Quinn Priester has a 2.51 ERA in his last 6 games/3 starts (32.1ip, 9er) and is holding opponents to a .191 AVG in this stretch (22-for-115, 10bb, 19k).

Patrick Star

Chad Patrick, who starts tomorrow, has a 2.84 ERA this season, which is ninth in the National League and first among qualifying MLB rookies.

Born Again Christian

In his last 16 games. Christian Yelich is batting .377 (23-for-61) with 6 HR and 15 RBI.....during this stretch, he has a .449 OBP/.689 SLG/1.138 OPS.

We Sal-ute You!

In his last 21 games, **Sal Frelick** is batting .329 (26-for-79) with 2 HR and 11 RBI.....during this stretch, he has a .369 OBP/.443 SLG/.812 OPS.

Rated Rookie

Caleb Durbin has 22 RBI this season. trailing only the Marlins' Liam Hicks [24] among National League rookies.

U Da Man!

Abner Uribe is unscored upon in 27 of his 31 appearances this season. including 19 of his last 20 outings and 6 in a row.....Uribe ranks among NL relief leaders in ERA (T4th, 1.48) and strikeouts (5th, 41).

Whipper Snapper

Nick Mears currently ranks second among National League relievers and fourth among Major League relievers in WHIP (0.69).

Fast Times

The Brewers have 85 stolen bases this season, marking the most in the National League and trailing only the Rays (93) in the majors.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is game 5 (1-3) of a 10-game homestand vs. San Diego (1-2), Atlanta (D-1) and St. Louis (4g)....is the team's longest homestand of the season....after an off day next Monday, the team takes a 6-game trip to Chicago-NL (3g) and Minnesota (3g).

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without Bob Uecker on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970)....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: LHP Nestor Cortes (left elbow), LHP Robert Gasser (left elbow), OF Garrett Mitchell (left oblique), OF Blake Perkins (right shin), LHP Connor Thomas (left elbow) and RHP Brandon Woodruff (right shoulder) are on the injured ...Cortes, Gasser, Perkins and Thomas are on the 60-day injured list.

IN THE STANDINGS [84 days]: The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: FIRST: 10*, SECOND: 19, THIRD: 41, FOURTH: 11, FIFTH: 3....the Brewers are currently in third place, trailing the first-place Cubs by 5.5 games and second-place Cardinals by 1.5 games (*9 days tied for first from 3/18-3/26 before playing a game).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The team is 11-9-1 in series play. Game 1: 11-11, Game 2: 11-10, Game 3: 11-10, Game 4: 2-1 Sweep Wins [2]: vs. BOS (3g, 5/26-5/28) and at PHI (3g, 5/30-6/1) Sweep Losses [1]: at NYY (3g, 3/27-3/30)

AT HOME: The team is 19-13 at home, going 7-3-0 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The team is 16-19 on the road, going 4-6-1 in series play.....the Brewers are 6-1 in their last 7 road games.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

<u>COACHES</u>: Returning from 2024 is associate manager **Rickie Weeks** (2nd season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach Jim Henderson (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (2nd season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (4th season), assistant coach Daniel de Mondesert (2nd season), infield coach Matt Erickson (2nd season) and third base coach Jason Lane (10th season/5th in current role)....first base coach **Julio Borbón**, lead hitting coach **Al LeBoeuf** and hitting coach **Eric Theisen** are all in their first seasons on the staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made eight replay challenges this season, going 5-3....their last challenge (won) came on 5/28 vs. Boston as an out call at second base involving Sal Frelick was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times in the last seven seasons (2018-24) and won the NL Central in four of the last seven, three of four, and two in a row.....Milwaukee is one of five teams to make the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons, joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees [6].....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight straight seasons (2017-24), missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24)....this does not include 2020.....the Brewers have 701 wins since 2017 (6th in MLB/3rd in National League).

PRIESTER AT A GLANCE: Quinn Priester, 24, will make his 12th appearance and eighth start.....he last pitched last Wednesday at Cincinnati in relief and earned a 9-1 win (5ip, 2h, 1r, 1er, 3bb, 4k, 1wp, 88 pitches).....the team is 1-6 in his starts.....he has 1 quality start.....opponents are batting .228 (47-for-206, 6hr).....he is 1-2 with a 2.83 ERA as a starter (35ip, 11er) and 2-0 with a 5.66 ERA in relief (20.2ip, 13er).....Priester was acquired from Boston on April 7 in exchange for OF Yophery Rodriguez, a Competitive Balance Round A selection and a player to be named [RHP John Holobetz on May 5].....he began the season at Triple-A Worcester, where he made his only appearance in a start on 4/3 at Jacksonville.

LAST SEASON: Priester went 3-6 with a 4.71 ERA in 11 games/7 starts with Pittsburgh (10g/6gs) and Boston (1gs).....his teams went 1-6 in his starts.....he had 2 quality starts.... opponents batted .277 [56-for-202, 7hr].....he went 1-5 with a 4.42 ERA as a starter [36.2ip, 18er] and 2-1 with a 5.54 ERA as a reliever [13ip, 8er].....Priester was traded by Pittsburgh to Boston on 7/29/24 in exchange for INF/OF Nick Yorke.

CAREER: Is 9-11 with a 5.39 ERA in 32 games/22 starts (155.1ip, 93er) while pitching for Pittsburgh (2023-24), Boston (2024) and Milwaukee (2025).....has gone 4-10 with a 5.16 ERA as a starter (111.2ip, 64er) and 5-1 with a 5.98 ERA as a reliever (43.2ip, 29er).....Priester was selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (18th overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Cary-Grove (II.) High School

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Priester has gone 26-17 with a 3.61 ERA in 87 games/84 starts while pitching in the Pittsburgh (2019-24) and Boston (2024-25) organizations (408.2ip, 361h, 188r, 164er, 149bb, 428k, 27hr).....he has held opponents to a .235 batting average.....he was a 2023 International League All-Star and Triple-A Indianapolis Pitcher of the Year.....he was named Pirates Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2022.....he was selected to the All-Star Futures Game in 2021.....he was a 2021 East League All-Star and High-A East League Pitcher of the Year.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 2-2 with a 5.05 ERA in 7 games/4 starts (35.2ip, 20er).....is 1-1 with a 5.03 ERA in 4 games/2 starts this season (19.2ip, 11er).
