THE TWINS: Have gone 2-3 through five games on their nine-game homestand, going 2-1 vs. Miami last week, followed by consecutive losses to Milwaukee over the last two nights... today, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the three-game series finale against the Brewers... starting tomorrow night, they will begin a three-game series with Houston through Wednesday afternoon.

TOMAH AND THEIR GREAT GAS STATIONS/REST STOPS STILL LOVE THE TWINS: The Twins lost to the Brewers last night at Target Field by a score of 2-1, their second one-run defeat after winning two straight one-run games in Cleveland last weekend... Tomah, WI native and former Brewer fan Connor Prielipp (1-2) was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing two runs (1 earned) on three hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and eight strikeouts... the offense recorded seven hits, two from Kody Clemens... Trevor Larnach drove in the club's only run with a solo home run in the third inning... the attendance was announced at 33,115, the second-highest attendance of the season (36,042 on Home Opener vs. Tampa Bay).

THE BAILEY SHOW: Bailey Ober began the season posting a 5.49 ERA (19.2 IP, 12 ER) with a .253 opponent batting average in his first four starts, from March 29-April 13... over his last five starts, he has posted a 2.23 ERA (32.1 IP, 8 ER) with a .159 opponent batting average, since his April 19 start.

THIS ONE'S FOR ALLLLL THE MOLITOR: The Twins and Brewers are playing each other for the third of six games this season... Minnesota will travel to Wisconsin for three games at American Family Field from August 7-9.

MAKING LEFTIES POPULAR AGAIN: Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the 18th time in 47 games... they have gone 6-11 against left-handed starters this season... their six wins were April 2 at Kansas City vs. Kris Bubic (5-1), April 7 vs. Detroit against Tarik Skubal (4-2), April 8 vs. Detroit against Framber Valdez (8-6), April 11 at Toronto vs. Eric Lauer (7-4), April 13 vs. Boston against Garrett Crochet (13-6) and May 14 against Miami against Braxton Garrett (9-1).

THE LAST DANCE: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the third time in 2026, the others being April 17-19 vs. Cincinnati in three games at Target Field and April 24-26 in three games at Tampa Bay.

KNIVES OUT: James Outman went 1-for-3 last night and is now hitting .333 (8-for-24) with a .902 OPS over his last nine games with an at-bat... he began the season 0-for-his-first-18 through April 18... he has four hits in his last nine at-bats, including a double, a triple and three RBI.

KREI ME A RIVER: Ryan Kreidler has reached safely in each of his last six games for the Twins... since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on Tuesday, he has reached safely five times in seven at-bats.

PITCH PERFECT: Over their last eight games, Twins starters have gone 2-3, 2.09 ERA (43.0 IP, 10 ER) with 13 walks, 39 strikeouts and a .171 opponent batting average... aside from the six runs allowed on Wednesday vs. Miami, they have allowed one run-or-fewer in every other start... over their last six games, Twins relievers have gone 2-1, 2.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 7 ER) with 16 walks, 22 strikeouts and a .223 opponent batting average.

BRAD COMPANY: Right-handed starter Taj Bradley will make a rehab start for Triple-A St. Paul today vs. Columbus at CHS Field at 2:05 pm (CT)... he was placed on the 15-day IL on May 9 with right pectoralis muscle inflammation.

OLD SCHOOL SUNDAY: On May 17, 2025, the Twins won their 13th and final game on the second-longest winning streak in club history with a 7-0 win over the Brewers in Milwaukee... Twins pitchers also extended their scoreless inning streak to a club record 33.0.

REMEMBERING HARMON: On this day in 2011, Twins legend Harmon Killebrew passed away at age 74 in Scottsdale, AZ after being diagnosed with esophageal cancer... Killebrew played 21 seasons for the Twins/Senators franchise, from 1954-1974... he was the 1969 AL MVP and was elected to the National Baseball Hall of Fame in 1984... Killebrew is the club's all-time leader in home runs (475), RBI (1,325), walks (1,321) and games (1,939).

TWINS MILB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Triple-A St. Paul outfielder Hendry Mendez and High-A Cedar Rapids left-handed pitcher Dasan Hill as the club's minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

 ☞ Is making his third career start against Milwaukee; 1-0, 3.27 ERA (11.0 IP, 4 ER) with four walks and 10 strikeouts.  
 ☞ In his most recent start on May 12 vs. Miami, Ober threw a complete-game shutout, allowing just two hits with no walks and seven strikeouts in a 3-0 Twins victory.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Bailey made his ninth start of the season on May 12 vs. Miami opposite right-hander Eury Pérez...earned the win, tossing his third career complete game and first career complete-game shutout...allowed just two hits – a second-inning single by Jakob Marsee and a fourth-inning single by Kyle Stowers – walked none and struck out seven batters across the 9.0 innings.

- ☞ Struck out the side in the third inning, marking the first time he has done so since the eighth inning on July 28, 2024 at Detroit.
- ☞ Retired the last 16 batters he faced to end the game, beginning with Connor Norby's popout to end the fourth inning...is the most consecutive batters retired by a Twins pitcher this season.
- ☞ Threw 64 of his 89 pitches for strikes for a season-high strike percentage of 71.9.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Bailey made his eighth start of the season on May 6 at Washington opposite right-hander Miles Mikolas...took his second loss of the season, allowing a season-high five runs on six hits - one being a go-ahead, two-run home run from Drew Millas in the fifth inning - in 5.0 innings pitched with two walks and three strikeouts, as the Twins suffered their largest loss of the season, 15-2, at Nationals Park.

- ☞ Matched a season low 82 pitches through 5.0 innings before being pulled after failing to record an out in the sixth inning.

**BREWERS, BRATS AND BAILEY:** Ober is making his third career start against Milwaukee, and first since 2023; he battled the Brewers twice in 2023, going 1-0 with a 3.27 ERA (11.0 IP, 4 ER), four walks, 10 strikeouts, a 1.09 WHIP and a .205 (8-for-39) BAA.

- ☞ Current Brewers batters are hitting a combined .244 (10-for-41) against Ober with three doubles (Andrew Vaughn, Christian Yelich x2), two home runs (Andrew Vaughn x2), two walks and 13 strikeouts.
- ☞ This will be Bailey's 26th career Interleague start; he is 6-8 with a 4.96 ERA (136.0 IP, 75 ER), 37 walks and 129 strikeouts...he has never won back-to-back Interleague starts in his career.

**COMPLETE GAME NOTE:** Bailey became just the eighth Twins starter to throw a complete-game shutout at Target Field (2010-), and was the 15th such game in the ballpark's history, 10 of which were by a Twins starting pitcher...he joined Seattle's George Kirby and Miami's Sandy Alcantara as the only starters to hurl a complete game this season, and is just one of two starters to throw a complete-game shutout (Sandy Alcantara, April 1 vs. Chicago-AL).

- ☞ Bailey has now thrown three complete games in his career, with the other two coming on June 22, 2024 at Oakland and June 18, 2025 at Cincinnati (5.2 IP).
- ☞ The outing is the first complete-game shutout with two-or-fewer hits allowed since Cincinnati's Hunter Greene allowed one hit in a complete-game shutout on September 18, 2025 vs. Chicago-NL.
- ☞ Ober's effort marked the first complete game by a Twin since his own effort in 2025, as well as the first complete-game shutout by a Twins starting pitcher since Pablo López blanked the Kansas City Royals 5-0 on July 5, 2023 at Target Field.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** In six MLB seasons, all with the Twins, Ober has gone 20-15 with a 4.00 ERA (351.0 IP, 156 ER), 85 walks, 342 strikeouts, a .233 (309-for-1327) BAA and a .708 OPS against in 64 starts at home compared to 15-17 with a 4.07 ERA (318.2 IP, 144 ER), 63 walks, 301 strikeouts, a .240 (289-for-1205) BAA and a .703 OPS against in 59 road starts.

- ☞ In six home starts this season, Ober is 4-0 with a 2.43 ERA (37.0 IP, 10 ER), 10 walks, 32 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .184 (25-for-136) BAA.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** In 2026, left-handed hitters are slashing .181/.245/.372 (17-for-94) with six doubles, four home runs, seven walks and 15 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .214/.280/.296 (21-for-98) with five doubles, one home run, eight walks and 24 strikeouts.

- ☞ His .181 opponent batting average against left-handed batters ranks seventh among all right-handed starters in Major League Baseball (min. 90 at bats).
- ☞ Opponents are hitting just .198 (38-for-192) against Ober, which ranks fourth among all qualified American League pitchers.

**THE ARSENAL:** Ober has relied on a six-pitch mix during his 2026 campaign; here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ Bailey has thrown 281 changeups this season, the most by an American League pitcher and second most in MLB, trailing Philadelphia's Cristopher Sánchez (318).
- ☞ He is second among MLB pitchers with a .167 (12-for-72) opponent batting average against the changeup (min. 70 plate appearances).
- ☞ Ober has a breaking run value of six, which ranks in the league's 97th percentile.
- ☞ His 7.1 foot extension ranks in the league's 95th percentile, which is the fourth highest by a starter in the American League; eighth highest among all starters in Major League Baseball.

**NOT A MADDUX, BUT AN OBER:** Ober became the 123rd pitcher in Major League Baseball history to record three-or-more complete games in under 99 pitches and just the fifth pitcher in Twins history to do so, since MLB began tracking pitch counts in 1988...below are the last five Twins 9-inning CGs with less than 100 pitches, prior to Ober's most recent outing:

CAREER NOTES

- Finished 2025 second on Twins staff in starts (27), innings pitched (146.1) and strikeouts (120).
- In 2025, made the Twins Opening Day roster for the second consecutive year and third in career.
- In 2024, pitched first career complete game on June 22 at Oakland, allowing two runs on four hits in 9.0 innings, with two walks and 10 strikeouts...threw just 89 pitches, becoming the first pitcher with a nine-inning CG and 10+ strikeouts on fewer than 90 pitches since David Cone.
- Struck out career-high 12 batters on September 18, 2024 at Cleveland (7.0 IP), fourth time on season and fifth time in career with double-digit strikeout totals.
- Set career highs in wins (12), starts (31), innings pitched (178.2) and strikeouts (191) in 2024.
- Made Postseason debut in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, allowing six runs on eight hits (4 HR) in 4.1 total innings between Games 1 and 3.
- In 2023, made 26 regular season starts for the Twins, going 8-6 with a 3.43 ERA (144.1 IP, 55 ER), 29 walks, 146 strikeouts and 12 quality starts.
- In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, going 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota.
- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
- Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
- Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
- Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA in 2019 and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K).
- In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for theernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season.
- Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston.
