Sale Scoreless

Today's starting pitcher, Chris Sale, is riding a 10.0-inning scoreless streak dating to July 10 at St. Louis. He covered just 3.0 innings in that turn against the Cardinals before rain forced the game into a delay.

Sale's last run allowed occurred on a home run by Mark Vientos (NYM) on July 4.

His 10.0-inning streak is the fifth-longest active by an MLB starter behind Zac Thornton (NYM, 18.0), Mick Abel (MIN, 14.0), Nolan McLean (NYM, 11.0) and Justine Steele (CHC, 10.2).

TODAY'S GAME: Atlanta and San Diego today conclude their four-game midweek series to round out their season slate against one another...The Padres secured the season set with their win on Tuesday...San Diego swept Atlanta in three games at Petco Park from June 22-24.

 The Braves were buoyed by a six-run eighth inning and staved off a late comeback bid to win last night, 7-6...Six Atlanta batters registered multi-hit performances.

 Since the beginning of the 2025 season, the Braves are just 3-10 (.231) against the Padres...All three of their wins in that span have occurred here at Truist Park.

 Atlanta entered this series with just a single win over San Diego since the start of 2025...The Padres have beaten the Braves more than any other team since the beginning of last year (10-3).

 RH Griffin Canning faced the Braves exactly a month ago on June 23 at Petco Park...After entering as the bulk pitcher following an opener, the 6-foot-2, 180-pounder surrendered four earned runs across just 0.2 of an inning in a Padres win, 7-6...In three all-time appearances against Atlanta while with Los Angeles-AL, New York-NL and San Diego, the native of Mission Viejo, CA, is 0-1 with a 12.91 ERA (11 ER/7.2 IP)...Atlanta acquired Canning from Los Angeles-AL in exchange for OF Jorge Soler on October 31, 2024.

CHRIS SALE: Is scheduled today to make his 19th start of the season with a 10-6 record and a 2.06 ERA (24 ER/105.0 IP)...The 2026 National League All-Star's ERA ranks second in MLB behind Jacob Misiorowski (MIL, 1.57)...Sale fired 7.0 shutout innings against Texas in his first outing following the All-Star break on July 17...The left-hander hasn't conceded a run since July 4.

 Among qualified National League hurlers, Sale also ranks sixth in WHIP (1.06), ninth in strikeouts (123) and is tied for ninth in opponent's batting average (.221).

 Since 1912, only four other 37-year-olds have matched Sale's ERA through their first 18 starts of a season: Dutch Leonard (1948), Phil Niekro (1984), Roger Clemens (2005) and Justin Verlander (2022).

 Sale hasn't allowed more than three runs in 15 consecutive starts, the longest active streak in MLB...Misiorowski is the only pitcher to post a longer streak this season (16 games).

 Sale, a 16-year major-league veteran, has faced the Padres six times previously...He's 4-0 all-time with a 1.80 ERA (8 ER/40.0 IP) against the club...His 1.80 ERA against San Diego is eighth-best against any single opponent...The southpaw from Lakeland, FL, has posted a better ERA against St. Louis (0.95), Chicago-NL (1.35), San Francisco (1.36), Pittsburgh (1.42), Colorado (1.44), Milwaukee (1.62) and Cincinnati (1.76).

JIM JARVIS: Yesterday went 2-for-4 with a double, run and an RBI, signifying his second consecutive multi-hit performance...The effort marked his fourth multi-knock game in 16 career appearances.

 Jarvis is one of nine MLB rookies this season to collect at least 16 hits in his first 16 career games, and one of just five in the National League...The last Brave to do so was Vaughn Grissom in 2022 (22 hits).

 Among the 65 major-league rookies with at least 50 plate appearances, Jarvis' .308 batting average leads the National League and ranks third in MLB behind Joshua Kuroda-Grauer (.417) and Wade Meckler (.311).

 Since embarking for his second stint in the big leagues on July 2, Jarvis' .871 OPS ranks third on Atlanta's club (min. 25 PA) behind Drake Baldwin (1.014) and Matt Olson (.948).

 Jarvis, a native of San Diego, hasn't struck out multiple times in any of his first 16 major-league games...He's one of just two rookies in the majors this season to start their career with such a streak (Yohendrick Piñago, TOR, 25 games)...The last Brave to do so was Daniel Castro, who posted a 19-game streak to start his career in 2015.

THE SERIES: The Braves today are looking to secure their 22nd series victory of the season, which would tie the Los Angeles Dodgers and Milwaukee Brewers for the most in MLB...Twenty-two series victories would also surpass Atlanta's total from the entirety of the 2025 campaign.

 Atlanta is playing its fifth four-game series of the season, and has yet to lose one...With a win today, the club will move to 3-0-2 in four-game sets.

 The Braves today will attempt to win their first series against the Padres since July 12-14, 2024, when they took two-of-three at Petco Park...Prior to this set, Atlanta had lost three straight series to San Diego.

 Atlanta has played to a 16-13 record in day games this season, and has won three of its last four...Drake Baldwin's .354 day-game batting average ranks second in the major leagues among qualifiers.

AUSTIN RILEY: Went 2-for-5 with an RBI last night...Both of his singles garnered exit velocities above 95 mph (97.3 mph, 109.0 mph), each registering as a hard-hit ball...Riley's 75.0% hard-hit rate is second-best in Major League Baseball after the All-Star break.

 The only batter in the majors with a higher hard-hit rate in that time is Pittsburgh's Esmerlyn Valdez (85.7%)...Riley's average exit velocity since the break is 96.5 mph.

 Seven of Riley's batted balls since the break have left the bat at over 105 mph – the most of any National League batter...Only Tampa Bay's Junior Caminero (9) has more in the majors.

Today's Game

🍷 Makes his 19th start of the season and the 331st of his career in the finale of a four-game series against San Diego...Atlanta is 11-7 in his 18 turns this year and has won two of the first three games of the set.

🍷 Will make his seventh career start against San Diego, owning a 4-0 record and a 1.80 ERA (8 ER/40.0 IP) in six previous starts...Has never been charged with a loss against the Padres...Faced them twice in 2025, going 0-0 with a 3.00 ERA (4 ER/12.0 IP).

🍷 Ranks second among qualified major league pitchers with a 2.06 ERA (24 ER/105.0 IP), trailing only Milwaukee's Jacob Misiorowski (1.57)...His mark is the lowest among major league left-handers.

🍷 His 2.36 ERA (107 ER/408.1 IP) since joining Atlanta in 2024 is the second-lowest among major league pitchers over that span, trailing only Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (2.35)...It is the lowest by a left-hander.

🍷 Has not allowed more than three runs in 15 consecutive starts, dating to April 12, the longest active streak of its kind in the majors this season...Is 8-5 with a 1.72 ERA (17 ER/89.0 IP) and 107 strikeouts over the span.

🍷 Only Milwaukee's Jacob Misiorowski (16 starts, March 26-June 26) has put together a longer run in 2026.

🍷 Since joining Atlanta in 2024, Sale has been charged with one loss in the second half of a season...Is 8-1 with a 2.03 ERA (25 ER/111.0 IP), 142 strikeouts and 21 walks in that span...Chicago (NL) handed him his lone post-break loss with the Braves, scoring three earned runs on September 10, 2025, to win, 3-2.

🍷 Is the sixth pitcher age 37 or older in the Live-Ball era (since 1920) to post an ERA that low through his first 18 starts of a season...The last to do so was Justin Verlander, who carried a 1.86 ERA through 18 starts in 2022.

🍷 Has made four starts on seven-or-more days of rest in 2026, the most of any pitcher in the majors...Is 2-1 with a 1.19 ERA (3 ER/22.2 IP) and 34 strikeouts in those outings.

🍷 Is 6-2 with a 1.35 ERA (8 ER/53.1 IP) in nine starts at Truist Park this season.

🍷 Was named to his 10th career All-Star team this season, his third in as many years with Atlanta...His 10 selections are tied with Justin Verlander for the most among active pitchers.

🍷 Is one of two left-handers in Braves franchise history to record a 10-strikeout game at age 37 or older, joining Hall of Famer Warren Spahn...Both of Sale's have come this season (11 strikeouts May 2 at Colorado, 10 on June 28 at San Francisco), while Spahn did so four times from 1958-60, all with Milwaukee.

🍷 His 11.11 strikeouts per 9.0 innings (2,702 SO/2,189.0 IP) are the highest rate in major league history (since 1901) among pitchers with at least 1,500.0 career innings.

🍷 His fastball has averaged 95.9 mph in 2026, the highest mark in any season since he became a full-time starter in 2012.

🍷 His 411 career appearances are the third-most among active starting pitchers (minimum 60 percent starts), trailing only Justin Verlander (556) and Max Scherzer (489)...His 330 career starts rank seventh among active pitchers.

🍷 Since 1968, three pitchers have maintained a sub-3.00 career ERA while making at least 300 starts: Pedro Martínez (2.93 ERA, 409 starts), Clayton Kershaw (2.54 ERA, 451 starts) and Sale (2.96 ERA, 330 starts).

2026

🍷 Won his 18th start July 17 against Texas, tossing 7.0 scoreless innings on two hits with no walks and six strikeouts in the 15-1 victory at Truist Park...His 2.06 ERA is the lowest by a Braves starter through his first 18 turns of a season since Tom Glavine posted a 1.75 mark through 18 starts in 2002.

🍷 Recorded his 500th strikeout as a Brave on July 4 against New York (NL), becoming the ninth left-hander in franchise history to reach the mark...Has compiled 513 strikeouts in 68 appearances (67 starts) in an Atlanta uniform.

🍷 Reached 150 career wins April 26 against Philadelphia, becoming the 265th pitcher in MLB history to do so...Allowed one hit over 6.0 scoreless innings with nine strikeouts in the 6-2 victory...Passed Chuck Finley (2,610) for 28th on the all-time strikeout list and seventh among left-handers.

🍷 Passed Tom Glavine (2,607) for 29th on the all-time strikeout list April 18 at Philadelphia.

🍷 Reached 400 career strikeouts with Atlanta on April 6, the 13th pitcher in franchise history to reach the mark.

🍷 **Awards:** NL Cy Young (2024), Rawlings Gold Glove (2024), NL Comeback Player of the Year (2024), AL All-Star (7x, 2012-18), NL All-Star (3x, 2024-26), and World Series Champion (2018).

🍷 In his 16th major league season, Sale was selected to seven consecutive AL All-Star teams from 2012-2018, was selected to the NL All-Star team in 2024, 2025 and 2026, and has eight career Top 10 finishes in Cy Young voting, winning the award with Atlanta in 2024.

🍷 In his first year with Atlanta and 14th major league season, Sale was named the National League Cy Young Award winner, a Rawlings Gold Glove Award recipient, a National League All-Star, a First-Team All-MLB Nomination and the National League Comeback Player of the Year, going 18-3 with a 2.38 ERA (47 ER/177.2 IP) and 225 strikeouts.

🍷 Led the National League in wins, strikeouts and ERA...Became the first pitcher in Braves franchise history to win the triple crown and first in the National League since Clayton Kershaw with Los Angeles in 2011.
