TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs **Joanna Schimmel's Cubs** and the sixth game (2-3) of a 9-game homestand that includes a pair of series losses vs **Bal** (1-2) and **Phi** (1-2).

ALL-STARS: RHP **Chase Burns** and INF **Sal Stewart** have been named to the 2026 National League All-Star team.

- It's the first career All-Star selection for both players.
- 2026 marks the third straight year in which Cin has multiple All-Stars.
- Burns** and **Stewart** are the third set of teammates in Reds history to each earn an All-Star selection at age 23 or younger in the same season (also **Johnny Bench & Wayne Simpson** in 1970, and **Frank Robinson & Vada Pinson** in 1959).

- ★ CHASE BURNS ★
- Is the third Reds pitcher in club history with 11 or more wins and 118 or more strikeouts before the All-Star break, joining **Edinson Volquez** (12w, 126k in 2008) and **Jim Maloney** (13w, 121k in 1963).
 - He leads the majors with 15 starts of 2 runs or fewer.
 - Is 10-0 with a 2.58 ERA over his last 14 starts...is the first Reds pitcher since 1985 to win 10 or more consecutive decisions during a single season.
 - The Reds are 14-4 this season when he pitches, including team victories in each of his last 6 apps and in 10 of his last 11.
 - He ranks among Major League starting pitcher leaders in wins (11, 1st), ERA (2.54, 7th), runs allowed per game (1.61, T2nd), opponents' batting avg (.206, 7th), and strikeouts (118, T13th).
 - Owns a 31.7% miss rate (819 swings/260 misses), 7th-best in MLB.
 - His 4.3 WAR leads the Reds and ranks T2nd among all Major League pitchers.
 - Will be 23 years, 179 days old on the day of the All-Star Game (7/14), the youngest Reds All-Star pitcher since **Mike LaCoss** in 1979 (23 years, 48 days).

- ★ SAL STEWART ★
- Finished second in the player balloting for NL third basemen (228 votes; **Max Muncy** 555 votes).
 - Was National League Rookie of the Month for April.
 - Is the seventh rookie in Reds history to make the All-Star team, the first since **Scott Williamson** in 1999, and the first position player since **Chris Sabo** in 1988.
 - Leads the Reds with 19 HR, 64 RBI, 89 H, 45 walks, and 40 XBH.
 - His 19 HR before the All-Star break are more than any other Reds rookie in franchise history (first ASG was in 1933).
 - Ranks among all Major League leaders with 64 RBI.
 - Joined **Jim Greengrass** (1953) and **Tony Cuccinello** (1930) as just the third Reds rookie since 1920 to have multiple months with at least 20 RBI (26 in April, 22 in June).
 - Became the sixth Reds batter since 1900 with at least 20 HR through his first 100 Major League games, joining **Adam Dunn** (27), **Hank Sauer** (26), **Aristides Aquino** (25), **Frank Robinson** (25), and **Bernie Carbo** (20).
 - Leads all NL Rookies in HR, RBI, 2B (21), BB, XBH, and TB (167).
 - Is the eighth Red to ever earn an All-Star nod at age 22 or younger, the first since teammate **Elly De La Cruz** in 2024.

GENO TIES BARRY: 3b **Eugenio Suárez** on Tue off **Phi's Zack Wheeler** belted his 198th home run as a Cincinnati Red, tying him with National Baseball Hall of Famer **Barry Larkin** for 11th on the club's all-time list...next up is **Eric Davis**, who ranks 10th with 203 HR as a Red.

SERIES NOTES: The Reds and **Cubs** are meeting for the second time this season...**Chc** swept the 4-game series at **Wrigley Field** from 5/4-5/7...that series featured 3 straight walkoff wins by the **Cubs** (5/4-5/6)...it was the first time **Chc** swept Cin in a 4-game series since 8/23-8/26, 2018 (also at **Wrigley Field**)...it was **Chc's** first sweep of Cin of any length since 2022. .

- Last year, Cin went 8-5 vs **Chc** for its third straight season series victory.
- The Reds are 196-194 vs **Chc** since 2003 and 93-112 since 2014...are 102-87 (.540) all time at **Great American Ball Park** and 469-505 (.482) all-time at **Wrigley Field**.

BRING 'EM ON: The Reds own a 28-33 record (.459) this season against opponents entering play with a .500-or-better winning percentage, but are 20-33 (.377) vs teams currently at or above .500.

- Have dropped 30 of their last 43 games vs teams entering play with a .500-or-better winning percentage.
- Are 22-17 (.564) vs teams currently under .500.
- Have the second-toughest remaining schedule in the majors based on opponents' winning percentage (.532; **NYM** .538).

STRUGGLING AGAINST PEERS: The Reds are 5-20 (.200) vs their NL Central counterparts and 22-37 (.373) against all National League opponents.

- Conversely, Cin owns the majors' seventh-best record vs American League teams (20-13, .606).

TOUGH SLEDDING: The Reds have dropped 8 of their last 11 games and 11 of their last 16 games.

- Went 20-11 (.645) to begin the year...entered May a season-high 9 games over .500 and in first place in the NL Central (+1.0)...ended the month of May 2 games over .500 and in fifth place (-6.0).
- Beginning 5/1, have gone 22-39 (.361).
- Beginning 6/1, have gone 12-22 (.353).

BLANKETY BLANK: The Red have been shut out 8 times this season, including twice on this homestand (7/3 & 7/9)...**SD** has been blanked 10 times to lead the majors while **SF** ranks second (9 times).

- Last night's 1-0 loss marked the 15th time this season the Reds have been held to 1 run or none, and the 33rd time they've been held to fewer than 3 runs in a game.

LAST TIME OUT: Was activated from the 60-day injured list on Sat, 7/4 and made his season debut in that afternoon's 8-5 loss vs Bal (3.1ip, 7h, 8r/8er, 4bb, 7k, 1hr, 1wp, 89TP).

- Was just the third time in his career that he allowed 8 or more runs in a game, the first time since 8/20/23 vs Tor (9).
- Matched his career high with 8 earned runs allowed.
- Produced 15 swings-and-misses (46 swings).
- Threw first-pitch strikes to 10 of 20 batters.
- Allowed as many as 11 baserunners for the first time since 10/1/23 at StL (12).
- Threw 24 pitches in the 1st inning, 18 in the 2nd, 18 in the 3rd, and 29 in the 4th.
- 5 of the 7 hits he allowed came vs left-handed hitters.

ON THE INJURED LIST: Missed Cin's first 87 games of the season while recovering from 3/11 surgery to remove bone chips from his right elbow.

- Made 3 rehabilitation appearances, including his first one on 6/18 for R-ACL Reds (vs R-ACL Cubs), and 2 more with AAA-Louisville (6/23 & 6/28 vs St. Paul)...did not allow a run in any of his 3 rehab apps (14.1ip, 5h, 13k, .106/.143/.170).

2026 SPRING TRAINING: Made 1 appearance for the Reds during Spring Training (2/28 at Mil; 1.0ip, 5h, 4r/4er, 1bb, 37TP).

2025: Went 7-4 with a 2.76 ERA in 19 starts.

- Was 1 of 4 Reds to be recognized as a finalist for the All-MLB Team, along with SS Elly De La Cruz, LHP Andrew Abbott, and RHP Emilio Pagan.
- On 3/27 vs SF made his second career Opening Day start (also: 2023).
- Collected his 500th career strikeout on 4/2 vs Tex and his 600th career strikeout on 9/13 at Ath.
- Pitched a complete-game shutout on 9/18 vs Chc...carried a no-hitter into the 7th inning of that game.
- Made his Postseason debut as the Reds' starting pitcher in Game 1 of the National League Wild Card Series at LAD.
- Twice was on the injured list (5/8-5/23 and 6/4-8/13) with a right groin strain.

2024 ALL-STAR: In 2024, was a National League All-Star, his first career selection...suffered the 5-3 loss in the Midsummer Classic (1ip, 2h, 2r/2er, 1hr, 18TP)...entered the 3-3 game in the fifth inning and retired his first 2 batters on flyouts (Det's Riley Greene and Tex' Cory Seager) before allowing a single to Bal's Anthony Santander and a go-ahead, 2-run HR to the game's MVP, Bos' Jarren Duran...finished the inning with Cle's David Fry popping out to shortstop.

Struck out Bal's Jeremiah Jackson in the 2nd inning on 7/5 for his 500th Major League strikeout...became the third-fastest Reds pitcher by appearances (87) to reach that milestone since 1893 (when the mound moved to its current distance), behind Hunter Greene (74g) and Luis Castillo (79g).

HEATING UP

Since allowing 7 runs in 4.2 innings on 6/17 vs NYM, has pitched to a 0.60 ERA over his last 3 starts (15.0ip, 1r/1er, 7bb, 14k, .170/.279/.208).
