4 Homers at GABP

Atlanta belted four home runs as a team last night, its fourth time doing so at Great American Ball Park since 2023.

Cincinnati has 14 such games in that time, but no other team has more than Atlanta.

Besides the Reds, the rest of the NL Central has combined for five, four-homer games here in that time: Pittsburgh (2), Chicago (1), St. Louis (1), Milwaukee (1).

Since 2023, Matt Olson (8) is tied for the most home runs by a visiting player alongside Oneil Cruz (PIT).

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Reds today conclude a three-game weekend series with the third of six games between the clubs this season...Atlanta will host Cincinnati in its final home series of the regular season, September 22-24, in a three-game homestand.

A Ronald Acuña Jr. (2), Matt Olson and Jorge Mateo each homered for Atlanta last night to clinch the series with a win, 5-2.

A The Braves went 5-2 against the Reds last season, playing games in three different cities: Atlanta, Cincinnati and Bristol, TN...Atlanta has taken the season series from the Reds in four of the last five seasons, playing to a 21-13 record since 2021.

A Since Great American Ball Park opened in 2003, Atlanta has hit the most home runs here (135) of any non-NL Central club...The team has averaged 1.7 home runs per game at this venue.

A LHP Nick Lodolo will start the series finale for the Reds with a 1-1 record and a 5.57 ERA (13 ER/21.0 IP)...In his most recent outing, he spun 6.0 one-run innings at Citi Field against the New York Mets, booking seven strikeouts and earning the win...The Californian has allowed at least one home run in each of his four MLB starts this season...The 6-foot-6 southpaw has made one career start against Atlanta, limiting the Braves to two runs across 6.0 innings at Truist Park on May 8, 2025...He didn't factor into the decision in a Braves win, 5-4.

SPENCER STRIDER: With a perfect 3-0 record and 3.46 ERA (10 ER/26.0 IP), is penciled to start his sixth game of the season...The Braves have won all five of his starts this year.

A Has garnered a whiff rate of 53.8% on his curveball, the second-highest rate among any starting pitcher that has thrown at least 75 curves...Ben Brown (CHC) has generated a whiff on 54.4% of his knuckle curves.

A Born approximately 107 miles from Great American Ball Park in Columbus, OH, Strider will make his third start (4th appearance) against Cincinnati...He's 1-0 all-time against the Reds with a 2.77 ERA (4 ER/13.0 IP), but hasn't faced the team since April 12, 2023...The right-hander has struck out 25 Reds in those 13.0 innings, good for a 17.3 K/9 – his highest against any single MLB opponent.

FACING LEFTIES: The Braves are set to face left-hander Nick Lodolo this afternoon and enter play with an 18-6 record against opposing southpaws...No team in baseball has more wins against lefties this season.

A Dating even further to 2019, no team in baseball has been better against lefties...The Braves have gone 184-105 (.637) versus left-handers in that span...The Dodgers rank second at .624 (204-123).

A Since the start of May, Atlanta has faced 14 left-handed starting pitchers...The club has played to a 11-3 record in those games.

RONALD ACUÑA JR.: Yesterday logged his first multi-home run game this season in a 2-for-4 effort, also drawing a walk...Since going more than a full calendar month without homering (spanning a 12-game IL stint), Acuña Jr. has homered in three straight games for the first time since August 31-September 2, 2023, against the Los Angeles Dodgers...The outfielder has homered in four of his last 12 plate appearances.

A He also stole a pair of bases last night, logging a multi-homer, multi-steal game for the first time in his major league career...He's the only player with such a game this season, and one of just nine to do so in the last 17 seasons...Acuña Jr. became just the 23rd player in modern MLB history (since 1900) to post a multi-homer, multi-steal game.

A The last Brave with multiple homers and multiple steals in a game was Ender Inciarte, who did so on August 17, 2017, at Colorado...Only two other players have done it in modern franchise history: Chipper Jones (1999) and Rafael Furcal (2005).

A The outfielder posted his 15th career multi-home run game, and his first since July 9, 2025, at the Athletics.

A Acuña Jr. has homered in at least four consecutive games on three occasions, most recently from May 14-17, 2023, in games at Toronto and Texas...His career best is five straight games, which he accomplished from August 11-14, 2018, versus Milwaukee and Miami (doubleheader).

A In 42 games through May 27, Acuña Jr. had two home runs, 12 RBI and eight stolen bases...In the three games since then, he has four homers, seven RBI and four steals.

THE RECORD: At 40-19, Atlanta is the first team in Major League Baseball to reach the 40-win mark...The next-closest team, the Los Angeles Dodgers, has played to a 37-21 record.

A This season marks the first time in franchise history that the club has reached 40 wins before the beginning of June...Its previous best was 39 wins, done in 1998.

A By games, Atlanta has won 40 of its first 59 for the fifth time in franchise history...The team also took 40-of-59 in 1953, 1997 and 2003, and set its club record by going 41-18 through 59 games in the 1998 season.

A The Braves have set a new high-water mark at 21 games above .500...The last time the water was this high was at the completion of the 2023 campaign, when the team finished 46 games above .500.

A Since the turn of the century, only five other clubs have suffered two-or-fewer series losses through 59 team games: the Seattle Mariners (2001), St. Louis Cardinals (2013), Los Angeles Dodgers (2020) and New York Yankees (2022, 2024).

Today's Game

Makes his sixth start of the 2026 season and the 83rd of his career today in the finale of a three-game series against the Reds at Great American Ball Park...Atlanta has won each of the first two games of the set.

Strider is 1-0 with a 2.77 ERA (4 ER/13.0 IP) over three career appearances against Cincinnati, two as a starter, with 25 strikeouts.

His lone win against the Reds came on July 2, 2022, when he allowed one run over 6.0 innings with 11 strikeouts in a 4-1 decision.

Enters play 3-0 with a 3.46 ERA (10 ER/26.0 IP) and 32 strikeouts over his first five turns of the season...Atlanta has won all five of his starts.

Earned his third victory of the season in his most recent outing, May 26 at Boston, allowing three runs over 5.0 innings with three walks and five strikeouts on 87 pitches in the 7-6 win at Fenway Park.

His 3.46 ERA (10 ER/26.0 IP) over his first five starts of the season is the third-lowest mark of his career over any season-opening five-game span, trailing a 1.80 ERA (6 ER/30.0 IP) over his first five starts of 2023 and a 2.84 ERA (4 ER/12.2 IP) over his first five appearances of 2022.

Was placed on the 15-day injured list on March 25 with a left oblique strain, missing Atlanta's first 34 games of the season before being activated on May 3.

Made three minor league rehabilitation starts in April, going 0-1 with a 1.42 ERA (2 ER/12.2 IP) and 18 strikeouts between High-A Rome and Triple-A Gwinnett...Posted a 2-0 record and a 3.24 ERA (3 ER/8.1 IP) over three Grapefruit League outings this spring with 11 strikeouts.

The Braves are 53-29 in Strider's career starts.

Owns a .636 winning percentage (42-24) in his career with Atlanta, the third-best mark among pitchers in the Atlanta era (since 1966) to make at least 80 starts for the club...He trails only Hall of Famer Greg Maddux (.688) and Max Fried (.670), and ranks just ahead of Hall of Famer Tom Glavine (.624).

2026

Earned his third win of the season on May 26 at Boston, allowing three runs over 5.0 innings with three walks and five strikeouts on 87 pitches in the 7-6 victory at Fenway Park...Duran and Rafaela hit back-to-back solo home runs in the bottom of the first.

Earned his second victory of the season on May 21 at Miami, allowing three runs over 6.1 innings with two walks and nine strikeouts on 100 pitches in the 9-3 win at loanDepot park...The nine strikeouts were his most in a start this season and the most since he fanned 11 on July 10, 2025 vs. the Athletics.

Received a no-decision on May 15 against Boston, allowing one run over 5.1 innings with three walks and four strikeouts on 84 pitches in Atlanta's 3-2 win in 10 innings at Truist Park.

Earned his first victory of the season on May 9 at Dodger Stadium, allowing one hit over 6.0 scoreless innings with two walks and eight strikeouts on 91 pitches in the 7-2 win at Los Angeles (NL)...It was his first decision since September 27, 2025.

Received a no-decision in his season debut on May 3 at Coors Field, allowing three runs and four hits over 3.1 innings with five walks, six strikeouts and one home run on 87 pitches in the Braves' 11-6 victory at Colorado.

Was activated from the 15-day injured list on May 3 after missing the first 34 games of the season with a left oblique strain.

2025

Went 7-14 with a 4.45 ERA (62 ER/125.1 IP) in 23 starts, his first season back from internal brace surgery on his right elbow.

Made his 2025 season debut on April 16 at Toronto, allowing two runs and five hits over 5.0 innings...It was his first start in 376 days, dating to April 5, 2024.

Was placed on the 15-day IL on April 21 (backdated to April 18) with a strained right hamstring and was activated on May 19.

Reached the 500th strikeout of his career on July 18 by punching out Toronto's Addison Barger.

Became the ninth pitcher in the Modern Era to reach 500 strikeouts in 68 appearances or fewer, and the first to do so since Cleveland's Shane Bieber in 2021.

The other pitchers on that list: José Fernández, Yu Darvish, Mark Prior, Kerry Wood, Hideo Nomo, Dwight Gooden and Herb Score.

Strider was the only pitcher in that group with more than three relief appearances in his first 68 games (13).

Reached the 600th strikeout of his career on August 25 against Miami, becoming the fastest primary starter in Modern Era history (by innings pitched) to the milestone.

Closed the year on a 2-2 run with a 2.79 ERA (9 ER/29.0 IP), 26 strikeouts and three quality starts over his final five outings.

His 4.45 ERA was the highest single-season mark of his career (minimum three appearances).

Career Recap

Drafted by Atlanta in the fourth round of the 2020 MLB June Amateur Draft out of Clemson University...Cleveland had previously selected him in the 35th round of the 2017 draft out of Christian Academy of Knoxville (Tenn.), but he did not sign.

Underwent Tommy John surgery in February 2019 and missed the entire collegiate season.

Made his MLB debut in 2021, appearing in two relief games for the Braves at age 22.

Was named to the 2023 National League All-Star team in his first full season as a starter.

Finished fourth in the 2022 NL Rookie of the Year voting after going 11-5 with a 2.67 ERA, 202 strikeouts and 10 quality starts in 31 appearances (20 starts).

Led the National League in strikeouts in 2023 with 281, going 20-5 with a 3.86 ERA in 32 starts.

Made two starts in 2024 before being placed on the 15-day IL on April 7 with a right elbow sprain...Dr. Keith Meister performed surgery to repair the ulnar collateral ligament with an internal brace on April 12, 2024 in Arlington, Texas.
