**RAY REPORT**—The Rays open their post-All-Star-break schedule with a seven-game road trip against the Yankees (4 to play) and Blue Jays (3 to play) tonight at Yankee Stadium...Tampa Bay closed the first half of the season winning seven of its last eight series for the first time in franchise history...the Rays 14-9 (.609) mark since June 19 is third best in the AL, trailing the Astros (17-6/739) and Red Sox (14-7/667)...they begin the second half of the season 5.5 games behind the Red Sox for the AL's third and final Wild Card spot...Tampa Bay has the hardest remaining schedule in the majors with a combined opponent winning pct. of .528 (Elias).

✦ With Sunday's victory vs. Cleveland, Tampa Bay concluded the first half with a .500 or better record for a franchise-best seventh consecutive season dating to 2017 (excl. 2020), surpassing a six-season run from 2008-13.

✦ Sunday's win also marked the Rays eighth consecutive rubber game victory, matching the longest streak in club history, per Elias (3x, last: July-Sept. 2018).

✦ The Rays recorded their fifth shutout win in Sunday's series finale...after blanking the Guardians in the series opener, it marked the first time Tampa Bay shut out an opponent twice in the same series since April 17-19, 2023 at Cincinnati.

✦ Tampa Bay moved to .500 for the 21st time, the most before the All-Star break in club history and second most in a full season behind 2017 (.522).

**NEW YORK STATE OF MIND**—In seven career starts against the Yankees, Zach Eflin is 3-2 with a 1.50 ERA (42.0IP, 7ER), including a 0.69 ERA (13.0IP, 1ER) in two outings this season...min. 40.0 IP, it marks the lowest ERA against New York among active pitchers, outpacing LAD Ryan Yarbrough (2.08)...under the same parameter, only two pitchers have a lower ERA against the Yankees since the beginning of the live-ball era (since 1920): Eddie Watt (1.29) and Stan Baumgartner (1.40).

**DAWGS GOTTA EAT**—Brandon Lowe registered his 114th career homer on Sunday, tying Ben Zobrist for fifth most in franchise history...B.J. Upton sits in fourth place with 118 HR...Lowe has hit safely in five straight games and in eight of 10 since July 4, slashing .371/.436/.600 (13-for-35) with 2 2B, 2 HR, 3 RBI and 4 BB...he ranks among the AL during that stretch in AVG (5th), OBP (6th) and OPS (7th, 1.036).

✦ He has hit safely in nine of 11 games against the Yankees since May 13, 2023, slashing .405/.452/.595 (15-for-37) with 1 2B, 2 HR, 11 RBI and 4 BB.

**PITCHING PROWESS**—The Rays rotation has turned in an MLB-best 2.68 ERA (104.0IP, 31ER) since June 23, ahead of the Braves (3.13) and Mets (3.26)...they have allowed two runs or fewer in 15 of 19 games in that span...they entered that stretch with a 4.50 ERA, 12th in the AL.

✦ Overall, Rays pitching has recorded an MLB-best 1.83 ERA (54.0IP, 11ER) since July 9 after allowing a season-high 13 runs on July 7 at Texas...it marks the club's best ERA over a six-game span since June 4-9, 2023 (1.50).

✦ Taj Bradley's 1.07 ERA (42.0IP, 5ER) since June 8 is the lowest in the majors, ahead of PIT Paul Skenes (1.14).

✦ Jason Adam has thrown 13.0 straight scoreless innings since June 18, the fourth-longest active stretch by a reliever in the majors...he has posted a .050 opp. AVG (2-for-40) and 0.38 WHIP during that stretch.

**PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE**—Isaac Paredes has drawn an MLB-high 14 walks since June 29, ahead of NYY Aaron Judge (12BB)...his 10 multi-walk games this season are tied for third most in the AL behind NYY Juan Soto (22G) and Judge (15G).

✦ Richie Palacios has drawn 1+ BB in 11 of his last 23 games since June 11, producing a 16.5 pct. walk rate during that stretch.

**RUNNIN' RAYS**—The Rays stole an AL-best 95 bags before the All-Star break, outpacing the Red Sox (88SB)...Tampa Bay paced the AL in steals at the break for the second straight season, accomplishing the feat for the second time in franchise history, joining 2008-09...according to Elias, the Rays are the first AL club to have the most steals before the break in consecutive seasons since the Astros (2015-16).

✦ Since July 1, the Rays are 14-for-17 (82.4%) on stolen base attempts, the most steals in the AL during that stretch...they have recorded at least 1 SB in 11 of 12 games in July.

✦ Josh Lowe's 7 SB since June 23 are second most in the AL behind CWS Luis Robert Jr. (8SB)...Randy Arozarena has 7 SB in 22 games since June 19 after having none in his previous 31 contests.

✦ Despite going a career-high 15 games since his last stolen base, José Caballero still leads the AL with 24 SB, besting BOS David Hamilton (23SB)...Caballero joined Carl Crawford (2009, 2004) as the only Rays to lead the AL in steals at the All-Star break.

**CLOSE SHAVES**—The Rays own the AL's best record in games decided by two runs or fewer at 34-16 (.680)...their 17-9 (.654) mark in one-run games ranks second behind the Red Sox (12-5/.706).

✦ Tampa Bay is an MLB-best 18-8 (.643) in games decided by two runs or fewer on the road, including wins in 11 of its last 15 such contests.

**RISP BUT NO REWARD**—Since July 5, the Rays are batting an MLB-worst .103 (8-for-78) with runners in scoring position...overall, Tampa Bay's .223 RISP AVG is second lowest in the majors, ahead of only Chicago-AL (.211).

✦ Tampa Bay's .223 RISP AVG would signal the lowest single-season mark in franchise history, surpassing the mark held by the 2011 Rays (.224).

**UPS AND DOWNS**—Tampa Bay pitching has posted a 3.22 ERA from innings 1-3, the second-lowest mark in the AL behind Seattle (3.15) and fifth lowest in MLB...from innings 4-6, however, Rays pitching owns an MLB-worst 5.44 ERA, with the next closest being the Diamondbacks (5.16)...their 3.94 ERA from the 7th inning on ranks 21st in MLB.

**HOMER (UN)HAPPY**—The Rays yielded the most home runs before the All-Star break in franchise history (126), surpassing the 2000 club (122)...the 126 HR are second most in the majors behind the Blue Jays (132HR).

✦ Tampa Bay hit 54 HR through its first 71 games, tied with Miami for the fewest in the majors...in 25 games since, the Rays have launched 32 HR, led by Brandon Lowe (6HR) and Isaac Paredes/Jose Siri (both 5HR).

✦ Despite having only 86 HR overall, tied for fourth fewest in MLB, Tampa Bay has earned an AL-best 15 wins without the assistance of a long ball...the Rays had 14 such victories all of last season.

**CONCRETE JUNGLE CLASH**—The Rays and Yankees continue their 13-game season series tonight in the Bronx, with New York holding a 5-4 advantage thus far...the Yankees claimed series victories from April 19-21 and May 10-12 before the Rays took two of three at Tropicana Field from July 9-11...min. 15 games, the Rays 36-30 (.545) mark against the Yankees since Aug. 18, 2020 is second best in MLB behind the Mets (13-9/.591)...this includes a 20-15 (.571) mark at Yankee Stadium during that stretch.

✦ Amed Rosario has hit safely in each of his last six games at Yankee Stadium since May 1, 2023, batting .360 (9-for-25) with 1 2B, 2 RBI, 4 R and 5 SB...in 21 career games at the venue, he is 23-for-75 (.307) with 3 2B, 3 HR and 10 RBI.

✦ Manager Kevin Cash received a World Series ring from the Yankees in 2009 after appearing in 10 games in May while Jorge Posada was on the injured list.

✦ Hitting coach Chad Mottola was selected fifth overall by the Reds in the 1992 First-Year Player Draft, one spot before the Yankees drafted Derek Jeter.

✦ C Ben Rortvedt appeared in 32 games for the Yankees last season and spent Spring Training with them before being traded to the Rays on March 27.

✦ RHP Zack Littell began the 2017 season in the Yankees minor league system before being dealt to the Twins at the trade deadline.

✦ Triple-A Durham manager Morgan Ensberg concluded his MLB career with the Yankees in 2008.

✦ Bally Sports Sun announcer Dewayne Staats was the Yankees lead play-by-play announcer from 1990-94.

✦ Rays Senior Advisor, Player Development & Baseball Operations Mitch Lukevics oversaw the Yankees farm system from 1989-95.

✦ Rays Director, Baseball Operations Cole Figueroa suited up for a pair of games with the Yankees in 2015 during his three-year MLB career.

✦ YES Network analyst John Flaherty was the Devil Rays Opening Day catcher in 1998 and spent five of his 14 major league seasons with Tampa Bay.

✦ Yankees special asst. to the GM Hideki Matsui was a member of New York's 2009 World Series championship team before concluding his 10-year MLB career with the Rays in 2012.

✦ Yankees P.A. announcer Paul Olden was a member of the Devil Rays radio broadcast crew from 1998-2004.

**TONIGHT'S START**—Eflin will toe the rubber for his 18th start of the season, including his 11th on the road...since throwing 6.0 scoreless innings on April 20 at Yankee Stadium, is 2-3 with a 5.68 ERA (44.1IP, 28ER) over his last eight road starts...the Rays are 8-2 in his last 10 starts overall...has recorded 5.0+ IP in 16 of his 17 starts...his 5.31 career ERA (125.1IP, 74ER) in July is his highest in any calendar month...he was on the 15-day IL (lower back inflammation) from May 20-June 5.

**LAST TIME OUT**—Was a tough-luck loser on July 10 vs. NYY, allowing two runs (one earned) on four hits and one walk while fanning six batters across a season-high-tying 7.0 IP (3x, last: June 22 at PIT)...threw a season-high 103 pitches, his most since Aug. 25, 2023 vs. NYY (also 103 pitches)...a Trent Grisham RBI-double put New York ahead, 1-0, in the 2nd inning...Gleyber Torres led off the 4th frame with a walk, advanced to third following a Yandy Díaz throwing error and scored on a Grisham sac-fly.

**BEST IN THE BRIGHT LIGHTS**—Eflin is 3-2 with a 1.50 ERA (42.0IP, 7ER) and 0.90 WHIP in seven career starts opposite New York...it marks his second-lowest ERA against any opponent in his career (min. 2G) behind the Twins (0.66)...he has allowed 2 ER or fewer in six of the seven starts, including four with 0 ER, and has held Yankees hitters to 2-for-18 (.111) with RISP.

Eflin has been even better in his last four starts vs. New York dating to Aug. 1, 2023, each of which have been quality...he has posted a 1.08 ERA (25.0IP, 3ER) and 0.76 WHIP in those outings.

**HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS**—In eight road starts since April 26, Eflin owns a 5.68 ERA (44.1IP, 28ER) and a 1.29 WHIP...min 40.0 IP, it marks the third-highest road ERA during that stretch ahead of only LAD James Paxton (6.30) and CLE Logan Allen (6.00).

In comparison, he has made four starts at Tropicana Field during that period, posting a 1.40 ERA (25.2IP, 4ER) and a 0.90 WHIP...it marks the fourth-lowest home ERA among MLB starters over that span (since April 26, min. 25.0IP), trailing PHI Christopher Sánchez (1.29), DET Tarik Skubal (1.35) and Erick Fedde (1.40 - by decimal points).

**FLIP THE SCRIPT**—For his career, Eflin is 15-21 with a 5.09 ERA (254.2IP, 144ER) over 57 appearances (46 starts) post-All-Star break...this, compared to 38-36 with a 3.95 ERA (628.2IP, 276ER) across 108 appearances (all starts) before the break.

Last season, Eflin made 14 starts in the second half...he posted a 4.50 ERA (36.0IP, 18ER) in the first seven outings, but closed the year with a 3.20 ERA (39.1IP, 14ER) to complete the season.

**FROZE HIM**—Since the beginning of last season, Eflin's 88 strikeouts looking are the most in the AL, trailing only PIT Mitch Keller (109), SF Logan Webb (95) and PHI Ranger Suárez (93) in all of MLB...of those 88 strikeouts, 65 (74.0%) have come on his sinker, the most on any individual pitch in the majors...TOR Kevin Gausman's four-seam fastball (62SO) is next closest...Eflin did not record a strikeout looking in his July 4 start at Kansas City for the first time since his June 5 outing at Miami.

**STREAKS GALORE**—Eflin has walked two batters or fewer in 51 straight starts dating to June 14, 2022, tied with SEA George Kirby for the longest active streak in the majors and tied for seventh longest in the majors since at least 1901...since 2005, only MIN Phil Hughes (64GS, 2014-16) has a longer streak...of the 51 starts, 48 have come with the Rays, the longest streak in franchise history.

From April 26-June 16, he did not issue a walk to 165 consecutive batters spanning 39.1 IP—both streaks are the longest in franchise history (prev. Corey Kluber, 150BF; Kluber/David Price, 35.1IP).

The 39.1 IP walk-less streak was the longest in the majors since SF Ross Stripling (42.0IP) from July 2-Aug. 16, 2023, per Elias.

Since both streaks concluded, Eflin has issued a walk in each of his last five starts, his longest streak since May 25-June 23, 2023 (6GS).

**QUALITY CONTROL**—Eflin paces the majors in walk rate (2.2%) and walks per 9.0 IP (0.82), while ranking second in SO/BB ratio (8.67) behind SEA George Kirby (8.92)...he has produced the lowest walk rate in the majors since 2020 (min. 1.750BF) at 3.7 pct., ahead of Zack Greinke (4.4%)...Eflin has walked one or zero batters in 41 of his 48 starts since the beginning of 2023—only Kirby (44) has more starts.
