AROUND THE HORN

ASU NIGHT TONIGHT: Sun Devils will come together for the start of the school year with ASU Night, featuring a co-branded D-backs x ASU Merrill Kelly jersey.

SUNDAY NIGHT CONCERT AT CHASE FIELD: Chase Field will play host to headliner My Chemical Romance and Mesa’s own Jimmy Eat World this Sunday night for the “The Black Parade 2026” tour stop...doors open at 5:00 p.m. and the concert is slated to start at 7:00 p.m.

HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs are 7-5 in their last 12 games.

- Geraldo Perdomo** has a 9-game hitting streak, batting .387 (12-for-31)/.874 OPS with 3 RBI, 6 walks and 2 stolen bases.
- Eduardo Rodriguez** has a 17.2 scoreless streak, dating back to Aug. 15.
 - Has back-to-back scoreless outings — 5.2 on Aug. 21 vs. Reds and 7.0 on Aug. 26 vs. Cubs...his 2 such outings of 5.0+ shutout frames are tied for the second-longest by a D-backs pitcher since 2023 (6 other instances) behind Zac Gallen’s 4 such starts (April 10-26, 2023).

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 2-1 vs. Phillies.

- Brandon Pfaadt** had his sixth quality start in his last 8 outings (6.0 IP, 2 ER, 5 H, 1 BB, 1 K).
- Jonathan Loáisiga, Juan Morillo** and **Kevin Ginkel** each tossed 1.0 shutout frame.
- Gabriel Moreno** had a RBI double and a single.
- Ryan Waldschmidt** had 2 singles.
- Geraldo Perdomo** and **Ketel Marte** each had 1 single and 1 walk.

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs reinstated OF **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** (strained right adductor) from the 10-Day Injured List, reinstated LHP **Blake Walston** (recovery from left ulnar collateral ligament surgery) from the 60-Day Injured List and transferred RHP **Ryan Thompson** (strained lower back) to the 60-Day Injured List.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are fourth in the NL Wild Card race, a 0.5 game behind the Padres (WC3, season tied 5-5), 5.5 games behind the Phillies (WC2, season tied 2-2) and 5.5 games behind the Cubs (WC1, trail season 2-4).

1-2 PUNCH:**Brandon Pfaadt** (team is 4-2) and **Eduardo Rodriguez** (team is 4-1), in a combined 11 starts (7 quality) in August, are 6-2 with a 2.56 ERA (23 R-20 ER in 70.1 IP), an opponent .207 AVG (54-for-261)/.573 OPS, 13 walks and 55 strikeouts.

MORILLO’S SILENT AUGUST: **Juan Morillo** had 11 scoreless outings (10.2 IP, 8 H, 4 BB, 10 K) in August, only the third D-backs reliever all-time with 10 or more scoreless outings in August, along with Joe Paterson in 2011 (7.0 IP, 5 H, 2 BB, 2 K) and J.J. Putz in 2012 (12.2 IP, 7 H, 2 BB, 15 K).

BACKSTOPS RAKED IN AUGUST: D-backs catchers, in 29 games in August, hit .330 (38-for-115)/.906 OPS with 14 dobules, 1 triple, 2 homers, 18 RBI and 9 walks.

- Among all teams in August (when batting as the catcher), ranked first with a .330 AVG (ahead of WSH .295) and 38 hits (ahead of MIL 32), second with a .384 OBP (to SEA .385), third with a .906 OPS (to SEA .956, MIL .906) and fourth with a .522 SLG (to SEA .571, MIL .536 and COL .529).

BATTING FIRST: **Geraldo Perdomo**, as the leadoff hitter, has reached base safely in 7 of his last 8 games, batting .344 (11-for-32)/.948 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 triples, 1 RBI and 4 walks.

BULLPEN BOYS: **Juan Morillo** has a 9-home-game scoreless streak (9.0 IP) with an opponent .194 AVG (6-for-31)/.531 OPS, 4 walks and 6 strikeouts.

- Brandyn Garcia** has held opponents scoreless in 23 of 24 home games this season, with a 0.43 ERA (1 ER in 21.0 IP), an opponent .145 AVG (10-for-69)/.395 OPS, 4 walks and 17 strikeouts.

HOME SWEET HOME: **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 5 straight home games (.412, 7-for-17, .912 OPS, 3 BB) and in 14 of 16 home games in August, batting .339 (21-for-62)/.841 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 triples, 4 RBI and 7 walks.

- Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 34 of his last 35 home games, batting .318 (41-for-129)/.877 OPS with 11 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 19 RBI and 21 walks.
- Tim Tawa** has reached base safely in 6 of his last 7 home games, batting .292 (7-for-24)/.829 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 3 RBI and 3 walks.

COMEBACK KIDS: The D-backs’ 41 comeback wins lead the Majors, ahead of the Cubs (40).

- 21 comeback wins at home are tied for fifth in the Majors.

OVER THE LONG HAUL: The D-backs’ 28 wins (28-19) since July 9 are tied for third in the Majors with the Rays (28) and Yankees (28) behind the Red Sox (33) and Braves (29).

- The D-backs went 15-14 (.517) in August, the seventh-best winning percentage in the NL.

VS. NL EAST: **Corbin Carroll** has a 12-game on-base streak vs. NL East (.256, 11-for-43, .919 OPS, 9 walks).

- Gabriel Moreno** has a 12-game on-base streak vs. NL East (.378, 17-for-45, 1.133 OPS, 6 walks).

TAWA’S RUN: **Tim Tawa’s** career-best 16-game on-base streak came to an end last night...in his last 17 games, is hitting .283 (17-for-60)/.842 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 homers, 9 RBI and 7 walks.

VS. PHILLIES: **Corbin Carroll** has a 12-game on-base streak, batting .280 (14-for-50)/.833 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers, 13 RBI and 3 walks.

- Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 11 straight home games, batting .441 (17-for-41)/1.015 OPS with 5 doubles and 5 walks.
- Ketel Marte** has a 13-game on-base streak, batting .317 (13-for-41)/1.002 OPS with 2 doubles, 3 homers, 9 RBI and 6 walks.
 - Has reached base safely in 11 straight home games, batting .441 (15-for-34)/1.336 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers, 8 RBI and 4 walks.
