TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants are coming off their first three-game sweep of the season as they won all three games against the Cardinals earlier this week...it also marks the first time SF has won three straight games since July 11-12 vs. COL and July 17 at SEA.

- ▶ San Francisco is looking for a win tonight to secure four straight victories for the first time this season...the Giants are the only MLB team that has not won four games in a row this year.
- ▶ SF needs to win just one of its final 16 games to avoid the second 100-loss season in team history (the club went 62-100 in 1985).

HOME SWEET HOME: The Giants have won eight of their last 12 games at home and are 23-16 (.590) in their last 39 games at Oracle Park dating to June 14.

- ▶ With Wednesday's victory, SF improved to .500 at home for the first time this season (36-36)...SF has only finished with a losing record at home five times in the Oracle Park-era (since 2000): 2019 (35-46), 2017 (38-43), 2008 (37-44), 2007 (39-42) and 2005 (37-44).

ON THE HILL: RHP **Anthony Molina** is slated to make his fourth start with the Giants...he's 3-0 with a 1.88 ERA (3er, 14.1ip) and a 0.70 WHIP over his first three starts.

- ▶ With a win tonight, Molina can become the third pitcher to win his first four games with the Giants since the franchise moved to San Francisco, joining **Billy Pierce** (8 games, 1962) and **Bill Swift** (4 games, 1992).
- ▶ Has made four appearances against the Padres in his career, all four of which came out of the bullpen while with the Rockies...has a 1.42 ERA (er, 6.1ip) in his career vs. San Diego.

SO WE MEET AGAIN: The Giants are facing **LHP Robbie Ray** for the first time since dealing him to San Diego at the trade deadline...Ray is 1-2 with a 4.71 ERA (15er, 28.2ip) in six starts with San Diego with the Padres losing four of the six games.

- ▶ Ray posted a 6-1 record with a 2.22 ERA (16er, 65.0ip) and a .192 opponents average over 11 starts with the Giants at Oracle Park earlier this year (March 27-July 25).

SAVE ME!: On Wednesday **RHP Trent Harris** earned his first MLB save and became the 12th different Giants pitcher to record a save this season, which is tied for second-most in MLB.

- ▶ The 12 different pitchers to record a save this season are the most in franchise history since saves became an official stat in 1969.

THE FUTURE IS BRIGHT: IF **Bryce Eldridge** extended his on-base streak to 18 games on Wednesday, which is tied with Mookie Betts and Jakob Marsee for the longest active such streak in the Majors...it's Eldridge's second 18+ game on-base streak this season after a career-best 22-game on-base streak from May 23-June 17.

- ▶ Eldridge had five hits and seven RBI in SF's last series against St. Louis and is now hitting .364 and slugging .545 since August 20...those numbers rank third and ninth, respectively, among hitters with at least 80 plate appearances in that span...his 19 RBI in that span are tied for second most in MLB, behind only teammate **Rafael Devers** (23) (STATS, LLC).

END OF AN ERA: IF **Rafael Devers** had a scheduled day off on Wednesday, which snapped his streak of playing 236 consecutive game since joining the Giants last June...overall, Devers had appeared in 309 consecutive games dating to his time with Boston.

- ▶ Devers' 28 home runs since June 6 are second-most in MLB over that span.

FOR ALL THE MARBLES: Single-A San Jose and High-A Eugene both began their quests for championships this week.

- ▶ San Jose won the California League's Northern Division title last night with a 3-1 victory over Stockton clinching a spot in the California League Championship Series, which begins Sunday at Lake Elsinore...**RHP Jackson Flora**, the 4th overall pick in the 2026 draft, struck out four batters over 2.0- scoreless innings...**IF Drew Smith**, the Giants' 15th round selection this year, drove in all three runs for the Giants.
- ▶ Eugene dropped each of the first two games of the Northwest League Championship Series to Vancouver...the teams enjoyed a day off yesterday before the series shifts to Eugene tonight for Game 3, which is a must-win situation for the Emeralds.

MO MONEY: The 24-year-old from San Joaquin, Venezuela, was acquired the night before the trade deadline from the Atlanta Braves in exchange for RHP Tyler Mahle...SF is the third club Molina has appeared with in the Majors, as he spent 2024-2025 with Colorado and 2026 with Atlanta and San Francisco.

LAST TIME OUT: Tied his career-high with 5.0 innings pitched while also matching a career-high six strikeouts in a win against the Mets, as he allowed two runs (neither earned) and just one hit in the effort.

VS. THE PADRES: Has pitched in four games against the Padres in his career, all four of which came out of the bullpen as a member of the Rockies...holds a 1.42 ERA (er, 6.1ip) in his career versus San Diego.

WITH THE GIANTS: Molina has won all three of his starts since he was called-up by the Giants dating back to August 25 versus Cin-cinatti, and he has a 1.88 ERA (3er, 14.1ip), 13 strikeouts, and 0.70 WHIP in that span...he is the first Giants pitcher to earn the win in each of his first three appearances with the team since **Alex Wood** in 2021...only two Giants in the SF era have earned the win in each of their first four appearances with the team (**Bill Swift** in 1992 and **Billy Pierce** in 1962).

WHAT'S BEEN WORKING: Since joining the Giants, Molina has held opponents to a .120 average (3x25) off his four-seamer with eight strikeouts, which he's thrown 54.7% of the time...in his time with At-lanta this season, he threw his fastball just 36.4% of the time and op-ponents were 3-for-8 off of it (.375)... furthermore, opponents are just 1-for-12 (.083) with three strikeouts against his changeup over his time with San Francisco.

WITH THE BRAVES: Pitched in three games for Atlanta this year prior to being traded (May 1, June 14 and June 16), posting a 5.40 ERA (3er, 5.0ip), and a 1.40 WHIP...oddly enough, Molina was on the Braves roster for the original games of this series back in June and pitched against SF in the June 16 game, surrendering a homer to **Willy Adames** in the 8th inning...Molina was originally claimed off waivers by Atlanta from Colorado on December 5, 2025 before be-ing outrighted on December 19.

THIS SEASON IN TRIPLE-A: Spent the majority of this season in Tri-ple-A for Gwinnett (Atlanta) and Sacramento (SF)...in total, he was 3-2 with a 3.55 ERA (25er, 63.1ip), 65 strikeouts and a 1.22 WHIP in 21 games (12 starts) at the Triple-A level.

LAST SEASON: Went 1-1 with a 7.27 ERA (28er, 34.2ip) and 24 strikeouts in 17 games (one start) for the Rockies in 2025...had a .351 opposing batting average (52x148) and a 1.67 WHIP... in 15 starts at Triple-A Albuquerque, he went 4-5 with a 6.59 ERA (51er, 69.2ip), 30 walks and 51 strikeouts.

WORLD CHAMP: Pitched for 2026 World Baseball Classic Champion Team Venezuela, making two appearances out of the bullpen.

JOURNEY TO THE SHOW: Molina debuted in the Majors on Opening Day in 2024 with Colorado as a Rule 5 selection from Tampa Bay... at 22 years, 76 days old he became the ninth-youngest pitcher to debut in Rockies history.
