PITTSBURGH PIRATES (25-29) vs. DETROIT TIGERS (26-27)

May 29, 2024 at Comerica Park, Detroit, MI – 12:40 EDT – GAME #55 & 56/ROAD #28 & 29 RHP JARED JONES (3-4, 3.05 ERA) & RHP PAUL SKENES (1-0, 2.25 ERA) vs. LHP TARIK SKUBAL (6-1, 2.25 ERA) & TBA

THE PIRATES:...were rained out yesterday...Went 3-3 on their homestand against San Francisco (1-2) and Atlanta (2-1)...Scored a season-high 11 runs Friday night...Have played in 13 games decided by one or two runs in their last 22 contests...Have played in 19 one-run games, which are the second-most in MLB behind the Cubs (21)...Are tied

with the Phillies, Cubs, Guardians and Mariners for the most wins (10) in one-run games in all of MLB...Have gone 5-2 in extra innings; the third-most wins in MLB behind the Guardians and Marlins with six apiece...Have gone 15-0 this season when recording 10-plus hits; the only undefeated team in the Majors in such games and a club record for the longest such streak to start a season, surpassing the 1939 club that started 14-0 when recording 10-plus hits to start the season.

LET'S PLAY TWO: Today the Pirates and Tigers will play a doubleheader for the third time in Detroit...The Pirates split their most recent doubleheader at Comerica Park on April 21, 2021...Pittsburgh also swept the Tigers on April 1, 2018...The Pirates played two doubleheaders in 2023, sweeping the Nationals on the road on April 29, while splitting against the Reds at PNC Park on August 13.

WE WENT TO JARED: Jared Jones will make the 11th start of his big league career in game one of today's doubleheader...Jones comes into today ranked second among all National League rookies with 68 strikeouts (Los Angeles' Yoshinobu Yamamoto leads all NL rookies with 69 strikeouts)...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, that's also the second-most strikeouts by a Pirate after a pitcher's first 10 Major League starts since 1893...Jose DeLeon is first with 85 in 1983 while Cy Blanton ranks third with 62 in 1934-35.

KEEPING UP WITH THE JONES': Jared Jones has posted a 0.97 WHIP and a 10.37 strikeouts per 9.0 innings rate through 10 career starts in 59.0 innings...According to StatsPerform, he is the third pitcher to debut in the modern era with a sub-1.00 WHIP and a strikeouts per 9.0 innings higher than 10.0 through 10 career starts (minimum 20.0 innings pitched), joining Masahiro Tanaka of the New York Yankees and Jose DeLeon of the Pirates.

PAUL GETS THE CALL IN GAME TWO: Paul Skenes will make the fourth start of his big league career in game two of today's doubleheader...Skenes has allowed one run in a combined 12.0 innings in his last two starts...Skenes, who is celebrating his 22nd birthday today, earned the first win of his big league career in his start at Wrigley Field on May 17, where he struck out each of the first seven batters he faced while not allowing a hit in 6.0 shutout innings...Skenes became the first pitcher in MLB history to have a start where he struck out the first seven batters or more and finished with zero hits allowed.

CLOSING IN ON ANOTHER MILESTONE: Andrew McCutchen comes into today one hit shy of 1600 as a member of the Pirates, which ranks 12th all-time in team history...Since May 11, McCutchen ranks 11th among all National League players in batting (.321), ninth in slugging (.554), tied for fourth in runs scored (12), fifth in OPS (.969) and ninth in OBP (.415).

NICKY G: Nick Gonzales has eight games with at least one hit and one RBI since making his season debut on May 10 (16 total games)...

According to StatsPerform, he is tied with Eddie Rosario for the second-most such games in the National League in that span and trails San Francisco's Heliot Ramos (nine) for the league lead.

<u>DIALING LONG DISTANCE:</u> The Pirates have hit 56.0 percent of their home runs this season after getting a first-pitch strike...According to StatsPerform, that's the highest percentage in MLB...In the pitch tracking era (since 1988), no team has hit higher than 51.1 percent after being in an 0-1 count.

LET'S GET IT STARTED: The Pirates have played in 54 games this season and have 27 quality starts, which are tied for the fourth-most in MLB and tied for the second-most in the National League behind the Phillies (32)...Pittsburgh already has more than half the number of quality starts the team had in 162 games in 2023 (53 quality starts).
