

BOSTON RED SOX (11-10) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (11-9) APRIL 20, 2024 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA - 4:05 EDT - GAME #21/HOME #7 RHP KUTTER CRAWFORD (0-0, 0.42 ERA) vs. RHP MITCH KELLER (2-1, 4.50 ERA)

THE PIRATES:...have lost a season-high four straight games...Opened their seven-game homestand with an 8-2 loss last night against the Red Sox...Began the season 5-0 for the first time since 1983...Swept a season-opening four-game series on the road for the first time since doing so in 1903 in Cincinnati.

ABOUT TODAY'S STARTER: Mitch Keller gets the start this afternoon in the middle game of this weekend series against the Red Sox...Keller has won each of his last two starts, allowing a combined four runs in 13.0 innings, since losing for the only time this season on April 3 at Washington.

<u>GIMME FIVE:</u> Mitch Keller tossed 7.0 innings Sunday afternoon again 5.0 innings in a game...It's the longest active streak in all of MLB com Burnett made 49 straight starts of at least 5.0 innings from May 8, 2

HOME COOKIN': Mitch Keller will make his second home start of the season this afternoon...The 28-year-old Keller is 8-3 with a 2.91 ERA (96.0ip/31er) in 15 starts at PNC Park since the beginning of last season...Keller's 2.91 home ERA since the beginning of last year is the 10th-lowest in all of MLB among pitchers with at least 90.0 innings...Logan Webb has the lowest home ERA in that time (2.15).

<u>REYNOLDS REWIND:</u> Five years ago today Bryan Reynolds made his big league debut after being promoted from Triple-A Indianapolis... Reynolds made his debut as a starter in center field while batting fifth in the lineup...He singled off San Francisco's Derek Holland in his second at-bat while the Pirates beat the Giants 3-1 in a rain-shortened five-inning contest...Reynolds went on to lead all Major League rookies in doubles (37) and set the single-season club rookie record (the previous mark of 35 was established by Paul Waner in 1926).

GIVE A LIKE TO ALIKA: Alika Williams extended his hitting streak to five games on Friday with his pinch-hit triple in the ninth inning...Williams has gone 5-for-12 (.417) with a double

and triple during his current five-game hitting streak... The 25-year-old Williams is tied for second in the National League with two triples...Washington's CJ Abrams leads the way with three.

OUR FAVORITE FRIEND: Joey Bart has two home runs in three games with the Pirates, making him the ninth Pirate since at least 1900 to record twoplus homers in his first three games with the team...Prior to Bart, the last Pirate to accomplish that was Derrek Lee, who went deep twice in his first three games in 2011...Bart has also recorded five RBI in his first three games with Pittsburgh...That has already matched his total from 30 games last season with the Giants.

KEEPING UP WITH CUTCH'S HITS: Andrew McCutchen enters today's action with 999 career singles with the Pirates...Among his 1572 hits with the Bucs, 313 have been doubles, 44 have been triples and 216 have been home runs... Arky Vaughan is 10th on the club's all-time list with 1,218 singles.

DOWN ON THE FARM: Nick Gonzales extended his on-base streak to 18 games last night after going 2-for-5 with a double and RBI...Gonzales' 18-game on-base streak is tied for the longest active streak in all of Minor League Baseball...Coming into today, he ranks second among all players at the Triple-A level in batting (.387) and first in hits (29).

ON THE MEND: Yasmani Grandal went 1-for-3 while serving as the designated hitter in his third game on rehab last night with Triple-A Indianapolis...He is now 1-for-8 with two RBI and 12.0 innings caught on rehab with Indianapolis...Grandal has been on the 10-day injured list since March 28 with left foot plantar fasciitis.
