts in 2012.

JoJo Romero (Aug. 21, 2020 at Truist) and **Jon Jay** (April 26, 2010 at Busch III) made their MLB debuts vs. the Braves.

Hall of Fame catcher **Ted Simmons** played his final three seasons with Atlanta (1986-88).

Braves Bench Coach **Walt Weiss** managed **Nolan Arenado** for four seasons in Colorado (2013-16).

Stubby Clapp played the 2003 season for the Richmond Braves (AAA-Braves).

Cardinals Communications Game Day Associates Supervisor **Jacob Mayer** was a 2015 Media Relations Trainee for Gwinnett (AAA).

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Southpaw will be making his 18th start of the season (42nd career) in his 109th career game.
- His 6 wins this season are a single-season best** and most by a Cardinals lefty starter since **Jordan Montgomery** also won 6 in 2023 as a starter.
- Owns the most wins (6) in MLB among lefty starters age 25 or younger this season; T-3rd most among any pitcher 25 or younger this season (Woo 8, Schwellenbach 7).**
- In his first 13 starts of the season, allowed just one extra base hit to a left-handed batter (double to Sal Frelick, 4/25 vs. MIL); allowed 4 XBH of his last 3G (3 doubles, HR).
- Cardinals have won each of his last four starts scoring 35 runs over those games. Held his opposition to two runs or less in each start (3-0, 2.25 ERA).
- Is looking to extend his career-high win streak to four games after recording three-straight winning decisions to close out the month of June.**
- Three-game win streak ranks as the longest of his career. One shy of the season-high (Gray & Mikolas - 4)
- Is the youngest Cardinals lefty starter age 25 or younger to win 6 games since Jaime Garcia won 13 in 2010 at age 23.**
- His 17 starts this season are a career-high**, and six more then he made in 2023 (11 starts); **he has established a single-season high for IP (97.1) this season.**
- Held the opposition to two runs or fewer in eight straight starts (April 13-May 24), longest streak by a Cardinal since Jack Flaherty ran off nine straight in 2019 (7/7-8/23).
- Is 4-2 in home games (3.75 ERA) this season & 2-4 on the road (3.65 ERA); Won back/back road starts (6/17 at CWS & 6/29 at CLE) after starting the year 0-4 away from home.
- Has worked 6.0 innings or more in 11 of his 17 starts this season; his start on 5/1 at CIN was cut short (3.0 IP) by a lengthy rain delay.
- Is a career 11-15 with a 4.80 ERA in his 41 career starts opposed to 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA in 67 relief appearances.

LAST TIME OUT: Received a no decision in 5.0 innings at CHI (7/5), tossing 5.0 innings allowing two runs on four hits and four walks tossing 94 pitches. Exited leading 3-2, but after the Cardinals bullpen surrendered runs to make it 5-3, rallied to win 8-6.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Has established single season-highs in wins, losses, games started, strikeouts and innings pitched this season.
- Held the opposition to two runs or fewer in a career-best eight straight starts this season (4/13-5/24).
- Surpassed 200 career strikeouts vs. Arizona (May 24).
- Earned his first road win of the season, and his single-season high 4th win on 6/17 at the White Sox, pitching 6.0 innings and allowing just two runs in 12-2 Cardinals win.
- Was dazzling in a 2-1 win over the Pirates and Paul Skenes on May 6 at Busch Stadium as matched his career high in strikeouts with 8 and limited the Buccos to just 3 hits while he logged a season-high 7.0 IP (99 pitches); It was his 4th consecutive winning decision in a Home start dating to last season (3-0 in 2025).
- Made his 3rd career start against Milwaukee on 4/25 and posted a 3-2 win as he limited the Brewers to just 5 hits and 1 earned run over his 6.0 IP; Improved his career mark vs. MIL to 3-0 with a 1.14 ERA.
- Blanked the Phillies on just 3 hits over his 6.0 IP (88 pitches) on 4/13 at Busch Stadium and was credited with his 1st win of 2025 (7-0).
- Pitched 6.0 innings allowing three runs for a quality start in his first start of the 2025 season vs. LAA (4/1); surrendered all his runs in the 3rd inning vs. LAA after retiring the first eight batters of the game.

CAREER:

- Is 8-6 career in 19 career starts at Busch Stadium and has a 3.66 ERA; won each of this 1st three career starts at Busch Stadium.
- Acquired by the Cardinals from the Tampa Bay Rays with C Edgardo Rodriguez and Rays Compensation draft pick B (RHP Tink Hence) in exchange for OF José Martínez, OF Randy Arozarena and Cardinals Compensation draft pick A (INF Alika Williams), January 9, 2020.

LIBERATORE vs. ATLANTA:

- Making his 3rd career start (4th app.) vs. the Braves. Has not allowed a run in 11.1 career innings vs. the Braves.
- Holds the 2nd-longest scoreless streak to begin his career against the Braves among active pitchers trailing only Patrick Corbin (27.2 IP).
- His scoreless streak to begin a career against the Braves is the 4th-longest by a Cardinals pitcher in the Expansion Era (1961) behind Joe Hoerner (14.1), Reggie Cleveland (13.0) and Carlos Martinez (12.2)
- Struck out eight batters over 6.0 scoreless innings in his last start vs. ATL at Busch Stadium (6/26/24). Allowed two hits and a walk in a 4-1 win.
- Held the Braves to a .132 Opponent BA in 42 total batters faced allowing just two doubles of his five hits.
