

RECENT REDBIRDS: After winning four of six on their road trip through Kansas City (2-0) and Cincinnati (2-2), the Cardinals return home to kick-off a seven-game homestand against the division-rival Milwaukee Brewers and Colorado Rockies...the Cardinals enter play today tied for 1st place in the NL Central (65-57, .5327), .005 pct. points ahead of Chicago (66-58, .5322)...The Cardinals are 21-13 since the All-Star Break, 4th-best winning percentage (.618) in the NL.

BINGE DRINKING: Starting tonight, St. Louis and Milwaukee face off in six of the next 10 games (Aug. 19-21 & Aug. 26-28 at Miller Park) bookending a four-game series against the Rockies during the Cardinals Hall of Fame and Players Weekends. The two Central Division rivals last faced each other four months ago in April, opening the season with 10 games over the Redbirds' first 24.

YOU WIN SOME, YOU LOSE SOME: Both St. Louis (April 17-present) and Milwaukee (March 30-April 16) have logged four-game win streaks in the season series. The last time St. Louis defeated Milwaukee in five straight was May 2-17, 2013.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Cardinals conclude the season by playing 24 of their final 41 games at Busch Stadium (including 15 of the next 18 games), where they are 34-23 with a .596 home win pct. ranking 4th in the NL. Only the Mets (55) have played fewer home games than St. Louis this season in all of Major League Baseball.

ZACH ATTACK: The Cardinals have had success against Zach Davies, highlighted by Matt Carpenter slashing .458/.536./1.000 (11-24) with three home runs, four doubles, four RBI and four walks in his career. Only Kyle Schwarber has homered (4) more off Davies, while Kris Bryant (16-47, .340) and former Cardinal Jedd Gyorko (13-21, .619) have more hits. Other notable Cardinals with success off Davies include Marcell Ozuna (7-18, .389/.450./444, 2B), Yadier Molina (6-19, .316, 2B) and Paul Goldschmidt (4-9, .444/.583./444).

TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS: The Cardinals are 31-22 in divisional play this season, and have won 15 of 21 over divisional opponents since the All-Star Break. Their .585 divisional winning pct. trails the Dodgers (.667, 36-18 vs. NL West) and Braves (.667, 32-21 vs. NL East) among NL teams.

GOLD STANDARD: Among Major Leagues with at least 150 career plate appearances vs. the Brewers, **Paul Goldschmidt** ranks 2nd all-time in MLB history in batting (.379, 77-203), on-base pct. (.484), and OPS (1.193), and 3rd in slugging. (.709).

WE'RE GOING STREAKING!!: Paul Goldschmidt (.472, 17-36) and Paul DeJong (.432, 16-27) are each riding nine-game hit streaks vs. Milwaukee this season (March 29-present), tying Joey Votto (June 22-July 24, 2019) for MLB's 2nd-Ion-gest active trailing only Dustin Pedroia's 11-gamer (5/17/08-5/11/17). The longest hit streak vs. the Brewers by a Cardinal is 19 shared by Allen Craig (April 13, 2013-July 13, 2014) and Albert Pujols (3/31/03-4/8/04). Marcell Ozuna (.338/.439/.632) has reached base safely in his last 19 games vs. Milwaukee since June 22, 2018 (longest by an active player). The Big Bear has also scored a run in his last nine games vs. the Brewers (March 29-present), which ties Scott Rolen (4/16/03-4/5/04) and Fernando Tatis (9/18/98-4/21/99) for longest by a Cardinal in history.

AND NOW, DEEP THOUGHTS: Paul Goldschmidt has hit six of his team-leading 28 home runs against the Brewers in 10 games this season. Goldy's six home runs against Milwaukee trail only Cincinnati's **Eugenio Suarez** (8 in 16 G) in MLB this season, and are tied for his 3rd-most vs. any opponent in a season (8 vs. the Dodgers in 2015; 7 vs. Pirates in 2019; 6 vs. the Dodgers in 2013). **Albert Pujols** holds the Cardinals single-season record of homers vs. the Brewers (8 in 2010).

BOMBS AWAY!: The Cardinals (20) and Brewers (25) have combined for 45 home runs through the first 10 games of their season series. St. Louis' single-season record of homers vs. the Brewers is 24 (2003 & 2018), while the Brewers already this season have matched their single-season homer high vs. St. Louis (2017). The Cardinals' high for homers against a single opponent this season is 25 off Pittsburgh (16 games).

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Paul DeJong graduated from nearby Antioch (III.) High School...resides in Hazelhurst, Wisc.

Marcell Ozuna was a Marlins teammate of Brewers outfielder Christian Yelich (2013-17).

Dexter Fowler and **Jordan Lyles** were traded for each other during the 2013-14 offseason (Dec. 3, 2013)...Colorado sent Fowler to Houston for Lyles and outfielder **Brandon Barnes**.

Yadier Molina hit his first Major League home run off Milwaukee's Matt Wise (Sept. 23, 2004).

Tyler Webb pitched for Brewers in two games in 2017...claimed off waivers by San Diego (April 2018). Cardinals Pitching Coach **Mike Maddux** previ-

ously served as the Brewers Pitching Coach from 2003-08...oversaw Brewers staff that ranked 2nd in the NL with a 3.85 ERA in 2008, lowest mark by a Milwaukee club in 16 years, en-route to securing the Brewers' first postseason berth in 26 years.

Devin Williams was born in Florissant, Mo. and resides in Maryland Heights...was First Team Rawlings/Perfect Game Preseason High School All-American as a senior at Hazelwood West High School in 2013...committed to the University of Missouri before being selected by Milwaukee in the 2nd round of the 2013 MLB Draft.

Cardinals Hall of Famer, broadcaster and Special Assistant **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Cardinals Director of Medical Operations/Head Athletic Trainer **Adam Olsen** is a native of Green Bay, Wisc...earned his Master's in Physical Therapy from The University of Wisconsin–Madison.

Cardinals Special Assistant to the GM, Player Procurement **Matt Slater** started in professional baseball serving as the Brewers' Scouting and Player Development Assistant (1991). Cardinals Hall of Fame catcher **Ted Simmons** played 13 seasons with St. Louis (1968-80), where he was a six-time NL All-Star and 1980 Silver Slugger Award winner...later traded by St. Louis with pitchers **Rollie Fingers** and **Pete Vuckovich** to Milwaukee for outfielders **David Green** and **Sixto Lezcano** and pitchers **Dave LaPoint** and **Lary Sorensen**...played five seasons with the Brewers (1981-85), where he was a twotime AL All-Star and faced off against the Cardinals in the 1982 World Series.

Brewers broadcaster **Bob Uecker** played two seasons (1964-65) with St. Louis...won the 1964 World Series...originally traded by the Milwaukee Braves to St. Louis for catcher **Jimmie Coker** and outfielder **Gary Kolb** (April 9, 1964).

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

- Rookie right-hander makes his 25th career start (52nd appearance) in tonight's start
- Leads all Major League rookies with 11 wins and is T6th in the National League.
- His team-leading 11 victories makes him the first Cardinals rookie to lead the Cardinals in that category since Matt Morris (12, 1997).
- Is 7-4 on the road this season, his seven road wins at T2nd among N.L. pitchers.
- Is 9-3 over his last 16 starts since May 18, tied for 2nd-most wins among National League pitchers with Clayton Kershaw (9-2) trailing only Washington's Stephen Strasburg (12-2).
- Since Ground Ball Pct. became a recorded stat in 1987, currently has the 10th-best single-season mark (57.5) in Cardinals history and lowest since Jaime García (57.9) in 2016.

LAST TIME OUT

• Pitched 6.0 scoreless innings, scattering five hits, dueling the Royals' Brad Keller (who had a no-hitter through 6.0 IP), in a game the Cardinals rallied to win 6-0. Was his second and longest scoreless start of the season (4.2 IP vs. LAD, 4/9) and his 7th road win of the season, T2nd in the National League.
