THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 2-5 (2-2 in Detroit and 0-3 in Baltimore), the Twins began their seven-game homestand with a split of the first two games this weekend with the Tigers...today, the Twins and Tigers will play the three-game series finale...after this series, the Twins will host the White Sox for a four-game series from tomorrow-Thursday...Twins are 2-5 at home this season, both their wins coming in their last three games.

ADJUST YOUR BUNNY EARS: Along with Bally Sports North, tomorrow's game will also be televised on Fox Sports 1...additionally, due to NBA playoff scheduling conflicts (Wolves vs. Suns), Tuesday night's Twins-White Sox game will be broadcast on Bally Sports North Extra.

BAILEY STAYS HOT, BEATS THE TIGERS: The Twins beat the Tigers yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 4-3, marking the Twins' second one-run win this season...the win snapped a season-long five-game losing streak as Minnesota won their first game since Saturday's Game 2 at Comerica Park...Bailey Ober (1-1) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on two hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts...Griffin Jax pitched a scoreless ninth inning on 12 pitches to earn his second save of the season...the offense recorded seven hits, highlighted by Byron Buxton and Austin Martin, who both went 2-for-4...Minnesota hitters also only struck out six times, tying their season-low.

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins are playing the seventh of 13 games against the Tigers today...Minnesota has gone 3-3 against the Tigers this season.
- These two will play their next series from July 2-4 at Target Field for three games.
- Rocco Baldelli has a managerial record of 50-36 against the Tigers — since 2019...only Terry Francona (51-29) has beaten Detroit more in that span.
- The Twins have gone 36-17 at home against the Tigers since the start of the 2018 season...in fact, in that time frame, the Twins only lost two home series to the Tigers, holding a 12-2-2 series record in that span.
- Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 122, 25 ahead of Chicago-AL (97).
- Ryan Jeffers has gone 6-for-20 (.300) with five RBI in six games against the Tigers this season...Jeffers' 27 career hits, seven home runs, 23 RBI and 16 walks against Detroit (46 games) are his most against any opponent.
- Carlos Santana has gone 1-for-15 (.067) in his career vs. Casey Mize but has drawn six walks (.333 OBP).

AUSTIN POWER: Austin Martin enters today with a six-game hitting streak, the third-longest for a Twin this season (streaks below)...the streak is tied for fifth longest active streak in the AL...during the streak, Martin is hitting .300 (6-for-20) with three RBI and seven run scored.

TWINS TRY MEATLOAF THE TIGERS: The Twins are looking for their second series win this season...their only series win came to open the season at Kansas City (full list to the lower right)...Minnesota went 27-19-5 in series play in 2023, going 15-8-3 at home and 13-11-2 on the road.
- The Twins are seeking their first series win over the Tigers since taking two of three at Comerica Park from June 23-25, 2023...they have gone 0-1-2 head-to-head in series play since.
- Since 2018, the Twins have gone 12-2-2 in series play against the Tigers in Minnesota.

BEEF, IT'S WHAT'S FOR DINNER: Brock Stewart has begun the season with nine-straight scoreless appearances (9.1 IP), allowing six hits with 12 strikeouts...he has allowed just one hit to a right-handed batter (Carson Kelly single on Friday)...Stewart's last run allowed came on a Jose Altuve grand slam on May 29, 2023 at Houston...he enters today with a 22.0-scoreless inning streak, the second-longest active streak in baseball, trailing only Brusdar Graterol (25.0) - Elias...since the start of last season, he leads baseball with a 0.49 ERA (minimum of 30.0 innings pitched).
- He ranks in the 94th percentile in baseball in average fastball velocity (97.3 mph).

SOME INJURY UPDATES:

- Max Kepler played in his third game on rehab assignment last night with Triple-A St. Paul at Indianapolis, going 3-for-5 with a walk and played all nine innings in rightfield...St. Paul plays at Indy again today at 12:35 pm (CT).
- Daniel Duarte is scheduled to undergo season-ending elbow surgery on May 8...he appeared in two games for the Twins this season, before being placed on the IL on April 8.
- Justin Topa is scheduled to throw live BP on Tuesday at Target Field...Topa has missed the start of the season with left patellar tendinitis.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Low-A Fort Myers infielder Rayne Doncon and Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher Marco Raya have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.
- Doncon, 20, played in six games for the Mighty Mussels, hitting .304 (7-for-23) with four doubles, two RBI, five walks, a .414 on-base percentage and an .892 OPS...the San Pedro de Macoris, Dominican Republic native was one of the pieces acquired by the Twins in the Manny Margot-Noah Miller trade with Los Angeles-NL in March...he is currently ranked as the club's 30th-best prospect by MLB.com.
- Raya, 21, made the start on Friday vs. Tulsa, pitching 3.0 scoreless innings in a start, with two hits allowed, no walks and four strikeouts...he has now posted a 2.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 2 ER) with no walks and 11 strikeouts in three starts for the Wind Surge this season...the Laredo, Texas native was selected by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of United South High School and is ranked as the club's sixth-best prospect by MLB.com and fifth-best by Baseball America.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1961, the Twins played their first game in Minnesota at Metropolitan Stadium after moving from Washington...they lost that game to the expansion "new" Washington Senators by a score of 5-3...Camilo Pascual was the starter for the Twins, allowing three runs on eight hits in 8.0 innings pitched...Ray Moore was the losing pitcher, allowing two runs in the top of the ninth inning...the Twins went on to win their first ever game in Minnesota the following day against the Senators.

**LAST START:** Faced the Baltimore Orioles for the first time in his career...Twins lost the first of the three-game series by a score of 7-4...took his third consecutive loss, the longest losing streak of his career after giving up a career-high 11 hits (2 HR) with six runs (4 ER), no walks and a season-high-tying six strikeouts...had clean innings in the bottom of the second and bottom of the fourth...gave up a pair of home runs to Ryan O'Hearn (3rd inning) and Cedric Mullins (5th inning)...exited after 5.0 innings, giving way to Matt Bowman who finished the game.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Faced the Los Angeles Dodgers for the first time in his career...took his second consecutive loss of the season after allowing six runs on seven hits (2 HR), with three walks and a season-high six strikeouts in 5.0 innings...after getting through a clean first 3.0 innings, gave up three runs in back-to-back innings in the fourth and fifth innings, on a pair of three-run home runs to James Outman (4th inning) and Will Smith (5th inning).

☞ Was the most runs runs he's allowed since June 6, 2023 at Tampa Bay (7 ER).

**VARLAND VS. DETROIT:** Facing the Detroit Tigers for the second time in his career...in the one start against them he is 0-1, 12.46 ERA (4.1 IP, 6 ER), two walks, four strikeouts, 2.54 WHIP and a .429 opponent batting average (6-for-21).

☞ His last start against the Detroit Tigers came on June 18, 2023, in which would be his last start the season...was later optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on June 20, and recalled on September 4, when he was moved to the bullpen for the remainder of the season.

☞ His last and only win against an AL Central opponent was against the Chicago White Sox, which was his first career major league win...came on the last game of the regular season in 2022 on October 5...Varland tossed 5.0 shutout innings, allowing four hits, no walks and five strikeouts.

**DUB SEEKING:** Louie is looking to snap a three-game losing streak and seeking his first win since September 12, 2023 vs. Tampa Bay, which was a relief outing...in his last six starts, he has gone 0-5, 9.31 ERA (29.0 IP, 30 ER) with 10 home runs and 45 hits allowed, dating back to June 6, 2023...his last win in a start came in Houston on May 31, 2023, pitching 7.0 shutout innings with four hits allowed, one walk and five strikeouts...his last win as a starter at home came against the Cubs on May 14, 2023 in a Twins 16-3 victory.

**BULLPEN GEM:** Moved to the bullpen starting on September 6 after being called up from Triple-A St. Paul Saints on September 4...Twins went on to win five out of the seven appearances he made in the month...pitched to a 1-0 record, 1.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 17 ER), one walk, 17 strikeouts and two holds.

☞ Began September with a ERA of 5.03 and ended the season with 4.63...batters hit .150 with a .191 BABIP and slugged .300...recorded two holds in the Postseason in back-to-back games vs. the Blue Jays pitching 0.2 innings with two hits, zero runs and one strikeout in the two appearances.

**BACK AT HOME:** Set to make his second start of the season at home after facing the Los Angeles Dodgers on April 9...he took his second loss of the season allowing seven hit (2 HR), six runs, three walks and a season-high six strikeouts.

☞ Last home win came in a regular season game on September 12, 2023 vs. Tampa Bay Rays...entered in relief for Joe Ryan in the fifth inning and pitched 2.1 scoreless innings, allowing one hit, no walks and three strikeouts...picked up his fourth win on the season.

☞ Is 2-4, 5.16 ERA (45.1 IP, 26 ER), 46 hits (12 HR), 11 walks, 43 strikeouts, 1.26 WHIP and a .263 (46-for-175) opponent batting average in 12 home appearances (7 starts).

**LEFTIES VS. RIGHTIES:** Through three starts in the 2024 season, left-handed hitters have hit .350 (14-for-40), with four home runs, two walks and 11 strikeouts...righties have hit .400 (10-for-25) with one home run, five strikeouts and three walks...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .254/.297/.486 with 10 home runs and 48 strikeouts against Varland, while righties are slashing .285/.336/.522 with 15 home runs and 60 strikeouts.

**PITCH BREAKDOWN:** Varland used a five-pitch mix in his first three starts of the 2024 season, including a 4-seam fastball, cutter, slider, changeup and sinker, according to Baseball Savant...used his four-seam fastball and cutter a combined 68.5 percent of the time in his first three starts of the 2024 season...below is a look at his 2024 repertoire through three starts:

☞ Ranks in the bottom 4% in the league in max exit velocity with 114.0, and also in the bottom 7% in expected batting average with .320.

**STRIKEOUT NUMBER 100:** Picked up his 100th career strikeout on April 9 vs. Los Angeles Dodgers, fanning Max Muncy in the top of the fourth inning.

☞ Became the 42nd player ever born in Minnesota to record 100 strikeouts.  
☞ Ranks 10th all time in strikeouts among Minnesota-born Twins players with 108.

**DAY MAN, FIGHTER OF THE NIGHT MAN:** In his career in day games he is 2-3, 5.05 ERA (46.1 IP, 26 ER), 48 hits, 13 walks, 48 strikeouts, a 1.32 WHIP and a .267 (48-for-180) opponent batting average...has made a total of eight starts in day games throughout his career (12 total appearances)...last one came April 2 in Milwaukee.

**CAREER NOTES**

- Made his major league debut in game one of a doubleheader on September 7, 2022 at New York-AL, becoming the 10th player to make his major league debut for the Twins in 2022 (5th pitcher).
- Earned first major league win October 5, 2022 at Chicago-AL (5.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 5 K).
- Had allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 18-straight minor league starts from May 18-August 31, 2022, going 4-4, 2.85 ERA (94.2 IP, 30 ER) with 31 walks and 111 strikeouts in that span...his teams went 12-6.
- Went 7-4, 3.34 ERA (105.0 IP, 39 ER) with 39 walks and 119 strikeouts in 20 games (19 starts) for Wichita in 2022 – was promoted to Triple-A St. Paul on August 8.
- Earned the win in his first career Triple-A start/appearance on August 12, 2022 vs. Columbus (5.1 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 8 K).
- Led all Twins minor leaguers in strikeouts (146) and innings pitched (126.1), tied for first in games started (23) and was second in ERA (3.06), second in winning percentage (.615), fourth in opponent batting average (.242) and WHIP (1.26), and tied for fifth in wins (8) in 2022.
- Named Jim Rantz Award winner as Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year in 2021 and 2022, one of two pitchers to ever win the award twice, joining José Berrios (2014-15).
- One of 32 Minnesota natives to play for the Twins and one of 16 to pitch...was one of three Minnesota natives on the Twins roster at one point in 2022 (also, Caleb Thielbar and Matt Wallner).
- Named starting pitcher on 2021 Twins MiLB.com organizational All-Star team.
- In 2019, made his professional debut with Rookie-Elizabethton...made three appearances, including one start...struck out 10 batters in 8.2 innings pitched.
- Selected by Twins in 15th round of 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Concordia University in St. Paul.
