TODAY'S TRANSACTION: Selected LHP Joe La Sorsa from AAA-Louisville and optioned him to Louisville.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Is Game 2 (0-1) of a 3-game series vs **Owen Buescher's Brewers** and the second game (0-1) of a 7-day, 6-game homestand that includes an upcoming 3-game series vs the **Diamondbacks**.
- Following Sun's game vs **AZ**, the Reds will embark on a 7-day, 6-game road trip at **Cle** (6/9-6/11) and **Det** (6/13-6/15).
- The Redlegs are coming off a 3-3 road trip at **KC** (2-1) and **Chc** (1-2).

SERIES NOTES: The **Brewers** have won each of the last 11 series, 12 of the last 13 series, and 15 of the last 17 series vs Cin dating back to 2021.

- The Reds on 8/30/24 were swept in a doubleheader vs **Mil** for the first time since 9/5/15 at **Great American Ball Park**...the 14-0 loss to the **Brewers** in 8/30/24 nightcap was Cin's largest margin of defeat since its 18-4 loss at **American Family Field** on 5/4/22.
- Since 7/16/21, **Mil** has won 41 of 56 meetings against Cin, including 23 of 31 contests against the Reds since the beginning of the 2023 season.
- The Reds have lost 30 of 40 games vs **Mil** at **GABP** since 9/24/19.

TJ MAX: OF TJ Friedl went 2-for-3 in yesterday's 3-2 loss vs **Mil**...has hit safely in 11 of his last 13g (.426/.483/.593).

- Had multiple hits in 7 straight games from 5/23-5/30 (15-for-30) and in 9 of 10 games from 5/19-5/30 (20-for-43, .465, 1hr, 3 2B, 1 3B, 10r).
- His 7-game multi-hit streak was the longest by a Red since **Jonathan India's** 8-game run in 2024 (6/22-6/29).
- Began the season with 6 hits over his first 29 at-bats (.207/.258/.207)...since then is slashing .319/.405/.461.
- Among left-handed batters vs right-handed pitchers, his 52 hits is 1 off the Major League pace (3 others)...slashing .329/.410/.481 vs RHP.

WREAKING HAVOC IN THE FIRST: The Reds have scored at least 1 run in the first inning 21 times this season, including last night vs **Mil** (2r, 4h).

- The Reds rank T1st in the majors with 50 runs in the 1st inning (**LAD** 50r, **Wsh** 50r)...this of course includes the 10 runs Cin posted in the opening frame on 5/10 at **Hou**.
- Cin has outscored opponents 50-21 in the first inning and are slashing .296/.380/.453 with 7 home runs.
- Reds pitchers have allowed runs (4r total) in the first inning 3 times over their last 20 games...overall, Cin is holding opponents to a .184/.282/.330 slash line in the opening frame this season.

HOME (RUNS) AWAY FROM HOME: The Redlegs are averaging 4.66 runs per game on the road compared to 4.34 runs per game here in **Cincinnati**...overall during the **Great American Ball Park** era (since 2003), the team has averaged 4.60 runs per game at **GABP** and 4.25 runs per game on the road.

- 5 times in the history of **GABP** has Cin averaged more runs per game on the road than at home (2023, 2013, 2009, 2004, 2003).
- Cin has homered 29 times in 29 games this year at home compared to 33 times in 32 road games.
- 2004 marks the only season during the **GABP** era in which the Reds hit more home runs on the road (102) than at home (92).

ELLY GETS 50: SS Elly De La Cruz in Sun's 7-3 loss at **Chc** belted his 50th career home run...at 23 years, 141 days he became the fifth-youngest Red to reach that milestone.

- Over his last 13 games (since 5/19), the switch-hitting SS is slashing .433/.514/.933 with 4 HR and 12 RBI from the left side.
- 8 of his 12 HR this season have either tied the game or put Cin ahead.
- Is on pace for 31 HR and 45 SB...would become the fourth player in franchise history to join the 30 HR / 30 SB club.

HARD TO SWALLOW: The Reds have lost 11 games this season in which they held a lead, including last night's 3-2 loss vs **Mil**.

- The Reds are 0-24 this year when trailing after 6 innings...their last win in such a scenario came on 9/17/24 vs **Atl** (trailed 5-4 after 6, won 6-5).
- Cin is 0-26 this year when trailing after 7 innings and 0-27 when trailing after 8 innings...their last walkoff win came in the 11th inning on 9/1/24 vs **Mil** (4-3).
- The Reds have 7 comeback wins this season...only the **White Sox** (5) and **Pirates** (5) have fewer.
- The Redlegs are 5-10 in 1-run games (.333) this season and 20-38 (.345) in 1-run games since the beginning of last year.
- Cin's 11 losses when allowing 3 runs or fewer rank 4th-most in majors.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the 3-2 loss on Wed at KC (5.0ip, 7h, 2r/2er, 1bb, 3k, 88TP).

- Has allowed 2 runs or fewer in each of his last 4 starts, and in 8 of 10 overall in 2025 (Reds are 5-5 when he pitches).
- Threw first-pitch strikes to 17 of his 21 batters (81%).
- Allowed 7 hits for the second time this season (also: 4/26 at Col)...had allowed 7 hits in his previous 3 starts combined.

MAY 23 at KC: On 5/23 was activated from the 15-day injured list and started that night vs Chc...did not factor in the decision in the 13-6 loss vs the Cubs (4.0ip, 3h, 2r/2er, 2bb, 2k, 1hr, 83TP)...was on the IL since 5/8 with a right groin strain and missed 2 starts.

- Exited the game with a 4-2 lead.
- Threw 37 pitches in the 4th inning (2h, 2r/2er, 2bb, 1hr)...marked the second time in his career that he fired as many as 37 pitches in an inning (also: 4/16/24 at Sea, 39TP in the 3rd inning).
- His 4th inning base-on-balls to Dansby Swanson marked the first time this season he walked a bottom of the order (7,8,9) batter, and the first time he did it since 8/13/24 vs StL (No. 7 batter Lars Nootbaar in the top of the 5th).

MAY 7 at ATL - INJURED : Exited the 5/7 game at Atl with a right groin injury after 2 warm-up pitches in the top of the 4th inning...had pitched 3.0 shutout innings to that point (2h, 6k, 53TP).

- Struck out all 3 batters he faced in the 2nd inning...was the third time this season he fanned all 3 batters he faced in an inning...has punched out all 3 batters he faced in an inning 17 times, which ranks second-most among all Major League pitchers since 2022, fewer only to Atl's Spencer Strider (22) and ranks sixth-most by a Cin pitcher in the expansion era (since 1961)...*courtesy Elias*.

ON MAY 2: Earned the 6-1 win on 5/2 vs Wsh (6.0ip, 2h, 1r/1er, 2bb, 12k, 1hr, 114TP).

- Collected his fifth quality start of the season.
- Fanned a season-high 12 batters...the only time he struck out more in a game was on 9/20/23 vs Min (14k).
- Marked his 10th career game w/ 10+ strikeouts.
- Struck out all 3 batters he faced in the 2nd inning...has fanned all 3 batters he faced in an inning 16 times, which ranks second-most among all Major League pitchers since 2022, fewer only to Atl's Spencer Strider (22).
- Became the eighth Red since at least 1901 to post an outing of at least 6.0 innings with fewer than 3 hits and 2 walks while striking out at least 12 batters (last: Trevor Bauer, 7/26/20 vs Det).

- Has thrown first-pitch strikes to 71.5% of the batters he's faced (153 of 214), fifth among Major League starters...*league average is 62.7%*
- Has been ahead in the count to 58.9% of his batters (126 of 214)...*league average is 47.3%*
- Among plate apps with at least 3 pitches, 2 of his first 3 offerings have been strikes to 67.5% of the batters he's faced in 2025, 2nd-best in the majors among starting pitchers.
- Has 15 three-pitch strikeouts this season, T8th-most in the majors.

WITH 2 STRIKES: Batters are swinging at his 2-strike pitches 67.0% of the time (fourth-most in the majors)...limiting batters to a .154/.209/.292 with 2 strikes

KEEPIN' IT 100: Has thrown 585 pitches at least 100mph, the most by a starting pitcher in the pitch track era (Jacob deGrom, 2nd, 317).

VS TOP OF THE ORDER: Is holding top of the order batters (1,2,3) to a .173/.244/.307 slash (13-for-75)

- Finished the month of May with a 0.55 ERA, third-lowest ERA by a Reds pitcher (min. 30ip) in a calendar month since earned runs became an official stat in 1912.

- Is the first Reds pitcher to post a 0.55 ERA over a 6-start, single-season span (min. 30ip) since RHP Hunter Greene's 0.48 ERA last year from 6/30-8/3.
- Is the first Reds starting pitcher to open a season with a 1.55 ERA or lower over 9 starts since RHP Johnny Cueto pitched to a 1.25 ERA over his first 9 starts in 2014.
