**WEDNESDAY'S NEWS:** The Orioles fell to the Red Sox, 5-3 in 10 innings, to drop the series...The O's have now lost four of the last six games after winning four of their previous five from August 30 to September 3...**Dean Kremer** tossed his eighth quality start of the season, including his second consecutive... Kremer recorded his third start this year of at least 7.0 IP (last: 4/30 vs. NYY) and retired each of the final 10 batters...**Emmanuel Rivera** connected on his third home run of the year and second with the Orioles in the third inning, all of which have come since July 30...**Anthony Santander** launched a game-tying solo homer in the eighth inning, his 41<sup>st</sup> of the campaign, surpassing **Nelson Cruz** for sole possession of eighth all-time on the Orioles' single-season home run list.

**WHAT'S TRENDING:** The O's have lost five of the last seven games since September 4...Despite this stretch, the team is 83-64 (.565) and 2.0 games behind the Yankees (.578, 85-62) in the AL East... Baltimore is 25-26 (.490) since the All-Star break and 30-33 (.476) since July 1...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 184-125 (.595), the second-best winning percentage in MLB behind the Dodgers (.607, 187-121) during that time.

☞ An AL East winner has not finished the season with a record under .600 since Boston in 2017 (.574, 93-69); the Red Sox also won the division in 2016 with that same record, as did Toronto in 2015.

**HOMER HAPPY:** The Orioles are second in MLB with 216 home runs behind the Yankees (217)...The Dodgers rank third with 204...The O's have hit 200 home runs in a season for the 13<sup>th</sup> time in team history and the 216 are the most by the club since 2017 (232)...Baltimore is averaging 1.47 homers per game this season, which would be the third-best mark in team history behind 1996 (1.58) and 2016 (1.56).

☞ Baltimore has an MLB-best nine players with at least 10 home runs: **Anthony Santander** (41), **Gunnar Henderson** (36), **Colton Cowser** (20), **Adley Rutschman** and **Jordan Westburg** (18), **Cedric Mullins** (15), **Ryan Mountcastle** and **Ryan O'Hearn** (13), and **Ramón Urias** (10); the team record is 10 players, done in 2019, 2000, and 1998.

☞ Henderson and Santander are one of two duos with at least 35 home runs, along with New York-AL's Aaron Judge (51) and Juan Soto (39); Baltimore did not have a player reach 35 homers last season, and this year marks the first time since 2016 that the team has had multiple players with 35+ home runs (Trumbo, 47; Davis, 38; Machado, 37).

☞ The Birds have hit 13 leadoff homers, the most by the club in a single season and second in MLB this year behind the Phillies (14); Henderson has 10 of those, second most in one season by an Oriole behind **Brady Anderson**, who hit all 12 in 1996; Cowser (2) and Westburg (1) have the other three for the O's in 2024.

**TOP GUNN:** **Gunnar Henderson** was named the AL Player of the Week on Monday...The award marked the second of his career, joining June 11, 2023...He slashed .417/.464/.833 (10-for-24) with one double, three homers, six runs scored, five RBI, three walks, and two stolen bases in six games while ranking among AL leaders during the period in slugging percentage (1<sup>st</sup>), home runs (T-1<sup>st</sup>), total bases (T-1<sup>st</sup>, 20), OPS (2<sup>nd</sup>, 1.297), batting average (T-2<sup>nd</sup>), and hits (T-2<sup>nd</sup>).

☞ His 36 home runs are the most by an Oriole shortstop in team history, surpassing the record of 34 held by **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (1991) and **Miguel Tejada** (2004).

☞ Henderson's 111 runs scored rank third in the AL and fourth in MLB, and are the most by an Oriole since **Jonathan Villar** (111) in 2019; the last Oriole with 112 or more runs is **Roberto Alomar**, who set the club record with 132 in 1996; Henderson is the sixth player in O's history (since 1954) to score 100 runs in back-to-back seasons after scoring exactly 100 times last year, joining with **Manny Machado** (2, 2015-16), **Adam Jones** (2, 2012-13), **Brian Roberts** (3, 2007-09), Anderson (2, 1995-96), and Ripken, Jr. (3, 1983-85).

☞ He's on pace to score 122 times; Alomar (132 in 1996), **Frank Robinson** (122 in 1966), and Ripken, Jr. (121 in 1983) are the only players in Orioles history (since 1954) to score at least 120 runs in a season.

☞ He ranks fourth in the AL and MLB with 7.4 fWAR; that is the best mark by an Oriole since Ripken, Jr. set the club record with 10.6 in 1991; eight Orioles (13 occurrences) have finished a season with at least 7.0 fWAR in a season; he's also among AL leaders in walks (3<sup>rd</sup>, 72), total bases (3<sup>rd</sup>, 309), home runs (T-4<sup>th</sup>, 36), extra-base hits (T-5<sup>th</sup>, 69), hits (6<sup>th</sup>, 162), on-base percentage (7<sup>th</sup>, .366), OPS (7<sup>th</sup>, .902), and slugging percentage (7<sup>th</sup>, .536).

☞ Henderson has hit 30 of his home runs as the leadoff hitter, the second player in Orioles history to do so, along with **Brady Anderson** (35) in 1996; he's batting .320/.377/.701 (31-for-97) with seven doubles and 10 home runs when leading off the game...His 1.078 OPS to begin a game is the best such mark in MLB this year and the second-best such OPS by an Oriole in team history, behind Anderson (1.256) in 1996 (min. 55 GS).

**MASHED TATERS:** **Anthony Santander** launched his 40<sup>th</sup> home run of the year on Monday, becoming the eighth Oriole (ninth occurrence) to do so and the first since **Mark Trumbo** in 2016 (see chart at right)... He's the eighth switch-hitter (12<sup>th</sup> occurrence) in MLB history to hit at least 40 homers in a season, along with New York-NL's Carlos Beltrán (2006), Houston's Lance Berkman (2: 2002, 06), Texas' Mark Teixeira (2005), Atlanta's Chipper Jones (1999), New York-NL's Todd Hundley (1996), San Diego's Ken Caminiti (1996), and New York-AL's Mickey Mantle (4: 1956, 58, 60-61)...Mantle is the only switch-hitter in MLB history to hit 50 homers, when he did so in 1956 (52) and 1961 (54).

☞ He's five RBI shy of 100 for the season; no Oriole has reached that mark since **Jonathan Schoop** (105) in 2017; the last Baltimore switch-hitter to do so is **Bobby Bonilla** (116) in 1996.

☞ Santander has hit 32 home runs since the start of June, trailing Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani (33) for the most in MLB during that time; his 41 home runs rank third in MLB behind New York-AL's Aaron Judge (51) and Ohtani (47).

☞ His 102 home runs since the start of 2022 rank sixth in MLB during that time and second in the AL, behind only Judge (150).

☞ He's the ninth player in O's history with multiple 30-homer seasons, joining **Manny Machado** (3, 2015-17), **Chris Davis** (4, 2012-13, 15-16), **Adam Jones** (2, 2012-13), **Rafael Palmeiro** (4, 1995-98), **Eddie Murray** (5, 1980, 82-83, 85, 87), **Boog Powell** (4, 1964, 66, 69-70), **Frank Robinson** (3, 1966-67, 69), and **Jim Gentile** (2, 1961-62).

☞ Santander is 13<sup>th</sup> in team history with 152 home runs, six behind **Melvin Mora** for 12<sup>th</sup>.

**HOLY COWSER:** **Colton Cowser** leads AL rookies and is tied for second among MLB rookies with 20 home runs with Milwaukee's Jackson Chourio, trailing San Diego's Jackson Merrill (23)...He's the 10<sup>th</sup> rookie in team history (since 1954) to hit at least 20 homers and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (28) last year...He also has 21 doubles, the ninth rookie in O's history to record 20 doubles and 20 home runs in a season and the first since Henderson (29-2B, 28 HR) in 2023...Among rookies, Cowser is tied for the AL lead and tied for second in MLB with 3.6 fWAR with New York-AL's Austin Wells and PIT's Paul Skenes, trailing San Diego's Jackson Merrill (4.3)...He's among AL rookies in runs scored (1<sup>st</sup>, 70), extra-base hits (2<sup>nd</sup>, 44), total bases (2<sup>nd</sup>, 196), doubles (T-3<sup>rd</sup>, 21), RBI (3<sup>rd</sup>, 62), and OPS (4<sup>th</sup>, .763).

☞ His 11 Outs Above Average are more than all other O's defenders combined, per Statcast; eight of those have come in left field, two behind Toronto's Daulton Varsho for the most among MLB left fielders; Detroit's Riley Greene is the next closest left fielder with four OAA.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Baltimore's penultimate road trip began in Boston on Monday...Following an off day yesterday, the Orioles face Detroit for three games beginning tonight...Despite losing 15 of the last 26 road games, the Orioles are 41-31 (.569) away from Oriole Park, the third-best road record in MLB this season behind the Padres (.583, 42-30) and Yankees (.600, 45-30)...The Birds are 93-60 (.608) on the road since the start of 2023, the only MLB club with a road winning percentage above .600 in that time.

**AGAINST THE TIGERS:** The Orioles and Tigers commence their season series tonight at Comerica Park...The two teams will face off for three games in Detroit over the weekend before meeting for three more in Baltimore next weekend...The O's won the season series against Detroit in 2023, going 6-1, including a three-game sweep in Baltimore from April 21-23...The 6-1 record last season marked Baltimore's first time winning more than five games in a single season against Detroit since the 2004 club swept the six-game season series...The Birds went 3-1 at Comerica Park in 2023 after going 5-12 in 17 games from 2017-2022...Baltimore currently holds the AL's top Wild Card spot while Detroit is 3.5 games back of the Twins for the final spot.

**THE SKIPPER:** Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He became the fourth Orioles manager to win AL Manager of the Year...He is two wins away from 400 for his career, all with Baltimore...Four previous managers have won 400 games at the helm of the Orioles: **Earl Weaver** (1,480), **Buck Showalter** (669), **Paul Richards** (517), and **Hank Bauer** (407).

**QUICK HITS:** Scheduled to make his seventh start with the Orioles and 26<sup>th</sup> this season tonight against the Tigers...Reinstated from the 15-day Injured List prior to his start on September 1; placed on the IL (right shoulder inflammation) on August 20, retroactive to August 17; marked his second stint on the IL this season after being reinstated on June 5 (lower back inflammation)...Won his first five starts to begin his Orioles career, joining Jack Harshman(1958) as the only Orioles to win each of their first five appearances with the club in team history; Eflin is the first to win each of his first five with all of them being starts and the first Oriole to win each of his first five starts with the team since Ben McDonald (7/21-8/13/90)...Was acquired by the O's from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for minor leaguers RHP Jackson Baumeister, INF/OF Mac Horvath, and OF Matthew Etzel on July 26...Became the first MLB pitcher since Andrew Cashner in 2019 to make back-to-back starts against the same opponent with different franchises in the same season (BAL and BOS against TOR), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*; no pitcher had been acquired by the Orioles in the same season and faced the same opponent he did in his previous start in franchise history (since 1954)...Ranks in the 99<sup>th</sup> percentile with a 2.8 walk percentage this season, per Statcast...Signed a three-year contract with the Tampa Bays on December 13, 2022...Spent seven seasons with the Phillies, going 36-45 with a 4.49 ERA (329 ER/659.1 IP) in 127 outings (115 GS) from 2016-2022...Acquired by Philadelphia from Los Angeles-NL on December 19, 2014 in exchange for Jimmy Rollins and cash considerations...Traded to the Dodgers a day prior as part of a package for Matt Kemp...Originally selected by the Padres in the C-A round (33<sup>rd</sup> overall) of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft out of Paul J. Hagerty (FL) High School.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered his eighth loss of the season and his first with the Orioles on September 7 vs. Tampa Bay after allowing three runs on eight hits (2 HR) and one walk with four strikeouts across 5.2 innings; exited with runners on first and second, both of which were stranded...Failed to complete 6.0 innings for the first time as an Oriole and for the first time since July 24 at Toronto (w/TB)...Surrendered a leadoff home run to Yandy Diaz, the second leadoff home run he has allowed this season, joining June 16 at Atlanta (w/TB) to Jarred Kelenic...Has gone at least 5.0 innings and allowed three or fewer runs in all six of his starts to begin his career with Baltimore; the only Orioles starters to have longer streaks to begin their career with the team this century are Jeremy Guthrie in 2007 (11) and current teammate Corbin Burnes this season (15)...Threw 91 pitches, 60 strikes.

**AGAINST THE TIGERS:** Making his second career start against the Tigers...Allowed one run on three hits and one walk with five strikeouts across 5.0 innings in his lone start vs. Detroit on April 1, 2023 (w/TB)...Comerica Park is one of four current stadiums that Eflin has never pitched in, joining Globe Life Field in Arlington, Target Field in Minneapolis, and T-Mobile Park in Seattle.

**AGAINST THE AL CENTRAL:** Making his 14<sup>th</sup> career start (15<sup>th</sup> appearance) against the AL Central...Has gone 9-3 with a 3.67 ERA (31 ER/76.0 IP) in those games...His last appearance against the division came on August 3 at Cleveland; earned the win after allowing two runs on five hits (1 HR) and three strikeouts in 6.1 innings.

**WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:** Eflin has issued 17 walks in 148.0 innings this season; his 1.01 BB/9 is the best in MLB among qualified pitchers...His 2.8 walk percentage ranks in the 99<sup>th</sup> percentile in MLB this season, the second-best mark among qualified pitchers, per Statcast, trailing only Seattle's Bryan Woo (2.5); the 2.8% walk rate would be his career low; the lowest walk rate by an Oriole in the Statcast era is Tommy Hunter (3.3, 2011)...12 of his 25 starts this season have been walkless, tied for the second most in MLB with Seattle's George Kirby, trailing only St. Louis' Miles Mikolas; had 13 such starts last year, tied for second most in MLB with Mikolas, while trailing Kirby (16).

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Set career highs in starts (31), wins (16), innings (177.2), and strikeouts (186), while also posting his a career low in ERA (3.50) and WHIP (1.02); the 16 wins were tied Toronto's Chris Bassitt for the most in the American League, becoming the third Rays pitcher to lead the AL in wins...Finished sixth in the AL Cy Young award voting...The Rays went 23-8 (.742) in his starts...Recorded a career-low 3.4 percent walk rate, trailing only Seattle's George Kirby (2.5%).

**POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE:** Eflin is 0-1 with a 5.17 ERA (9 ER/15.2 IP) in 11 career Postseason outings (16S)...Made his first career Postseason start last season, taking the loss in Game 1 of the American League Wild Card series against the Texas Rangers on October 4 at Tropicana Field (w/TB)...Allowed five runs on nine hits (2 HR) and two walks (1 BB) in 5.0 innings...Appeared in 10 playoff games in relief for the Phillies in 2022, posting a 3.38 ERA (4 ER/10.2 IP) en route to a National League pennant.
