TODAY'S GAME: With a series victory secured after an 8-6 win last night, the Giants can sweep this three-game series with a victory this afternoon to end the road trip on a higher note than it began.

- ► SF is 3-6 heading into the final game of its 10-game trip (1-2 in Boston, 0-4 in Philadelphia and 2-0 so far here in Denver).
- ▶ Day games have typically brought out the best of the Giants so far this season as the club is 9-6 in day games and 8-15 in night games...SF is averaging 4.5 runs/game during the daytime compared to 3.4 runs/game in night games.
- ▶ The Giants enter today's game having won consecutive games for the first time since April 22-23 vs. the Mets... SF has not won three in a row yet in 2024, one of two MLB teams that has yet to do so...the other team is the Rockies, who haven't won consecutive games all season.
- Arizona was in the same boat as the Giants and Rockies but they won their third straight last night.

YEAH HAR, WE'RE IN THE ROCKIES: Since 2021, the Giants are 20-8 vs. the Rockies at Coors Field with a +58 run differential.

- ► The Giants are 19-4 in their last 23 games against Colorado (regardless of venue) dating to August 21, 2022.
- ► The last time SF swept a three-game series here at Coors was last June, doing so June 6-8.
- ▶ In 53 overall games against the Rockies since 2021 the Giants are 40-13 with a +120 run differential...SF's .755 winning percentage vs. Colorado since 2021 is tops in the Majors for any team against a single opponent (min. 30 games played).

MORE...MORE!: SF snapped its 11-game streak where they'd scored four or fewer runs by scoring five in Tuesday night's win...they followed it up by scoring eight runs last night.

- It's the third time the Giants have scored five or more runs in consecutive games this season...the other two times were March 29 and 30 at SD(eight and nine runs, respectively) and April 22-23 vs. NYM (five runs apiece).
- ▶ Even with the last two games, the Giants are still slashing .228/.294/.341 over their last 13 games dating to April 24...in that span they are averaging 3.08 runs/game in that stretch, scoring 40 runs in 13 games.
- ► The 3.08 runs/game in that time is third-worst in the Majors ahead of only the Pirates (2.29) and Reds (2.85).
- ▶ Last night's win brought the Giants to 10-0 this season when scoring five or more runs...the Giants are the only team the Majors without a loss when scoring five or more runs this season.

WALK THE LINE: RHP Ryan Walker tossed another scoreless inning last night, lowering his ERA to 2.25.

 Over his last 10 games dating to April 18, Walker has pitched 10.0 scoreless innings, allowed three hits, walked one and struck out 18.

WINNDOW OF OPPORTUNITY: RHP Keaton Winn gets the ball in the final game of this trip and is looking to bounce back from a rough start on Saturday in Philadelphia.

- Winn could not escape the first inning at Citizens Bank Park amidst rainy conditions following an hour delay...he threw 39 pitches in the first inning, recording only two outs and allowing five runs on four hits with two walks.
- ▶ Prior to that outing, Winn pitched to a 1.96 ERA (5er, 23.0ip) in his previous four outings with the Giants going 3-1 in that stretch.
- ▶ The 26-year-old isn't unfamiliar with Coors Field having made one start here last year...he allowed three runs on three hits over 4.0 innings on September 16 in SF's 9-5 loss to the Rockies.

WADE AND SEE: IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr. is slashing .341/.472/.427 with four doubles, one homer and 12 RBI in 36 games so far this season...his .472 on-base percentage is best in MLB (min. 100 PA) while his .341 average is seventh-best.

- ▶ Wade has a 19.8% walk rate, also tops in the Majors min. 100 PA ahead of PHI's Bryce Harper (16.9%) and TB's Richie Palacios (16.8%).
- ▶ Lastly, Wade enters today with a 170 wRC+, seventh-best in the National League.

POP TARTS: OF Michael Conforto hit his team-leading sixth homer yesterday with his solo shot in the second inning...out of SF's 33 total homers as a team, which are 21st of 30 MLB teams, 21 of them have been solo shots (64%).

Six of the Giants last eight homers have been solo shots dating to April 28.

WE'RE GOING HOME!: Today's game marks the final game of SF's longest road trip of the year (10 games and 11 days)... after today's game the Giants will fly back to San Francisco where they'll open up a nine-game homestand over 10 days against the Reds (Friday-Sunday), Dodgers (Monday-Wednesday) and Rockies (May 17-19).

- ▶ The Giants are 9-7 at Oracle Park this year and are 2-0-1 in their last three series there.
- ▶ During the homestand, SF will enjoy an off day on May 16 to end a run of 16 straight games from April 29-May 15.

IT'S IOWA: The rookie made his first career Opening Day roster and is slated to face the Rockies for the second time in his young career...Winn was selected by the Giants in the fifth round (136th overall) of the 2018 draft out of Iowa Western Community College and made his debut last season.

LAST TIME OUT: Made the shortest outing of his career on Saturday at Philadelphia...threw 0.2 innings in the rain and had his start cut short after giving up five runs on four hits with two walks...did not strike out a batter for the first time in his MLB career (16g) and suffered the loss in the start....Winn became the first Giants starter to throw 0.2 innings or less and allow at least five earned runs since LHP Erik Surkamp on September 24, 2011 at Arizona (0.2ip, 3h, 6r, 6er)

VS. COLORADO: Has faced the Rockies twice in his career, going 1-0 with a 5.40 ERA (6er, 10.0ip) in the two starts...the right-hander struck out 14 and limited opponents to a .216 clip in those outings...his last start against Colorado came on September 16, 2023 here at Coors Field, when he held the Rockies to three hits and three runs over 4.0 innings.

IN THE FAST LANE: Batters are just 3-for-26 (.115) with 10 strike-outs off his four-seam fastball this season...Winn's .115 opposing average with the four-seamer is third-lowest in MLB among starters who've thrown at least 100 four-seamers...more specifically over his last five starts dating to April 12 in Tampa, Winn has held opponents hitless in 18 at-bats ending with the pitch while striking out eight batters in 19 plate appearances.

BANANA SPLIT: Winn's trademark is his splitter, which he's been using 42.2% of the time this season...12 of his 28 strikeouts this season have come off the pitch and he's limiting opponents to a .218 (12x55) clip with just three extra-base hits (.327 SLG)... Winn's 42.2% splitter usage this season is the highest of any starting pitcher in MLB.

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 19...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- Four of his six outings with SF have been scoreless.
- ▶ The 6'11" right-hander is tied for the tallest pitcher in MLB history with RHP Jon Rauch.

#77 LUKE JACKSON > RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball **Last Game:** 5/6 at PHI; 1.1ip, h, bb, k (21 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 22...he suffered a low back strain on Opening Day against the Padres back on March 28.

- ► In 10 appearances at Triple-A (all in relief), Rodríguez had a 1.69 ERA (2er, 10.2ip) with 10 strikeouts and four walks...batters were hitting .184 off him to start the year.
- ▶ Had a 4.37 ERA in 45 appearances last year between Double-A Richmond (2.97 ERA in 16 games) and Triple-A Sacramento (5.73 ERA in 27 appearances).
- ▶ Has allowed only 13 homers in 261.2 career minor league innings.
- Originally signed by SF as a non-drafted free agent on July 2, 2017 out of the Dominican Republic.
