### Sean Murphy

Atlanta's catcher doubled home two runs in the sixth inning last night, his 39th and 40th RBI of the season.

In doing so, he matched Javy López (1998) for the most RBI by a Braves primary catcher through the club's first 60 games in a season, since RBI became official in 1920.

Murphy has already driven in 60% of the runs he did last season, when he tallied a career-most 66 RBI in 148 games. He is on pace for 108 RBI on the year.

Murphy has compiled 2.8 fWAR this season, most by a catcher in baseball.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Braves and Mets tonight continue a three-game series with what is the fifth of 13 games between the teams this season...The two will next meet from August 11-13, playing a four-game set at Citi Field in Queens.

*A* Atlanta rallied from a three-run deficit to beat New York, 6-4, last night and move to 3-1 in four games with the Mets this season.

*A* The Braves went 10-9 against the Mets last season, taking the season set from their N.L. East rivals for the fifth consecutive season...They also went 10-9 in 2021, 7-3 in 2020, 11-8 in 2019 and 13-6 in 2018...Since the start of the 2018 season, Atlanta is 54-36 (.600) against New York overall.

*A* The Braves have won nine of the last 11 games with New York dating to last season, outscoring the Mets 64-36 (+28) over the stretch...Atlanta is 7-1 against New York here at Truist Park in that span.

*A* Atlanta and New York tied atop the N.L. East with identical 101-61 records last season, with the Braves winning the title based on the head-to-head tiebreaker...The Braves were a season-worst 10.5 games behind the first-place Mets on June 1...From that date through the end of the season, Atlanta played to a 78-34 (.696) record, the best mark in baseball...New York went 67-44 (.604), the sixth-best mark in the majors.

*A* RH Charlie Morton is set to make his second start of the season against New York, and his 20th career appearance versus the Mets...The 6-foot-5, 235-pound right-hander allowed six hits and four runs over 5.1 innings on May 1 at Citi Field to take the loss...Morton is 4-6 with a 3.82 ERA (43 ER/101.1 IP) in his career against New York, fanning 100.

*A* RH Max Scherzer has faced Atlanta more than any other team in his career, making 31 total appearances and 29 starts against the Braves...The 6-foot-3, 215-pound native of St. Louis, MO, is 13-10 with a 3.77 ERA (77 ER/183.2 IP) in his career versus Atlanta, striking out 217.

**WIN:** Atlanta erased a three-run deficit to rally and beat New York, 6-4, last night...The Braves improved to 13-5 (.722) against N.L. East opponents with the win.

*A* The Braves have 36 wins through their first 60 games this season...Since 2000, it is their fourth-best mark through 60 decisions, following 2003: 41-19 (.683), 2000: 39-21 (.650) and 2013: 37-23 (.617)...They went on to win the National League East in each of those seasons.

*A* The win marked Atlanta's second straight come-from-behind win after also doing so Sunday at Arizona...The Braves improved to 13-24 (.361) when trailing at any point this season, the 11th-best record in baseball.

*A* The Braves have won back-to-back home games, and will look to tie their season-long winning streak here at Truist Park with a win tonight.

**BRIAN SNITKER WINS:** Atlanta's win last night was the 578th of Brian Snitker's managerial career, and his next win will tie him with George Stallings for the third-most wins by a manager in franchise history.

*A* Stallings managed the Braves to a 579-597-25 record in 1,201 games at the helm from 1913 to 1920, including a World Series title in 1914.

*A* Snitker and Stallings trail just Frank Selee (1,004 wins) and Bobby Cox (2,149 wins) on the franchise leaderboard.

*A* Snitker became the fifth manager in franchise history to skipper 1,000 games on April 6 earlier this season, joining Cox (3,860), Selee (1,677), Stallings (1,201) and Bill McKechnie (1,235).

*A* Snitker has compiled a 578-475 (.549) record as manager of the Braves, winning five consecutive N.L. East titles and the World Series in 2021...Since taking over for Atlanta on May 17, 2016, Snitker's 578 wins stand as fourth most for any manager in baseball...The Dodgers' Dave Roberts (672) and Guardians' Terry Francona (601) rank first and second, respectively, while the Rays's Kevin Cash (593) sits third.

*A* Atlanta's 23 postseason wins since Snitker took over in 2016 are third most in baseball, trailing just the Astros (53) and Dodgers (45).

*A* Research courtesy the Elias Sports Bureau.

**BULLPEN:** Three Atlanta relievers combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings last night and the Braves' bullpen has not allowed a run since May 30 at Oakland, a scoreless streak of five games and 16.0 innings...The club is 4-1 in that span.

*A* That scoreless stretch is the longest active in the majors by both games and innings, and the Braves' longest this season in both regards.

*A* The Braves' bullpen last posted five straight scoreless games from August 13-16, 2022, in contests against the Miami Marlins (3 games) and New York Mets (2 games)...The team hasn't done it in six consecutive games since 2019.

*A* By innings, the club last posted a longer scoreless streak from October 1-4, 2022, also against the Mets (2 games) and Marlins (2 games)...That streak spanned 16.2 innings.

*A* Every MLB club, except for Atlanta, has allowed at least one run in relief this month.

*A* Since the start of last season, Atlanta's 2.92 bullpen ERA against New York is third-best among the Mets' N.L. opponents...Only Milwaukee (2.29) and Chicago (2.45) have been better.

*A* The Atlanta bullpen pitched to a 4.11 ERA (90 ER/197.0 IP) prior to the start of its current streak, ranking 18th in the majors...Its current scoreless run has lowered the collective ERA to 3.80 (90 ER/213.0 IP) for the season, 12th best in baseball.

#### Today's Game

- A* Set to make his 12th start of the season and second against New York.
- A* Struck out nine hitters while scattering six hits, three runs, and two walks over 7.0 innings in his last start against Arizona.
- A* Became the sixth pitcher in franchise history to pitch at least 6.0 innings and strikeout nine or more in an outing at age 39 or older.
  - A* Passed R.A. Dickey and Hall-of-Famer Cy Young with three such games.
  - A* Trails Hall-of-Famers Phil Niekro (10), John Smoltz (8), and Warren Spahn (4).
- A* Morton has either won or lost each of his starts this season...His 11 consecutive games with a decision is the longest active streak in 2023.
- A* Morton has struck out 321 hitters with his curveball since the beginning of the 2020; the most in the majors.
  - A* During that span hitters are missing on 53.1% of curveballs thrown, the second highest rate in the majors...The MLB average is 11.6% (among QS).
  - A* Over the last two seasons he has thrown his curve on 40.2% of pitches, also the most in baseball among qualified starters.
  - A* Utilizing his curveball on 46.3% of pitches thrown this season.
- A* Morton's 976 strikeouts since the 2018 season are the fourth most in baseball.
  - A* Prior to the 2018 season, Morton threw his curveball on 21.3% of pitches throughout his career.
  - A* Since the beginning of 2018 he has thrown his curve on 36.2% of pitches.
- A* Enters play with only 20% of balls put in play against him registering as line drives this season.
  - A* Tied for the second lowest mark in the National League.
- A* Hitters are registering a .345 batting average on balls in play against Morton in '23.
  - A* The MLB BABIP this season is .301 for qualified starters.
  - A* Batters are hitting 39.0% of balls 95 mph or higher against Morton while the MLB average for qualified starters is 39.5%.
- A* In his age 39 season, Morton is the sixth-oldest active pitcher in the majors.

#### 2023 Recap

- A* Struck out 10 hitters over 6.2 scoreless innings in his win against Texas on May 15.
  - A* Has now struckout at least 10 hitters in six games since turning 38, passing Hall-of-Famer Cy Young for the ninth most such games dating to 1901.
  - A* Morton is the first player with at least six games of 10 or more strikeouts at his age since Hall-of-Famers Randy Johnson and John Smoltz.
- A* Made his first start of the season against St. Louis.
  - A* Only struck out one hitter through 5.1 innings pitched against the Cardinals, marking just the ninth time in his career Morton pitched at least 5.0 frames while failing to record at least two punchouts and the first since June 5, 2015 against Pittsburgh.
- A* Struck out San Diego's Jake Croneworth on April 8 to record his 1,700th career punchout.
  - A* Is one of 16 active pitchers in baseball with as many strikeouts.

#### 2022 Recap

- A* Made 31 starts during his 15th major league season and went 9-6 with a 4.34 ERA (83 ER/172.0 IP) and 205 strikeouts...Compiled 1.6 bWAR on the year.
  - A* Morton's 205 strikeouts last season were fifth most in the National League, and he is one of just three pitchers in Atlanta franchise history to log at least 200 strikeouts in multiple seasons...He struck out 216 last year...Hall-of-Famers John Smoltz (five seasons) and Phil Niekro (three seasons) were the only others to do so
- A* With his start on May 25, became the 10th active pitcher in the majors to make 300 career starts.
  - A* Over his first 150 career starts, from his debut through August 20, 2015, Morton compiled a 44-65 record and a 4.46 ERA...In his next 150 starts, he went 66-33 with a 3.61 ERA.

#### Career Recap

- A* A 15-year major league veteran, has compiled a 121-107 record and a 4.02 ERA (831 ER/1861.2 IP) across 334 games, 333 starts...Has fanned 1,769 and pitched a pair of shutouts.
  - A* Has pitched for Atlanta (2008, '21-22), Pittsburgh (2009-15), Philadelphia (2016), Houston (2017-18) and Tampa Bay (2019-20).
  - A* Is a two-time All-Star (2018 & 2019) and won the 2017 World Series while with Houston and 2021 World Series with Atlanta.

### Ronald Acuña Jr. • OF • 6-0 • 205 • 25 yrs • #13

• **MLB Ranks:** Hard-hit balls (1st, 111), stolen bases (2nd, 26), runs (2nd, 52), total bases (3rd, 134), extra-base hits (T-3rd, 30), batting average (4th, .329), hits (4th, 79), OPS (4th .962), multi-hit games (T-4th 24), fWAR (5th, 2.9) on-base percentage (6th, .404), slugging percentage (6th .558), doubles (T-10th, 17).  
• Has reached base safely 110 times and in 54 of 60 games this season; tied for the most in the majors...Ranks second to Los Angeles' Freddie Freeman in times on base (113)... Over the last 20 seasons, Freeman (55 in 2018) is the only Brave to reach base safely in more games through the club's first 60 contests.  
• Through Tues., he's on-pace for 32 home runs and 70 stolen bases....no player in MLB history has ever recorded 30+ home runs and 60+ stolen bases within a single-season.  
• Currently leads the N.L. in stolen bases and ranks second to Freeman in OPS (.967)... Seeking to become the third player since integration in 1947 to lead their league in both categories...He'd join: Willie Mays, twice (1957-58) and Rickey Henderson (1990).  
• Collected three hits and stole a pair of bases, Sunday at Arizona...Marked his eighth three-hit game of the season; one shy of the major league lead.  
• His 26 stolen bases are the most by a Brave through 59 team games since Otis Nixon, 32, in 1991...Nixon went on to set the Braves Modern Era (since 1900) single-season stolen base record that year, finishing with 72.  
• Hit his 12th home run of the season, Saturday at Arizona...Per Statcast, Saturday's blast traveled 464 ft.; his fifth HR this season of more than 450 ft. -- no other player has more than three...Each of his last 10 HR have gone 420+ ft.; the longest such streak, by any player, since Statcast began tracking in 2015...Owns five home runs of 450+ feet this season; the single-season record, since 2015, is 10 (Giancarlo Stanton in '17).  
• Singled to lead off the game, Friday at Arizona...Marked the 30th time he's reached base safely to lead off a game this season (25 hits, four walks, one HBP)...He's come around to score 17 times... The Braves have gone 17-8 (.680) when he records at least one hit in the first inning...Singled twice in the opening frame, May 28 vs. Philadelphia.  
• Owns a .464 batting average (26-for-56) in the first inning...Over the last 50 seasons, the highest single-season first inning average (min. 100 plate app.) belongs to Colorado's Larry Walker, .453 (43-for-95) in 1999...The Braves record for hits is 49 -- set by Marquis Grissom in 1996 and matched by Chipper Jones in 1998.

• **NL Ranks:** RBI (T-9th, 39), home runs (10th, 13), total bases (10th, 111).  
• Among qualified second basemen, ranks second in home runs (13) and total bases (111); third in RBI (39) and extra-base hits (25); seventh in OPS (.791).  
• Homered for the second consecutive game, Tuesday vs. New York (NL)...His 13 home runs are one shy of St. Louis' Nolan Gorman for the most among primary second basemen this season... Historically speaking, it's the third instance of a Braves primary middle-infielder recording 13-or-more home runs within the club's first 60 games... Albies did so previously, with 14 in 2018...Prior to Albies, the lone player to do so was Hall of Famer Rogers Hornsby for the 1928 Boston Braves (14).  
• Hit a two-run home run, his 12th of the season, as part of a four-hit afternoon, Sunday at Arizona...He's the only Brave with multiple four-hit games this season, also: May 3 at Miami...Since 2000, he is one of three Braves to record four-or-more hits, homer and steal a base within a single-game on multiple occasions, (also: June 30, 2021 vs. NYM), joining Freddie Freeman (3x) and Chipper Jones (twice).  
• Of his 13 home runs, five have come against left-handed pitching...Hit 12 of 44 total home runs (27%) vs. LHP from 2020-22.  
• His .424 batting average (28-for-66) vs. LHP ranks second among all qualifiers this season, trailing Toronto's Matt Chapman (.439)...His 28 hits off southpaws lead MLB.  
• Career .337/.363/.580 hitter vs. LHP in 772 plate appearances...His .337 average is the highest among active players, while his .580 SLG ranks sixth (min. 500 PA).  
• Since his first full season in 2018, leads all second basemen in RBI (357) and extra-base hits (281), while ranking third in home runs (105) and doubles (155), fourth in runs scored (393) and in hits (671) -- minimum 500 games played at second base.
