## MILWAUKEE BREWERS (58-42) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (38-61)

July 27, 2021 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA -- GAME #98/HOME #48

LHP BRETT ANDERSON (2-5, 4.26 ERA) vs. RHP LUIS OVIEDO (1-1, 7.23 ERA)

**THE PIRATES...** had the day off yesterday after returning home from a six-game road trip to Arizona (0-3) and San Francisco (2-1)...Collected a season-high 16 hits in their 10-2 win in San Francisco Saturday night...Have won two of their last three games after losing four in a row...Have gone 9-8 in their last 17 games after losing six in a row...Have scored a season-high 11 runs twice; 7/5 vs. Atlanta and 6/18 vs. Cleveland...Have won a season-high three straight games on four occasions.

**PIRATES AT THE PLATE:** The Bucs are hitting .299 (109-for-365) in their last 10 games while collecting 10 or more hits eight times...Their .293 batting average since the 4th of July is the highest in all of MLB...The Pirates also rank first among all Major League teams with a .278 batting average and a .349 on-base percentage during the month of July.

**LOVE THE HOME COOKIN':** The Pirates have produced a .333 batting average in their last six games played at PNC Park, going 72-for-216 with 14 doubles, eight home runs and a .917 OPS...They have banged out 10 or more hits in four straight home games and five times in their last six...The Pirates have gone 3-1-1 in their last five series played at PNC Park.

**BUCS AND BREW CREW:** The Pirates and Brewers are meeting this week for the fourth of six times this season...The Bucs have lost six of the last seven games played in the series after taking two-of-three in Milwaukee April 16-18 and are 3-7 overall this season...Beginning tonight the Bucs and Crew are scheduled to play each other nine times in the next 20 days.

**STRIKING NUMBERS:** After matching their season high with 14 strikeouts Friday night in San Francisco, the Bucco pitching staff punched out 12 batters Saturday night and 11 more Sunday afternoon...The pitching staff has now struck out at least 10 batters in five straight games (57 K's total in 42.0ip).

**BIG BEN:** In seven games against the Brewers this season, **Ben Gamel** has gone 9-for-22 (.409) with three doubles and three solo home runs...Gamel is hitting .318 (21-for-66) with four homers and 10 RBI in 20 games this month and he has hit safely in 14 of his last 17 starts, going 20-for-63 (.317) with a .411 on-base percentage and a .998 OPS.

**CENTER OF ATTENTION:** All-Star outfielder **Bryan Reynolds** connected off Johnny Cueto Friday night for his team-leading 18th home run - 17 of which have come while playing center field...Reynolds leads all National league center fielders with 17 home runs and has hit the second-most in the Majors behind Texas' Adolis Garcia (18)...Since becoming the everyday center fielder on April 22, Reynolds' 91 hits from that position are tops in the N.L. and second in MLB behind Mullins (96).

**THE RAP ON REYNOLDS:** **Bryan Reynolds** has produced four straight multi-hit games (9-for-17) and enters tonight's action ranked fifth in the N.L. in batting (.312) and fifth in OPS (.922)...He has hit safely in seven straight games (13-for-32, .406) and in 11 of his last 12 (19-for-50, .380)...B-Rey's .528 slugging percentage and .922 OPS are tops among all switch hitters.

**PLAYING THE FIELD:** Dating back to the action on May 9, the Pirates and Athletics have made the fewest amount of errors in MLB...In that time, the Bucco defense has committed 25 errors in 67 games and 2326 chances (.989 fielding pct).

**THE BIG NOGOWSKI:** **John Nogowski** connected off Taylor Widener for his first big league home run last Tuesday night in Arizona...Nogo has hit safely in 12 of his 16 games with the Pirates (23-for-62, .371)...He has also hit safely in all six of his games at PNC Park since joining the Pirates (12-for-26, .462) and his 23 hits since making his Pirates debut on 7/5 are tied for the fifth-most in the Majors...Nogowski's .371 batting average in July is the third-highest in the big leagues.

**CHASEN DOWN GAMES:** Since he made his season debut with Pirates on 5/12, **Chasen Shreve** has made a team-leading 30 appearances - only five pitchers in the N.L. have made more in that time...Shreve has been scored upon in just four of his 30 appearances and has posted a 1.42 ERA (19.0ip/3er) in his last 20...Chasen has held left-handed hitters to a .162 batting average this season, limiting them to two hits in their last 20 at bats.

**STRATTON HIS STUFF:** **Chris Stratton** led all National League relief pitchers in innings pitched (30.0) last season...He picked up the win Friday night in San Francisco and enters today's action ranked third among all Major League relievers with 52.1ip...Dating back to May 1, Stratton has gone 2-0 with a 1.38 ERA (39.0ip/6er) and 38 strikeouts in his 30 appearances.

**STEADY AT SHORT:** **Kevin Newman** leads all Major League shortstops with a .997 fielding percentage, having made just one error in 290 total chances...He began this season with 76 consecutive errorless games, a National League record to start a season and a club record for a shortstop at any point in a season.

**BITS ON BEDNAR:** Bucco righthander **David Bednar** leads all National League rookie relief pitchers in appearances (43) and trails only Kansas City's Jake Brentz (48) among all big league rookies...Bednar has made nine straight scoreless outings (9.0ip) and has been scored upon just once in his last 15 appearances (14.0ip/1er)...In addition, he has made 14 consecutive scoreless appearances at PNC Park (11.2ip) and has a 1.35 ERA (20.0ip/3er) at home this season.
