## AROUND THE HORN

**D-BACKS USA250 PACKAGE:** There is no better place to celebrate Independence Day weekend than Chase Field as the D-backs host a 2-night must-see Fireworks Spectacular presented by Bar-S on Friday, July 3 and Saturday, July 4...in recognition of America's 250th anniversary celebration, the D-backs are offering a special USA250 ticket package for the July 3 and July 4 games...fans can purchase 4 lower-level or club-level tickets for \$250 by using offer code USA250.

**HERE'S THE STORY:** The D-backs' current 7 straight wins vs. Giants are their most to start a season against any opponent in franchise history [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

- The D-backs' 7 straight wins vs. Giants are their second most all-time, behind their 9 straight from Sept. 3, 2011-May 11, 2012.
- The D-backs are 14-4 in their last 18 NL West matchups (2-1 @ Rockies, 3-0 vs. Giants, 3-1 vs. Rockies, 3-0 @ Giants, 2-2 vs. Dodgers, 1-0 vs. Giants).
- **Ketel Marte** (1,182) is 1 hit shy of surpassing Paul Goldschmidt (1,182) for second most hits in franchise history, behind Luis Gonzalez (1,337).
- **Ketel Marte** has homered in a career-high-tying 3 straight games (also: 7 others, last: Sept. 20-22, 2024) and in 4 of his last 5...has reached base safely in 16 of his last 17 games, hitting .318 (21-for-66)/1.013 OPS with 5 doubles, 5 homers, 10 RBI and 6 walks, including reaching base 2+ times in 10 games.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base in 20 straight starts, hitting .310 (22-for-71)/.918 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers, 7 RBI and 13 walks.
- **Brandon Pfaadt** is making his first start with the D-backs since April 11 @ Phillies (L, 4-R-3 ER in 6.0 IP) and first appearance since June 3 vs. Dodgers in relief.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs won 5-4 vs. Giants.

- **Eduardo Rodriguez** (W, 1 ER in 7.0 IP, 5 H, 0 BB, K) made his sixth start of 7.0+ innings and 1 or fewer runs allowed, tied for most in the Majors (also: 2 others)...it's his third season with 6+ starts of 7.0+ innings with 1 or fewer runs allowed (last in 2023).
- **Ketel Marte** homered (16) for a career-tying third consecutive game to tie Paul Goldschmidt for second most hits (1,182) in franchise history...was his franchise-leading 16th leadoff homer.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** (1-for-3, 2B, 3 RBI) broke the game open with a 1-out, bases-loaded double to make it a 4-1 game.
- **Nolan Arenado** (2-for-2, HR, RBI, BB) plated the fifth run with his ninth homer in the sixth.
- **Paul Sewald** notched his 19th save.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The D-backs recalled RHP **Brandon Pfaadt** from Triple-A Reno and optioned RHP **Juan Burgos** to Reno following last night's game.

**GIANT SWEEP:** Entering this series, the D-backs have logged multiple sweeps vs. Giants in a season (in 3 or 4 game series) for the second time all-time (also: July 25-27, 2008 and Sept. 15-18, 2008)...the D-backs last swept the Padres twice in a season (Sept. 2-4, 2019 and Sept. 27-29, 2019).

- The D-backs are looking to sweep the same opponent 3 straight times in a single season for the first time in franchise history.

**DOSE OF MARTE AND 'DOMO:** In his 7 games vs. Giants this season, **Ketel Marte** is batting .467 (14-for-30)/1.418 OPS with 2 doubles, 4 homers and 13 RBI...the only player with more RBI vs. a single opponent is Dansby Swanson vs. Mets (16 in 7 G).

- Vs. Giants, **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 12 straight games, batting .333 (14-for-42)/1.002 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 12 RBI, 9 walks and 1 stolen base.

**THE GIANT SLAYER:** **Nolan Arenado's** 36 homers, 86 extra-base hits, 120 RBI and 184 hits vs. Giants are the most among active MLB players.

- Since 1985, only 4 other players have hit 30+ homers vs. Giants: Gary Sheffield (34), Paul Goldschmidt (32), Jeff Bagwell (32) and Larry Walker (32).

**GABI AMONG CATCHERS:** Since May 13, **Gabriel Moreno** ranks among catchers [min. 25 GS] in OBP (1st, .411), walks (1st, 19), stolen bases (T-1st, 4, with Hunter Goodman/COL), AVG (2nd, .317) and OPS (3rd, .899).

- Has reached base safely in 31 of his last 35 games, batting .317 (39-for-123)/.899 OPS with 6 doubles, 5 homers, 17 RBI, 19 walks and 4 stolen bases...has reached 2+ times in 19 of those games.

**CORBIN'S WAR RANKS:** **Corbin Carroll's** 3.6 fWAR ranks sixth among position players, behind Pete Crow-Armstrong/CHC (4.9), Bobby Witt Jr./KC (4.2), Dillon Dingler/DET (3.7), Yordan Alvarez/HOU (3.6) and Otto Lopez/MIA (3.6).

**GLOVEWORK:** The D-backs' defense ranks among the Majors in fielding pct. (3rd, .990) and fewest errors (3rd, 29), behind the Dodgers (1st, .991/1st, 26) and Padres (2nd, .991/2nd, 27).

- The D-backs' 27 Outs Above Average rank second in the Majors, behind the Cubs (38).

**CONTROLLING THE ZONE:** D-backs batters' 77.4 pct. contact pct. and 605 strikeouts rank second in the Majors, behind the Rays (80.1 pct., 580).

**MAKING THEM CHASE:** The D-backs' 31.8 pct. pitcher chase pct. ranks third in the NL, behind the Phillies (32.7 pct.) and Dodgers (32.2 pct.).

**BULLPEN SPOTLIGHT:** **Taylor Clarke** is scoreless in 21 of his last 24 games, going 1-1 with a 1.19 ERA (4 R-3 ER in 22.2 IP), 12 H, 8 walks and 14 strikeouts.

- **Kevin Ginkel** is scoreless in 10 of his last 12 games, going 2-0 with a 2.53 ERA (3 ER in 10.2 IP), 11 hits, 5 walks and 10 strikeouts.

**UP FOR THE CHALLENGE:** The D-backs' 61.0 pct. total challenge win pct. ranks tied for second in the Majors with the Tigers, behind the Reds (63.0 pct.).

**VS. GIANTS:** The D-backs swept both of their initial 3-game series (vs. Giants May 18-20 and @ Giants May 25-27)...have now won 5 consecutive season series, including the previous 4 by a single game (7-6 from 2023-25 and 10-9 in 2022).
