RUBBER MEETS THE ROAD

The Washington Nationals square off against the New York Mets in the rubber match of this three-game series on Thursday afternoon...The Nationals are 2-2 in rubber games...With a win today, the Nationals would secure their fourth series win of the season and their first back-to-back series win of the season.

- The Nationals won game two last night against the Mets, 14-2, scoring a season-high in runs...**Cade Cavalli** struck out 10 batters in 6.0 innings of work, his second consecutive start striking out at least 10 batters...The last Nationals pitcher to strike out at least 10 in back-to-back starts was **Max Scherzer** (July 23 and July 29, 2020).
- Brady House** hit his first career grand slam in the fourth inning...**Curtis Mead** finished the night going 4-for-5 with two extra-base hits (2B, HR), hit-by-pitch, two RBI and four runs scored...The Nationals offense scored seven runs in the fourth inning, the most runs in an inning this season.
- The Nationals return to D.C. for a six-game, seven day homestand against the Milwaukee Brewers (Friday-Sunday) and the Minnesota Twins (Tuesday-Thursday).
- Washington is 11-7 (.611) on the road in 2026, the second most road wins in Major League Baseball...The .611 road winning percentage is seventh in Major League Baseball.

START ME UP

Washington's starters have posted a 2.48 ERA (8 ER/29.0 IP) with 39 strikeouts and seven walks across the last six games.

- Cade Cavalli** struck out at least 10 batters for the second consecutive start...He has struck out 25 batters with just two walks over his last three starts.
- Jake Irvin** has 13 strikeouts against zero walks in his last two starts.
- Foster Griffin** set career-highs in both innings pitched (7.0) and strikeouts (8) in his last scoreless start against the White Sox on April 26...He's pitched to a 2.67 ERA with 30 strikeouts in six starts this season.

PRETTY OFFENSIVE

The Nationals rank second in Major League Baseball with 170 runs, the second most by a Nationals club in team history (2005-pres.) through its first 31 games behind the 2017 National League East champion Nationals (194).

- Washington has scored 32 runs in the first inning, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals have scored 62 runs in the seventh inning or later, the most in MLB.
- Washington has scored at least five runs 20 times this season, the most in Major League Baseball.

WHAT A RELIEF

Washington's bullpen has allowed just two earned runs on eight hits with 14 strikeouts in the last four games...They've held opponents to a .163 average and have recorded one save and a hold.

- Brad Lord** has allowed just one earned run with four strikeouts and no walks in his last four games (9.0 innings)...He has held batters to a .161 average (5-for-31) in that span.
- PJ Poulain** is 2-0, allowing three earned runs on nine hits with four strikeouts in his last 10 games (three starts)...Eight of the 10 games have been scoreless.
- Paxton Schultz** recorded his first career save on April 26 at Chicago (AL).

GOOD WOOD

James Wood has placed himself among the league leaders...See chart to the right.

- Wood leads Major League Baseball in on-base percentage (.477), home runs (11st, 9), runs (26) and walks (11st, 26) since April 5...This comes after starting the season 4-for-26 (.111) in eight games from March 26 to April 4.
- He is one of three players Major League Baseball with more than one batted ball greater than 116.0 MPH this season with **Yordan Alvarez** (3) and **O'Neil Cruz** (3).
- Wood's 42 batted balls over 100 MPH are the most in Major League Baseball.

HITTERISH

Some notes on a few Nationals hitters as of late:

- Luis Garcia Jr.** is 8-for-23 (.348) with two doubles, four RBI, one stolen base and four runs scored over his last seven games...He's hit safely in four of the seven.
- Brady House** has hit safely in eight of his last 10 games, going 8-for-36 with two home runs, seven RBI, four walks, one stolen base and six runs scored...Hit his first grand slam on April 29 at New York (NL); also marked his first career game with four RBI.
- Jorbit Vivas** has hit safely in 15 of his 18 starts this season and has reached base safely in 11 consecutive starts.

FRAME JOB

Bobby Wilson's catchers rank tied for third in Major League Baseball with three Catcher Framing Runs (**Drew Millas** - 2, **Keibert Ruiz** - 1) along with the New York Yankees, according to Baseball Savant...*"Catcher Framing Runs converts strikes to runs saved on a .125 run/strike basis, and includes park and pitcher adjustments. To qualify, a catcher must receive 6 called pitches per team game."*

FARM REPORT

YOU CAN'T SIME

Fredericksburg right-handed pitcher **Miguel Sime Jr.** struck out nine batters in 3.2 scoreless innings in yesterday's start...He has struck a total of 32 batters and has held opponents to a .125 average (6-for-48) across 14.2 innings for Fredericksburg this season...His 32 strikeouts are the most among Washington's system.

Two-time National League All-Star (2018, 2022) signed with the Nationals on Feb. 11...A veteran of 10 Major League seasons, most recently with the St. Louis Cardinals (2018-25).

- Is third in Major League Baseball with 133 starts and is fifth with 755.0 innings pitched since the start of the 2022 season...Is behind only Logan Webb (138) and Dylan Cease (136) for the most starts in MLB since 2022.
- Is 1-2 with a 2.20 ERA (4 ER/16.1 IP) in four career Postseason games (three starts).
- Spent three seasons in Nippon Professional Baseball, pitching for the Yomiuri Giants from 2015-17.
- Participated in the 2018 All-Star Game at Nationals Park.

LAST APPEARANCE

Mikolas gave up two earned runs on four hits and no walks in 3.2 innings of work on April 24 against the Chicago White Sox at Rate Field.

vs. NEW YORK

Miles Mikolas is set to make his 10th career appearance against the Mets...He holds a 2-4 record over New York.

- Mikolas owns a 5.17 ERA (27 ER/47.0 IP) with 28 strikeouts and nine walks in nine game starts against the Mets.

Went 8-11 with a 4.81 ERA in 31 starts...Marked his fourth consecutive season with 31 or more starts.

- Went 4-0 with a 1.34 ERA and a .192 opponents' average in six starts from April 23 to May 23.
- Posted a 2.77 ERA in five starts from Aug. 28-Sept. 20 with a record of 1-1...Allowed two or less earned runs in all the five games and struck out 15 batters across 26.0 innings.

Led Major League Baseball with 35 starts, becoming the first pitcher to record 35 starts in a season since Jhoulys Chacin (35) in 2018 with Milwaukee.

- Pitched 201.2 innings, giving him back-to-back seasons with 200 innings, marking his 3rd career season with 200-or-more innings.
- Was Cardinals Opening Day starting pitcher, the second of his career, and 1st since 2019.
- Made two relief appearances for the United States in the World Baseball Classic posting a 1.50 ERA in 6.0 innings pitched.
