METSCELLANEOUS: The Mets opened up their 2025 home schedule with a 5-0 victory over the Blue Jays yesterday...The Mets continue their first homestand of the season, a six-game stand against the Blue Jays (1-0) and the Marlins (three games).

WHAT DO YOU SAY JAY?: Tonight, the Mets will honor the legendary Jay Horwitz with an on-field pregame ceremony...This year, Jay is celebrating his 45th anniversary with the New York Mets...In 2022, the Press Box at Citi Field was named in his honor...In 2023 he was honored with the New York Mets Hall of Fame Achievement Award...Horwitz served as the director of media relations for the Mets from 1980-2018...He currently serves as the organization's vice president, alumni public relations & team historian.

LET'S GO STREAKING: The Mets have won back-to-back games for the first time this season...The team has won three of their last four...New York is over .500 for the first time this season.

FOR PETE'S SAKE: Pete Alonso has homered in back-to-back games and three of his last four...His homer yesterday was his 57th career in Interleague Play, the ninth-most in major league history...His 57 Interleague homers are the second-most in the majors since 2019, trailing only Aaron Judge (58)... Alonso is batting .292 (7-24) with six runs, two doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI, six walks with a .433 OBP, a .750 SLG and a 1.183 OPS in seven games this year...His 10 RBI so far this season are tied for the third-most by a Met through their first seven games played of the season (also: Alonso, 2022, Wright 2006, Piazza 2001 and Henderson 1978).

SHUT UP: Yesterday, the Mets recorded their first shutout of the season... Last year, the team did not record a shutout until their 92nd game (7/11 vs. Washington)...Their 10 shutouts since July 11, 2024 are tied with Milwaukee and Tampa Bay for the second-most in the majors during that span.

HERE'S THE PITCH: The Mets sport a 2.03 ERA (14 ER/62.0 IP) this season... That places them third in the majors and in the Senior Circuit...Only the Padres (1.65 ERA) and Dodgers (2.00 ERA) have a lower mark...This includes a 2.48 ERA (10 ER/36.1 IP) from the starting staff and a 1.40 ERA (4 ER/25.2 IP) from the relief staff...The Mets bullpen is second in the majors with a 1.40 ERA...Only the Padres (0.60 ERA) have a lower mark.

IN THE CITI: The Mets are 1-0 at Citi Field this year... New York finished the 2024 season going 46-35 at home, including a 46-34 record at Citi Field (one home game in London)...The Mets went 33-12 at Citi Field from June 12 until the end of the season...The team lost consecutive games at home only three times in that period...New York posted a 3.57 ERA at home, which was sixth in the majors and fourth in the NL...The Mets went 43-38 at Citi Field in 2023, posting a 3.89 ERA.

THEY'RE OUT OF OUR LEAGUE: This year marked the first time in franchise history that the Mets open their home and road schedule against an Interleague Opponent...The Mets are 2-2 in Interleague Play this season... The team went 24-22 in Interleague play last year...Overall, New York owns a 280-278 record in Interleague play.

ALWAYS JUAN: Juan Soto has safely reached base in all seven games with the Mets this season...He is sporting a .387 OBP with three extra-base hits, three RBI and six walks.

Jays in New York from September 1, 1997 - May 15, 2018...Since then, the team is 3-5 against the Jays in NYC.

MAX POWER: Max Kranick has retired 17 of the 18 batters he has faced this season...He retired his first 12 batters of the season before allowing a single to Vladimir Guerrero Jr. with one out in the eighth inning yesterday...Kranick has extended his career-high scoreless streak to 10.2 innings (since: 5/7/22).

WE FOUND NIMMO: Brandon Nimmo has safely reached base in each of his first seven games of the season...He is 7-27 with three runs, one double, two homers, four RBI, two walks and an .829 OPS.

KIDS OPENING DAY: Tomorrow, Sunday, April 6, will be Kids Opening Day, with all kids in attendance having the opportunity to enjoy pre-game entertainment at Mets Plaza beginning at 11:10 a.m...Citi Field will introduce Family Sundays, which will feature a ticket offer for four starting at \$50, with pre-game entertainment on Mets Plaza and family-focused activities throughout the ballpark.

WE REMEMBER: The New York Mets announced that the team will wear a tribute uniform patch all season long to honor Mets Hall of Famer Ed Kranepool...Kranepool passed away on September 8, 2024, at age 79... Kranepool played for the Mets from 1962-1979, spending his entire 18-year career with the Mets...He was a member of the 1969 Miracle Mets, a 1965 All-Star and the club's all-time leader in games played...Kranepool remains in the Mets all-time top 10 in many statistical categories including plate appearances, hits, at-bats, total bases, doubles, RBI, walks and runs scored... He was inducted into the Mets Hall of Fame in 1990.

FIRST TIMES: Made his New York Mets debut on March 29 at Houston and he pitched 5.2 innings, gave up four hits, issued two walks, gave up two runs and struck out four in the Mets' 2-1 loss.

**GRIFFIN FANNING:** During Spring Training, he struck out 22 batters over his 14.1 innings of work, highlighted by his nine strikeouts in 4.2 innings vs. Tampa Bay on March 17...His 22 strikeouts ranked ninth in the Grapefruit League and tied for the 17th-most across the majors...Canning finished the spring with an impressive 1.88 ERA (3 ER/14.1 IP) and a K/9.0IP of 13.8...In his last two major league seasons Canning has recorded 130 and 139 strikeouts respectively.

**WORKHORSE:** Last season, he set a career-high with 31 starts and 171.2 innings pitched for the Angels and in 2023 he finished with 127.0 innings...He is just one of 51 pitchers to throw at least 125.0 innings in each of the past two seasons...In the last two seasons combined, Canning has thrown 298.2 innings which ranks 48th in the majors over that time.

**KEEP THE CHANGE:** Canning's changeup is one of his best pitches and last season it had a run value of four which ranked eighth in the majors...He threw his changeup 26.7% of the time and held his opponents to a .259 batting average against that pitch...He also generated a 28.8% whiff% on his changeup which was the 11th-highest clip in the majors...In his first start this season at Houston, he threw it 18.4% and it produced a 37.5 whiff% while picking up a strikeout with the pitch.

**STAY GOLDEN:** Canning was awarded the American League Rawlings Gold Glove in 2020, and he owns a career .951 fielding percentage...Last season he had a perfect fielding percentage on his 32 chances.

**WELCOME TO NEW YORK:** He signed a one-year contract with the Mets on December 19, 2024, and he had spent his entire five-year major league career with the Angels prior to signing with the Mets this past offseason...Canning owns a career 25-35 record with a 4.77 ERA (272 ER/513.2 IP) and 487 career strikeouts.

**CITI FIELD DEBUT:** Today Canning will make his Mets home debut, and prior to today he had only made one start at Citi Field when he was with the Angels...On August 27, 2023, he went seven innings struck out nine and only gave up one run in Queens...In his major league debut/home debut with the Angels on April 30, 2019, Canning also pitched against Toronto just as he will do with the Mets today.
