NATIONALS NEWS

SHIPPIN' UP TO BOSTON AS A GAME NOTE TITLE? HOW CLICHÉ.
Following a series win in Baltimore, the Washington Nationals head up I-95 to take on another American League East foe, the Boston Red Sox, for the first of three games from Fenway Park on Monday night.

- Washington took their fourth straight series from the Orioles with a 6-4 win yesterday at Camden Yards...**Luis García Jr.** recorded a three-hit day including a pair of home runs...**Zack Littell** earned his 7th win of the year with 5.0 innings of two-run ball...**PJ Poulin** locked down his third save finishing the last 2.0 innings.
- The Nationals are 26-17 (.605) on the road this season, the third best road record in MLB behind the Dodgers (28-16, .636) and the Brewers (24-14, .632).
- Washington is 32-26 (.552) since April 25 and are 10-3-1 in their last 13 series since May 12.
- Tonight's matchup continues Washington's stretch of 13 games in 13 days that began on Friday in Tampa Bay... Washington's next off day is July 2.

ROSTER MOVES
The Washington Nationals recalled right-handed pitcher **Riley Cornelio** and left-handed pitcher **Carson Palmquist** from Triple-A Rochester and placed left-handed pitchers **Mitchell Parker** (left elbow inflammation) and **Richard Lovelady** (left triceps strain) on the 15-Day Injured List on Monday...Nationals President of Baseball Operations Paul Toboni made the announcements.

- Palmquist, 25, returns for his second stint with the Nationals this season...He worked 3.1 innings of one-run ball with three strikeouts in his start against Philadelphia on June 24.
- Cornelio, 26, returns to the Nationals for his third Major League stint of the year...He struck out 12 and allowed just one run in 7.0 innings over his last three outings for Triple-A Rochester.

WHAT A WEEK, HUH?
Luis García Jr. went 10-for-19 (.526) with six home runs, two doubles, nine RBI, three walks and eight runs scored in six games from June 22-28.

- With his six home runs in his last six games, García Jr. became just the fourth Major Leaguer since the beginning of the 2022 season to hit six homers in a six-game span joining: **Kyle Schwarber** (May 9-15, 2026), **Eugenio Suárez** (July 12-21, 2025) and **Aaron Judge** (Aug. 20-25, 2024).

GOING RIGHT AGAINST LEFT
The Nationals lead Major League Baseball in OPS against left-handed pitching (.772) and rank second in average (.268) and on-base percentage (.343) against southpaws.

- Washington is 16-10 against left-handed starters this year, tied for the fifth best winning percentage in Major League Baseball.

ROTATION NOTES
Washington's starting rotation (regardless of opener) has pitched to a 2.20 ERA (10 ER/41.0 IP) over the last eight games.

- Foster Griffin** has allowed just four earned runs and no more than one run per game over his last five starts, pitching to a 1.15 ERA with 33 strikeouts and just four walks in 31.1 innings.
- Zack Littell** is tied for the Major League lead in wins (6) since May 15...Littell is 6-2 with a 3.92 ERA in nine games (seven starts) over that span...He has allowed two runs or less in seven of those nine outings.

HOMER HAPPY
Since May 6, the Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 75 home runs ahead of the White Sox (71), Phillies (70) and Athletics (69)...Washington ranks second in slugging (.453) and fourth in OPS (.772) over this stretch.

- The Nationals have hit 112 home runs this season, the fourth-most in team history (2005-pres.) through 85 games behind the 2017 Nationals (125 HR), 2019 Nationals (119 HR) and 2016 Nationals (114 HR).

CORNER BATS
Since May 22, Washington's corner infielders **Luis García Jr.** (13 HR, 30 RBI), **Curtis Mead** (9 HR, 20 RBI) and **Jorbit Vivas** (2 HR, 7 RBI) lead Major League Baseball with 24 home runs and 60 RBI...These stats reflect when they are in the game at one of the corner positions (not PH or DH).

- Luis García Jr.'s** 13 homers rank second in Major League Baseball over this span, while Mead's 10 (one as DH) are tied for fourth in the National League.
- In addition, **Luis García Jr.** leads Major League Baseball with 33 RBI since May 22.
- Jorbit Vivas** homered on back-to-back games from June 23-24 for the first time in his career...In his last six games, he is hitting .333 (6-for-18) with two homers, five RBI, two walks and four runs scored.

NAS (H)IM
Nasim Núñez is 17-for-41 (.415) with a double, two triples, seven RBI, five walks, seven stolen bases and seven runs scored over his last 14 games...He has hit safely in 11 of the 14 games and has produced six multi-hit efforts.

- He has reached base safely in 17 of 20 games, hitting .365 (23-for-63) with a .420 on-base percentage (6 BB) and a .460 slugging percentage (2 2B, 2 3B).
- His career-long 15-game on-base streak and nine game hitting streak were the longest such streaks by a Nationals player this season.
- On the season, he leads Major League Baseball with 32 stolen bases and trails only **Trea Turner** (35 in 2017) for the most stolen bases prior to the All-Star break in Nationals history (2005-pres.).

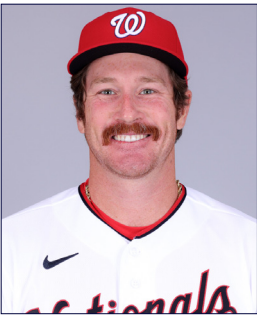

Two-time National League All-Star (2018, 2022) signed with the Nationals on Feb. 11...A veteran of 10 Major League seasons, most recently with the St. Louis Cardinals (2018-25).

- Is ninth in Major League Baseball with 136 starts and is sixth with 809.0 innings pitched since the start of the 2022 season.
- Is 1-2 with a 2.20 ERA (4 ER/16.1 IP) in four career Postseason games (three starts).
- Spent three seasons in Nippon Professional Baseball, pitching for the Yomiuri Giants from 2015-17.
- Participated in the 2018 All-Star Game at Nationals Park.

LAST APPEARANCE

Mikolas tossed 3.1 innings and allowed two runs on five hits...He took a no-decision in the 5-4 loss to Philadelphia on June 24 at Nationals Park.

vs. BOSTON

Mikolas is set to make his fourth career start against Boston...He is 1-1 with a 6.59 ERA (10 ER/13.2 IP) and five strikeouts against the Red Sox.

WHAT HAVE YOU DONE FOR ME LATELY?

Mikolas has pitched to a 3.28 ERA over his last seven outings, including four without allowing a run.

DON'T WALK SIGN

Mikolas has issued just three walks in 35.2 innings across his last seven outings...the 0.76 walks per 9.0 innings ranks first in Major League Baseball and his 5.33 strikeout-to-walk ratio (16 SO/3 BB) ranks sixth in the National League since May 22.

- Went 4-0 with a 1.34 ERA and a .192 opponents' average in six starts from April 23 to May 23.
