Phoenix, 1B Rhys Hoskins went 2-for-3 with a double, grand slam and 5 RBI.....CF Garrett Mitchell went 2-for-4 with a run....LHP DL Hall made the start (2ip, 5h, 2r, 2er, 1bb, 3k)....LHP Robert Gasser tossed 3.0 scoreless innings (2h, 1bb, 3k).....in Las Vegas, CF Jackson Chourio went 2-for-4 with a run and RF Sal Frelick went 2-for-4 with a walk.....1B Jake Bauers produced 3 RBI.....RHP Carlos Rodríguez made the start (2.1ip, 3h, 2r, 2er, 2bb, 4k, 1hr, 1wp).

TODAY'S STARTER: #51 - RHP FREDDY PERALTA

RHP Freddy Peralta, 27, went 12-10 with a 3.86 ERA in a career-high 30 starts last season.....he held opponents to a .212 batting average with a career-high 210 strikeouts in a career-high 165.2 innings.....his 12 wins and 16 quality starts also marked career highs.....the team went 17-13 in his starts.....he ranked among National League leaders in K/9IP (3rd, 11.41), WHIP (5th, 1.12), H/9IP (5th, 7.12), strikeouts (T5th, 210) and K/BB (7th, 3.89).....Peralta is signed through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

ALSO SCHEDULED TO PITCH...

RHP Joel Payamps, 29, went 7-5 with a 2.55 ERA and 3 saves in a career-high 69 relief appearances during his first season with Milwaukee.....his 28 holds tied for second in the National League.....opponents batted just .219.

RHP Trevor Megill, 30, went 1-0 with a 3.63 ERA in 31 games (2 starts) during five stints with Milwaukee last season after he was acquired from Minnesota on April 30 in exchange for a player to be named and cash.....he struck out 52 batters in just 34.2 innings.

RHP Tobias Myers, 25, is a non-roster invitee.....Myers went 10-5 with a 5.03 ERA in 27 games (26 starts) last season at Double-A Biloxi.....he led the Southern League in strikeouts (168) and innings pitched (137.2).
