**IN THE WIN COLUMN:** The Giants earned their first victory of the 2026 season last night, defeating the Padres by a 3-2 count...the win snapped the Giants' three-game losing streak and gave Manager Tony Vitello his first career win in the big leagues...following the win, Giants players presented Vitello with a bottle of premium Champagne.

**ON THE MOUND: RHP Logan Webb** takes the ball for his second start of the season...the two-time All-Star made his fifth career Opening Day start last Wednesday against the Yankees and was touched for seven runs (six earned) on nine hits and one walk in 5.0 innings...his seven runs allowed matched the most he's given up in a home start in his career.

- ▶ Webb went winless in three starts against the Padres last year, going 0-2 with a 4.19 ERA (9er, 19.1ip)...he enters his start tonight, winless in his last four starts against San Diego, dating to September 2024 (0-3, 4.63 ERA).
- ▶ Webb is 4-5 with a 3.15 ERA (35er, 100.0ip) in 17 career games (16 starts) against the Padres...he's 1-2 with a 4.38 ERA (19er, 39.0) in seven career starts here at Petco Park.
- ▶ Webb was named an All-Star for a second consecutive season in 2025 and finished the campaign leading the Majors in innings pitched (207.0) and leading the National League in strikeouts (a career-best 224) while going 15-11 in a career-high 34 starts...he finished fourth in the NL Cy Young voting and also won his first career Gold Glove.

**LET'S SCORE SOME RUNS:** Only the Giants (4) have scored fewer runs this season than the Padres (9)...the Giants were shut out in their first two games of the season, then scored one run on Saturday and three last night.

- ▶ According to MLB Network, the Giants' four runs tie the Divisional Era record for fewest through the first four games of a season (tied with the 2018 Giants and 1988 Orioles).

**AGAINST THE PADRES:** Dating back to September 2024, the Giants have struggled against the Padres, posting a 4-13 (.235) record with a -49 run differential.

- ▶ They have also dropped 11 of their last 17 games here at Petco Park...during that stretch, SF hitters have posted a .211 batting average, while Giants' pitchers have posted a 5.32 ERA and allowed 5.7 runs per game.

**NOTABLE BVP: IF Matt Chapman** is 6-for-15 (.400) with three homers off tonight's opposing starting pitcher Germán Márquez...**IF Willy Adames** is 4-for-11 (.364) with three homers...**IF Manny Machado** is 13-for-41 (.317) with one double and one homer in his career off Logan Webb...**OF Fernando Tatis Jr.** is 7-for-34 (.206) off Webb with eight strikeouts.

**WILLY VS. SD: IF Willy Adames** owns a .393 career on-base percentage against the Padres, fifth best among active players (minimum 100 PA)...it is Adames' second-highest mark against any team in his career behind a .404 OBP against the Blue Jays (STATS, LLC).

**ON THE RISE: IF Luis Arraez** owns a combined .320 career batting average in March and April, which is the best among active MLB players (minimum 500 PA)...the last MLB player who had a higher career March/April average was Moises Alou (.331), who retired after 2007 (STATS, LLC).

**IN THE 'PEN:** The Giants' bullpen has been a bright spot for SF through the first four games of the season, posting a 2.30 ERA (4er, 15.2ip) and 17 strikeouts with a .135 opponents batting average against...however, Giants relievers have allowed one home run in each of their last three games.

**TONY V:** Manager **Tony Vitello** was named the 40th field manager in Giants history on October 22, 2025.

- ▶ Vitello spent the last eight years (2018-2025) as head coach of the University of Tennessee where he went 341-131 (.722), leading the Vols to a National Championship in 2024.
- ▶ The 47-year-old helped transform Tennessee baseball into a national powerhouse during his time in Knoxville, guiding the program to six NCAA regional appearances (2019, 2021-2025), five super regionals (2021-2025) and three Men's College World Series appearances (2021, 2023, 2024).

**GOLD GLOVE: 2025** | **ALL-STAR: 2024, 2025**

**WEBBMASTER:** Is in his eighth season in a Giants uniform and is in the third year of his five-year contract extension he signed in 2023...the 29-year-old is the longest-tenured Giant on the roster after making his MLB debut on August 17, 2019 at Arizona.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered the loss on Opening Day last Wednesday versus the Yankees in SF's 7-0 defeat...Webb allowed all seven runs (six earned) in 5.0 innings in what was just the second time in 88 career starts (91 games) at home that he'd allowed seven runs in a game (also July 10, 2024 vs. Toronto)...after a clean 1st inning, Webb was roughed up for five runs on five hits in the 2nd inning as the Yankees sent nine men to the plate in the frame.

**\*FLIPS OPEN SIGN AROUND\*:** Webb's five consecutive Opening Day starts are now second-most in team history trailing only **Juan Marichal's** six straight Opening Day starts from 1964-69...Webb is also one of five pitchers in team history to make at least five Opening Day starts...the others are: Marichal (10), **Carl Hubbell** (six), **Larry Jansen** (five) and **Madison Bumgarner** (five).

**VS. SAN DIEGO:** Faces the Padres for a first time this season after facing them three different times in 2025 and going 0-2 with a 4.19 ERA in those starts...SF lost each of Webb's three starts versus San Diego a season ago...overall, the righty is 4-5 with a 3.15 ERA (35er, 100.0ip) in 16 career starts (17 games) against the Friars...most of his success against San Diego has come in SF...here in SD, Webb is 1-2 with a 4.38 ERA (19er, 39.0ip) in seven starts with SF winning only one of those games.

**CHANGING:** Last season, Webb logged a career-best 32% whiff with his changeup, up from 22% with the pitch in 2024...batters had a .207 average against it in 2025...the Yankees, however, went 4-for-11 with a triple off his changeup last Wednesday...since the start of 2025, the Padres have a .605 OPS on changeups, a few ticks below league average (.634).

**HE POSTS:** Since 2022, no pitcher in the Majors has thrown more innings than Webb's 825.0 innings...the next closest pitcher is Detroit's Framer Valdez, who has logged 773.2 frames...Webb's 85 quality starts since 2022 are also tops in the Majors ahead of Valdez' 84...lastly, his 133 starts in that span are most in MLB ahead of the STL's Miles Mikolas and the TOR's Dylan Cease (131 apiece).

**DO IT FOR WEBBY:** The Giants were only 18-16 in Webb's 34 starts last year, which was actually an improvement over them going 16-17 in his 33 starts in 2024...since 2022, SF as a team is 67-66 in Webb's 133 starts yet his 3.26 ERA in that time is 11th-best in MLB among starters who have made at least 75 starts...his 2.94 FIP in that span is best in the National League and trails only DET's Tarik Skubal (2.50).

**STARS & STRIPES:** The Giants' ace suited up for USA in the World Baseball Classic and made two terrific starts in their win over Brazil plus their quarterfinal win over Canada...in the two outings, Webb was 2-0 with a 1.04 ERA (1er, 8.2ip) with five hits allowed, one walk and 11 strikeouts...Webb was one of two Giants named to the WBC All-Tournament Team (also **Luis Arraez** at 1B for champion Venezuela).

**CACTUS LEAGUE:** With his time at the WBC, Webb only made three Cactus League starts and was 2-0 with a 6.75 ERA (7er, 9.1ip) with 10 strikeouts to one walk...six of the seven runs he allowed in Cactus League play came in his final start upon returning from WBC action.

**LET'S LOOK BACK:** The Rocklin, CA native finished fourth in the NL Cy Young Award voting in 2025 after leading the Majors in innings pitched (207.0) and the National League in strikeouts (224) while going 15-11 with a 3.22 ERA...*the last Giant prior to Webb to lead the NL in both innings pitched and strikeouts was Bill Voiselle in 1944*...Webb garnered his second All-Star selection, eclipsed the 200-inning threshold for a third straight season, made a career-best 34 starts and set a career-high with his 224 strikeouts...you can see Webb's National League rankings from last season below.

**HELPING THE CATCHER:** Webb improved his ability to keep runners in check in 2025 and limit steals...he had +5 Net Bases Prevented (a sum of advanced prevented and outs added assigned to the pitcher)...he had scores of -5 in 2024, -9 in 2023 and -4 in 2022, -1 in 2021 and -3 in 2020...from 2020-2024, Webb allowed an average of 14 stolen bases/year (72 in five seasons)...in 2025, Webb allowed nine stolen bases.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER** **ADRIAN HOUSER RHP** #12  
**2025 RECORD: 8-5, 3.31 ERA**  
 Will be making his Giants debut after signing a two-year contract with SF this offseason.  
 Started three Cactus League games, going 1-0 with a 3.46 ERA (5er, 13.0ip), 11 strikeouts and a 1.15 WHIP.  
 Is coming off a strong 2025 season in which he went 8-5 with a 3.31 ERA (46er, 125.0ip) and 92 strikeouts...started the year with a 2.10 ERA (16er, 68.2ip) in 11 starts for the White Sox before struggling with Tampa Bay (4.79 ERA).

**Last Game:** 3/28 vs. NYY; 1.0ip, h, r, k, hr (15 pitches)

- ▶ Made his fourth career Opening Day roster (also with Pirates in 2025, 2024 and with Blue Jays in 2021).
- ▶ Signed a Major League contract with the Giants on March 21 after opting out of his minor league deal with the White Sox on March 20...was in camp with the Sox as a NRI and went 2-0 with eight strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP over 6.0 shutout innings.
- ▶ Appeared in 39 games at the Major League level in 2025 for Pittsburgh (35 games) and Toronto (four games) and was a combined 1-3 with a 4.63 ERA (18er, 35.0ip).
- ▶ Left-handed batters were 7-for-60 (.117) with two extra-base hits (both doubles) off him last season...has held lefties to a .181 clip (67-for-370) in his MLB career.
- ▶ **Cactus League Stats:** 0.00 ERA, 3h, 0r, bb, 8k, 0.67 WHIP (6g)

- ▶ On his fourth career OD roster (also: 2020-2022 with Pittsburgh).
- ▶ Began 2025 on NYY's injured list with left rib fractures...made six rehab appearances before appearing in 12 games with NYY (3.38 ERA, 6er, 16.0ip)...was then DFA'ed on Aug. 5
- ▶ Signed a minor league contract w/SF on Aug. 13 and made five appearances (one start) with SF, posting a 4.26 ERA (6er, 12.2ip) with 12 strikeouts and a 1.26 WHIP.
- ▶ Hasn't allowed HR in his last 33.2 MLB innings dating to Oct. 4, 2022.
- ▶ **Cactus League Stats:** 2.45 ERA, 5h, 4r, 3er, 9bb, 11k (5g)

### #70 JOSÉ BUTTÓ ▶ RHP

(boo-TOH)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Slider, Sinker, Changeup, Sweeper

**Last Game:** 3/27 vs. NYY; 0.2ip, 2h, r, er, hr, 2k (17 pitches)

- ▶ On his second career Opening Day roster (also 2025 with NYM).
- ▶ Helped Venezuela win the WBC, tossing 5.2-scoreless innings, allowing just one hit over five games.
- ▶ Was acquired from the Mets on July 30, 2025 as part of the RHP Tyler Rogers trade.
- ▶ Pitched in 21 games for SF last season, going 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA (10er, 20.0ip), 17 strikeouts and a 1.45 WHIP.
- ▶ Was 3-2 with a 3.64 ERA (19er, 47.0ip), 41 strikeouts and a 1.38 WHIP in 34 games with the Mets before the trade last season.
- ▶ His 55 appearances in 2025 were by far a career-high after being used as a primarily as a starter prior to the 2024 season.
- ▶ Did not allow a run in 16 of 21 outings w/SF but did allow eight of 16 inherited runners w/SF to score.
- ▶ **Cactus League Stats:** 2.25 ERA, 5h, r, er, bb, 2k (3g)

### #93 MATT GAGE ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Splitter

**Last Game:** 3/30 at SD; 1.0ip (15 pitches)

- ▶ Made his first career Opening Day roster...has appeared in three of SF's first four games and tossed 3.0-scoreless innings.
- ▶ Signed a MiLB deal with SF on July 2, 2025 after spending the majority of the year in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ Went 0-1 with a 3.91 ERA (11er, 25.1ip), 24 strikeouts and a 1.50 WHIP in 27 games (two starts) for the Giants last season.
- ▶ Has not allowed a HR in his last 35.2 innings dating to June 11, 2023.
- ▶ He's the first wearer of #93 in SF Giants history...#93 is the highest player-worn uniform number in SF-era history, passing No. 87 (worn by RHP Dan Otero in 2012).
- ▶ Originally was a 10th-round pick of the Giants in 2014 before his career journey brought him back to SF last season.
- ▶ **Cactus League Stats:** 2.84 ERA, 3h, 2r, 2er, 9k (7g)

### #45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

**Pitch Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball

**Last Game:** 3/25 vs. NYY; 1.0ip, k (10 pitches)

- ▶ On his first career Opening Day roster after returning to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite.
- ▶ Has not appeared in a game since Opening Night (3/25).
- ▶ Dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of the 2025 season while with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ During his rehab last season, he changed his diet to add more muscle and got his weight up to 215 pounds...he also tinkered with his mechanics after talking with roommate and former Giants farmhand Wil Jensen.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.
- ▶ **Cactus League Stats:** 0.96 ERA, 6h, r, er, 2bb, 11k, 0.86 WHIP

### #68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

**Pitch Arsenal:** Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup

**Last Game:** 3/28 vs. NYY; 0.2ip, h, bb, k (20 pitches)

- ▶ Made his third career Opening Day roster (all with San Francisco).
- ▶ Missed the beginning of camp with lower back tightness...made his first appearance on March 13...made four appearances total including last Monday's exhibition outing vs. Monterrey.
- ▶ Had a 1.02 ERA (2er, 17.2ip) in his final 21 outings last season (May 12-July 2) before hitting the injured list with a left elbow sprain on July 3...did not pitch for SF the rest of the year.
- ▶ Walked 20 batters in 30.0 innings in 2025 (15.6% walk rate).
- ▶ **Cactus League Stats:** 0.00 ERA, 2h, 0r, 4k, 0.67 WHIP (3g)
