RAY REPORT—The Rays conclude a six-game road trip against the White Sox (3-0) and Pirates (1-1, one to play) with this afternoon's rubber match at PNC Park...will return to Tropicana Field for a six-game homestand against the Reds and Twins starting tomorrow night...have won seven of their last eight games and are 10-3 in their last 13 on the heels of a 2-5 start...are 4-1 on a stretch of 27 games in 28 days from April 14–May 13, with the lone off day coming on April 23...lead the AL with a .600 (12-8) winning pct., tied for sixth in the majors...marks their best start since 2023 (17-3) and ties the fifth-best start in franchise history...have a half-game lead over the second-place Yankees (12-9) in the AL East, holding sole possession of first in each of the last five days...have spent six days in first, five in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth.

- ★ The Rays trailed by four runs in the 4th inning, rallied for five runs in the 5th following a two-hour, 27-minute rain delay, and ultimately prevailed, 8-7, in 13 innings during yesterday's marathon win...the time from first pitch to final out was six hours, 39 minutes...it was their fifth last at-bat win, tying the Yankees for the major league lead.
- ★ The four-run deficit was their largest overcome in victory since June 18, 2025 vs. BAL (trailed 8-0, won 12-8) and largest on the road since June 13, 2025 at NYM (trailed 5-1, won 7-5)...it was their third win this season after trailing by multiple runs, joining April 6 vs. CHC (trailed 2-0, won 6-4) and April 10 vs. NYY (trailed 2-0, won 5-3).
- ★ The Rays have left 33 runners on base over their last three games, their second most in any three-game span over the last four seasons (2023-26), trailing July 3-5, 2024 (34)...their 160 LOB are fourth most in MLB behind the Astros (173), Pirates (172), and Mariners (166) despite their .292 (96-for-329) average with men on base ranking second to the Tigers (.292) by percentage points.
- ★ The Rays have scored first only three times in their last 12 games, including none of their last three contests, despite a 9-3 record in that span...their AL-most seven comeback wins are fifth most in the majors, and they are the only AL team and one of five MLB clubs that has posted a winning record (6-5) in games their opponent scored first, joining the Diamondbacks (9-3), Dodgers (6-3), Brewers (8-6), and Braves (4-3).
- ★ The Rays have not committed an error in six of their last seven games...they led the majors with 17 errors across their first 13 games (Opening Day–April 10).

WHAT'S AT STAKE

- ★ Win three consecutive series for the first time since May 19-28, 2025 (HOU, TOR, MIN).
- ★ Claim three straight road series wins for the first time since April 22–May 15, 2025 (four straight).
- ★ Record their fifth straight series win over the Pirates and improve to 6-4-0 vs. Pittsburgh in series play...avoid their first series loss to the Pirates since June 27-29, 2017 at PNC Park...win back-to-back series in this venue for the first time.
- ★ Improve to 12-3 in their last 15 meetings with the Pirates dating back to June 24, 2022.
- ★ Start 13-8 (or better) through 21 games for the fifth time, joining 2023 (18-3), 2019 (14-7), 2012 (13-8), and 2010 (16-5)...match 2012 for the fourth-best start in franchise history.

ALL HANDS ON DECK—Yesterday's 13-inning affair was the Rays longest game by innings since April 16, 2024 vs. LAA (13 inn., 7-6 W) and longest on the road since May 20, 2022 at BAL (13 inn., 8-6 L)...they also played a 15-inning contest in Game 2 of the 2023 AL Wild Card Series at CLE (1-0 L)...at four hours, 12 minutes, it was their longest game by time since MLB introduced the pitch clock in 2023, surpassing Sept. 5, 2023 vs. BOS (3:57), and longest overall since the aforementioned May 2022 game at BAL (4:22)...the Rays used 22 players, including all 13 position players and all eight relievers in their bullpen...it was their second time using 22 players since 26-man rosters were introduced in 2020, joining Sept. 27, 2022 at CLE...they used nine pitchers for the 11th time—this excludes the eight times they met that mark from Sept. 1 on prior to the 2020 season, when expanded September rosters were reduced from 40 players to 28.

- ★ Between **Chandler Simpson** and **Junior Caminero** (both 2-for-7), the Rays had multiple hitters record 7 AB (or more) for the first time since June 27, 2019 at MIN in an 18-inning, 5-hour, 42-minute affair (**Travis d'Arnaud**, **Yandy Diaz**, **Avisail Garcia**, **Austin Meadows**, **Tommy Pham**).
- ★ Rays relievers combined for 9.1 IP, their first time surpassing the 9.0-inning mark since Aug. 18, 2024 vs. AZ (10.0IP)...it was the second time in franchise history the bullpen eclipsed that mark while yielding 1 ER or fewer, joining the aforementioned 18-inning win at MIN (16.0IP, OER)...the pen's season-high 149 pitches were its most since Sept. 5, 2025 vs. CLE (152)...seven Rays relievers yielded 0 ER, most in a game since April 16, 2024 vs. LAA (7).
- ★ It marked the Rays third extra-inning win, second most in the majors to the Cardinals (4) and their most through 20 games of a season in club history.
- ★ With a runner on first and two outs in the 5th inning, the Rays recorded four straight hits en route to five runs, their most two-out RBI in a frame since April 6, 2024 at COL (5, 8th inn.)...the Rays .281 (66-for-235) average with two outs paces the AL.
- ★ The Rays used three pinch hitters and recorded two pinch-hit RBI courtesy of **Jonny DeLuca's** two-run double...the club has six pinch-hit RBI in its last four games vs. one in its first 16 games.
- ★ The Rays remained undefeated (4-0) when tied entering the 9th inning after going 7-13 last season...the four such victories lead the majors.

YANDY MAN CAN—**Yandy Diaz** singled in the 5th inning last night for his 910th hit with the Rays, tying **B.J. Upton** for fourth on the club's all-time hits list...with 102 HR, he is also two homers shy of matching seventh-ranked **Carl Crawford** (104HR) (see tables to the right)...Diaz has hit safely in 17 of the Rays 20 games and is batting .344 (11-for-32) with 2 2B, 1 HR, 6 RBI, and 5 BB over a season-high eight-game hitting streak...he has also reached base safely in 15 straight games (April 1–pres.) and 19 of the Rays 20 games overall...it ties **ATH Nick Kurtz** and **SEA Julio Rodriguez** for the longest active on-base streak in the AL...Diaz paces the AL in average (.354) and hits (28), ranks third in on-base pct. (.446), fifth in OPS (.978), and is tied for seventh in RBI (17).

- ★ From the 7th inning on, Diaz is batting an MLB-leading .591 (13-for-22)...he paces the majors with a .552 (16-for-29) average against relievers...he is also tied for second in the AL with a .500 (10-for-20) RISP average and is tied for sixth with a .261 (9-for-34) two-strike average.
- ★ Diaz has reached base safely 41 times, second in the majors to **HOU Yordan Alvarez** (48) and most in club history through the Rays first 20 games, surpassing **Evan Longoria** in 2012 and **Fred McGriff** in 1998 (both 38 TOB)...the record through 21 games was previously 40 TOB, shared by Longoria in 2012 and **Jonny Gomes** in 2006...with 10 games left, Diaz is on pace to reach safely 61 times by the end of April, which would best **Tommy Pham** (52) in 2019 for the most TOB over such a span in Rays history.
- ★ He is 15 hits shy of reaching 1,000 for his career, which would make him the 20th Cuban-born player in major league history to reach the milestone.

TRAVELING MAN—**Nick Fortes** has reached base safely in a career-high 14 straight road games dating back to Sept. 25, 2025, batting .378/.440/.489 (17-for-45) with 2 2B, 1 HR, and 7 RBI in that span...it marks the longest streak by a Ray since **Jonathan Aranda** (24G) from July 5, 2025–April 1, 2026 and longest by a primary catcher since **Wilson Ramos** (14G) from June 6–July 14, 2018...the only Tampa Bay backstop with a longer streak is **John Flaherty** (18G from June 4–July 24, 2002)...Fortes' streak is tied with **LAA Taylor Ward** for the third-longest active run in the AL behind **TEX Corey Seager** (19G) and **CWS Miguel Vargas** (18G).

SMALL BALL—The Rays pace the majors in contact rate (80.4%), singles (136), infield hits (33, per Baseball-Reference), ground-ball hits (75), and sacrifice hits (9, T1st with MIL) while ranking second in strikeout rate (18.43%) to the Blue Jays (18.41%)...they lead the AL in bunt hits (6) while ranking second in stolen bases (23)...they have gone from first to third or scored on singles 16 times, tied with the Mariners for second in the AL to the Tigers (20)...the Rays rank fourth in the AL/sixth in the majors with 1.7 BsR, an all-encompassing baserunning metric calculated by FanGraphs...they also pace the AL with 25 "productive outs," defined by Baseball-Reference as advancing any runner with none out or driving in a baserunner with the second out of an inning.

- ★ **Chandler Simpson** leads baseball with 11 infield hits while **Yandy Diaz** is tied for third in the AL with five...**Jonny DeLuca's** 5 RBI as a pinch hitter are the most in MLB, and he is one of two players in the AL with multiple hits as a pinch hitter (2-for-5) along with **HOU Joey Loperfido** (2-for-4).
- ★ Six Rays have recorded multiple stolen bases, tied with the Athletics for the most in the AL...six have tallied a hit as a pinch hitter, second most in MLB to the Rockies (8).
- ★ The Rays have won an AL-high-tying five games without the benefit of a home run, matching the Red Sox...they have scored five runs or more without homering an MLB-best six times and have scored only 25 of their 100 runs via their 17 HR...the club is undefeated (4-0) when out-homering opponents, but it also has a winning record (6-5) when being out-homered.

SUGAR SHANE—Shane McClanahan will toe the rubber for his fourth start of the season and third on the road...is seeking wins in back-to-back starts for the first time since he won three straight from June 5-16, 2023...missed the last two years after his second Tommy John surgery wiped out his 2024 season and nerve-related issues sidelined him for 2025...marks his 78th career start and 37th career road start...selected by the Rays in the Compensatory Round (31st overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of South Florida.

★ Was selected for the AL All-Star team in 2022 and 2023, earning a starting nod in the former season...joined **David Price** (2010) as the only Rays pitchers to start an All-Star Game...McClanahan and **Evan Longoria** (3x) are the only Rays players to earn All-Star nods in two of their first three major league seasons.

LAST TIME OUT—Earned his first win of the year after allowing three runs (2ER) on two hits (HR) and four walks with four strikeouts over 5.0 innings on April 14 at CWS...yielded two walks and a single through the first two scoreless frames...allowed two baserunners to reach base in the 3rd inning before **Everson Pereira** launched a three-run homer that shrunk the Rays 4-0 lead to 4-3...worked his way out of that inning and retired each of his final seven batters faced to get through the 5th.

BUCS ON BOTH SIDES—McClanahan will be starting opposite the Pirates for the third time in his career...in those two starts, he has gone 2-0 with a 1.38 ERA (13.0IP, 2ER) and 19 strikeouts to two walks.

★ Across nine career starts vs. NL Central opponents, he is 3-2 with a 1.66 ERA (54.1IP, 10ER), 11.26 SO per 9.0 IP, and a 0.88 WHIP...he has never allowed more than two earned runs in an outing against the division and has fanned seven or more batters in seven of the nine starts, six of which were quality.

★ Despite his success opposite the NL Central, the Rays have dropped two of his last three starts against the division.

LIMITING THE DAMAGE—McClanahan has surrendered just five hits in 47 at-bats, good for a .106 opp. batting average...min. 45 AB, that ranks third in the majors behind **TEX Jacob Latz** (.093) and **LAA Jose Soriano** (.104)...under the same parameters, his .170 opp. slugging pct. is fourth lowest, having allowed just one extra-base hit (HR) across his three starts.

STRIKEOUT ARTIST—With four strikeouts in his previous outing at CWS, McClanahan passed **Matt Garza** and **Ryan Yarbrough** for the 10th-most strikeouts in franchise history (469SO)...he is now 25 strikeouts from tying **Matt Moore** for ninth on the Rays all-time list and fourth among Tampa Bay lefties.

★ During his first three seasons (2021-23), McClanahan's 10.14 strikeouts per 9.0 IP ranked second among MLB left-handers (min. 400.0IP) behind **Blake Snell** (11.85)...under the same parameter, it was the second-highest mark by a southpaw through his first three major league campaigns, trailing SD/PIT **Oliver Pérez** (10.34)...his 456 career strikeouts were sixth-most by a left-hander in franchise history and were the most by any Ray through his first three seasons, regardless of handedness, outpacing **James Shields** (448, 2006-08) despite McClanahan (404.2IP) throwing 150 fewer innings than Shields (554.2IP).

★ Min. 1,000 BF, his 33.4 pct. whiff rate from 2021-23 ranked fourth in the majors behind **ATL Spencer Strider** (37.0%), **SD Blake Snell** (33.7%), and **MIL Corbin Burnes** (33.7%)...he led the majors with a 48.4 pct. whiff rate on his changeup in that span (min. 1,000 changeups thrown).

★ Min. 400.0 IP, his 3.02 ERA (404.2IP, 136ER) from 2021-23 ranked second in the AL to **LAA Shohei Ohtani** (2.84) and was second among all left-handed pitchers in the majors to **ATL Max Fried** (2.71).

THE ROAD BACK—McClanahan exited his start on Aug. 2, 2023 at Yankee Stadium with left forearm tightness and was placed on the 15-day IL the next day...he consulted with three doctors before opting for his second Tommy John surgery, performed by Dr. Keith Meister on Aug. 21, 2023 in Dallas, Tx...resumed throwing off the mound in August 2024 and faced live hitters at the Rays spring facility in Port Charlotte, Fla. the following month...entered the offseason fully healthy and began his usual spring build up...in his third Grapefruit League start, was removed with left triceps tightness, which was later diagnosed as nerve irritation...began the year on the 15-day IL and was moved to the 60-day IL on April 26...consulted with nerve specialist Dr. Gregory Paul in Dallas after feeling discomfort during his first full-distance bullpen session June 7...resumed throwing progression shortly after the visit...made three rehab starts between the FCL Rays (July 8) and Triple-A Durham (July 8 & 13)...was pulled from his rehab assignment on July 22 with biceps tendinitis...underwent radial nerve decompression surgery on his left triceps Aug. 11, performed by Dr. Steven Shin in Los Angeles, officially ending his hopes of a 2025 return.
