BIRDLAND BITES: Tonight, Baltimore opens a six-game homestand against Washington (3 to play) and Chicago-AL (3 to play)...The Birds return from a nine-game West Coast swing, going 4-5 against the Mariners (1-2), Dodgers (2-1), and Angels (1-2)...The O's enter play today 1.5 games back in the Wild Card and 11.0 games behind the Yankees in the AL East.

🦅 In Wednesday's 7-6 defeat against Los Angeles-AL, Baltimore pitching struck out a season-high 17 hitters, its most strikeouts since September 21, 2025 vs. New York-AL (also 17)...O's pitching also permitted seven walks, tied for their second most on the season behind May 4, 2026 at New York-AL (8).

🦅 The 7-6 defeat marked the O's fifth loss of the season in which they lost after holding the lead through the seventh inning (led 5-2, lost 7-6)...Marked their second such defeat on the road trip, joining June 19 at the Dodgers (led 5-3 through 8th inn., lost 6-5 in 9th inn.).

ROGERS ROLLING: Trevor Rogers enters tonight having thrown 11.0 consecutive scoreless innings, the fifth-longest active streak among all MLB starters behind MIN's Mick Abel (14.0), AZ's Eduardo Rodriguez (12.2), ATH's Gage Jump (12.0), and teammate Kyle Bradish (11.2).

BATTLE OF THE BELTWAYS: The O's have lost or tied five straight series against the Nationals, including a three-game sweep at Camden Yards last season.

🦅 Taylor Ward has reached base safely in each of his first 15 career games against the Nationals, including hits in 12 of the contests, batting .345 (20-for-58) with four doubles, one home run, five RBI, and 11 walks against 14 strikeouts...It is the third-longest active career-opening on-base streak against the Nationals behind CIN's Elly De La Cruz (23 G) and STL's Alec Burleson (17 G).

PETE AND THE NATS: In 108 career games against the Nationals, Pete Alonso is slashing .296/.390/.572 (117-for-395) with 23 doubles, one triple, 28 home runs, and 75 RBI.

🦅 Since 2005, his 28 long balls against Washington are tied with LAD's Freddie Freeman for the fifth most by any MLB player behind Ryan Howard (43), NYY's Giancarlo Stanton (38), and PIT's Marcell Ozuna/Hanley Ramirez (both 31)...The 28 homers are his second most against any opponent behind the Marlins (33).

🦅 Alonso has gone a career-high 17 straight games without a long ball against Washington, with his last coming on September 17, 2024.

🦅 Overall, in 22 games this month, Alonso is batting .300 (24-for-80) with two doubles, seven home runs, 17 runs, 19 RBI, and 13 walks.

TIGHT SQUEEZE: The Birds have gone 6-12 (.333) in one-run games, the second-lowest winning percentage in MLB in such contests ahead of the Red Sox (5-12, .294).

LEFTY MASHER: Coby Mayo is slashing .304/.361/.750 (17-for-56) with four doubles, seven home runs, and 15 RBI off left-handed pitching this season.

🦅 Since May 11, he is 11-for-23 (.478) with two doubles, five home runs, and 10 RBI off southpaws.

🦅 Overall, his .731 slugging percentage against left-handed pitching is third highest in MLB (min. 50 PA) behind NYY's Paul Goldschmidt (.823) and MIL's Andrew Vaughn (.800) while his 1.111 OPS is also third behind Vaughn (1.364) and Goldschmidt (1.323).

START ME UP: Over the last nine games since June 16, Baltimore starters have posted a 2.96 ERA (18 ER/54.2 IP) and a .217 (44-for-203) opponent average.

🦅 Over that span, the Birds 2.96 ERA is the fifth-lowest mark in MLB behind the Pirates (2.57), Brewers (2.80), Tigers (2.81), and Astros (2.85).

🦅 Overall, O's pitching owns a 3.91 ERA across 41 games at Camden Yards compared to a 4.98 ERA over 41 road games.

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 73 straight games since April 6, the second-longest active streak in the majors this season behind St. Louis (78).

🦅 The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season on April 5 at Pittsburgh...The Orioles join the Brewers as the only teams in MLB to have only one game with zero walks.

🦅 Baltimore is 29-26 when drawing 3+ walks, compared to 9-18 when drawing two or fewer free passes.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT: Blaze Alexander is slashing .375/.418/.563 (42-for-112) with 10 doubles, one triple, three home runs, 14 runs, 22 RBI, seven walks (1 IBB), five stolen bases, and two hit-by-pitches in 43 games since May 1 after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in April.

🦅 Since May 1, he ranks among MLB leaders (min. 100 PA) in batting average (1st), on-base percentage (5th), and OPS (6th, .981)...His seven games with at least three hits during that stretch are tied for the major league lead with NYM's Carson Benge, MIL's William Contreras, and PHI's Brandon Marsh.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: Taylor Ward ranks among MLB leaders in walks (3rd, 64), times on base (4th, 145), and on-base percentage (9th, .389)...Gunnar Henderson led the team with 62 walks a year ago and with 78 free passes in 2024.

🦅 The only Oriole player in team history (since 1954) to have more walks prior to July in a season was Randy Milligan (1990), who had 65 walks through June that season.

🦅 Ward recorded 64 walks and 76 hits through 80 career games with the Orioles...The only other players to have at least 60 walks and 75 hits through 80 career games with the club in franchise history (since 1954) were Albert Belle (63 BB, 82 H), Bob Nieman (62 BB, 89 H), and Ken Singleton (68 BB, 89 H).

🦅 His 15 multi-walk games are second most in the majors behind LAA's Mike Trout (19)...Last season, Jackson Holliday led the Orioles with nine multi-walk efforts.

TROUBLE WITH THE 2'S: Orioles pitching has allowed opponents to slash .261/.351/.406 with two outs...The batting average is second highest in MLB ahead of the Royals (.265)...The on-base percentage is second highest in MLB ahead of the Angels (.351)...Their .757 OPS is fifth highest in the majors ahead of the Royals (.805), Nationals (.769), Rangers (.761), and Reds (.760).

🦅 Baltimore hurlers own a .548 opponent OPS with two strikes, the third-highest clip in MLB ahead of Colorado (.601) and the Athletics (.557).

QUICK HITS: Rogers is scheduled to make his 15th start of the season and 117th of his career...Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (illness) on May 12...Voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining Randy Myers (1997), Mike Cuellar (1974), and Dave McNally (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since Rodrigo Lopez (2002)...Acquired from the Miami Marlins in exchange for INF/OF Connor Norby and OF Kyle Stowers on July 30, 2024.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win on June 20 at Los Angeles-NL after tossing 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing one hit and two walks with a season-high-tying six strikeouts (3x, last: 4/14 vs. AZ)...Threw 96 pitches, 60 strikes.

- Marked his second career start throwing 7.0+ scoreless innings on one hit or fewer, joining July 26, 2025 vs. Colorado (W, 7.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 K).
- Held Dodgers left-handed hitters to a 0-for-10 mark with four strikeouts.
- Enters tonight's start having thrown 11.0 consecutive scoreless innings.

BELTWAY BATTLE: Rogers is set to make his 12th career start opposite the Nationals, having gone 3-5 with a 3.88 ERA (23 ER/53.1 IP)...Has suffered three consecutive losses vs. Washington from April 29-August 13, 2024, recording a 5.29 ERA (10 ER/17.0 IP).

- Rogers allowed three earned runs or fewer in each of his first eight career starts against the Nationals, going 3-2 with a 3.22 ERA (13 ER/36.1 IP).

ENCOURAGING SIGNS: Over four June starts, Rogers is 2-1 with a 2.22 ERA (6 ER/24.1 IP) and a .500 opponent OPS.

- He went 0-3 with a 10.31 ERA (21 ER/18.1 IP) and .996 opponent OPS across four May starts...Among all MLB starters who made at least four starts in May, his 10.31 ERA was second highest ahead of COL's Kyle Freeland (12.46).
- He has held the opposition to a .188 (3-for-16) clip off his changeup this month after they hit .348 (8-for-23) against the offering in May.
- Owens a .154 (2-for-13) opponent average on his sweeper in June after opponents went 3-for-7 (.429) off the pitch in May...His usage on the sweeper is up to 13.8 percent this month after throwing it 10.4 percent of the time in May.

TWO-OUT TROUBLES: Opponents are slashing .354/.413/.495 (35-for-99) with six doubles, one triple, two home runs, and 27 RBI off Rogers with two outs.

- His .908 opponent OPS with two outs is the fourth-highest mark in the AL (min. 100 BF) and the eighth highest in MLB.
- Opponents are slashing .500/.561/.778 (18-for-36) with four doubles and two home runs off Rogers with runners in scoring position and two outs.

ORDER OF OPERATIONS: Rogers has held the opposition to a .208 (25-for-120) batting average the first time through the order... However, they are hitting .299 (32-for-107) the second time through and .305 (18-for-59) the third time around.

- Nine-hole hitters are slashing .385/.429/.500 (10-for-26) with three doubles off Rogers.

MAKING HISTORY: During the 2025 campaign, his 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) was the lowest mark by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), ahead of Dave McNally (1.95 ERA, 1968) and Jim Palmer (2.07 ERA, 1972)...His .180 opponent average (70-for-388), .263 opponent slugging percentage, and .503 opponent OPS were the lowest marks by an Oriole starter (min. 100.0 IP) in franchise history (since 1954), while his .240 opponent on-base percentage ranked second behind McNally (.232 OBP, 1968).

2025 IN REVIEW: Went 9-3 in 2025 with a 1.81 ERA (22 ER/109.2 IP) on 70 hits (6 HR), 29 walks, and two hit batters with 103 strikeouts across 18 starts...Led the Orioles with a career-high 5.5 *Baseball Reference* Wins Above Replacement, the third-highest mark by an Oriole southpaw in franchise history (since 1954).

- His ERA was second lowest in MLB behind TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (1.73), while his opponent average, opponent slugging percentage, and opponent OPS each led all pitchers (min. 100.0 IP).
- On August 1 at Chicago-NL, threw his first career complete game (L, 8.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 8 K), becoming the first Oriole starter to throw a complete game since Dean Kremer (9/23/22 vs. HOU, 9.0 IP)... Became the first Oriole to suffer a loss in a complete game since Chris Tillman (9/14/13 at TOR, 8.0 IP, 6 H, 4 R, 1 HR, 2 BB, 4 K).
