AROUND THE HORN

\$100 MILLION IN GIVING: The D-backs and Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation have earned a place among professional sports' most impactful philanthropic organizations in fewer than three decades, reaching a historic milestone of \$100 Million In Giving through their signature "D-backs Give Back" approach and investment in communities across Arizona...March 9 will forever be celebrated annually as "D-backs Give Back Day" as proclaimed by Arizona Governor Katie Hobbs ensuring the organization's longstanding statewide commitment will be recognized each year.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are 7-2 in their last 9 games and 10-4 since May 9, tied for the NL's most wins in the span (also: 10 by Brewers and Braves).

- The D-backs' .630 home win pct. (17-10) ranks fourth in the NL, behind the Braves (.680, 17-8), Cubs (.667, 18-9) and Brewers (.640, 16-9).
- The D-backs' 17 home wins in their first 27 home games are their most since 2017 (19)...have had 18+ wins in their first 28 home games 5 times (1999/20-8, 2000/20-8, 2002/19-9, 2008/19-9 and 2017/20-8).
- At home vs. Rockies, the D-backs have won 6 of their last 7 games and 11 of their last 13.
- **Tommy Troy**, D-backs' No. 4 prospect by MLB Pipeline, makes his MLB debut today in left field.
- **Corbin Carroll**'s season-high 11-game hitting streak is the Majors' longest active streak...is batting .375 (15-for-40)/1.225 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 10 walks (9 K).
- **Ketel Marte** has a 7-game hitting streak, tied for the Majors' fourth longest active streak (also: 3 others)...is batting .500 (14-for-28)/1.474 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 homers, 9 RBI and 4 walks (0 K).
- **Ryan Waldschmidt** has reached base safely in 10 of his last 11 games, batting .361 (13-for-36)/.883 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 RBI and 5 walks.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 5-4 vs. Rockies.

- **Zac Gallen** earned his second straight win after allowing 3 runs in 5.1 innings (6 H, 2 BB, 6 K).
- **Kevin Ginkel** (0 ER in 1.0 IP) tossed his fifth consecutive scoreless outing and has stranded 7 inherited runners in his last 4 games.
- **Paul Sewald** recorded his third save in as many opportunities (12th - 3rd in NL).
- **Ketel Marte** had his third multi-hit game in his last 4 and has homered in 3 of his last 5 games.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** had his third multi-hit game in May and has reached safely in 10 straight games.

VS. LEFTIES: The D-backs are 4-0 vs. lefty starters at home (Tarik Skubal/DET on April 1, Martín Pérez/ATL on April 5, Anthony Kay/CWS on April 22 and Robbie Ray/SF on May 18).

- The D-backs are 8-0 in their last 8 games vs. Rockies' lefty starters.

NO K'S: Ketel Marte has not struck out in 36 straight plate appearances (8 G since May 15 @ Rockies, Top 4), the Majors' longest active streak.

- It is tied for his third longest streak without a strikeout (also: 36 PA from July 4-14, 2024), behind his career-long 41 PA from June 30-July 16, 2019 and 39 PA from July 29-Aug. 7, 2019.

TRIPLE WATCH: Corbin Carroll is 1 triple shy (49 in 534 G) of 50 career and 4 from setting the club record (current: Stephen Drew, 52 in 773 G).

DIVISION SHOWDOWNS: The D-backs are 7-2 in this stretch of 13 straight NL West matchups (2-1 from May 15-17 @ Rockies, 3-0 from May 18-20 vs. Giants, 2-1 from May 21-24 vs. Rockies, May 25-27 @ Giants) and 17 of their next 20 (also: June 1-4 vs. Dodgers).

SERIES WINS: The D-backs have won 3 of their last 4 series (won 2-1 vs. Mets, lost 1-2 @ Rangers, won 2-1 @ Rockies, won 3-0 vs. Giants).

GINKEL GETTING IT DONE: Since April 29, no reliever has stranded more runners than **Kevin Ginkel** (10 IR/O IS)...is 1 of 2 relievers to strand 8+ inherited runners (also: Justin Sterner/ATH with 8 IR).

ABOVE .500: The D-backs were last 4 games above .500 on April 22 (14-10)...the D-backs were a season-high 5 games above .500 on April 18 (13-8).

OFFENSE OUT OF THE GATES: In their last 9 games since May 15 from innings 1-3, the D-backs have scored 24 runs and are batting .330 (36-for-109)/.897 OPS with 9 doubles, 2 triples, 2 homers and 12 walks.

PEN IN MAY: In May, the D-backs' bullpen ranks among the Majors in hits (1st, 37), walks (1st, 18), extra-base hits (2nd, 11), OPS (2nd, .537), WHIP (3rd, 1.01), opponent AVG (3rd, .192) and ERA (4th, 2.32).

- The D-backs bullpen's 12 scoreless games in May are second most, behind the Dodgers (15)...last reached 13 in May from May 1-29, 2018.

BULLPEN AT HOME: In their last 12 home games, the bullpen has a 1.48 ERA (6 R-5 ER in 30.1 IP) with an opponent .160 AVG (17-for-106), 8 walks and 22 strikeouts.

STARTING STRONG: Since May 5, D-backs' starters have recorded a MLB-leading 13 quality starts in their last 18 outings and allowed 2 or fewer runs in 11 of those.

- Since May 5, the D-backs' rotation ranks among MLB leaders in innings (1st, 116.2), IP/G (1st, 6.1), WHIP (1st, 0.99), OBP (1st, .257), ERA (3rd, 2.55) and strikeouts (T-5th, 93).

VS. ROCKIES: The D-backs have won 11 of their last 13 series since 2023, going 29-13 (.690).

- Have won 7 straight home series since Aug. 7, 2022 and 13 of their last 14 home series since Sept. 27, 2020.

• **Ketel Marte** has hit safely in 14 of his last 17 games, batting .431 (28-for-65)/1.245 OPS with 11 doubles, 3 homers, 16 RBI and 9 walks.

• **Corbin Carroll** has a 13-game hitting streak, batting .333 (18-for-54)/1.105 OPS with 4 doubles, 5 homers, 12 RBI and 8 walks.

ON DECK @ GIANTS: The D-backs are 6-1 in their last 7 games vs. Giants.

- Swept their last series 3-0 from May 18-20.
- Have won 4 consecutive season series by a single game since 2022 (7-6 from 2023-25 and 10-9 in 2022).

NEXT STARTER: RHP MERRILL KELLY (4-3, 5.71)

- Is seeking his fourth straight win.
- Recorded his third consecutive quality start on May 20 vs. Giants (3 ER in 6.0 IP, 8 H, 0 BB, 4 K).

- With runners in scoring position, is hitting .333 (14-for-42)/1.135 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 homers, 23 RBI, 8 walks and 2 sac flies.
- Hit his seventh career grand slam on May 18 vs. Giants (last: August 21, 2024 vs. Brewers while with the Cardinals)...became the second D-back all-time to hit a first-inning grand slam from the cleanup spot (also: Stephen Drew on April 28, 2011 vs. Cubs).
- His grand slam was the first instance in MLB on 1 of the first 6 pitches of a game with pitch data dating back to 2000 (source: Elias Sports Bureau).
