### TODAY'S GAME:

- Is Game 2 (1-0) of a 3-game series vs **Ian Kraft's Royals** and the second game (1-0) of a 7-day, 6-game road trip that includes an upcoming weekend series at **Wrigley Field**.
- Following Sun afternoon's affair in **Chicago**, the Reds will return home to **Great American Ball Park** for a 6-game homestand vs the **Brewers** (6/2-6/4) and **Diamondbacks** (6/6-6/8).
- The Reds are coming off a brief 3-game homestand vs **Chc** (1-2).

### SERIES NOTES:

- The Reds are 18-21 all-time vs **KC**, including 12-7 here at **Kauffman Stadium** and 4-11 at **Great American Ball Park**.
- The **Royals** swept the Reds last season in a 3-game series at **GABP** (8/16-8/18)...it was **KC's** first ever 3-game sweep in **Cincinnati** and the first **Royals'** 3-game sweep of the Reds since 6/12-6/14, 2009 in **Kansas City**...of the 13 **Reds/Royals** series, 8 have resulted in sweeps.
- The Reds' first appearance at **Kauffman Stadium**, a 3-game sweep here in **June 1999**, was their first appearance in **KC** since the **Red Stockings** and **Cowboys** of the **American Association** met in 1889.
- The first game of that **June 1999** series was postponed because of a power failure...the Reds swept the next day's doubleheader, 9-4 and 7-4 in 10 innings, before winning the series finale, 14-3...was the first doubleheader in interleague history.

**WREAKING HAVOC IN THE FIRST:** The Reds have scored at least 1 run in the first inning 19 times this season, including in each of the last 4 games (3r in the 1st on Fri, 2r in the 1st on Sat, 4r in the 1st on Sun, 1r in the 1st yesterday).

- The Reds lead the majors with 46 runs in the 1st inning...this of course includes the 10 runs Cin posted in the opening frame on 5/10 at **Hou**.
- Cin has outscored opponents 46-21 in the first inning and are slashing .294/.383/.4425 with 6 home runs.
- Reds pitchers have allowed runs (4r total) in the first inning 3 times over their last 14 games...overall, Cin is holding opponents to a .182/.269/.339 slash line in the opening frame this season.

**REDS BATTING:** Through the Reds' first 16 games (3/27-4/13), Cin batters slashed .200/.272/.320 and averaged 3.88 runs per game...in 39 games since then (4/15-5/26), the club ranks fifth in the majors with a .265 AVG, third with a .341 OBP, eighth with a .426 SLG, and seventh by averaging 4.95 runs per game.

**HOME (RUNS) AWAY FROM HOME:** The Redlegs are averaging 4.85 runs per game on the road compared to 4.43 runs per game back home in **Cincinnati**...overall during the **Great American Ball Park** era (since 2003), the team has averaged 4.60 runs per game at **GABP** and 4.26 runs per game on the road.

- 5 times in the history of **GABP** has Cin averaged more runs per game on the road than at home (2023, 2013, 2009, 2004, 2003).
- Cin has homered 29 times in 28 games this year at home compared to 26 times in 27 road games.
- 2004 marks the only season during the **GABP** era in which the Reds hit more home runs on the road (102) than at home (92).

**NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM:** The Reds have not been swept in any of their first 18 series this season, including this one (5-11-1).

- It marks Cin's longest streak of consecutive series without being swept to begin a season since 2012, when it went 22 straight series before getting broomed in a 3-game set from 6/18-6/20 at **Cle**.

**TJ MAX: OF TJ Friedl** has multiple hits in each of his last 4 games (8-for-18) and in 6 of his last 7 games (13-for-31, 3 2B, 1 3B).

- Began the season with 6 hits over his first 29 at-bats (.207/.258/.207)...since then is slashing .304/.390/.440.
- Ranks among Major League leaders batting leadoff (min. 40g) in AVG (.289, 4th), OBP (.372 2nd), SLG (.406, 7th), OPS (.778, 6th), hits (57, 6th), and times on base (84, T4th).

**REHABBERS:** Updates on the following Reds who are currently on rehabilitation assignments in the club's minor league system:

- INF Christian Encarnacion-Strand** (low back inflammation) began his rehab assignment Thu (5/22) and has made 3 apps (3-for-10, 2 2B, 2rbi, 1bb, 4k).
- OF Jake Fraley** (left calf tenderness) began his rehabilitation assignment Sat for Louisville and has made 2 apps (1-for-8, 1hr, 1k).

**ELLY MAKING HISTORY:** **SS Elly De La Cruz** on Fri vs **Chc** collected his 300th career hit...at 23 years, 132 days, became the fifth-youngest Red among those who debuted since 1900 to produce 300 hits (*courtesy Elias*).

- De La Cruz** is the fastest Major Leaguer by appearance (310g) since **RBI** became an official stat in 1920 to reach 300 hits (300), 150 RBI (153), and 100 stolen bases (118) for his career, surpassing **Fla's Hanley Ramirez** (328g, 2005-2008)...(*courtesy Elias*).
- On 5/11 at **Hou** appeared in his 300th career game, becoming the first Major Leaguer since 1900 with at least 115 extra-base hits and 115 stolen bases through his first 300 career games (*courtesy Elias*).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered the 5-3 loss at Pit on 5/21 (5.0ip, 5h, 2r/2er, 4bb, 3k, 102TP).

- After opening the season 5-0, this was his third loss in 5 outings and 4 decisions.
- Allowed a season-high 4 walks for the 10th time in his career.
- Did not allow a home run for the first time in 7 apps.

**MAY 16 vs CLE:** Earned the 5-4 victory on Fri vs Cle (5.0ip, 3h, 3r/3er, 3bb, 4k, 1hr, 90TP).

- Was his fifth win in 9 starts.

**MAY 10 at HOU:** Didn't factor in the 13-9 victory at Hou on 5/10 (2.1ip, 9h, 7r/7er, 1bb, 1k, 1hr, 51TP)...was staked to 10-0 and 12-1 leads but couldn't get out of the 3rd inning.

- Was his shortest start since pitching 0.2 inning on 9/28/21 vs Cle (3h, 3r/3er, 1bb, 14TP).
- Was the first time allowing 7 or more runs in a game since 6/11/24 vs NYY (5.2ip, 7h, 7r/6er, 1bb, 6k, 1hr, 1hb).

**APRIL 11 vs PIT:** Earned the victory in the 5-3 win vs Pit on 4/11 (5.0ip, 2h, 3r/3er, 3bb, 3k, 88TP).

- Carried no-hit bid into the 5th inning before allowing a 1-out double to Tommy Pham...marked the fourth-longest no-hit bid of his Major League career.
- Became the 11th Reds pitcher since 1900 to win each of his first 3 pitching appearances with the club, the first since teammate Andrew Abbott in 2023 (*courtesy Elias*).
- Got off to a 3-0 start for the first time in his career.

**LEAD SINGER:** Made his Reds debut in the 14-3 win vs Tex, on 3/31 and allowed just 1 hit and 2 walks over 7.0 scoreless innings (8k).

- Became the first Reds pitcher since 1900 to post a start of at least 7.0 scoreless innings with 1 hit or fewer in his team debut (*courtesy Elias*).
- Became the first Cin pitcher with a scoreless start of at least 7.0 innings in his Reds debut since RHP Tom Seaver (9ip) on 6/18/77 at Mon.
- Was his 11th career scoreless start of at least 7.0 innings (last: 7/26/24 for KC vs Chc).

**2 STRIKE HOMERS:** Has allowed 15 home runs with 2 strikes on batters since 2024, T2nd most in the majors (4 this season).

**ANSWERS THE CALL:** Since his 2020 debut his 134 starts rank 16th in the majors while his 737.0 innings rank 18th.

**PERSONAL:** Played collegiately at the University of Florida where he was named 2018 SEC Pitcher of the Year and winner of the Dick Howser Trophy...was named *Baseball America* College Player of the Year in 2018 and a finalist for the Golden Spikes Award...helped lead the Gators to the school's first NCAA College World Series championship in 2017...struck out 12 vs LSU in Game One of the CWS finals, the most strikeouts in the championship round since at least 2003...was teammates at Florida with another 2018 first-round pick, Jonathan India, for whom he was traded in 2024...Graduated from Eustis High School (FL), the same school attended by 1972 Nobel Prize winner John Robert Schrieffer, former NASA astronaut David Walker, and former Reds catcher Chris Okey.

**STREAKING:** Opened the season 4-0 for the first time in his career...the last Reds starting pitcher prior to Singer to win his first 4 decisions was LHP Andrew Abbott in 2023.

**LAST TIME OUT:** On 5/23 was activated from the 15-day injured list and started that night vs Chc...did not factor in the decision in the 13-6 loss vs the Cubs (4.0ip, 3h, 2r/2er, 2bb, 2k, 1hr, 83TP)...was on the IL since 5/8 with a right groin strain and missed 2 starts.

- Exited the game with a 4-2 lead.
- Threw 37 pitches in the 4th inning (2h, 2r/2er, 2bb, 1hr)...marked the second time in his career that he fired as many as 37 pitches in an inning (also: 4/16/24 at Sea, 39TP in the 3rd inning).
- His 4th inning base-on-balls to Dansby Swanson marked the first time this season he walked a bottom of the order (7,8,9) batter, and the first time he did it since 8/13/24 vs STL (No. 7 batter Lars Nootbaar in the top of the 5th).
