**BIRD WATCHING:** The St. Louis Cardinals open a three-game series/homestand with the San Diego Padres tonight at Busch Stadium. The Cardinals returned home from a six-game/seven-day road trip to New York-NL (2-1) and Minnesota (1-2) last night. Both the Cardinals and Padres rank 2nd in their respective divisions. Earlier this season, the Cardinals and Padres split a four-game series at Petco Park.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** St. Louis enters today in 2nd place in the NL Central, 5.0 games back of Milwaukee, 2.5 games ahead of 3rd-place Chicago and in possession of the top Wild Card position with Philadelphia and San Diego occupying the final two slots.

**WHO'S YOUR PADRE:** The Cardinals all-time .662 (174-89) home win pct. in St. Louis over the Padres (1969-present) is the 3rd-best by one home team vs. any visitor in MLB history (min. 100 games). -Elias SB

- Since Busch Stadium III opened in 2006, the Cardinals .694 home win pct. (43-19) vs. the Friars is their 2nd-best against any visitor behind only Colorado (.734, 47-17).

- The Cardinals all-time .584 (307-219) win pct. over San Diego is their 4th-best against any opponent (min. 50 games), while no NL team sports a higher all-time win pct. over San Diego than St. Louis.

**JUNE JOLT:** Through 12 games in June, the Cardinals have the highest batting average (.277), slugging (.477), most RBI (68) and home runs (20) among National League teams who did not play in Las Vegas over the previous week.

**ROAD RAGE:** During their last road trip, the Cardinals hit 14 home runs, tied for the most in MLB over that period (June 9-14) with Minnesota and Colorado. **Alec Burleson** hit 5 HR over that period, tied with Milwaukee's **Jackson Chourio** (MIL) for the most in MLB.

**MAY IN JUNE:** After a rough namesake month, **Dustin May** turned around an 0-4, 3.86 ERA over five starts in May to leading the Cardinals staff in strikeouts (15) and ERA (2.31) in two June starts. May pitched back-to-back nine strikeout games at MIL (5/27) and vs. TEX (6/2). He added six more punchouts at NYM (6/9) in his last start of 6.0 scoreless innings. May has faced the Padres more than any other team in his career with 11 starts and 14 appearances.

**WE'RE GOING STREAKING!:** **Alec Burleson** is riding a career high 14-game hitting streak (19-58, .328/.381/.707) since May 30, 2nd-longest active behind **Zack Gelof** (18) of the Athletics. Burleson has scored a run in his last nine games (June 5-present), MLB's longest active and overall this season. The last Cardinals player with a 10-game streak was **Albert Pujols** (11) from July 31-Aug. 13, 2010. **Rogers Hornsby** holds the franchise record scoring in 17 straight games in 1921.

**RBI GUYS:** Entering tonight's game, **Jordan Walker** (56 RBI) is tied for the Major League lead with **Andy Pagés** (LAD). Walker, along with teammate **Alec Burleson** (51 RBI), became the most recent pair of Cardinals teammates with 50 or more RBI in the first 69 games of a season since 1B **Albert Pujols** (60) and 3B **Scott Rolen** (51) in 2003.

**Fernando Tatis**, father of Padres outfielder, **Fernando Tatis Jr.**, played three seasons with St. Louis (1998-2000)...is famously remembered for hitting two grand slams in one inning (April 23, 1999 at Los Angeles), both off of **Chan Ho Park**.

Cardinals TV broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played parts of four seasons in San Diego (1997-98, 2002, 2005) and appeared in the 1998 World Series...was a part of the Padres broadcasting team for 12 seasons (2012-23)...resides in San Diego.

**Ramón Urías**'s younger brother, **Luis Urías**, played parts of two seasons in San Diego (2018-19), where he made his MLB debut.

**Brant Brown** (June 15, 1996 at Wrigley), **Daniel Descalso** (Sept. 18, 2010 at Busch III), **Dustin May** (Aug. 8, 2019 at Dodger Std.), and **Brad Thompson** May 8, 2005 at Busch II) made MLB debuts vs. the Padres.

Cardinals President of Baseball Operations **Chaim Bloom** began his baseball career as a Baseball Operations Intern with the San Diego Padres.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** was the Padres bench coach for three seasons (2016-18).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 26 games for San Diego in 2008...traded by St. Louis to San Diego for **David Freese** (Dec. 14, 2007).

Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith** was selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 1977 MLB Draft...played four seasons with San Diego (1978-81)...traded by San Diego with Al Olmsted and Steve Mura to St. Louis for Luis DeLeon, Sixto Lezcano and Garry Templeton (Dec. 10, 1981).

Padres Asst. Hitting Coach **Mike McCoy** was selected by St. Louis in the 34th round of the 2002 MLB Draft...played six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Padres Baseball Operations Advisor **Allen Craig** played parts of five seasons (2010-14) with St. Louis, where he was a 2013 NL All-Star and member of 2011 World Series Champion Cardinals.

Padres Coach **Nick Punto** played 63 games for St. Louis in 2011 and was a member of the 2011 World Series Champions.

**Jon Jay** played the 2016 season with San Diego...traded by St. Louis to the Padres for **Jedd Gyorko** and cash (Dec. 8, 2015).

Padres Coach **Peter Summerville**'s brother, **Andrew**, was drafted by St. Louis in the 12th round in 2017...pitched two minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ray Lankford** played parts of two seasons for San Diego (2001-02)...traded by St. Louis with cash to the Padres for **Woody Williams** (Aug. 2, 2001).

Padres broadcaster **Carlos Hernandez** played 17 games for St. Louis in 2000...traded (July 31, 2000) to St. Louis with **Nate Tebbbs** from the Padres for **Heathcliff Slocumb** and current Memphis (AAA) manager **Ben Johnson**.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Daniel Guerrero** graduated from San Diego State Univ. in 2020...interned for NBC San Diego in 2019...also served as backup MLB.com reporter on-site at Petco Park.

Padres Special Asst. **Brian Esposito** played parts of two seasons for Memphis (AAA) in 2006-07 and one game for St. Louis in 2007.

Cardenales broadcaster **Polo Ascencio** was born in nearby Tijuana, Mexico...considers Padres Eduardo Ortega as a broadcasting mentor.

## TONIGHT'S GAME:

- The 28-year-old **Dustin May** makes his 14th start as a member of the Cardinals (71st career start & 85th appearance) tonight.
- Returns home to make his 12th career start (15th app.) against the Padres, leaders in both starts and app. vs. an opponent.
- Has a 6.0 inning scoreless streak entering following his last start in New York.
- Since the start of his surname month, ranks 2nd on the Cardinals with 44 strikeouts since May 1 (Liberatore, 46). Despite a rough start to the season in his first two outings, ranks in the Top 25 among National League pitchers in innings pitched, strikeouts, qualifying ERA and opponent BA.
- Received one run of support or fewer in five of his last eight starts (April 27-present), and a total of just 15 runs in those eight starts.
- Fanned a season-high 9 batters in 2 of his last 3 starts since May 27. Since then, ranks 8th among MLB pitchers in strikeouts.
- Pitched 6.0 innings in every start over a four-game stretch (April 27-May 15), the longest streak of his career and tying **Michael McGreevy** for the longest by a Cardinal this season. All were quality starts.
- His four caught stealing on attempted base stealers, T-3rd among NL pitchers with teammate **Matthew Liberatore** (4).
- Issued just three walks to right-handed batters among 110 RH batters faced, limiting RH batters to a .210 BA (22-105) and 1 HR.
- Joins **Nathan Church** (2024-26), **Hunter Dobbins** (2026), **Mark McGwire** (1997-2001), **Red Schoendienst** (1945-56, '61-63), and **Rex Hudler** (1990-92) as notable red-headed Cardinals.

**LAST TIME OUT (Tuesday, June 9 at N.Y. Mets): W, 7-0; 6.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 6 SO - 101 pitches.**

Posted his first scoreless start of the season, and most recent since 8/12/25 at HOU w/BOS.

Threw a season-high 101 pitches, most since 8/18/25 (100 vs. BAL).

Has not allowed a home run over his last 23.0 innings; longest in-season streak since his final five starts of 2023 (24.0 IP).

## 2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

**POPPING THE CORK IN NEW YORK:** Fired his first scoreless start as a member of the Cardinals pitching 6.0 scoreless innings of four-hit ball with six strikeouts in a 7-0 'Birds win at Citi Field (6/9), running the St. Louis win streak to five games. His first win since 4/21 at MIA (7 starts).

**BASEBALL HQ TOUR:** Took time on June 9 to tour MLB's Central Offices while the Cardinals spent their off-day in NYC.

**OH NO-NO:** Took a no-hitter in the 8th inning at MIL (5/27), broken up by a **Garrett Mitchell** lead-off double, and eventually lost 2-1; Threw a season-high 7.0 IP and fanned a then season-high 9 batters; the only Brewers batsmen to reach safely before the 8th came via a HBP and catcher's interference.

**DECISIONS, DECISIONS:** His 2026 season has been one of streaks starting with 2-straight losses, then 3-straight wins and now a career-high 4-straight losses.

**STEADY STARTER:** Has quality starts in 8 of his 13 starts; Has allowed 3 runs or fewer working into the 6th inning in each of his last 11 starts for a 2.89 ERA (65.1 IP/21 ER) in that span. He has received just 15 runs of support over his last eight starts (3.72 RSA).

**KICKING THE BABIP HABIT:** 17 or his 71 hits allowed this season came in his first two starts (24%); he still owns the 5th-highest BABIP (.324) in the National League.

**DON'T WALK TO STRANGERS:** Has the 2nd-lowest walk percentage among Cardinals starting pitchers behind **Michael McGreevy** (6.0%) with 6.6%.

**MAY'S DAY:** Started on May 3 while wearing uniform No. 3, against his former team, the Dodgers, suffering 4-1 loss that snapped his 3-game winning streak.

**NOCTURNAL NIGHTMARE:** Has made a team-high 7 starts in Day games this season (1-6, 5.73 ERA), ranking T-4thin NL; is 3-0 with a 2.57 ERA in his 6 Night starts.

**BACK-TO-BACK JACK:** Gained a 5-3 win vs. CLE (4/15) as he paired back/back quality starts & wins over BOS & CLE during that homestand.

**MILESTONE WIN:** Bested his former team the Red Sox on 4/10 in a 3-2 win. It was his 1st win as a member of the Cardinals and his 20th career win.

**TIGER STRIKE:** Was hit for a season-high seven runs on seven hits (and struck in leg by line drive) over 3.1 innings in an 11-6 loss at Detroit (4/4) in his second start. First Cardinals pitcher since **Mike Parisi** (2008) to begin a season allowing 6 or more runs in his first two starts of a season; and the first Cardinal to pitch the Opening Day series since **Dizzy Dean** (1936).

**OPENING ACT:** Took the loss in his Cardinals debut at Busch Stadium vs. TB (3/29) allowing six runs over 4.0 inning. Tied his career-high allowing 10 hits, the first Cardinals pitcher to allow double-digit hits in his debut in 55 years since **Chris Zachary** surrendered 10 to the Phillies (5/3/1971) *Elias*. Recorded his 300th career strikeout retiring **Junior Caminero**.

**MAY VS. SAN DIEGO:**

- Making his 12th start and 15th appearance vs. the Padres, his most against any opponent.
- Pitched 5.0 or more innings in each of his 11 starts vs. SD (relief app. discounted); the longest active streak of 5.0-inning starts to begin a career against the Padres since 2019.
- Lost in his first start this season vs. SD (5/9) allowing three runs in the 5th inning after leading 2-0, as St. Louis fell 4-2 at Petco Park.
- Earned a loss in his MLB Debut against the Padres on Aug. 2, 2019 at Dodger Stadium. Scattered nine hits for four runs (three earned) over 5.2 innings. Hunter Renfroe (swinging) was his first career strikeout victim.
- His only double-digit strikeout game in his career is against San Diego, fanning 10 Padres over 6.0 innings on April 25, 2021 at Dodger Stadium.
- Faced the Padres twice in 2020 NL Division Series with Los Angeles, throwing 3.0 scoreless innings while picking up a win Game 1. Also started Game 3 as an opener (1.0 IP) at Petco Park as the Dodgers swept the three-game series.
- Recorded his only Major League hit vs. San Diego, beating out an infield single off Eric Lauer after Kike Hernandez was intentionally walked in front of him.
