**TODAY'S GAME:** SF wraps this three-game series with Miami this afternoon looking to take the series after dropping last night's contest by a run.

- ▶ The Giants have lost 11 of their last 18 games dating to August 11 after last night's loss to once again drop them a game under .500 entering play today.
- ▶ SF remains is 6.5 back of the Braves (74-62) for the final Wild Card spot with the Mets (72-64), Cubs (70-66) and Cardinals (68-68) in between...per *FanGraphs*, SF's playoff chances are now 1.1%.
- ▶ The Giants are 10-6 in rubber games this season.

**ROSTER MOVES:** With rosters expanding to 28 today, **RHP Tristan Beck** was returned from his rehab assignment and activated from the 60-day IL...**C/OF Blake Sabol** has also been recalled from Triple-A Sacramento.

**PEDIATRIC CANCER AWARENESS DAY:** Today is Pediatric Cancer Awareness Day presented by Toyota and supported by UCSF Health.

- ▶ The Giants will be joined by 350 guests, including patients and their families and oncology nurses and doctors, for the game...guests will represent more than 10 hospitals and nonprofit organizations that support kids in their battle with cancer.
- ▶ The Giants will host a special pregame ceremony and a number of activations throughout the game - including the replacement of traditional player scoreboard headshots with versions hand-drawn by current pediatric cancer patients - to help raise awareness.
- ▶ Along with all of MLB, both teams and on-field personnel will wear gold ribbon decals and wristbands. Kids facing a cancer diagnosis will participate in numerous pregame experiences including First Pitch, Honorary Captain, Game Ball Delivery, Play Ball and more.

**IT AIN'T EASY:** The Giants have the second-toughest remaining schedule in MLB in terms of their opponents' combined win%...SF's remaining opponents have a .547 win%, which trails only the Rockies (.553).

**GO FISH:** Since the start of the 2018 season, the Giants have won each of their last five home series vs. Miami, going 12-6 with 11 of 18 games being decided by one run (*Stats, LLC*).

- ▶ **OF Michael Conforto** has 21 homers, a .956 OPS and 60 RBI in 95 career games vs. Miami, which rank sixth, fifth and tied for seventh (respectively) among active players (min. 150 plate appearances).

**OUT THE GATE:** Giants starters as a unit have a 3.70 ERA (99er, 241.0ip) since July 9...the 3.70 ERA in that time is fifth-best in the Majors but second-best in the National League behind the Brewers (3.46) in that span.

**WEBBMASTER:** National League innings leader **RHP Logan Webb** takes the hill this afternoon for his 29th start of the season and his first against the Marlins since May 20 of last year here at Oracle.

- ▶ Webb has been terrific over his last six starts dating to July 31, posting a 1.70 ERA (8er, 42.1ip) with 35 strikeouts and an opponents batting average against of .171...Webb's 1.70 ERA in that time is third-lowest in the NL behind PHI's Zack Wheeler (1.62) and teammate **LHP Blake Snell** (1.64).
- ▶ At home this year, Webb is 7-3 with a 2.26 ERA (23er, 91.2ip) and has allowed a mere two runs over his last 31.2 innings here (0.85 ERA) spanning four starts dating to July 31...the Giants as team are 9-4 in his 13 starts at home this year and 5-2 in his last seven starts at home dating to June 12.

**WE STAN:** **RHP Tristan Beck** returns to the Major League roster today after missing the club's first 137 games of the year recovering from surgery to remove an aneurysm from his upper right arm that was found during Spring Training.

- ▶ Beck had the surgery on March 4 at the nearby Stanford Medical Center performed by Dr. Jason Lee.
- ▶ He's made five rehab starts for Triple-A Sacramento, logging a 7.90 ERA (12er, 13.2ip) with 17 strikeouts and three walks.
- ▶ The 28-year-old appeared in 33 games (three starts) for the Giants last year posting a 3.92 ERA and came into this season poised for a role on the MLB roster before his injury popped up during Spring Training.

**BE A GOLDFISH:** The Giants finished above .500 in August at 14-13...they did so in spite of a tough month at the plate.

**SEPTEMBER 1, 1947** - In a 2-1 win against the Boston Braves, the Giants' **Jack Lohrke** homered to set a season record for home runs by a club. The Giants had then hit 183 home runs, topping the 182 hit by the 1936 Yankees. They would end the season with 221 round trippers.

**HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR:** Earned his first career All-Star selection, joining **OF Heliot Ramos** as the two Giants in the Mid-summer Classic...Webb became the first homegrown (drafted and developed) Giants pitcher to be named to an All-Star Game since **LHP Madison Bumgarner** was selected to the team in 2016.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor in the decision last Tuesday at Milwaukee in SF's 5-4 win over the Brewers...threw just 5.0 innings and allowed four runs on four hits with three walks and four strikeouts...gave up two homers in the outing, his first game allowing multiple homers since July 17, 2023 at Cincinnati.

**SIX PACK:** Over his last six outings dating to July 31, Webb has allowed a combined eight runs over 42.1 innings (1.70 ERA) with 35 strikeouts and a .171 opposing average (26x152) to go with his 4-0 record in that stretch...his 1.70 ERA since July 31 is third-best in the NL behind PHI's Zack Wheeler (1.62) and teammate **LHP Blake Snell** (1.64).

**VS. MIAMI:** Will be facing the Marlins for the sixth time in his career...is 1-1 with a 2.67 ERA (9er, 30.1ip) and 30 strikeouts in the five starts...here at Oracle Park, Webb is 1-0 in three starts, two of which were scoreless, and allowed just one run over 19.0 innings (0.47 ERA) with 12 hits (.188 average) and 18 strikeouts.

**ON THE LEADERBOARDS:** Webb leads all NL pitchers in innings this season at 177.2 and ranks second in MLB, just behind KC's Seth Lugo (179.0ip)...the right-hander also ranks among the top of MLB leaderboards in FIP (2.92, 3rd), fWAR (3.9, 6th), quality starts (18, T-7th) and ERA (3.24, 14th).

**DADDY LONG LEGS:** Webb has finished at least 7.0 innings on 15 different occasions so far this season, most of any pitcher in the Majors...only three other Giants starters this year have finished 7.0 innings (**Blake Snell** (4x), **Jordan Hicks** on April 5 vs. SD and **Kyle Harrison** on May 7 at COL).

**KILLA WHALE:** Is making his 14th start at home this season and is 7-3 with a 2.26 ERA (23er, 91.2ip) in his previous 13 starts at Oracle in 2024...his 2.26 ERA at home ranks as the fifth-best figure among qualified pitchers...the Giants have gone 9-4 in Webb's 13 starts here this year and are 40-18 in his 58 regular season starts in this ballpark since the beginning of 2021...Webb in that span is 29-15 with a 2.38 ERA (99er, 374.2ip) and three complete games (two shutouts).

**KEEP 'EM IN THE YARD:** With two homers in his last start, Webb snapped a streak of 43.1 innings without giving up a homer that dated to July 20 at Colorado...still, Webb has given up just nine homers this season (third-fewest among qualified pitchers) and has surrendered a total of four homers over his past 12 starts (78.1ip)...Webb's 0.46 HR/9ip this season is currently a career-best and leads all active pitchers, just ahead of ATL's Chris Sale (0.47) and PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (0.47).

**BOOTS ON THE GROUND:** Through 28 starts this year Webb owns a 56.5% ground ball rate, fourth-best in the Majors behind HOU's Framber Valdez (60.4%), PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (59.8%) and ATL's Max Fried (57.8%)...he leads the Majors with 299 produced ground balls this season.

**FIRST IMPRESSIONS:** Has a 4.50 ERA (14er, 28.0ip) and .257 opposing average in the 1st inning this season...in all other innings, Webb has a 3.01 ERA (50er, 149.2ip) and is holding batters to a .250 clips with 121 strikeouts.

**THE LONG GAME:** Since the start of 2022, Webb has thrown 586.0 innings, most in the Majors in that time ahead of Aaron Nola (565.0), Corbin Burnes (560.0) and Miles Mikolas (553.1).
