Top 40 Hits of 2025

The Brewers have 40 hits over the first 2 games of this series, which ties the franchise record for hits over a 2-game span.....the team also notched 40 hits (31/9) from 8/28-8/29, 1992 in a pair of wins at Toronto.

Mr. Vaughnderful

Andrew Vaughn, who was acquired from the White Sox on June 13 and joined the team on July 7, is batting .371 (23-for-62) with 6 HR and 24 RBI in 18 games as a Brewer while posting a .431 OBP/.726 SLG/1.157 OPS....he is on an 8-game hitting streak during which he is batting .452 [14-for-31] with 4 HR and 12 RBI while posting a .471 OBP/.903 SLG/1.374 OPS.

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without Bob Uecker on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

IN THE STANDINGS (138 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST**: 24*, **SECOND**: 57, **THIRD**: 43, **FOURTH**: 11, **FIFTH**: 3.....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the Cubs by 2.0 games (*9 days tied for first from 3/18-3/26 before playing a game).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The team is 22-12-2 in series play, including this series. Game 1: 22-14, Game 2: 22-14, Game 3: 19-15, Game 4: 3-1
Sweeps [6]: vs. BOS (3g, 5/26-5/28), at PHI (3g, 5/30-6/1), at MIN (3g, 6/20-6/22), vs. LAD (3g, 7/7-7/9), vs. WSH (3g, 7/11-7/13) and at LAD (3g, 7/18-7/20) Were Swept (1): at NYY (3g, 3/27-3/30)

AT HOME: The team is 36-20 at home, going 13-5-0 in series play.....are 24-11 in the last 35 home games and 13-4 in the last 17.....had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from 7/7-7/13.

ON THE ROAD: The team is 30-24 on the road, going 9-7-2 in series play, including this series....are 20-6 in the last 26 road games and 8-1 in the last 9 contests with a current 3-game winning streak.....have had three season-high 5-game road winning streaks, coming from 5/25-6/2, 6/19-7/2 and 7/6-7/21.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

COACHES: Associate manager Rickie Weeks (2nd season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (7th season), assistant pitching 6 strategy coach Jim Henderson (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (2nd season), lead hitting coach Al LeBoeuf (1st season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (4th season), hitting coach Eric Theisen (1st season), assistant coach Daniel de Mondesert (2nd season), infield coach Matt Erickson (2nd coach season), first base coach Julio Borbón (1st season), third base coach Jason Lane (10th season/5th in current role).

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made 19 replay challenges this season, going 12-7.....their last challenge (lost) came on 7/30 vs. Chicago-NL as an out call at first base involving William Contreras stood.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times in the last seven seasons (2018-24) and won the NL Central in four of the last seven, three of four, and two in a row....Milwaukee is one of five teams to make the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons, joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseaso eight straight seasons (2017-24), missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include 2020.....the Brewers have 732 wins since 2017 (4th in MLB/2nd in National League).

HENDERSON AT A GLANCE: Logan Henderson, 23, will make his fifth start of the season.....his last start for the Brewers came on 5/25 at Pittsburgh as he had no decision in a 6-5 win (5ip, 5h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 6k, 1hr, 89 pitches).....he left with a 3-1 lead.....the team is 4-0 in his starts.....he has 1 quality start.....opponents are batting .187 [14-for-75, 3hr).....Henderson also has 16 appearances/15 starts at Triple-A Nashville this season, where he is 10-4 with a 3.59 ERA [77.2ip, 62h, 32r, 31er, 24bb, 87k, 9hr].....he made his Major League debut in his start on 4/20 vs. Athletics.....he was selected by Milwaukee in the fourth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of McLennan (TX) Community College, where he was named 2021 NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year in his Ione season (17g, 14gs, 10-2, 1.66era, 97.2ip, 169k).

EASY AS 1-2-3: Henderson became the first pitcher in franchise history to win each of his first three career games in the Major Leagues.....he was in line for his fourth consecutive win in his last outing on 5/25 at Pittsburgh but was the victim of a blown save (Nick Mears surrendered lead in sixth inning).

STRIKE THREE, YOU'RE OUT: Henderson has 29 strikeouts through his first four career games in the majors, trailing only Freddy Peralta (35 in 2018) in franchise history.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Henderson has gone 21-14 with a 3.26 ERA in 60 games/59 starts in the Brewers farm system [2022-25].....he has produced 320 strikeouts in just 251.1 innings pitched (11.46 K/9IP) while holding opponents to a .205 batting average and posting a 1.02 WHIP.....he was limited to just 7 starts in his first professional season (2022) due to a fractured right elbow.....he was credited with the best control and best changeup in the organization by Baseball America prior to the 2024 season.

AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 2-0 with a 0.82 ERA in 2 starts (11ip. 1er]....ON THE ROAD: Is 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA in 2 starts (10ip. 3er).
