TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Giants finish a three-game set today with the seventh and final meeting between the clubs this season...The teams will not meet again until next April 17-19, when the Giants will return for three games here at SunTrust Park.

A The Braves have won eight of the last nine games with San Francisco after taking the first two games of this series and winning three-of-four games in San Francisco, May 20-23...They have outscored the Giants, 35-12, this season after last night's 8-1 win.

A Friday night's series-opening victory also ensured the Braves the season set with San Francisco, and Atlanta has not lost the season series with the Giants for the last three seasons...They went 4-3 in 2017 and 3-3 last season.

A The Braves are looking to sweep a series from the Giants for the second consecutive season; they took all three games at San Francisco last year, September 10-12...They have not swept the Giants in Atlanta since winning all three games here in May of 2000.

A LHP Dallas Keuchel is set for his third career game, all starts, against San Francisco...The lefty is 0-1 with a 4.09 ERA (5 ER/11.0 IP) in his two starts against the Giants, last facing them in 2018 when he went 6.0 innings and allowed one run, earned, in a 2-1 Astros win.

A RHP Logan Webb has never faced Atlanta...The rookie is 1-1 with 7.79 ERA (15 ER/17.1 IP) in four road starts to start his career...He has yet to complete 6.0 innings in any of his first six career games.

100 WINS?: The Braves won their 96th game of the season last night, and need to go 4-2 or better over their final six games to reach triple-digit victories in a single season for the ninth time in franchise history and for the first time since 2003.

A The 2003 club went 101-61 on their way to a five-game NLDS loss to Chicago...It marked the team's second-consecutive season of 100 wins; the 2002 also won 101 games.

A The Braves won triple digits in three consecutive seasons from 1997-1999, while the '93 went 104-58.

A The other two 100-win seasons came prior to the modern era in 1892 (102-48) and 1898 (102-47).

A Atlanta is currently 3.5 games behind Los Angeles (NL) for the top seed in the league.

A One more win would give the Braves their most single-season victories since that 2003 team won 101.

ATTENDANCE: The Braves and Giants drew 40,899 fans last night, Atlanta's 17th sellout of the season.

A The Braves are 12-5 in home sellouts this year.

VS. BOCHY: The Braves are set to face San Francisco manager Bruce Bochy for the final time today, as the 64-year-old is set to retire at the end of the season.

A The Braves are 110-86 (.561) against Bochy during his 25-year career, including 3-7 in two postseason series.

A Bochy went 39-65 against the Braves while with San Diego, but led the Padres to a 4-2 NLCS victory in 1998.

A He then joined San Francisco in 2007, and led the Giants to a 45-47 record over Atlanta since then... San Francisco beat the Braves, 3-1, in the 2010 NLDS.

THE ROTATION: LHP Max Fried tossed 5.1 shutout innings last night, earning his 17th win of the season, the most by an Atlanta pitcher since Tim Hudson also won 17 games in 2010...Hall-of-Famer Tom Glavine was the last Braves southpaw to win 17 games, when he recorded 18 victories in 2002.

A The Braves have used the same five starting pitchers for the past 45 games, and the rotation has compiled a NL-best 23-9 (.719) record and a 3.37 ERA.

A The ERA is also the fourth best mark in baseball, trailing only St. Louis, Cleveland and New York (NL).

50 WINS AT HOME: The Braves won their 50th home game of the season last night...They last won 50 home games in a season in 2003, when that club went 56-25 at Turner Field, tying the single-season record for most home wins...They also won 56 games in 1996, 1998 and 1999.

A The Braves are one of just six teams in the majors to win at least 50 games at home this season...The Dodgers and Cubs are the only other NL clubs to do so.

RUNS: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. scored once yesterday, giving him 127 runs this season and moving him within four of tying the franchise modern-era record for a single season...OF Dale Murphy had 131 in 1983.

A Acuña Jr. has the fourth most runs in a single season in the franchise's modern era.

A Third place is Hank Aaron, who had 127 in 1962... Rafael Furcal is in second place with 130 in 2003.

40-40?: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. needs three steals to become the fifth player in baseball history to collect a 40-homer, 40-steal season.

A OF José Canseco was the first player to go 40-40, reaching 42 home runs and 40 steals in 1988...Barry Bonds then matched those numbers in 1996, while Alex Rodríguez had 42 homers and 46 steals in 1998...Alfonso Soriano then had 46 and 41 in 2006.

A Prior to Acuña Jr., those four players were the only ones to go 40/35...Bonds did it twice, going 40/37 in 1997, a year after his 42/40 season.

Today's Game

- A* Makes his 18th start of the season and the 201st of his career...Is his 210th career appearance.
- A* Since his season debut on June 21 has induced 15 double plays, most in the National League and second most in the majors...The White Sox' Ivan Nova has 16.
- A* Keuchel has 190 ground balls against him since his debut this season, easily most in the majors...Oakland's Brett Anderson has 166 ground balls in that span to rank second.
- A* The closest National League pitcher, Philadelphia's Aaron Nola, has 150, 40 fewer ground balls than Keuchel.
- A* Set for his 10th start of the season at home, and is 4-2 with a 2.72 ERA in his first nine turns...Is 4-4 with a 4.76 ERA (24 ER/45.1 IP) in eight starts on the road.
- A* Seven of his eight turns at SunTrust Park have been quality starts, and Atlanta is 6-3 as a team when he starts here.
- A* Has made one Sunday start at SunTrust Park and beat the Marlins, 4-3, on July 7th...Allowed five hits and two runs in 7.1 innings in Atlanta's final game before the All-Star break.
- A* Faces San Francisco for just the second time in his career, and for the first time this season...Is 0-1 with a 4.09 ERA (5 ER/11.0 IP) in his first two games.
- A* Pitched against them once last season while with Houston, August 7 at San Francisco...Allowed three hits and one run in 6.0 innings, taking a no-decision in Houston's 2-1 win.
- A* Is allowing opponents to bat .262 (102-for-389) against him on the season, with a .333 on-base percentage and .416 slugging.
- A* With runners in scoring position, is holding opponents to a .181/.299/.349 line, with 15 hits in 83 at-bats...Opponents are batting .099 points lower with runners in scoring position than they are with no one on base (.280, 60-for-214).
- A* In 42 opponent at-bats with runners in scoring position and two outs, has allowed just eight hits (.190) and 10 RBI.

2019 Recap

- A* Lost his last start, 9/17 vs. PHI, to stop a streak of five consecutive starts in which he won.
- A* Allowed just four earned runs during the stretch, pitching to a 1.16 ERA (4 ER/31.0 IP)...Struck out 28 in 31 innings.
- A* Won five consecutive starts for the first time in his career...Had previously won four straight on five occasions, last in 2018...No Braves starter has won six straight turns since Kris Medlen in 2012, and no Atlanta lefty has done so since Mike Hampton in 2003.
- A* Started, 8/20 vs. MIA, and allowed six hits and one run over 6.0 innings to earn his fourth win of the season.
- A* Struck out opposing pitcher Elieser Hernandez leading off the third inning for the 1,000th strikeout of his major league career.
- A* Became the 49th active pitcher to have 1,000 career strikeouts, and the second on the Braves staff (Julio Teheran).
- A* Pitched against the Mets, 8/14 at SunTrust Park, and tossed 6.0 scoreless innings.
- A* With that start, has pitched against 27 of the 30 major league clubs...Has never faced either Atlanta or Houston, the two teams he has played for, and the Los Angeles Dodgers.
- A* Started, 7/23 vs. KC, and logged his sixth career double-digit strikeout game...Fanned 12 Royals over 6.0 innings, one off his career high.
- A* The last Atlanta pitcher to fan more batters in a single start was Kris Medlen, who struck out 13 Nationals over 7.0 innings on September 14, 2012.
- A* Beat the Padres on 7/12, allowing just six hits and one run over 7.0 innings.
- A* Earned the win in Atlanta's final start before the All-Star break, 7/7 vs. MIA, and in Atlanta's first game after the break, 7/12 at SD...Became the third Braves pitcher to start and win consecutive regular season games for the Braves in the modern era (since 1900) and the first since Johnny Sain on 9/6 and 9/11/48.
- A* Pitched at least 7.0 innings in each his three starts from 7/2-12, going 2-1 with a 2.11 ERA (5 ER/21.1 IP) in that span.
- A* Was the first Atlanta starter to pitch at least 7.0 innings in three consecutive turns since 2017, when Jaime García did so from 5/31 to 6/11.
- A* Signed by the Braves to a one-year major league contract on 6/7...Was recalled to Atlanta on 6/21.
- A* Became the first former Cy Young winner to join Atlanta midseason since the Braves acquired reliever Mark Davis from the Kansas City Royals in 1992.

Career Recap

- A* Selected by the Houston Astros in the seventh round of the 2009 First-Year Player Draft...Signed by Jim Stevenson.
- A* Is a four-time Rawlings Gold Glove Award winner (2014-16, 18), two-time American League All-Star (2015, 2017) and the 2015 AL Cy Young Award winner. Has pitched in parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues (2012-18).

Saves/Opp: 1/1 **Holds:** 8 **1st Batter/Retired:** 41/33 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 21/6

- Is 1-0 with 3.60 ERA (12 ER/30.2 IP) in 41 games with Atlanta...Thirty-four of his 41 appearances have been scoreless, including 21 of his last 25.
- Converted his first save chance of the season, 8/14 vs. NYM...Was the seventh save of his career.
- Celebrated 10 years of major league service time on July 27.
- Has a 27.00 ERA (6 ER/2.0 IP) against LAD this season...Has a 1.93 ERA (6 ER/28.0 IP) against all other teams.
- Twenty-three of his 41 appearances have been less than 1.0 inning.
- Holding left-handed batters to a .164 (9-for-55) average with 19 strikeouts...Righties are 13-for-56 (.232).
- Atlanta acquired him from the Oakland A's on 4/28 in exchange for cash considerations...Was designated for assignemnt by Atlanta on 5/14 and re-signed to a major league contract on 5/18.

- Was returned from his major league rehabilitation assignment and reinstated from the 60-day injured list 9/12... Was placed on the IL, 7/11, and missed 56 games with a fractured right great toe
- Is 0-0 with 2.61 ERA (10.1 IP) in 12 appearances with ATL this season...Has struck out 14.
- Went 0-1 with a 3.04 ERA (9 ER/26.2 IP) in 22 games with the Strippers this season, and fanned 41 batters while walking just four...In seven games with the Strippers during his rehab assignment, allowed six runs.
- In 2017 made his first Opening Day roster and appeared in 29 games out of the bullpen for Los Angeles (NL) before suffering a full tear of the ulnar collateral ligament in his left elbow that ended his season in August.

Shane Greene • RHP • 6-4 • 200 • 30 yrs • #19

Saves/Opp: 1/3 **Holds:** 10 **1st Batter/Retired:** 23/16 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 4/4

- Is 0-1 with a 4.22 ERA (10 ER/21.1 IP) in 23 games with the Braves, and 0-3 with a 2.28 ERA (15 ER/59.1 IP) in 61 games on the season...He has converted 23 of 28 save opportunities.
- Snapped a streak of 13 consecutive scoreless appearances on 9/7 vs. Washington...Held opponents to just four hits while striking out 14 through 13.0 innings during the streak...Logged his first save with Atlanta, 9/6 vs. WSH.
- Allowed runs in four of his first six appearances with the Braves, and allowed all four inherited runners to score.
- Made his Braves debut on 8/3 vs. CIN, allowing a run in the ninth inning to blow a save.
- Acquired from Detroit on 7/31 in exchange for LHP Joey Wentz and OF Travis Demeritte...At the time ranked fourth in the AL with his 22 saves, while his 1.18 ERA was the second lowest in baseball among qualifying relievers.
- Was 0-2 with 22 saves and a 1.18 ERA (5 ER/38.0 IP) with 43 strikeouts and 12 walks in 38 games out of the bullpen for the Tigers this season.

Luke Jackson • RHP • 6-2 • 210 • 27 yrs • #77

Saves/Opp: 18/25 **Holds:** 9 **1st Batter/Retired:** 67/42 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 26/12

- Is 8-2 with a 3.88 ERA (30 ER/69.2 IP) in 66 games this season...Has converted 18 of his 25 save chances after logging just one career save prior to 2019...His seven blown saves are tied for third most in the majors.
- Has eight wins in relief this season, the most by a Braves reliever since Oscar Villarreal also had eight in 2006.
- Left-handers have just 17 hits in 102 at-bats (.167) against him...Righties are hitting .326 (56-for-172).
- Has fanned 98 batters in 69.2 innings for a career-best 12.66 SO/9.0 IP ratio.
- Earned his 18th save, 8/11 at Miami...Has four saves of at least 1.1 innings.
- Recorded his second consecutive two-inning save, 5/15 vs. STL, to become the first Braves closer with back-to-back two-inning saves since Hall of Famer John Smoltz in 2002

Chris Martin • RHP • 6-8 • 225 • 33 yrs • #51

- Is 1-3 with a 3.48 ERA (21 ER/54.1 IP) in 56 games on the season, including a 4.41 ERA (8 ER/16.1 IP) in 18 games with Atlanta...Has a 1.83 FIP with the Braves.
- Struck out the three hitters he faced on nine straight pitches for an immaculate inning on 9/11 vs. Philadelphia... The first for Atlanta since Buddy Carlisle on July 7, 2007.
