**RAY REPORT**—Coming off a 3-6 homestand against Boston (0-3), Kansas City (1-2) and Oakland (2-1), the Rays open a five-game road trip through Baltimore (3 to play) and Miami (2 to play) tonight at Oriole Park...have won three of their last four games on the heels of a season-high six game losing streak...however, they have lost seven of their last 10 contests overall after posting an 11-4 mark in their previous 15 from May 3-18...are tied for third place in the AL East after spending nine consecutive days in fourth...are in the midst of a stretch of four off days over 15 days from May 23-June 6, which precedes a run of 19 games in 20 days from June 7-26.

Following yesterday's 12-inning, 6-5 victory over the Athletics, the Rays have won in walk-off fashion in back-to-back games for the first time since Aug. 11-12, 2023 vs. CLE...their four walk-off victories are tied with three other clubs for fourth most in the majors, trailing the Marlins, Mets and Orioles (5).

With the win, the Rays improved to 14-12 in May, securing a winning May for the seventh straight season (excluding 2020)...the 2016 Rays were the last to post a sub-.500 May record (11-16)...the 14-12 mark this month ranks sixth in the AL/12 in MLB. Since May 1, the Rays are 13-4 when scoring 4+ runs compared to 1-8 with three runs or fewer.

Tampa Bay's pitching staff has turned in a 2.31 ERA (39.0IP, 10ER) over the club's last four games...that mark stood at 1.62 before an official scoring change earlier today converted a May 28 error by **Brandon Lowe** to a **OAK Max Schuemann** hit, resulting in 3 ER charged to **Zack Littell**.

The Rays 22 road games played are the fewest in the majors, with the Orioles 24 being next closest...they have won four of their last five away games after going 7-10 in their first 17...16 of their 22 (72.7%) contests on the road have been decided by two runs or fewer, the highest percentage in MLB, ahead of the Brewers (67.7%).

**RECENT TRANSACTIONS**—Earlier today, the Rays selected RHP **Justin Sterner** from Triple-A Durham and optioned LHP **Tyler Alexander** to Durham...Sterner's first appearance will mark his major league debut.

**SERIES TALK**—The Rays are 5-3-0 in their last eight series following a 3-5-2 start...they have won back-to-back road series (BOS, TOR) after losing each of their previous three (NYY, CWS, MIL) and are searching for a third straight road series win for the first time since winning six straight from July 28-Aug. 30, 2023 (excl. multi-season streaks).

Tampa Bay is 6-12 in series openers, including 6-3 in its last nine after going 1-8 in its first nine...the Rays have won three straight road series openers after losing four straight to begin the campaign.

**ARE YOU SIRI-IOUS?**—Coming off his fourth career multi-homer game yesterday, **Jose Siri** is 5-for-11 (.455) with 1 2B, 2 HR and 4 RBI over his last three games...he has tallied a game-tying/go-ahead RBI in the 9th inning or later in back-to-back games, becoming the first Ray to turn the trick in consecutive team games since **Austin Meadows** from July 21-22, 2021...entering the current stretch, Siri had zero such RBI in 269 career games.

Yesterday, he launched a game-tying home run in the 9th inning off a 100.0 mph pitch from **OAK Mason Miller**, becoming the first Ray in the pitch tracking era (since 2008) to homer on a pitch of 100.0+ mph in the regular season...including the postseason, **Mike Brosseau** (100.2 mph in G5 of 2020 ALDS vs. NYY **Aroldis Chapman**) is the only other Tampa Bay hitter to accomplish the feat.

**RALLY RAYS**—The Rays 15 comeback wins are tied for fourth most in the majors, trailing the Phillies (18), Nationals, Orioles and Yankees (17 each)...they have recorded each of their last four wins in come-from-behind fashion, their longest streak since Sept. 5-9, 2023 (4)...the Rays have trailed at some point in each of their last 11 games, but have managed a 4-7 record in that span...they have held a lead entering the 9th inning just once in their last nine games (May 26 vs. KC), going 3-6 in those contests...their last wire-to-wire win came on May 17 at TOR (4-3)...overall, 53.6 pct. (15/28) of their victories have been comeback wins compared to 37.4 pct. (37/99) in 2023.

The Rays have recorded back-to-back walk-off wins for the 11th time in club history...they accomplished the feat twice in 2023: April 21-22 vs. CWS and Aug. 11-12 vs. CLE...**Jose Siri** and **Richie Palacios** tallied their first career walk-off plate appearances over the last two games—according to Elias, it marks the second such occurrence in club history, joining **Sean Rodriguez** (2B) and **Cole Figueroa** (HR) on May 22-23, 2014 as part of a club-record three straight walk-off wins.

**Tampa Bay ranks among MLB leaders in wins when trailing after six (T2nd, 6), seven (T1st, 5) and eight (T3rd, 3) innings.**

**In the 8th inning or later, Rays hitters lead the AL in on-base pct. (.337) and rank second in batting average (.259) behind the Rangers (.260)...Isaac Paredes', .415 (17-for-41) average from the 8th frame on paces the AL (min. 30AB) and ranks third in the majors behind CHC Mike Tauchman (.436) and LAD Shohei Ohtani (.425).**

**DOWN TO THE WIRE**—The Rays are 11-4 (.733) in one-run games, tied with Seattle (11-4) for the most wins and best winning pct. in the majors...**Tampa Bay's 20-8 (.714) record in games decided by two runs or fewer leads MLB, ahead of Baltimore (18-9/.667) and Philadelphia (14-7/.667)...their 28 games decided by two or fewer runs are tied for second most in the AL behind the Yankees (29)...14 of the Rays last 16 contests since May 13 have been decided by three runs or fewer.**

**They have won each of their last five one-run games, their longest single-season streak since April 23-May 6, 2022 (5)...seven of their last eight wins have come by two runs or fewer, while each of their last seven losses have been by 3+ runs.**

**ON-BASE PAREDES**—**Isaac Paredes** has reached base safely in 27 of his last 28 games since April 28, hitting .326/.435/.526 (31-for-95) with 7 2B, 4 HR, 16 RBI, 16 BB and 15 SO...he ranks third in the AL in on-base pct. and fourth in average during that span.

Paredes is the fourth player in Rays history with a .295+ AVG, 500+ SLG, 20+ BB and 40 SO or fewer in his first 53 games of a season, joining **Yandy Diaz** (2023), **Steve Pearce** (2016) and **Ben Zobrist** (2009).

**RUNNING WILD**—The Rays lead the AL and rank fifth in the majors with 60 SB, but their 24 CS are also the most in MLB...according to Baseball Reference, they have made 21 outs on the basepaths, second most in the AL behind the Angels (26)...this statistic does not include pickoffs, caught stealing or force plays.

**José Caballero** is responsible for one-third of the Rays 60 SB...**his 20 SB are second most in MLB behind CIN Ely De La Cruz (31) and are the most through a player's first 50 games with the Rays in club history, outpacing Mallex Smith (16, 2017).**

**BIRDLAND**—The Rays and Orioles open a 13-game season series tonight with the first of seven matchups over the next 11 days...the clubs will meet again from June 7-10 at Tropicana Field...the Rays will return to Baltimore from Sept. 6-8 to conclude the season series...in 2023, the Rays went 5-8 against the Orioles, snapping a streak of six consecutive season series victories...Tampa Bay is 6-11 at Oriole Park since 2022...the Rays have lost eight of their last 12 games against the Orioles overall and are 12-17 in the last 29 meetings on the heels of a 27-2 stretch in the previous 29 meetings.

- In club history, four Rays have hit home runs onto Eutaw Street: **Ben Grieve** (2002), **Aubrey Huff** (2003), **Logan Morrison** (2017) and **Austin Meadows** (2019)...three have been hit against the Rays, most recently by **Adley Rutschman** off **Zach Eflin** on May 9, 2023.
- Orioles starter **RHP Albert Suárez** was part of the Rays international free agent class in 2006...he remained in the organization until 2014, advancing as high as Double-A Montgomery before signing a minor league deal with the Angels ahead of the 2015 season.
- Rays **RHP Shawn Armstrong** spent parts of three seasons with Baltimore from 2019-21, appearing in 85 games.
- Rays **LHP Garrett Cleavinger** was selected by the Orioles in the third round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft and remained in the organization until being dealt to the Phillies in 2017 in a trade involving former Ray **RHP Jeremy Hellickson**.
- Rays Hitting Coach **Chad Mottola** appeared in six games for the Orioles in 2004...he was originally drafted by the club in 1989, but opted to attend UCF.
- Rays Asst. Pitching/Rehab Coach **Rick Knapp** is a Baltimore native.
- Rays Director, Amateur Scouting **Chuck Ricci** was drafted by the Orioles in 1987, spending seven seasons in the club's farm system from 1987-93.
- Rays Head Athletic Trainer **Joseph Bengt** spent 10 seasons as an AT in the Orioles system (2001-10).
- Rays Vice President, Asst. GM **Kevin Ibach** spent seven years with the Orioles as a baseball operations coordinator from 2000-07.

**TONIGHT'S START**—Civale will take the ball for his 12th start of the season, including his sixth on the road...has gone 0-3 with a 7.75 ERA (33.2IP, 29ER) in his last seven starts after pitching to a 2-1 mark and 2.74 ERA (23.0IP, 7ER) in his first four...is seeking his first win since April 9 at LAA...has gone 4-7 with a 5.66 ERA (102.0IP, 63ER) in 21 starts since the Rays acquired him from the Guardians on July 31, 2023.

**LAST TIME OUT**—Did not factor into the decision on May 25 vs. KC, allowing two runs on four hits, one walk and one hit batter with five strikeouts across 5.0 innings.

Retired the first four batters he faced before allowing a solo homer to Nelson Velázquez...a Bobby Witt Jr. RBI-single in the 3rd inning accounted for his second earned run.

Threw a season-low 71 pitches...has hit a batter in back-to-back starts for the second time in his career (3G: April 24-May 5, 2022).

**BOH'S AND O'S**—Civale has made three career starts opposite Baltimore, going 2-0 with a 6.75 ERA (16.0IP, 12ER)...he has worked 5.0+ innings in each outing, but has allowed a total of six home runs, including 3 HR in his first career start at Camden Yards on June 5, 2021.

He is 6-8 with a 5.50 ERA (91.2IP, 56ER) in 18 career starts against AL East opponents, including 1-2 with a 5.57 ERA (21.0IP, 13ER) in four starts this season.

**TIME TO BATTLE BACK**—In four starts to open the season, Civale went 2-1 with a 2.74 ERA (23.0IP, 7ER) while limiting opponents to a .200 (17-for-85) average...in seven starts since, he is 0-3 with a 7.75 ERA (33.2IP, 29ER) while allowing opponents to hit .304 (42-for-138).

**ROAD WOES**—In five starts away from Tropicana Field this season, Civale owns a 7.40 ERA (24.1IP, 20ER), the fifth-highest road ERA in the majors (min. 20.0IP) behind CHC Kyle Hendricks (9.55), SF Keaton Winn (7.97), OAK Paul Blackburn (7.65) and HOU Spencer Arrighetti (7.54).

In 10 road starts since joining the Rays last season, Civale is 3-4 with a 5.63 ERA (46.1IP, 29ER)...prior to joining Tampa Bay, he allowed two earned runs or fewer in 13 of his previous 14 road outings from Aug. 21, 2022-July 30, 2023, posting a 2.52 ERA (75.0IP, 21ER).

**CRUISING, THEN BRUISING**—From innings 1-3, Civale has posted a 2.37 ERA (33.0IP, 10ER) and a .200 (24-for-120) opp. average...from the 4th inning on, he owns a 9.89 ERA (23.2IP, 26ER) with a .340 (35-for-103) opp. average...he has allowed a combined 25 runs (23ER) in the 4th and 5th innings compared to 13 runs (all earned) in all other frames...this includes 14 runs allowed in the 5th inning, tied with STL Miles Mikolas for the most in the majors.

He has struggled to escape innings, allowing opponents to slash .297/.373/.514 (22-for-74) with two outs...17 of the 31 RBI recorded against him have come with two outs, including 4 of the 11 HR.

**STARTING AT THE TOP**—Civale has limited opposing lead-off hitters to a .107/.167/.214 (3-for-28) line, T8th-lowest opp. AVG in MLB (min. 25BF)...five- and six-hole hitters have given him the most trouble, as they are hitting a combined .422 (19-for-45) with 6 2B, 5 HR and 12 RBI...overall, opposing 5-9 hitters have gone 35-for-109 (.321) with 7 2B, 8 HR and 22 RBI off Civale, while 1-4 hitters are 24-for-114 (.211) with 3 2B, 3 HR and 9 RBI.

**BIT BY THE LONG BALL**—Civale's 11 HR allowed are tied for third most in the AL behind teammate Tyler Alexander (13HR) and CLE Logan Allen (12HR)...he has yielded at least 1 HR in 10 of his 11 starts and in 16 of his last 18 dating back to Aug. 23, 2023 vs. COL...entering that stretch, he had permitted just 1 HR in his previous 10 starts from June 25-Aug. 16, 2023.

Nearly half (18) of the 37 runs he has allowed this season have come on the 11 HR against him.
