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## STAY INFORMED

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RAY REPORT-The Rays conclude a five-game road trip through Baltimore (1-2) and Miami (1-0, 1 to play) tonight at loanDepot Park...are 5-3 in their last eight games on the heels of a season-high six-game losing streak....however, they have lost nine of their last the midst of a a run of 19 games in 20 days from June 7-26

Tampa Bay has recorded 10+ hits in three consecutive games for the first time lampa Bay has recorded 10
Randy Arozarena (1-for-1, 2BB, R, 2HBP) reached base safely a career-high-tying five times last night (3x, last: May 20, 2022 at BAL - 13 inn.)...it marked his second time doing so in a nine-inning affair (Oct. 2, 2021 at NYY).
The Rays have recorded 1+ XBH in 20 straight games against the Marlins dating back to Aug. 29, 2020...with a win tonight, Tampa Bay would improve to 13-1 (.929) in its last 14 games in Miami dating back to May 14, 2019.
Tampa Bay scored nine runs last night for the first time since plating a seasonhigh 10 runs on May 3 vs. New York-NL...it marked the first time the Rays scored $9+$ runs on the road since Oct. 1, 2023 at Toronto (12R)
The Rays 14 wins when their opponent scores first are tied with Baltimore and New York-NL for second most in the majors behind New York-AL (17)...Tampa Bay's 14-19 (.424) winning pct. in such games ranks fifth in MLB behind NYY (1710/.630), PHI (13-10/.565), BAL (14-14/.500) and CLE (12-14/.462).
Tampa Bay has trailed at some point in each of its last 15 games, going 6-9 during that stretch...the Rays 10 wire-to-wire victories are tied with Los Angeles-AL for third fewest in the AL, ahead of Chicago-AL (8G) and Oakland (9G)...their last wire-to-wire win came on May 17 at TOR (4-3).
RECENT TRANSACTIONS-Prior to tonight's game, Tampa Bay reinstated RHP Zach Eflin (lower back inflammation) from the 15-day IL and optioned RHP Justin Sterner to Triple-A Durham.

TAKING THE BAIT-Tampa Bay is $22-3(.880)$ vs. Miami since the beginning of $2019 .$. no team has a better record vs. a single opponent in that span (min. 15G), with the next closest being Houston's 15-3 (.833) mark against Colorado.

DAWGS GOTTA EAT-Brandon Lowe (2-for-4, 2B, HR, 5RBI, BB, 2R) tallied his fourth career game with 5+ RBI last night (last: 5RBI, April 9, 2023 vs. OAK)...the 5 RBI were the most by a Ray since Jonathan Aranda drove in six on Oct. 1, 2023 at Toronto.

Lowe reached 318 career RBI, surpassing Kevin Kiermaier (316) for eighth on Tampa Bay's all-time list...Fred McGriff is seventh with 359 RBI.
Last night, he recorded multiple extra-base hits against left-handed pitching for the fifth time in his career (last: May 7,2022 at SEA - 2HR)...marked his first homer off a southpaw since Aug. 27, 2023 vs. NYY (Carlos Rodón).
In his last six games vs. Miami dating to Sept. 25, 2021, Lowe is 11 -for-23 (.478) with five doubles, two home runs and 8 RBI.

THE LOWE DOWN-Josh Lowe has tallied at least one hit and one run scored in each of his first four career games vs. Miami...With one hit and one run tonight, he would join WSH Jeimer Candelario (May 16-June 17, 2023) as the only players to accomplish the feat in each of their first five career games against the Marlins.

BEND(IX), BUT DON'T BREAK-The Rays 17 comeback wins are tied with the Tigers for fourth most in the majors behind the Orioles, Phillies and Yankees (all 18).

Each of Tampa Bay's last six victories have been come-from-behind wins...it marks the first time they have accomplished the feat since a stretch of eight comeback wins from May 8-18, 2013 (Elias).
Yesterday, the Rays snapped a streak of 14 straight games in which they did not hold a lead entering the 7th frame, their longest single-season streak since Aug. $1-15,1998$ (14G)...the longest single-season streak in franchise history was 16
games from June 24-July 13, 1998 (Elias). games from June 24-July 13, 1998 (Elias).

SOUTHPAW SUCCESS-The Rays will face a left-handed starter for the third consecutive game and for the 16th time this season, going 10-5 in the 15 previous matchups...they h tarter just five times in its last 37 ames since April 23 compared to 10 in its first 24 games starter just five times in its last 37 games since April 23 compared to 10 in its first 24 games Since the beginning of 2023, the Rays are 34-16 (.680) when facing left-handed Atlanta (35-16/.686).

A LITTLEBREATHING ROOM-With yesterday's 9-5 win, Tampa Bay snapped a streak of 20 straight games in which it did not secure a win by 4+ runs...prior to yesterday, the Rays last win of 4+ runs came on May 11 vs. New York-AL (7-2)...the 20-game stretch was the longest by a Rays club since July 27-Aug. 24, 2017 (27G).

DOWN TO THE WIRE-The Rays are 12-4 (.750) in one-run games, the second-best winning pct. in the majors behind the Mariners (13-4/.765)...Tampa Bay's $21-9$ (.700) record in games decided by two runs or fewer leads MLB, ahead of Philadelphia (17) 8/.680)...their 30 games decided by two or fewer runs are third most in the AL behind (21), but their 22 losses by $3+$ runs are second most in the AL behind the White Sox (28). The Rays have won each of their last six one-run games, their longest singleseason streak a seven-game run from Aug. 10-Sept. 2, 2019.
TWO SIDES OF THE COIN-Tampa Bay has stolen an AL-best 60 SB , ranking fifth in MLB behind Washington (95SB), Cincinnati (88SB), Milwaukee (81SB) and Philadelphia (70SB)...however, the Rays have been caught stealing an MLB-high 28 times, ahead of Los Angeles-AL (24CS), and have the third-worst stolen base pct. (68.2\%) in the majors ahead of Los Angeles-AL (68.0\%) and San Francisco (65.5\%).

The Rays have been caught stealing four times at third base, tied with Milwaukee for the most in the majors...they are the only team to have multiple players

TODAY'S START-Following his reinstatement from the 15-day IL (lower back inflammation), Eflin will make his 11th start of the campaign tonight, including his seventh on the road...is seeking his first win in Miami since Aug. 24, 2019...has recorded 18 consecutive starts of 5.0+ innings, the longest active streak in the AL.
LAST TIME OUT-Recorded 6.0 frames, but did not factor into the decision of the Rays $5-4$ win in Toronto on May 18 (6.0IP, 9H, 4ER, 3 SO)...yielded a pair of hits the first time through the order, but held the Blue Jays scoreless until George Springer's RBI-single in the 4th frame... allowed three more runs in the 5th, but worked a 1-2-3 6th inning to conclude the outing...his nine hits allowed matched a season high (3x)... departed with the Rays trailing, 4-3, but Jonny DeLuca hit a go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning to secure the win.

FISH ARENOT FRIENDS-In 18 career games (17GS) against Miami, Eflin is $5-8$ with a 4.91 ERA (99.0IP, 54 ER )....he has a six-game losing streak agains the Marlins since the start of 2020, posting a 5.93 ERA (41.0IP, 27ER) ove nine outings (8GS) during that stretch....however, in his most recent outing he recorded 6.1 scoreless frames on Aug. 30, 2023 at loanDepot Park (6.11P 4H, OR, 4 SO .... his clubs are $1-7$ in his last eight starts against Miami (PHI. $0-6 ; 1 B: 1-1$ ), providing him with one or zero runs of support in six of the eight stars...he has made more against the Marlins than any other opponent in his career
WE'RE GOING STREAKING-Eflin has walked two batters or fewer in 44 straight starts dating to June 14, 2022, tied with SEA George Kirby for the longest active streak in the majors...since 2010, only four starters have strung together longer streaks: Phil Hughes (64GS), Clayton Kershaw (47GS), Michael Pineda (46GS) and Josh Tomlin (45GS)

Of the 44 starts, 41 have come with the Rays....he is one start shy of tying the franchise record held by Andy Sonnanstine, who walked two or fewer in 42 straight starts from Aug. 5, 2007-Sept. 21, 2008 two or fewer in 42 straight starts from Aug. 5, 2007-Sept. 21, 2008 . streaks in Rays history belong to Corey Kluber $(150,2022)$ and Streaks in Rays history
Eflin has recorded 5.0+ IP in 18 straight starts since Aug. 19 (G2) 2023, the longest active streak in the AL and third longest in the majors.

IT'S A MARATHON-In innings 1-5, Eflin has posted a 2.88 ERA (50.OIP, 16ER) and held opponents to a . 233 ( 45 -for-193) average and .596 OPS...from the 6th inning on, he owns an 11.00 ERA (9.0IP, 11ER), 426 (20-for-47) opp. average and 1.279 opp . OPS...he has allowed nine of his 27 (33.0\%) of his total runs in the 6th frame.

When his pitch count resides between 1-60, opponents are 39 for-167 (.234) against him...once he surpasses the 60 -pitch mark, opposing hitters have gone 26 -for- 73 (.356).
Opponents are batting a combined .210 (37-for-176) against Eflin the first two times through the order, including .186 ( 16 -for- 86 ) the second time through...opposing hitters have produced a 28 -for- 64 (.438) clip the third time through the lineup and beyond.

OUALITY CONTROL-Min. 50.0 IP, Eflin paces the majors in walk rate (1.6\%), walks per 9.0 IP (0.61) and SO/BB ratio (10.57).... he walked only two of his first $130 \mathrm{BF}(1.5 \%)$ in 2024 before walking consecutive batters on April 26 at CWS (Robbie Grossman/Eloy Jimenez)...he has not issued a walk to his last 114 BF since the back-to-back free passes.

Min. 400.0 IP , he has produced the lowest walk rate in the majors since 2020 at 3.8 pct., ahead of Zack Greinke (4.4\%).
Eflin's 68.92 pct. strike rate since the beginning of last season ranks second in the majors (min. 200.0IP) behind SEA George Kirby ( $70.63 \%$ )...his 8.21 SO/BB ratio ranks second behind Kirby ( 9.46 ) under the same parameter.
Eflin has walked one or zero batters in 34 of his 41 starts since signing with the Rays ahead of the 2023 season...only Kirby (39GS) has more such starts during that span
